'We must learn to spend our money in places where it is not the only thing about us that is welcome...together we can create change in the world.'

I am honored to be featured by the Houston Gay & Lesbian Yellow Pages as a role model for the gay and lesbian community. Being a role model is a daunting responsibility, a tremendous challenge and a supreme compliment all at the same time.

I have spent more than 15 years working, learning and growing in the gay/lesbian civil rights movement, following my own mentors and role models. It has been difficult. It has been rewarding. Not everyone can be publicly gay, or even openly gay. But each of us can contribute.

The world is having to face the fact that we are not going away, and that many of us are out of the closet to stay. Some don't like our "lifestyle." But polls reflect a growing acceptance of our rights—to serve in the military, to work in the profession of our choice, to have legal protections for our families.

In more and more cities the new role models are gay and lesbian elected officials. African-Americans, Hispanics, Asians know that they can best be represented by someone who has lived their unique life experiences. A black lesbian in Seattle, an HIV+gay manin New York, and a gay former school teacher in Austin are among more than 100 openly gay elected officials from around this country. We may still offer our

votes to good non-gay candidates, but we will elect our own as well. We must learn the power of the voting booth.

You probably picked up this particular publication because you'd rather support gay, lesbian and gay-friendly businesses whenever you have a choice. I feel my money goes further when I patronize one of these businesses. Many of them donate money back to the com-

AIDS Foundation Houston, Inc. 524-AIDS

AIDS Foundation Houston, Inc., a not for-profit 501 (c) (3) corporation founded in 1982, was the first community-based organization established in the Houston area solely dedicated to HIV related issues.

The mission of AFH is to reduce transmission of HIV through prevention education, to empower people living with HIV, their families and significant other through the provision of social services, and to promote community involvement in HIV issues through volunteerism.

The AIDS Hotline provides free, confidential HIV/AIDS information & referrals and is operated by volunteers - 524-AIDS. Office hours: 9:00 am - 6 pm, Mon-Fri. Telephone: 623-6796.

The Dizinger Foundation 3701 Montrose Blvd. 522-8660

The Dizinger Foundation is a 501 (c) (3) tax-exempt organization established in 1992 to assist and educate people affected by or afflicted with AIDS. The foundation's goal is community-wide recognition and involvement; to help those in need with love and compassion, so that people who have AIDS know that they are neither alone nor forgotten. The Foundation was

formed to analyze the needs of the community in order to plan for immediate eradication of voids in services. Dizinger Foundation is making a conscious effort to make AIDS awareness and awareness of our programs available to many diverse groups. Additionally, the face of AIDS is ever-changing, and adjustments must be made in both existing and new programs to accommodate involvement from different groups. AIDS knows no social, racial nor economic boundaries, and HIV service providers must be equipped to deal with people from a variety of backgrounds. We are obligated to have bilingual and bicultural-competent staff members to meet any language problems that may arise. Additionally, different ethnic backgrounds must be considered at all phases of future planning, whether it involves location of programs or services offered.

Two programs have been formulated in our short existence. The Dizinger/FIRM co-op helps family members infected and affected by HIV disease and we provide non-perishables and nonconsumables to those not receiving enough from Food Stamps alone. We make deliveries and hold nutritional seminars. The other program is educational outreach, facilitated by the Houston NAMES Project (The AIDS Memorial Quilt). Through educational outreach, we hope to give seminars at the corporate level, to community groups and to schools, (we are an official educational program of H.I.S.D.) A dual goal is anticipated from outreach: understanding of the disease and how it is transmitted 2. compassion for those who are afflicted.

We're busy, indeed, and moving forward rapidly. Our theory is that provision of services for this group in need, needs to be prompt, as one thing a person with AIDS does not have is *time*.

Jewish Family Service PO Box 20548 Houston 77225

Jewish Family Service offers a full range of counseling and environmental services to Jewish people with an HIV infection (HIV+, ARC, AIDS) as well as to their families, lovers, care givers and friends. Fees are based on ability to pay. Direct Services: Counseling, Support Group, Financial Aid, Housekeeping, Psychiatric Evaluation & Treatment, Stress Management, Job Placement, Funeral Planning, Family Counseling, Hospital Outreach, Case Management and Networking with Out-of-Town Services.

Miss Camp America Foundation, Inc. PO Box 742 Bellaire 77402 (713) 520-STAR

The purpose of the Miss Camp America Foundation is to raise funds to donate to 501 (c) (3) AIDS related charities that provide medical, housing and other necessities to individuals that have contracted the AIDS virus.

We sponsor about five fund-raising events each year culminating with our major fund-raiser, the annual MISS CAMP AMERICA PAGEANT every September, currently at the Houston Music Hall.

For twenty four years, Miss Camp America has brought to Houston audiences the final word in theatre—CAMP, providing for an evening of fun, laughter, choreography, oversized wigs and head pieces size 15 heels and legs (hairy,

of course). The ultimate spoof on The Miss America Pageant, Miss Camp America was founded in 1969 as a social club whose members had a "natural" penchant for theatrics.

The Montrose Counseling Center is a non-profit organization which provides quality and affordable comprehensive mental health services. The Center was founded in 1978 and is dedicated to serving the needs of all Houston residents. with particular emphasis on those of the gay, lesbian, and bisexual communities. The Center provides outpatient counseling and psychotherapy in 3 program areas: Chemical Dependency Treatment, HIV/ AIDS, and LIFE. The LIFE program deals with issues such as relationships, co-dependency, stress, grief, and depression. Services are provided to individuals, couples, and families, as well as in group settings.

Omega House is a residential hospice for medically indigent, terminal-phase AIDS patients. The hospice provides psychosocial support in addition to palliative medical care. Omega House is a non-profit (501) (c) (3) organization and registered as a special care facility by the Texas Department of Health. Residents are admitted without regard of their ability to pay.

NLAH serves the leather/sm/fetish community and is an organization, for all individuals who value sharing, feedback, education and comradeship with others regardless of sexual orientation. Emphasizing education and safety, the NLAH sponsors educational/training programs as well as social and charitable events and furnishes speakers to interested groups in Houston's heterosexual and homosexual communities.
