The La Ronde Room at The Fontainebleau Hotel in Miami Beach has been the Florida home of the country's biggest stars for years. The first time I ever went there was in 1960 to see Patti Page, then "The Singing Rage". I was back in 1967 to see Eddie Fisher and more recently in 1972 to see Ann Margaret. These and many other greats in the world of entertainment have appeared here at The Superstar Theatre in Miami's best known hotel. Now it is also the home of some of the nation's top stars in the field of female impersonation and their show, Jewel Box "76".

Producers Keith Landon, Rene Rodriguez and Irving Warshowsky have brought drag out of the closet and onto the front porch. Those of us who are regulars at the gay clubs have known for a long time that some of the finest talent in the entertainment world can be seen there regularly. Now the general public can see it too in one of the country's best known showrooms.

Jewel Box "76" is different from the acts you will see in your local club in only a few respects. The first and probably the biggest difference is the setting. The big stage at the La Ronde Room, the excellent acoustics, lighting, and sound enable the cast to do things that they could never do in a smaller, less equipped showplace. The second major differ-

ence is the fact that they do the same show night after night. This enables the performers to perfect their parts and to make improvements in the acts as they go along. The third difference is that the performers here are all among the best in the business and true professionals. And they give a professional, top notch performance every night.

The show stars Emore', Michael St. Laurent and Logan Carter (better known to gay audiences as Roxanne Russell). The beautiful Bobbie Lake and Rachaell Santoni, and four attractive and talented dancers, Ernie Michaels, Matthew Monroe, Tony McIntosh, and Dan Storey, complete the cast. They appear in a series of scenes recreating popular performances of several outstanding female entertainment figures.

Almost every scene is a production number in that it involves a set, props and backup performers and/or dancers. The opening number is called "Follies and Chorus Line" and includes a lot of dancing by the cast while the stars parade about the stage in elaborate costumes reminiscent of Las Vegas Revues.

Then follow the star's impressions of eight top female entertainers. Michael St. Laurent appears as Liza Minnelli, Ann Miller and Bette Midler. Emore' gives her versions of Josephine Baker, Diana Ross and Shirley Bassey, and Logan Carter appears as Carmen Miranda and Marilyn Monroe.


CONTEST REPORT




Richard Conway Crowned Gay America Daytona Beach


These sequences are the heart of the show and all are done extremely well. The sets, props and supporting performers add to the talented performances of the stars to make each a memorable experience. 


