**A Tale As Old As  
Time Breaks Box  
Office Records At  
Houston's Music Hall**

**B**uild a live stage musical based on one of the most popular and highest-grossing animated films in history, and they will come. And they are coming, in droves! Disney's *Beauty and the Beast*, the first venture of Walt Disney Theatrical Productions, is currently being presented at Houston's Music Hall courtesy of Theatre Under the Stars. The latest press release from TUTS, dated Wednesday, December 8, announced that they had sold almost \$400,000 in tickets, which wins the record as "the second largest number of legitimate theatre tickets sold in a single day anywhere in the U.S., including Broadway (the one exception being the first-day sale of tickets to the Broadway production *Phantom of the Opera*).

The burning question now pursing your lips is, "Does the production warrant such unprecedented sales?" The answer is a resounding "You bet your Beast!"

Walt Disney Pictures' *Beauty and the Beast* was the first animated film to receive an Oscar nomination for Best Picture. When the film was released in 1990, *New York Times* drama critic Frank Rich lamented, perhaps prophetically, that "the best new Broadway musical is a movie!"

*Beauty and the Beast* employs an Academy Award-winning score by composer Alan Menken (*Little Shop of Horrors*, *Aladdin*, *The Little Mermaid*), featuring songs by him and the late Howard Ashman (including the Oscar-winning title number). Additionally, the musical's score features another song by Ashman and Menken, "Human Again," that was not used in the film, plus five new songs—"No Matter What," "Don't Be Afraid of Love," "Maison des Lunes," "Home" and "If I Can't Love Her"—written with lyricist Tim Rice (*Evita*, *Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dream Coat*, *Jesus Christ Superstar*, *Chess*). The book for the musical was written by Linda Woolverton (*The Incredible Journey*, *Aladdin*), who also wrote the screenplay for the film.

The traditional ingredients for a Broadway musical are a hummable score, a good book, lively dancing, beautiful sets and costumes and exceptional singing and acting talent. *Beauty and the Beast* serves up this recipe and then some.

Now for the special effects. Fantasmaglorious, eye-popping and brilliantly executed. The good news is, unlike some recent Broadway musicals, *Beauty and the Beast* is not totally dependent on its spe-

cial effects; they're an added bonus. The dazzling "Be Our Guest" production number is straight out of the Ziegfeld Follies. The other good news—and this is pretty major—is that the producers of the stage *Beauty* have captured the sweet, fairy-tale charm of the animated version beautifully.

As Mrs. Potts sings in the title number, *Beauty and the Beast* is based on a "tale as old as time," but an enduring one. A curse is put on a young prince to teach him that "beauty is within," and he is turned into a beast. His household servants, also cursed, are turned into inanimate objects. If he can feel true love and have it returned before a rose loses all its petals, the curse will be broken. But, unless you've lived in a time warp for the last 100 years, you surely know the store line, so I won't go on.

Robert Jess Roth, a New York stage director who has spent the past three years developing projects for Disney, deserves great praise for his courage in following in such well-honored footsteps and his exceptional ability in doing so. He has come up with some outstanding "stage pictures" and helped create many lovable and refreshing characters.

If this production does travel to the Big Apple, as currently scheduled, there should be, with one exception, *no* cast changes. For this is surely a dream cast if I've ever seen one.

Susan Egan, who recently toured with Tommy Tune's *Bye Bye Birdie*, essays the book-loving heroine Belle with enchanting charm, and her singing is crystal perfect. Tony Award nominee Terrence Mann is by turns scary, funny, sad, tender and altogether heartwrenching as the Beast, also registering a vibrant singing voice. Burke Moses as Belle's village suitor Gaston, with his enormous pompadour, hunky body and super good looks, performs cartoonish machismo sensationally. His booming baritone is clear and strong.

Kenny Raskin as Lefou, Gaston's sidekick who's forever getting slapped and kicked around, is a scream; he's a scene stealer. Beth Fowler as Mrs. Potts (the teapot) is wonderful, and sells her version of the title song with great aplomb.

But my heart went out to two very gifted actors who were a huge delight, Heath Lamberts as Cogsworth (the clock) and Gary Beach (the candelabrum). Lamberts was all a twit and fidget and fuss, and magnificently so. Beach brought to mind Jack Haley, the Tin Man in *The Wizard of Oz*, with his polish, charm, soul, finesse and flair. He is the consummate actor's actor. My crystal ball reveals Tony nominations in their futures.

Adequate, but not on a par with the rest of the cast, is Tom Bosley as Belle's father Maurice. Bosley, of *Happy Days*, *Murder She Wrote* and *Father Dowling Mysteries* fame, was not imbued with the same infectious charm as his cohorts, and his one song, "No Matter What," was a hard sell for a non-singer.

A golden citation to Jim Steinmeyer for his thrilling special effects.

Laurels and kudos to Frank M. Young, founder and Executive Director of Theatre Under the Stars, for his commitment in world-premiering *Beauty and the Beast* in Houston. It should have a healthy life in New York, but remember, the Bayou City had it first.

*Beauty and the Beast* has been extended through January 9 at Houston's Music Hall, so—if there are any seats left by the time this review comes out—let the adults take the hand of the child you and journey to this magical experience. You'll both have a wonderful time.

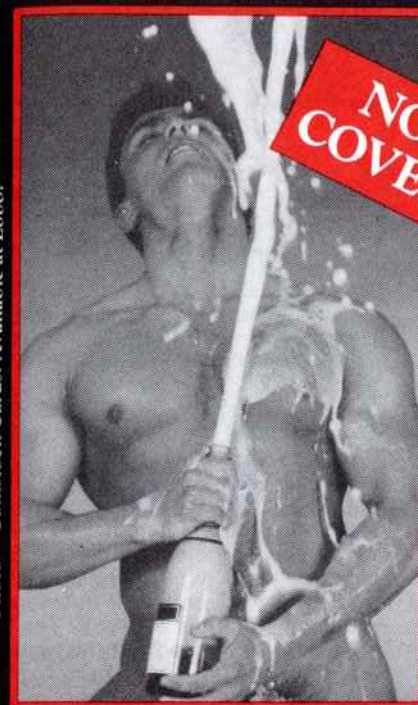

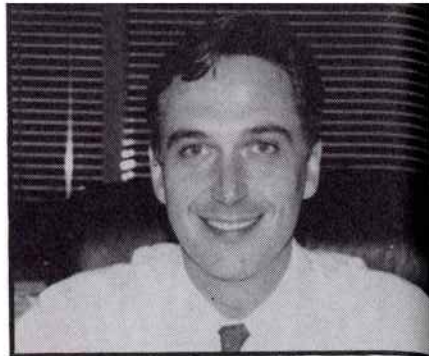

## Questions & Answers on HIV

**I am HIV-positive and have developed a terrible problem with diarrhea. I am afraid I'll lose more weight if I'm unable to stop it. What sort of medicines should I try?**

Diarrhea can be a major problem in HIV-positive people. The severity can range from simple nuisance to devastating debilitation. You should report any diarrhea lasting more than several days to your doctor's office. If the diarrhea is particularly severe or accompanied by fever or abdominal pain, you should report it immediately. Severe diarrhea may rapidly result in dehydration and electrolyte imbalance.

If your diarrhea is persistent, it needs to be evaluated. Such evaluation usually starts with collection of stool specimens which your doctor will have analyzed for certain bacterial and parasitic infections. If no cause for the diarrhea is found with these tests, the next step is to undergo an examination of the colon with a fiber optic scope. This is an uncomfortable test but very well tolerated, and can be done on an outpatient basis. During this examination, the doctor looks directly at the colon for any abnormalities. Any such abnormal-appearing areas are biopsied and sometimes cultured. If no answer is obtained from this test, sometimes performing a similar fiber optic examination of the stomach and upper small intestine may yield a diagnosis. Also, some medications can cause diarrhea as a side effect. A careful review of the medications you are currently taking may reveal one of them to be the culprit.



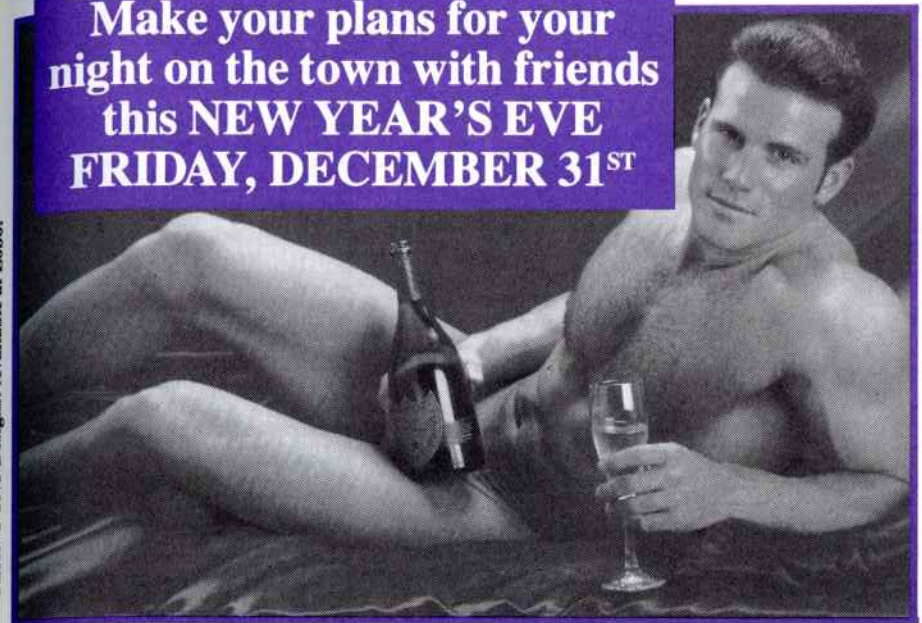
Unfortunately, despite exhaustive testing, many times no definite cause for chronic diarrhea can be found. In these cases, symptomatic treatment may be the best that can be offered. It is uncommon that we are unable to reduce the frequency and severity of the diarrhea to a tolerable level. Certain foods, such as dairy products, may have to be eliminated from the diet. The addition of fiber-containing medications such as Metamucil may be helpful in giving stools more form. Drugs to slow the motility of the gastrointestinal tract, such as Lomotil or Imodium, may reduce the number of stools. The use of specially formulated nutritional supplements, like Liposorb or Nutren, may be necessary to avoid malnutrition. Occasionally, intravenous nutrition may become necessary to reverse the weight loss and malnutrition brought about by chronic diarrhea.

**My doctor wants me to have the hepatitis vaccine. I am HIV-negative and don't see why I need this. What do you recommend?** There are several forms of viral hepatitis. Viral hepatitis B is of particular concern for gay men. This form of hepatitis is transmitted by contact with bodily fluids of an infected person. Among gay men, sexual contact with an infected person is the most common mode of transmission. This infection is much more easily transmitted than HIV. Therefore, the safe sex rules generally touted to protect against HIV infection may not protect against hepatitis B infection. The disease may also be transmitted by exposure to infected blood.

products or intravenous needles. It is also occasionally transmitted by eating contaminated raw or undercooked shellfish. When a person is infected with the hepatitis B virus, the symptoms may range from none at all to clinically obvious hepatitis. Therefore, there are a significant number of people who are unaware that they have had hepatitis B. Unfortunately, some of these people become chronic carriers of the hepatitis B virus and continue to be contagious. Such individuals can transmit the virus unknowingly.

Hepatitis B is considered serious because it can lead to chronic liver disease, including cirrhosis of the liver and even liver cancer. Regardless of your HIV status, if you are sexually active, you should be vaccinated against hepatitis B. This generally requires testing before vaccination to be sure that you have not unknowingly been exposed to the virus in the past. If you have not, this is definitely a case of an ounce of prevention being worth a pound of cure.

**It's holiday time and I know I'm going to be tempted by Christmas cheer. I'm on several prescription drugs. Can I safely have a few cocktails?**

Alcohol itself can be considered a drug and, as such, it has the potential to interact with other drugs. The effect of certain medications can be accentuated by alcohol. This is particularly true of sedating medications such as Valium, Xanax, Ativan, sleeping pills and some antidepressants. The effect of other medications may be diminished by alcohol. Flagyl and Anabuse are among the medications which may cause a severe reaction when mixed with alcohol.

If the prescription bottle issued by the pharmacist is labeled with a caution against alcohol, I would advise following that caution and avoiding alcohol for that particular medication. Even over-the-counter medications can have interactions, so be sure to read the label for warnings. If you have questions about a particular medication, check with your doctor before mixing it with alcohol.

## RELATIONSHIPS:

### NO PAIN, NO GAIN?

Why do so many of us shy away from relationships with people who are, in most ways, the "ideal" we've always sought out, and instead chase after those who are "high-maintenance"? Is there some unspoken challenge that needs to be met before we can become seriously interested in another?

I've heard lots of guys state, "I'm just not ready for a relationship right now." I don't know about the rest of the world, but I don't recall ever waking up one morning and saying, "Okay, today I'm ready for a relationship." My experience has taught me that a relationship with the right person will come along at the least convenient time and, most likely, under the most inconvenient of circumstances. The old "Cinderella"-type romance, while a nice fantasy, just does not happen very often in the real world.

A person who comes on very strong at the start of a relationship, but cannot resist closing their heart as soon as the other partner has opened theirs, can be thought of as having an "addiction to attraction." People who tend to behave in this manner can be referred to as "emotional distancers" because they don't go around maliciously hurting others, they do seriously want committed relationships. What they lack are the spiritual and emotional skills that would enable them to settle down. As soon as such a person sees human faults and weaknesses in someone they are attracted/addicted to, they run away, often without any rational explanation.

People who are so "addicted" are very often looking for perfection, which is a subconscious way for them to sabotage their own relationships and make sure that love never has a chance to blossom in their lives. The initial "high" of romance can be so tantalizing that the real work of growth, which needs to follow the initial attraction phase, can seem dull and boring, making it appear impossible to commit to the other person. As soon as that person is



seen to be a real human being with genuine feelings, the "addict" becomes what may be called an "emotional distancer," one whose ego is somehow repelled and wants to find somewhere else to play.

Why are we attracted to such relationships? Is it because we're drawn to the illusion of "meaning"? Sometimes a person who apparently has nothing to offer comes on as though they are offering the world. They tend to be so dissociated from their own feelings that they have become highly skilled performers, subconsciously playing whatever "part" our fantasies prescribe. But ultimately, the responsibility for the pain is still our own.

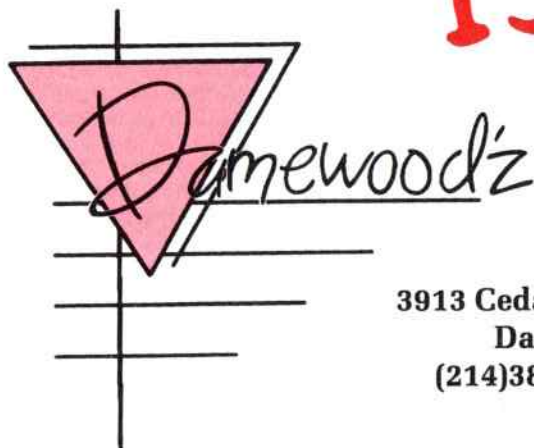
If we hadn't been looking so hard for someone to make us feel complete, we would not have been vulnerable to the "lie" these types of people often represent. At the end of a relationship with someone like this, we feel as if we've taken a drug—we've had a fast and very exciting ride, and it seems as though something meaningful was happening between the two of us. Then the emotional drug supply is cut off by one person, often quickly and without reason, and the emotional pursuer ends up crashing and burning in an emotional upheaval. The person left behind will often experience days or weeks of emotional torment, while his or her counterpart is out having fun. What appeared to one person as meaningful and special is now realized to have been nothing meaningful at all.

We can see that this kind of thing is not good, it's not healthy and we don't want to do it again. But, until we learn from past relationships and allow those experiences to guide our future, and until we break this behavior pattern, we will continue to fall into these kinds of relationships. We really do deserve better treatment!

The question people so often ask themselves at the end of one of these relationships is, "How could I have been so stupid?" Once we've had enough of self-pity, we will admit to ourselves that we were not

really stupid after all—we suspected all along that something was “not quite right” and that it was an emotional drug we were enjoying. But we allowed it to continue because it made us feel good and happy. Often, we should be able to recognize exactly what the game is with these types of people shortly after we meet them, yet we’re often so attracted to them and the emotional high they represent that we are willing to pretend we did not notice the red flags for a week, a day or however long the affair lasted. Denial is much easier than reality.

The fact that someone told us, “You’re such a wonderful person!” or “How lucky I am to be out with someone like you!” after knowing us for only a short time should set off a flashing red alert. These statements are often based on superficial observations that actually have little meaning. We can be so hungry to hear these words because our own egos are starved for some special attention—and hearing such words can make us put aside our rational considerations.

When we become “ego starved,” we often run desperately after whoever comes along and happens to know the right words. Don’t wear your heart on your sleeve—but don’t keep it so tightly covered that no one can reach you. Protect yourself from needless hurt and pain; no matter how right it feels at the time, if it is right now, it’ll be right in a few weeks or a few months.

The road to a successful relationship is often rocky and full of potholes, but those who are willing to make an honest effort will find that the “emotional pursuers” really are the pot of gold at the end of the rainbow. And, rather than our needing the “emotional distancer” to feel complete, it’s the emotional distancer who ultimately will realize that he or she needs us.

Although there is some comfort in the familiar, ending our destructive behaviors and relationship patterns can only help us to begin conquering our fears. By eliminating bad habits and replacing them with good ones, we will begin to feel better about ourselves and regain our self-respect. As our self-confidence grows, so, too, will our belief in future companionship. We must learn to accept that we deserve to love and to be loved.

## HOUSTON CAUCUS TO CHOOSE OFFICERS JANUARY 5

*All Executive Positions, Four Seats  
On Board Left Open.*

HOUSTON — All four executive posts and four board seats will be up for grabs when the Houston Gay & Lesbian Political Caucus holds its election meeting on January 5 at the Stouffer Presidente Hotel. Terri Richardson, who has served as Caucus president since winning that post in a special election held last September, opted against running for reelection and is instead seeking the vice presidency. Gary Van Ooteghem declared his intention to run for board seat 9, Clair Koepsel is seeking board seat 7 and Dale Carpenter will try for seat 8.

Elections to fill Caucus board seats are staggered, with three normally open every year. Matthew Houston is running for position 4, which was left vacant with the resignation of Liz Shuler.

There were no self-nominations for the positions of president, secretary or treasurer.

Amid rumors about as yet unannounced candidacies, two Caucus members told TWT NEWS last week that they had either decided to run for president or were considering the possibility.

Gary Van Ooteghem, who was defeated by Richardson for the position last September, confirmed that he will place his name in nomination for the presidency at the group's January election meeting, after he has withdrawn his candidacy for board seat 9.

In addition, Lane Lewis said he had been approached by several people who encouraged him to run, but had not yet made a firm decision.

Talking with TWT NEWS about her decision not to seek reelection, Richardson said she had not anticipated the degree to which the demands of the presidency would affect the rest of her life.

"It's very time-consuming; the time constraints the Caucus places on its president is something I didn't expect." She added that, if elected vice president, she hopes to gain additional experience in that position and perhaps reconsider running for president later on.

Another factor, Richardson said, was

criticism of her by some Caucus members. "I think that there are people who've been members for quite a while who think perhaps I haven't paid enough dues to be president."

But she said she feels positive about what the organization has accomplished during her term. "The Caucus is moving in a real good direction. We're playing good politics now; we fielded our [City Council] candidates and gained some experience, and I think I played some small part in that."

"I think I've done a good job, and I think there are other people who think I've done a good job."

## DALLAS EXERCISE PROGRAM AIMS TO HELP THOSE WITH HIV

*Proponents Believe 'Immunocise'  
May Strengthen Immune System,  
Enhance Quality of Life.*

DALLAS — After more than a decade of research and medical trials, there is still no truly effective treatment for AIDS. Prolonging and enhancing the lives of those with HIV infection therefore depends on a broadbased strategy that includes the use of antiviral and other drugs, supplements and other approaches designed to address both physical and emotional effects of the disease.

Jay Gondek, a Dallas fitness trainer, has developed an exercise program that he believes can help people with AIDS fight the physical effects of their illness and enhance the quality of their lives.

Dubbed "Immunocise," Gondek's program focuses on regular exercise as a means of enhancing the immune system. "If you want or need to gain weight, then you need to do so along with exercise, because padding yourself with fat is not particularly helpful. If an opportunistic infection occurs, you need protein stores to resist it and make your drug therapies work."

Cade Fields Newman, an HIV nutrition specialist, concurs. "There is a high correlation between muscle mass and chemical well-being. Protein makes the body function; immunity is based on protein stores. Exercise promotes protein formation in tissue throughout the body. Fortifying protein stores should be a central preparation for coping with AIDS."

Immunocise is specifically designed for people who are HIV-positive or living with AIDS at all stages of infection. It was developed for those who want increased endurance and flexibility, and it helps reduce stress and promote positive thinking through improved self-image.

Many participants say the program has helped them tremendously. John, who is HIV-positive, declares, "This program has changed my life! Not only did it change my attitude mentally; physically, my T-cell count increased. I don't feel that medications work without some type of [physical] activity."

Gondek does not view Immunocise as the one answer to those seeking relief from the effects of AIDS. As he puts it, "We really are part of a team effort." But he does see it as a viable and necessary complement to the treatment programs prescribed by physicians.

"We've helped a lot of people already," Gondek says, "but we know there are others out there that we could be helping who don't know about us. I'd really like to see as many people as possible participate, because it's something I truly believe in."

## AIDS QUILT PANELS TO GO ON DISPLAY IN SAN ANGELO

*Hotel Cactus to Be Site of First Ever  
Such Exhibit January 14-16.*

SAN ANGELO — In the past, AIDS was viewed as a disease that struck "those



people"—gay men, Haitians or intravenous drug users in big cities. But as the pandemic has spread, people in smaller communities across America have also felt its effects as friends and loved ones contract the disease, shattering forever the myth that AIDS only affects "them."

Perhaps in no other city in Texas is this disturbing trend more apparent than in San Angelo. The mid-sized farming and ranching community in central Texas, known for its rolling hills and small-town feel, until a few years ago knew nothing about AIDS other than what its residents read in national newspapers and magazines or saw on the national news.

All that changed in 1990 when the San Angelo AIDS Foundation was created, bringing the issue to the forefront of people's minds and making AIDS the topic of dinner conversations in the community. Suddenly, San Angelo knew about AIDS.

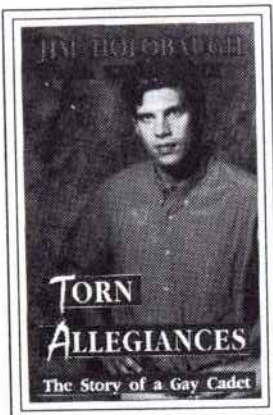
It seems tragically appropriate, therefore, that the San Angelo organization and the NAMES Project will bring the AIDS Memorial Quilt to this rural town in an effort to educate its citizens about the disease and its effects on both those with it and on the community in which they live.

## RENOVATION NEARLY FINISHED ON HOUSTON PWA RESIDENCE

### Tour Last Thursday Provides Glance at Efforts Of Designers On Behalf Of Milam House.

HOUSTON — One of the most devastating effects AIDS can have on those with the disease is to rob them of their economic independence, making it difficult or impossible to maintain even a minimally decent standard of living. A caring group of Houstonians, aware of this problem, founded an organization in February, 1992, whose goal was to provide a residence for PWAs who can no longer live alone but who don't need the expensive care provided by a nursing home or hospital.

Last Thursday evening, Milam House opened its doors to the public for several hours, giving visitors a chance to tour the facility and view the results of months of renovation work designed to transform the Montrose-area site into a comfortable, attractive residence with a homelike atmosphere.

Each of the four bedrooms, as well living areas and other parts of the house, was furnished and decorated, at no expense to the nonprofit organization, by a different Houston interior design firm. Artwork, furniture and other supplies used in the restoration were donated by artists, craftsmen and businesses.

Funding for Milam House, primarily in the form of in-kind donations, has come from a variety of nonprofit groups, churches and other sources. The renovation project, which according to Milam House officials was received so enthusiastically that more furnishings were donated than

were actually needed, has a value of \$306,000 measured in in-kind goods and services.

The building selected to house the residence was constructed early in this century, and has been the site of a restaurant, two nightclubs, an Episcopal bishop's residence and a funeral home. The ravages of time, as well as lightning damage and two hurricanes, had left their mark on the structure.

John Kirkpatrick, who joined Milam

House in May of this year and has been House Manager for nearly two months, said renovation is nearly complete, save for a few "finishing touches" like exterior painting.

The facility, which has space for up to eight residents, currently houses five. Those clients receiving Social Security Income/Social Security Disability are expected to pay up to 30% of their income for room and board; no one, however is refused admission to Milam House because of inability to pay.

The Colt 45's have agreed to pay the monthly lease on Milam House for an indefinite period. Corporate sponsors include Union Texas Petroleum and Chase Manhattan Bank.

Proceeds from donations at last Thursday's open house will help the facility pay operating expenses. Milam House needs volunteers to serve in a variety of functions, as well as continuing financial support is also needed. For more information, call (713)520-9248.

## DALLAS HEALTH CLUB HELPS LOCAL EFFORT AGAINST AIDS

### Food Drive Brings in Items for Resource Center's Pantry.

DALLAS — As AIDS touches an ever-widening segment of the American population, there are encouraging signs that more and more citizens, institutions and businesses outside the gay and lesbian community are realizing that the epidemic is not a moral crisis but rather a health threat, and they are responding by mobilizing their efforts against the disease.

One such example of these efforts is the support shown by the Centrum Health Club of Dallas for local AIDS service providers. Long a leader in fitness causes for the elite and trendy in Oak Lawn and Highland Park, the club has recently developed an increased awareness of those social issues that have a direct impact on the physical well-being of both its membership and the community as a whole. While the club is no stranger to AIDS support—Major Artery's Centrum Pro Shop, a tenant in the club, donates sizable portions of its income to the AIDS Resource Center through sales of its world-class art collection, and the Centrum sponsors teams in Dallas' annual LifeWalk campaign—new programs the staff is developing do represent the first in-house effort the club has mounted to offer support to the city's AIDS community.

One area in which the Centrum has had a major impact has been in raising funds and food and hygiene items for the AIDS Resource Center Food Pantry. Beginning last November, and lasting throughout this holiday season, the club has held a food drive, offering incentives to new and current members to participate. In addition, donation cans for monetary contributions have been placed throughout the facility.

Just before Thanksgiving, the Food Pantry van picked up two full loads of food and hygiene product items from the club—a trend that the Centrum planned to continue this month.

"The AIDS Resource Center is such a wonderful service organization and touches so many people's lives," says Shannon Duncan, coordinator of the project for the Centrum. "We hope our members will join in on the spirit of giving this holiday season."
