
Van Dyk In Between

From early Berlin techno and house through to progressive trance, producer/DJ Paul van Dyk has soundtracked the German electronic dance scene ever since he moved to the city and began mixing in 1988. A native of a German town near Frankfurt, van Dyk first heard house music on the radio during the mid-'80s. Soon he was experimenting with a rudimentary turntable setup, and after hitting Berlin, he gigged around the city.

By 1991, he had appeared at the legendary Tresor club; he later set up his own E-Werk club, and debuted on record as Visions of Shiva, with fellow trance wizard Cosmic Baby. He remixed for New Order, Humate, Sven Väth, and others, then signed to the German MFS Records for his first album,

1994's *45 RPM*. By the midpoint of the 1990s, van Dyk had become a globe-trotting DJ and remixer. His second album, *Seven Ways*, resulted in British and German dance chart entries for the singles "Beautiful Place," "Forbidden Fruit," and "Words." While both of his albums were issued in America during 1998, van Dyk added a remix collection (*Perspective*) and mix album (*Vorsprung* Dyk *Technik*) to his discography. 2000 saw the release of the single "Tell Me Why (The Riddle)," the album *Out There and Back*, and the EP *We Are Alive*. As a follow-up to global club dates in support of those releases, van Dyk released another EP, *Columbia*, in mid-2001. After a relatively quiet 2002 (on the recording front), van Dyk returned with a mix-album/greatest-hits/DVD (*Global*), the soundtrack to a film (*Zurdo*), and a new production album (*Reflec-*



tions). He released the second volume of his *Politics of Dancing* mix album series in 2005.


In Between, Paul van Dyk's first studio album in four years, and only his second in seven, was certainly a long time coming. In fact, it was questionable whether another studio album would come at all. A lot changed over that span of time in terms of musical trends -- the rise (and descent) of microhouse, for instance -- but thankfully van Dyk sticks with what he does best on *In Between* rather than experiment with an assortment of styles like he did on his previous album.

The album features a wide range of collaborations including David Byrne (Talking Heads), Jessica Sutta (Pussycat Dolls), Ashley Tomberlin (Luminary), Alex M.O.R.P.H., Lo Fi Sugar, Rea Garvey (Reamonn), Ryan Merchant and Wayne Jackson. Paul van Dyk received a Grammy nomination in 2005 for Best Dance/Electronic Album for his original album "Reflections" - this marked the first time NARAS recognized this category.

Aside from his musical activity, Paul van Dyk has always dedicated a significant part of his life to politics and social justice: from his youth, when he fled over the Berlin Wall to the West, to his children's charity in India's Mumbai, and his partnership scheme with the German Red Cross to help poor children in Berlin. In 2004, PvD was the only electronic artist involved in a nationwide tour with the Rock The Vote campaign, where he joined the likes of Bono, P Diddy, the

Black Eyed Peas and George Clinton in campaigning for America's youth to sign up to vote in the presidential election. He most recently received Berlin's Medal of Honor (Landesverdienstorden) in recognition of his work with Ruckenzwind, a charity organization he founded dedicated to helping poor children in Berlin. He joins a distinguished list of arts and political establishment figures with this honor.


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First Splash Survival Guide

Sunscreen - This is a Texas summer and the words used to describe the weather are hot, hot, hot. Common sense should tell you how much to take with you, how much to apply and how often.


Swimwear - Or not. Hippie Hollow is a nudist reserve. The decision is yours...


Across The Universe
