Jason: Through surrogacy. The boys' biological mother (the egg donor) and their birth mother (the surrogate) are two different women. Mason and Noah get to see their birth mother regularly. She lives in Houston and we are like brother and sister.

Does one of you fall into more of the mommy role?
Jason: Um, yeah. Me. deMarco's such a man.

What do you hope fans will take away from your new album and tour?

Jason: We want people to leave the concert feeling inspired. We would especially love for the kids of nontraditional families to see that there are a lot of other kids out there with a 'different' kind of family, and that it's not only okay, but freakin' awesome.

Tell us about your new album.

deMarco: It's called "SAFE". We will be performing a lot of music from the album as well as our arrangements of songs that we haven't recorded yet such as "Imagine" and "Hallelujah". There will be a mixture of original and cover songs.

What's next for Jason & DeMarco and family?

deMarco: We would like to record a new CD. We like the idea of a lullabye album of classics like "Baby Mine" and "Somewhere Over the Rainbow". It goes along with our family theme.

Jason: After the tour, we will be focusing on the release of my book, "The Journey of Same-Sex Surrogacy".

What is the hardest thing about being gay Dads in Texas?

deMarco: Luckily for us, nothing. Surprisingly, everyone that learns that Jason and I are a couple and have these beautiful boys expresses genuine happiness for us. We steered clear of certain conservative courts throughout the process and have surrounded ourselves with lovely and supportive people.

What do you enjoy doing most about being Dads?

Jason: Everything. I don't even mind the poopy diapers.

Jason & deMarco's "Celebrating Families of Diversity" tour kicks off in Houston on Friday, February 1, 2013 at Unity Church.

Wayne has always been fascinated with music and where it can take you when you're listening to it, so he wanted to get behind the scenes and quick – it's impossible to deny something you're passionate for.
