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

Snooze Cruise Sacktime In The Sky By Scott Young

It used to be that any travel service worthy of the name was as much interested in getting you there as getting you there. But to paraphrase Gertrude Stein, it's the there part of your trip that your travel agent is now most concerned about because he no longer has much choice about the 'means to the end'.

Without the competition of railroad service at home (except on some comfortable Amtrak/ Conrail lines), and with the sea lanes virtually empty of ships going abroad (except popular cruise ships), it's air everywhere. Although air travel has the virtue of adding many precious days to one's vacation, what is to be deplored is that the same airlines that once competed for your travel dollars no longer care about anything except the dol-

Creature comforts are rapidly disappearing from domestic airlines. For example, on many planes that in-flight 'snack' indicated by a big 'S' on your timetable-and which used to mean at least a choice of fresh sandwiches—is now something prepared abroad as a 'courtesy gimmick' by European processed-food exporters, and actually given to airlines for distribution aloft.

Just how ridiculous this pracice has become was noted by the writer on a recent Allegheny flight, when at 'S' time the flight attendant wheeled in the 'hospitality cart' and gave each passenger (1) a tiny cellophane bag containing a one-inch cube of Danish Havarti cheese and two miniscule sesame-seed sticks, plus (2) a four-ounce plastic glass of ice cubes over which she poured about a third of a can of Tab. (One can of Tab served three passengers!) Big 'S' indeed. Had this been a shuttle flight one might have excused the meager repast, but it was a nearly five-hour flight with two long, boring stops, when something a little more imaginative (and filling) would have been

appreciated.

What is now happening to in-flight food service is also happening to the physical comfort (read discomfort) of the passenger. This is particularly distressing if one is unlucky enough to be assigned the window seat of any DC9 plane. Here, the curvature of the plane's body turns in at about 'feet level' and so the sardined passenger arrives at his destination with one foot 'si-godlin', or asleep, or otherwise temporarily incapacitated. Also, in many cases the once-fresh seat-back cover is no longer attached. You rest your head on the same greasy 'dimple' other passengers have deepened. Dig in!

While so many domestic airlines seem bent to seeing how much joy they can squeeze out of you by squeezing you in, some foreign airlines are doing just the opposite. Whether it's because the directors and personnel are natively more courteous, or there's more competition, you, the passenger, are in luck. This is especially true of certain Asian airlines—notably Singa-

pore Airlines.

Gay guys sex-orbiting the Far East are enthusing about Singapore Airlines. They've been visiting all the fascinating gay places of Asia we've been covering in various Ciao! articles, and which are arranged in convenient thumbnail digest form in our gay travel guide "Private Stock." Because of the considerable distances from city to city/country to country, they have come to appreciate Singapore Airlines' 'snooze cruises' . . . a gay way of describing the 'berthable divans' (as they are quaintly called) of Singapore's 747s. By getting a good sevenhours' sleep across country and continent they arrive in the next gay capital refreshed and humppily gorgeous, instead of mugwumpish and not so. These flying beds also prevent the devitalization caused by jet lag. Here's how the plan works:

At present, Singapore Airlines operates its 747s from London to

27 cities of Asia. It is expected that by midsummer there will also be snooze-cruise service from our own West Coast to the same Ciao!-covered cities, plus, hopefully, Honolulu. So keep this in mind if Asia looms large in your vacation plans. It can help you get (and do) more on your Oriental swing. The idea originated because so many London businessmen needed to arrive bright-eyed 'n bushytailed for conferences after longhaul flights. Singapore Airlines obligingly installed six-feet by four-feet convertible divans-tobeds on all its 747 first-class. upper-level lounges.

Currently each 747 has six such divans, plus four reclinable swivel seats-which are quite comfortable. It is amusing, but for straights this arrangement leaves something to be desired—there is little/no privacy . . . something that guys will appreciate all the more because of the cruising opportunities this open arrangment affords. What makes it more cruislily comfortable is that each two 'bedettes' face each other across a cocktail table. Conversation with a compatible companion across the way is thus made all the easier. One divan per 747—because it is behind a folding door—has strict privacy. This can be plus or minus, depending on how one looks at it. Since the lights are extinguished during the night, however, such privacy is not only gayly needless, but can be cruisingly thwarting.

Each divan has a 'sleep belt' (not a 'chastity belt', although at first one may think it somewhat sexually limiting). This must be kept in place while you are horizontal-all during your flight-because of the sudden turbulences that occur as one flies over the roof of the world. in and around, through and over the huge mountain ranges of Asia. Although sex during flight is a 'gingerly' thing at best (since there are straights occupying the divans, as well as gay guys), and one must be discreet at all times, the challenge is too interestingly daring or daringly interesting to pass up. But once the plane has 'settled down' for

the night such caution is a bit much.

Among other amenities of the 747 flights of Singapore Airlines are the (a) incomparable food, available in both American/European and Oriental cuisines . . . and (b) the bottomless 'flowing bowl'. You get cocktails and never-ending cognac during your flight—without charge. No third-of-a-cup of Tab and two sesame-sticks for this super airline! And you don't have to ask for more of the grape . . . your stewardess will have anticipated you wish!

Be sure to reserve your divanby-day/bed-by-night well in advance of your flight, particularly if you are flying great distances. More and more people on the move—gay and straight—are hip to this Shangri-la of the Skies. It has brought the comfortable Pullman to celestial

travel.


Gay Palma By Ralph W. Davis



Palma, on the island of Majorca, is the largest of the six Balearic Islands 120 miles from Barcelona. Whether you fly or come by boat you will encounter the lovely Bay of Palma, marked at one end by a fairy-tale castle and at the other by an imposing Gothic cathedral. Those who like narrow curving seventeenth-century streets and magnificent cathedrals will be quite happy here. To make Palma even more attractive to visitors it has the

style and elegance of the French Riviera. Unlike the Riviera, though, it isn't outrageously expensive. The American dollar still stretches far in Spain, and even the better hotels, restaurants and shops are within the budget of the average visitor.

Gay life tends to be more relaxed in Palma than in other parts of Spain. During my visit I watched bored cab-drivers stand around a plaza amusing themselves with grab-ass, and listened to a waiter serenade me while eyeing my basket. But because of these incidents it wouldn't be correct to conclude that gay life is flaunted here. Remember, you are still in Spain, and the police aren't sympathetic to gays. If Spaniards act a little bold at times, it's only because they know the acceptable limits. On the other hand, you will be better off being discreet since you are unfamiliar with the idiosyncrasies of their police justice. If you do remain discreet you will have more reason to remember your holiday with love.



There aren't too many cruisy areas in Palma. What there are, however, attract most of the gays living or visiting the island. The only bar I found popular with gays was Le Petit Pigalle at 9 Calle José Villalonga. Incidentally, there are two Villalongas. José is the only one near Gomila Park (below Castillo Belver). When you get to Plaza Gomila, ask for Calle del Soldado Marroig (or the British-American Club). At the corner, half a block from the club, is Villalonga. Just follow it about two blocks and you'll be at the bar. For dining, there are several nice restaurants at Villalonga and Calle de Luis Fabregos. If you don't want to dine, and are too early to drink at Pigalle, you should consider the sidewalk cafes on the Plaza Gomila. Some beautiful young men flutter about here, ingratiating others with their suggestive smiles. You can have a drink here, and maybe if you smile back you may save yourself a trip to Pigalle.

Outside cruising is by far the most popular way of meeting others in Spain. Of course, you can succeed almost anywhere if you remain alert. But your chances of connecting are better if you head for the following places:

At night, and sometimes during the day, the gardens to the right of the Melia Mallorca Hotel on the Paseo Maritimo. Also you should stroll through the gardens of the Almudaina Palace with your eyes wide open. (This palace, incidentally, was the ancient residence of the Moorish kings and later the Royal House of Mallorca.)





Another area is around the steps and gardens to the hilltop cathedral, and the promenade at the city walls below the cathedral. The main plaza, Generalissimo Franco Plaza, is discreetly gay. Swimmers may try Playa Illetas by the rocks on the right of the beach and the terraces to the left of it.

This doesn't seem like much, but when you realize how small Palma is you will begin to discover how gay this charming little resort in the Mediterranean is. So give Palma a try. The Spanish are a nice change. They're so gracious and handsome and sexy.

The Way It Was
Ellis Island Now

Like most American cities, New York was awash in the symbolism of freedom on the occasion of our Bicentennial Celebration last July Fourth—an unforgettable spectacle that was climaxed by the stately arrival of the 200 Tall Ships from all over the world which proudly dipped their colors as they proceeded past the Statue of Liberty to anchor in New York Harbor.



Although the Statue of Liberty has long symbolized freedom to millions of immigrants, there were thousands in that vast November/December 1976 crowd who had come to revisit Ellis Island, which, in their early years, had been of greater significance. They came with their third-generation grandchildren to show them how and why Ellis Island, as an immigration depot, had made them even prouder Americans.

To them the Statue of Liberty is just a symbol—Ellis Island was a test of endurance in which only the rugged made it through the doors at the other end to what they never doubted would be a better life. Having made it, they were all the prouder—thus the Bicentennial was of poignant importance.



Although a physical examination of all immigrants is still a requirement of the National Health Service, it is done more comfortably and scientifically today . . . blood-tests in shining labs; vaccinations; and particulary X-rays to quickly determine whether tuberculosis is present. In grandfather's day this was really a test, and an often arduous one. He, his wife, perhaps his children, and his comrades from many European countries were marched up a broad, steep flight of stairs that led to the huge waiting room on the second floor. A health inspector watched from the top of the steps as they climbed, his clinical ear listening for a telltale shortness of breath, or wheezing that would have indicated the dread TB.

The thought of the 'physical'

struck terror into many doubting hearts. If they couldn't pass muster they'd be on their way back to poverty-land-courtesy of the shipping lines that had brought them here . . . a businesslike understanding between them and the United States Immigration Service. It may be a mark of the sturdiness of Americans of European descent that in these tough years only 2% were denied admission. Most came from good peasant stock and passed their entrance tests with flying colors. This ruggedness has been a prime factor in making/keeping our country

Until it was closed in 1924 (air travel had made the facility obsolescent) twelve million Europeans had passed the grueling test and had gone happily through the doors of the Ellis Island administration building to what must have seemed to them the Promised Land. Then the buildings were allowed to fall into decay. No one seemed to care.



But with the Bicentennial Celebration as a reason for doing so, the National Park Service decided to reopen it to visitors. Some repair and restoration of the buildings has taken place, and in some ways this historic Open Sesame to a new life can be seen as it was originally. Visitors will still have to pick their way through clumps of vegetation and strangely-empty doors/rooms to reach the ferry slips where the immigrants embarked for Manhattan-the last lap of their way to a new home. This neglect, however, seems somehow to symbolize the difficulties they faced, and the endless hours they spent waiting for their names to be called for one or more examinations. Their fears must have been great that

the next examination might send them back from whence they came.

Oddly enough, tourists are now asked to do the same thing . . . to wait until their names are called-perhaps some of the same names, a generation removed-to join groups of other tourists. Michalik . . . Martucci . . . Goldberg . . . Resnikoff . . . Mildonian . . . Schultz. What memories this must revive for those older people who experienced this when it was really rough-and how proud their grandchildren must be of their courage, stamina and ruggedness that kept them doggedly here until final approval of their admission to the United States.



It's amazing how Ellis Island has caught on in its status redivivus. It has become almost as much of a tourist attraction as Lady Liberty. There are presently six daily tours to Ellis Island to see it 'the way it was'. All boats leave the dock at Battery Park in Lower Manhattan from 9:45 a.m. to 2:45 p.m. Tickets for the tour may be purchased either at the Statue of Liberty booths on the mainland side, or at a stand on Liberty Island-so that you can do both. The fare is \$2.75, and is a small price to pay for a look at some American history one doesn't read very much about in dusty books.

If your ancestors reached these shores by way of Ellis Island, you too will take great pride in retracing **their** steps. It will not only make you admire them all the more, but will give you a sense of the destiny that was, in a way, preordained for you. It's worth a few hours of anyone's visit to New York. Add it to your next trip to The Big Apple.

Gay Chicago

If you knew Chicago in the fifties, as I did, it was a pretty grim place for a gay guy looking for action. Gay bars flourished even in those dark ages but police entrapment was commonplace—so if you did the city only occasionally it was wiser and far more fruitful to do your thing at the Lawson Y (still active) or in the johns at Northwestern in nearby Evanston (still active). Back then it might have been easier for a stranger to stay in town, rather than travel to Evanston, and make the scene at the Blackstone Baths-but even there they were so uptight that if you appeared to be anyting less than nellie you were suspect and simply not admitted.

Today it's a whole other thing in Chicago. Thanks to the legalization of homosexuality between consenting adults, in particular, and changing times, in general, gay Chicago swings. It's a great city with lots to do-and once you learn to get around (get yourself a map right off-or rely on taxis) you won't have any difficulty finding exactly what you want. And if you want to know what special gay events are happening when you're in town-phone 427-2111 for information.

Because the city sprawls it is necessary to think in terms of sections—and if you are unfamiliar with Chicago it is advisable to plan your day ahead and limit your activity to bars and other places within a particular area. It will save a lot of time and travel expense. Here's the scene:

NORTHSIDE

Boundaries are Irving Park north to Howard Street, and from Irving Park west to the city limits. The farther north or west you go the better the neighborhood becomes. In the section north from Irving Park to Foster and west from Sheridan Road to Ashland Avenue there is a heavy deposit of Chicanos and Blacks; Foster and Ashland seem to be cut-off point. That's where you

start getting into ethnic neighborhoods populated by Swedes, Greeks and Jews.

Bars

Blue Pub, 3059 W. Irving Park. Mostly those 30 and over enjoy this bar. On Friday and Saturday nights there's a sing-along at the piano.

Closet, 3325 N. Broadway. Go around 11 p.m. for the best crowd; people start arriving in force about that time. Gay men and women fill the dance floor. On Sunday evenings there's a free buffet at 8 p.m.

Garland's, 3510 N. Broadway. You'll enjoy yourself even in the afternoon. Garland's boasts the city's largest beer garden. There is dancing to a juke box and a lot more in planning stages at this time. The age spread is good.

Lost & Found, 2529 W. Irving Park Rd. Dancing but mainly lesbians.

Mike's Aragon, 1113 W. Lawrence. Everything here—typical of bars in rough neighborhoods. Come and shop for tough hustlers.

Mike's Terrace, at 1137 W. Granville St. Cruising is poor but dancing is good. The crowd is young but not in the chicken category.

Pepper's, 1502 W. Jarvis Ave. The decor is 1930-ish and the young-but-not-that-young crowd is friendly. There's dancing.

21, 3042 W. Irving Park Rd. The place is going on its sixteenth year—and that says a lot. Dancing to a jukebox. There is a good ol' midwestern fish-fry from 8 p.m. until midnight on Fridays, and a buffet (all you can eat!) on Sundays at 8 p.m.

Baths

Man's Country, 5015 N. Clark St. Possibly Chicago's best. You'll need a membership card or a sponsor to join (a nominal fee). Lots to do. There's even entertainment twice a week and help with medical problems. Plus, of course, what you go to a gay baths for: action—and there are water beds to do it on. Phone 278-2069 before going, concerning membership or whatever.

Outdoor Cruising

There's cruising east of Outer Drive from Montrose to Lawrence, day and night—but beware of toughs. North of Lawrence there is a wooded area famous for its daytime orgies—but the bushes are dangerous at night. And not far away, between Montrose and Wilson, you'll find a john that faces Outer Drive. For general cruising start at Montrose (in the park at the path near Outer Drive) and walk slowly to Foster Avenue.

NEW TOWN

Go north from about Fullerton Parkway to Belmont Avenue, and west from Sheridan Road to Halsted Street—and you're in New Town. Not only is this area considered the best gay section in town, but wandering around is not only pleasant but rewarding (especially along Broadway between Diversey and Belmont). Bars

Broadway Limited, 3112 N. Broadway. This super bar is Chicago's most popular disco. All kinds of diversions such as a beanbag-chair lounge that features a jumbo TV; pool table; piano bar; a western bar on the mall level that opens at noon for leather guys; live d.j.; dining in railroad cars (dinner from 6 p.m. until midnight, snacks and/or breakfast until closing, lunch at noon); etc. You must join, but that's only a formality at the door. Wide age range-depending on what section turns you on.

Bushes, 3320 N. Halsted St. A pleasant bar decorated with live foliage. Pleasant vibes from classical to rock from the juke-box that's low enough to whisper sweet nothings in his ear.

Carol's Pub, 2519 N. Halsted St. A hodgepodge of delights, ranging from low prices for drinks, to a free buffet on Mondays at 10 p.m., to live shows with go-go boys. There's a game room and beer garden connecting. Small dance area (jukebox) and you never go hungry—thanks to Carol's free snacks.

Cheeks, 2730 N. Clark St. The place to go if you like eyeballing go-go boys and men (every night). There's dancing and a smattering of hustlers.

C.K.'s, 1425 W. Diversey Pk'wy. Dancing and snacks—in



El Dorado, 2683 N. Halsted St. Go on weekends for the best crowd; it's primarily Latin. Straights check it out too-particularly if they've got tail for sale. Dancing.

Grapevine, 2548 N. Halsted St. There's dancing but the main feature is a friendly island bar.

Greenleaf, 1770 Greenleaf. Because of its proximity to Loyola and Northwestern, the crowd is humpily collegiate. There are game machines and a pool table. Dancing and snacks.

His & Hers, 944 W. Addison. Pleasant but mainly lesbians. Dancing (jukebox) and live entertainment Sunday evenings. Hot sandwiches are featured.

Knight Out, 2936 N. Clark St. Come day or night—there's food and a friendly square bar. Dancing (jukebox) and the bulletin board with its sometimesamusing items is a great icebreaker. An equal mixture of gay men and women.

Le Mere Vipere, 2132 N. Halsted St. This complex is a popular disco. There's entertainment and the crowd is young.

Little Jim's, 3501 N. Halsted St. There are special features all the time and occasional food fests. Jukebox dancing.

Melodies, 3174 N. Clark St. Dancing to selections by a live d.j. The crowd is evenly mixed, gay men and women. There's a lounge away from the dance area and hot sandwiches are available. Appealingly decorated with stained glass and live plants.

Petunia's, 2559 N. Southport. The petunias here are females, but there are usually enough men around to make it worthwhile. Dancing. The crowd is friendly.

Shari's, 2901 N. Clark St. On weekends it's packed with young stuff. Dancing.

Snake Pit, 2626 N. Halsted St. The crowd here is hip; some Latins, much macho. There's dancing and snacks.

Touché, 2845 N. Lincoln Ave. The fireplace makes for very pleasant surroundings. A nice place to sit and talk. Hotdogs are always a dime.

Virgo Out, 2546 N. Clark St.

Home for a cycle club (The Tradewinds) so the ambiance is leather. Buffets are frequent happenings. There's dancing.

Ye Old Mill, 3407 N. Paulina St. Dancing and snacks.

Zolar, 936 W. Diversey Pk'wy. New and popular with a young crowd. Amusements and dancing.

Makeout Place

Try the john as well as the back row at the Parkway Cinema, 2736 N. Clark St. Straights, so be cautious.

Outside Cruising

Where Broadway, Diversey and Clark meet is cruisy. Walk Broadway from Diversey to Belmont for rewarding contacts. Also Pine Grove from Surf to Wellington. The park area near the lagoon from Deming Place to Fullerton Parkway is heavily cruised but very dangerous, especially at night. Ditto for the john near the lagoon, and hills on the east side of the lagoon.

The Belmont rocks, from Belmont to Diversey, is still very gay for swimmers and sunners in warm weather. In the park itself, the john near Fullerton and Stockton Drive is popular with gays and vice during zoo

hours.

OLD TOWN

This area is from Division Street south to Armitage Avenue; from Clark Street east to Halsted Street.

Bars

Butterfly, 1437 N. Wells St. Homemade fast food makes the place a hit. There's a beer garden, dance floor (jukebox), and the crowd is mixed gay men and women.

Den One, 1355 N. Wells St. Large dance area and special events. But it's private and you've got to join at the doorwith a member if the place is busy the night you go.

Glory Hole, 1343 N. Wells St. Night and day. On weekends there are go-go boys. The beer garden was recently enlarged and has an above-ground swimming pool and sundeck. Other amusements, such as movies on Thursday nights. Moderately macho in ambiance.

Le Pub, 1944 N. Clark St.

There's dancing in this class place. On Sunday afternoons at 5 p.m. there are movies in the lounge. The restaurant here is very popular and there's live entertainment on weekends. On Sunday mornings from 11:30 there's brunch. Don't go in torn dungarees. Private, but there's no problem joining.

Gay Flicks

Try the **Bijou**, 1439 N. Wells St. Strictly gay—and sometimes the action is hotter in the seats and in the john than on the screen.

Outdoor Cruising

Lincoln Park is cruised—particularly the two johns . . . one in the fieldhouse basement, near the ball diamond at LaSalle Drive and Clark Street; and at Armitage and Clark behind the museum and in front of the lagoon. Be cautious of vice and don't go at night.

NEAR NORTH

Still the most elegant section of town. The area stretches from around Superior Street north to North Avenue, and from Lake Shore Drive west to LaSalle Street.

Bars

Alfie's, 900 N. Rush St. A new disco that is quite popular. At cocktail time there is piano entertaiment, and on weekends there are popular afternoon 'tea dances.'

Big Daddy's, 848 N. Clark St. If you know the games hustlers play you'll be in heaven here . . . especially if you're a Big Daddy.

Baton, 463 N. Clark St. Shows at 10 p.m. Dancing too. Call ahead for a good table. The phone number is 644-5269.

Dugan's Bistro, 420 N. Dearborn St. This super bar attracts a very hip and humpy crowd. On weekends there is a comedy drag show. A live d.j. takes over the disco from 10 p.m. And the cruising is pretty good.

Flight, 420 N. Clark St. The crowd is easy, the music is low. Mechanical games for your amusement (they're great icebreakers) and a pool table to bring the macho out in you.

Gold Coast, 501 N. Clark St. This leather bar is among the most famous in the country. There's a pool table and a jukebox. All kinds of amusements—if you're into leather.

Haig, 800 N. Dearborn Pk'wy. This oldtimer has been around for years—and it gets all types . . . including a lot of losers who frequent nearby Bug House Square. Nonetheless, it is popular—and somewhat of an institution. Note: It's right across the street from the Lawson Y . . . in case you hit a dull night there.

King's Ransom, 20 E. Chicago Ave. The U-shaped bar is good for conversation. There's a small dance floor and the ambiance is masculine. On cold nights the fireplace helps.

Ritz, 937 N. State St. There's dancing. Black guys, mainly, and some of them are into hustling. Day and night.

Saturday's, 661 N. Clark St. There's dancing and the crowd is young.

Stage 618, 618 N. Clark St. There's dancing; the crowd is older (buyers) and younger (hustlers).

Stars, 61 W. Hubbard. Dancing here, and there's usually a good age spread.

Sunday's, 430 N. Clark St. The campy front on this bar makes it stand out like a neon sign. Dancing and a dazzling light show. Films on Monday nights.

Ten-Oh-Two, 1002 N. Clark St. Hustlers for sale.

Trip, 27 E. Ohio St. Another popular super bar. On the first level there's a restaurant; on the second level there's a cocktail lounge as well as a dance floor and occasional live entertainment; and on the third level there's a disco with a live d.j. plus go-go boys on weekends. A hit.

Baths

There are three in this part of town. The Club, 609 N. LaSalle St., is part of the national chain; take your membership card for the usual treats. The new Ohio & State, 9 E. Ohio St., has the same amusements, plus dancing. The Wacker, 674½ N. Clark St., is an old standby—but it is perhaps best on weekends.

Gay Flicks

Try the **Newberry**, 856 N. Clark St. Good gay films plus the usual action in the seats and john.

Restaurant

In addition to those restaurants that are discussed under Bars, above, try **Poofy's**, 508 N. Clark St. This is not a bar but strictly a restaurant—not only convenient to all the gay bars in this area but also open all night. If you go for dinner, take your own wine. It's gay—both men and women.

Outside Cruising

If you're looking for trash, try Bug House Square. The Oak Street Beach at Oak and Lake Shore Drive is very gay and the place to go for your sun in warm weather. And don't forget that at Dearborn and Chicago, right across the street from the Haig (see Bars, above) is the Lawson YMCA—favored by gays for years. Naturally, the street out front can be rewarding.

DOWNTOWN

The area is heavily Black when the offices close. Grant Park, between Randolph and Monroe Streets can be cruisy—but rough at night. If you want to walk on the wild side—try the walkway along the Illinois Central tracks. If you're into johns, expect the usual at the Greyhound Bus Station. The johns at

Marshall Field's sometimes see action. So does the basement john at Carson's. The john in the I.C. Station at Randolph and Michigan is busy, especially during rush hour. And finally, the john in the basement of the Monroe Theatre, 57 W. Monroe, is alive (mostly Black); straight porno shown here.

THE SUBURBS

If you have wheels, drive on out to Touhy (Iroquois) Woods, west of Touhy Ave., across the Des Plaines River, and follow the path from the parking lot. Daytime only—and exercise caution in this meatrack.

In nearby Forest Park, the bar to go to is the **Hideaway II**, 300 S. Harlem Ave. At this writing the second floor lounge is open, and the first floor should be swinging by the time you read this (closed as a result of a fire). The disco is popular.

In Calumet City try the Bank Vault, 200 S. State St. There's a square bar and dance floor. On weekends sandwiches are available, and on Sundays at 5 p.m. there's a free salad bar.

Or, check out Mr. B's, 606 State Line St. This is the fourth oldest gay-owned bar in America and has been here for 26 years. Dancing to a jukebox.

And finally, the **Patch**, at 155th and Wentworth; it's been around for 13 years. Dancing to a jukebox. There's also a pool table.

In Evanston, go directly to the Northwestern campus . . . the grounds are cruised by humpy students. Johns that see action are in the Drama Building; Fisk Hall basement; the Music Building; the New Library (3rd, 4th and 5th floors); and the Old Deering Library basement. The nearby Y has some activity.

OF INTEREST TO ALL

For gay magazines and publications featuring gay Chicago—go at once to Bob's News Emporium, 5100 Lake Park. The management is friendly and this is a good place to go to pick up reading material that will help make your stay complete.

Chicago is a great old town it's really swinging these days!

Nile Awhile! Cleopatra Cruise

The cruise ship as a floating hotel has recently been a subject of articles in Ciao! and QQ Magazine. What at first may have been a unique experience for gay guys who found island-hopping in the Caribbean more sexually productive—via a daily trek from ship to shore (then back for more)—was described in pinpointed detail (brothel to boy-brothel coverage, one might say) in the December 1975 issue of Ciao!

This has become the definitive 'Caribbean Gay Guide' because it is so meticulously all-encompassing, and it's still available from the QQ Publishing Company; flip the pages of this issue for an advertisement. Because gay places/bars/action spots and the gay characteristics of a particular area rarely change in the Caribbean, this guide is—and should remain—timely.

More recently we cruised the Rhine in a floating hotel, and now we should like to point out some delights in cruising the Nile. It was, after all, Cleopatra's lifestyle; she 'barged' off in a snit whenever Burton became a bit testy. You remember! Just now, with all the strife in the Middle East, Egypt is a completely safe country to visit, and a cruise along the Nile is a joy.

Because a Nile cruise lasts just five days it makes a pleasant adjunct to one's visit to Greece and Turkey, and, of course, Egypt itself. Moreover, it fleshes out a vacation period when one is specifically doing Kenya, seeing what may be the apocalypse of its wild animal life. The distance between Kenya and Egypt, of course, is greater. Plane and sail. But best of all, a Nile cruise makes it possible for one to see 4,000 years of ancient history come to vivid life-a panorama of such magnitude it could not be experienced if one simply takes roots at the Cairo Hilton and bus-tours forth-andback from the city each day.

THE CRUISE SHIPS

There are two excellent cruise ships plying the Nile-the Isis and Osiris-and they really are floating luxury hotels, with every convenience. Each cabin is air-conditioned and has its own lavatory, toilet and shower, and many are so conveniently arranged that, via connecting doors, they can be made into getting-to-know-you suites if enough gay guys are aboard (and invariably there are). Formality is almost foreign to these cruise ships. The only really semi-dress occasion is a onenight gala for the passengers (Nubian belly dancers, finger cymbals clanginging . . . all that). There are all kinds of shops and services aboard, too . . . always something to do if you can tear your eyes from the glory of Egypt as you sail along.

As on any cruise ship, a favored spot for putting the fix on a likely trick is the swimming pool. On the Isis and Osiris there is also an extensive area along and around the pool, with casual tables and chairs where one can 'convert' a diving acquaintance of a few moments before in to a diving sexpartner for the night.



Like the Rhine-cruise ships, there are no portholes on the Isis and Osiris. Each cabin has its large picture window, and if you wish, you can just sit by the window and watch history gliding by. What makes these

cruises so distinctive from a historical point is that there are lectures/demonstrations about what you are going to see once the ship docks in one of the successive ports. These talks are always fascinating, and when you finally reach a port you eagerly set out with the tour director and find yourself learning more—and more fascinatedly—about the cradle of civilization in a five-day Nile cruise than you did in a year of musty Ancient History I. Returning to the ship, you'll enjoy sharing your day's experiences and discoveries with equally-interested gay others at dinner. The food is gourmet all the way, and because it is served buffet style there are obviously many additional opportunities for a cruisy wink.

FROM LUXOR TO ASWAN

First day: Arriving in Luxor in the morning, your afternoon sightseeing includes the fabled Temples of Luxor and Karnak. No rush . . . the ship remains overnight in Luxor. You'll be wise to check your copy of "Private Stock," our gay travel directory, for interesting gay places in Luxor (as we note therein, almost everything gay happens along the banks of the Nile in Luxor, so in a very real sense you're in the midst of whatever there is-all the time you're in Luxor!). You'll particularly want to cruise the Nile area between the Winter Palace and Savoy Hotels. Also the park opposite the Luxor Hotel, along the side of the Temple of Luxor. No mummies they!

Second Day: You're still in Luxor. Sightseeing takes you to Thebes' Necropolis, the Valley of the Kings, the Tomb of Tutankhamen (the excavation of which, you may recall, started us off on the Art Deco movement). Also the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir-el-Bahari, the romantic Valley of the Nobles, Valley of the Queens (theirs, not ours), the Temple of Medinet Habu, and the famed Colossi of Memnon, facing the Nile. Overnight stay in Luxor, with plenty of cruising opportunity ashore.

Third Day: Morning departure for Esna. Here the principal sight is the Temple of Esna. In the afternoon the ship leaves for Edfu where the point of particular interest is the Temple of Horus which was built 237 years B.C. and is the best-preserved and most complete example of an Egyptian temple. Overnight at Edfu. Check the shoreline.



Fourth Day: In the morning you depart for Kom-Ombo to visit the Ptolemaic Temple of Kom-Ombo with its beautiful murals and reliefs. Afternoon arrival in Aswan. Visit Elephantine Island and the Museum of the Aga Khan. Overnight stav in Aswan. Check the new edition of "Private Stock" for late listings of gay areas in Aswan. The principal area at this writing is in the gardens of the Cataract Hotel.

Fifth Day: In the morning visit the Unfinished Obelisk in the ancient granite quarries, the Old Dam Temple of Kalabsha and that stupendous creation of modern man in ancient Egypt-the High Dam of Aswan.

You won't have a dull moment from beginning to end of a Nile cruise, and for general travel information on arrivals, hotels, departures from either Luxor or Aswan (depending on whether you are going up or down the Nile), your travel agent will have the latest—everything you need. It's a wonderful way to relive a legend.

Gay Detroit By Tom Banks

Detroit, also known as Motor

City (three of the country's largest corporations are here— General Motors. Chrysler and Ford) and Murder City (it has the highest crime rate in the nation), and which has produced the likes of Robert Vesco, Soupy Sales, Alice Cooper and the Edsel, still attracts over a million tourists and conventioneers each year-and they all return home safe and sound and convinced that things aren't as bad as what they had imagined before going. The bad is too often exaggerated-and the good is simply brushed aside. And there is good in Detroit-excellent restaurants such as the London Chop House and Joe Muer's (for seafood); fun eateries such as Doug's Body Shop, where one dines seated in the body of an old automobile; ethnic neighborhoods where you can eat like Mama used to cook; fabulous tours, like the one given at the Ford River Rouge Plant where cars are put together (it's a kind of industrial Disneyland); the old Eastern Market where you can spend a Saturday afternoon browsing among the outdoor stalls where farmers come to sell produce and livestock, and shop for imported merchandise in the numerous shops that surround the market; and, of course, the gay establishments (if you like Blacks you'll be in Seventh Heaven-but if you're strictly looking for Honky Donkey Dicks ... never fear—plenty are here).

BARS

Adobe, 19326 Conant St. An even mixture of Blacks and Whites come here to cruise and dance. The age spread is also good. Spanish decor and the place is open afternoons too.

Blue Boy, 1500 E. State Fair. A new entry for dancers.

Brass Rail, 6545 Woodward Ave. Food is served from 9 a.m. on. The crowd is Black and older and mixed (straights).

Club 870, 870 W. McNichols. Also known as Bookie's and Gagen's. Dancing and dining. There is also entertainment, and the place opens at 11 a.m. Some beats here too-if you're looking for something different.

Escape, 15606 Joy Rd. A nice neighborhood bar. Dancing.

Famous Door, 1256 Griswold. The downstairs section is gay and has dancing as well as entertainment (a drag show) certain nights of the week. Opens at 10 a.m.

Gas Station, 19106 Woodward Ave. Another recent entry. Dancing and amusements, and the crowd is young.

George's Inca Room, 13314 Fenkell. Dancing here too. A young crowd. Popular.

Gold Coast, 2971 E. 7-Mile Rd. Best on weekends for dancing. Young crowd.

Gold Dollar, 3127 Cass. The drag shows here are also popular with straights, so the crowd is mixed. Showtime is 9:30, 11, and 12.45.

Interchange, at 1501 Holden. Dancing here—and this is your place if you're into western and leather.

Menjo's, 928 W. McNichols. Dancing and amusements. Gets a young crowd. Popular.

Silver Star, 9310 Greenfield. Food. A neighborhood crowd. Pleasant, but not worth a special trip.

Tiffany's, 17436 Woodward Ave. Tiffany shades and the like give the place a nice feeling. Humpy bartenders and easy cruising. Very popular—especially on Sunday mornings from noon, when there's Breakfast at Tiffany's for brunchers. Masculine.

Todd's, 8139 E. 7-Mile Rd. Dancing. Very friendly place.

Town Pump, 2305 Park Ave. There's food. Dancing too. Also go-go boys.

Woodward, 6426 Woodward Ave. The place has been here for 23 years. Opens at 8 a.m. Two bars. Popular.

Ye Iron Hinge, 7610 Woodward Ave. Dancing (there's a live d.j.) and drag shows. Opens at 11 a.m. Young crowd. Food. Popular.

If you get hungry after the bars close try **Ted's On The Park**, 18002 Woodward Ave. It's opposite Palmer Park and open 24 hours. Sometimes it gets pretty gay, once the crowds arrive in early morning and outnumber the straights.

BATHS

Akron Health Club, 7530 E. 7-Mile Rd. Opens in the afternoon and closes at 1 a.m. weeknights and 3 a.m. weekends. If you like a mixed crowd of gays and straights without the fluff found at gay baths, you might be happy here. It's popular.

Club, 7646 Woodward Ave. The usual expected at the national chain. Take your membership card.

Prudential Health Club, 124 E. State Fair. Membership required but it's easy to join at the door. Opens late afternoon. Lots of extras, and pleasant. There are also workout facilities . . . if you're interested.

MOVIES

Wood-Six Twin Theatre, at 16549 Woodward Ave. Gay flicks and hot action if you hit a good crowd.

BOOK SHOPS

There are two great places and they can get quite cruisy. Uptown Book Store, 16541

Woodward Ave., and also the branch at 16401 W. 8-Mile Rd. Good selection of magazines, etc.

MEETING PLACES

In summer try Belle Isle Park; the beach attracts a lot of gay guys.

In River Rouge Park there's a surprise at every turn. Let's hope it isn't the vice.

On Woodward Avenue, between 6 and 7-Mile Roads young hitchhikers are usually available for a price. Be careful; some are rough.

ACTION SPOTS

Palmer Park is active. The fountain area opposite Covington Street is cruisy. The path in the woods near the golf course sees action. And the john near the duck pond gets its share. Night and day—but you'd be wise to limit your visit to daylight hours.

If you're into johns—try those at Higbee's Department Store; J.L. Hudson Department Store; University of Detroit (basement toilets in the Student Union and Library buildings); and Wayne State University (the basement toilets in the Student Union and McKenzie Hall; the 1st, 2nd and 3rd floors in the Education Library; and the 1st floor in State Hall). Exercise the usual precautions.

Like all other big cities Detroit can spell trouble—if you aren't aware of that possibility before you go and if you set yourself up as an easy mark. If you're used to making it in places like New York and Chicago—you'll have a great time . . . and you'll go back for more.

Copenhagen

Copenhagen is one of the most stable cities in the world in many respects . . . and particularly concerning homosexuality. Of course there have been some changes in gay establishments in the last couple of years, when we made our last report on the city, but things are pretty much the same today as they were then and have been for years. Copenhagen may not have the frenzied excitement of Amsterdam for its gay visitors-but it certainly has plenty going for itself and at a pleasantly relaxed pace.

All travel books on Denmark inevitably come to the same conclusion-that Danes are preoccupied with eating. One who has never visited the country therefore precludes that he will encounter a nation of heavyweights. Not so. They are beautiful people-not by contemporary thin-is-in standards but by a measuring rod for beauty that will outlast any fad: trim and solid with no bones showing and an acceptable amount of muscle in the right places. It comes from proper nutrition.

Danes do eat a lot—but if you take the time to notice, you will find that their meals are high in protein foods (fish, especially, meat fowl and eggs) and low in carbohydrates (bread in particular). Butter and cream are used in the preparation of many dishes-but are seldom used as additives at the table; rarely will a Dane gorge himself on bread or drench his vegetables with melted butter. It is surprising that bread is seldom served at home-and in restaurants it is often necessary to request some (a single slice without butter is usually what you get).

And while it is quite true that Danes drink a lot of beer when eating they seldom request second portions (no doubt a consequence of beer bloat). Nor are they big on desserts; most people find a small ice cream or some fresh berries satisfying. Pastry is generally reserved for

breakfast—and usually only one piece is eaten.

Danes are full of energy. They work hard by day and play harder by night. When they vacation they tend to choose activity—much swimming and hiking. This lifestyle, coupled with balanced meals, contributes in no small way to their physical beauty.

Facially they have soft lines and they are fair. Most have light brown hair—but you are likely to find even more blonds in Denmark than in Sweden. There are many dark-haired beauties too. Suffice it to say that by our standards they are handsome people spanning a range of facial types.

But the Danes are not only beautiful to look at; they have healthy minds too. It comes from having been liberated from within. They are independent. Their outlook is mature. They have a great sense of humor. To them sex is not only natural and healthful; it is also beautiful and they go about it without shame. And that includes gay sex. In Denmark, as anywhere else in the world, society prefers heterosex to homosex if only to insure procreation-but in Demnark homosexuality is not frowned upon, but simply accepted as still another form of human expression. Gay people, therefore, receive the same human considerations enjoyed by everyone else. But the Danes do frown on public display of emotion, whether gay or straight-and consider necking in public, and the like, in bad taste. They believe that what you do with your life-provided it does not interfere with the lives of others-should not be forced on

This article will concentrate on Copenhagen, the city and its gay life primarily because it is being written for the occasional visitor. Denmark as a whole is small but offers a lot for the tourist who wants to see everything—what with interesting woodland and seashore resorts not far from the capital, and hundreds of fascinating islands a distance away which require more than a brief visit.

I can't think of a more enjoyable city in Europe for gay guys than Copenhagen. Amsterdam is still the Gay Capital of Europe (please see the August 1976 Ciao! for a big article on Amsterdam) and it is a gem of a city. But gay life there is hectic; there is so much to do-and so many to be done-that you just keep going . . . going . . . going without letup. After Amsterdam you're ready for a rest home. Opportunities for sex in Copenhagen compare with those in such cities as London (see the June 1974 Ciao! for a big feature on London) and Munich and Paris but things are so spread out in these places that you waste a lot of time getting from here to there and they lack a lot of Old World charm which Copenhagen has no shortage of. So-for as much gay life as you want in a city where you are certain to make it with Danes (Amsterdam and London and Paris and so many other European cities attract so many tourists that you are likely to always end up in bed with someone from home) . . . for a city where gay guys are as beautifully humpy as the most fantasized stereotypes we have about mid-western farm-boys . . . for a city where homosexuals receive human dignity-and where it is legal . . . for a city where sex is as expert and diversified as it is here at home (in most European cities you will find that the emphasis is on anal sex and that guys are inept at oral antics) . . . for a city where gay guys bathe regularly (most Europeans seldom bathe-let alone douche) ... for a city where you can enjoy Americanized sex with a foreign accenttry Copenhagen.

WHEN TO GO

Whenever you visit Copenhagen you'll have a wonderful time. Winter and summer have their good and bad points.

In summer the weather is ideal—warm sunny days and cool evenings. The days are long, too; sunset is around 11 p.m. and sunrise at 3 a.m. Every year over 400,000 Americans travel to Copenhagen—mostly in

summer-and many are gay guys. This means there is no shortage of contacts during July and August-but it also means that you are likely to meet as many tourists as locals . . . which may or may not be to your liking. Tivoli Gardens—the fabulous amusement park in Copenhagen center-opens from May until September . . . affording still another diversion to fill your time. And motoring through Denmark is pleasant when it's warm-and that includes visits to nearby wooded meatracks and nude beaches.

Winters are never extreme but there are many sunless days and much fog. Tivoli Gardens is closed and outdoor activity is restricted to street cruising in Copenhagen proper. But there is so much to fill your time; the bars are full of Danes-as are the baths and film clubs. Not to mention john cruising. And the big advantage of going in winter is that prices are lower and there is no hassle finding a hotel-because tourists are scarce. Which leads to the greatest winter bonus of all; as an American you will be a standout (the Danes are fast to admit that American gays are the greatest sex going)—and you are certain to make it with Danes almost exclusively.

WHERE TO STAY

If you go in summer be sure and book hotel space before you arrive or you may find yourself wasting a full day trying to locate. If that happens, however, go directly to Kiosk P in the Central Railway Station in the heart of town and get assistance from the Accommodations Bureau (open daily from 9 a.m. to midnight). They know what's available and do not charge for their services.

Avoid such big Old World hotels as the d'Angleterre, the Imperial and the Palace—which lack modern conveniences and have lobby setups that make it impossible to get guests in and out. There are two big hotels which are modern and so impersonal that pickups can be brought in anytime. They are the Sheraton-Copenhagen Hotel, at Vester Søgade 6, and the Royal,

Hammerichsgade 1. Rates are about \$32 a day for a double. Both hotels are centrally located, only a few minutes walking distance from most of the sights and gay places. The SAS air terminal is on the ground floor of the Royal; its basement john is mildly cruised.

There are numerous budget hotels throughout the city. Most offer sparsely furnished rooms and no services-and at night the front door is locked . . . making it necessary for you to ring for the night porter to get in. This discourages bringing in guests. There is one exception the Hotel Vesta, Colbiornsensgade 5 . . . which is about a block from the Sheraton. Your room key opens the front doormaking it easy to get tricks in late at night. For this reason the place is favored by gays—but it is dumpy.

Copenhagen has a gay hotel called **Baltica**, Jernbanegade 4, next to Town Hall and only a stone's throw from Madame Arthur and the Why Not (see bars, below). It's pleasant enough and the corridors are sometimes rewarding. And rates aren't high. Write in advance for reservations. The **Jorgensen** is still your best bet; it's very pleasant, gay, and on a good street. Write (Nørre Søgade 29) or call 11 91 06 for reservations.

If you are planning a long stay in Copenhagen you might enjoy living just outside the city in your own cottage. Perhaps in Charlottenlund, a seaside resort which has a nighttime meatrack about 20 minutes by commuter train or bus from downtown Copenhagen. For information on cottage rentals throughout Denmark write to Dansk Centralkontor for Sommerhus-Udlejning A/S, Falkoneralle 7, DK-2000 Copenhagen F.

DINING

The Why Not (see bar section below) is a good breakfast place if you feel like eating after doing the bars all night. It opens at 5 a.m.

Sandwiches are available at the Pan Club (see bar section below) afternoons and evenings.

Oskar Davidsen's Søpavil-

lonen is a very good restaurant to sample smørrebrød-the open-faced sandwiches Denmark is famous for. But prices are high and it isn't unusual to run up a tab of \$10 per person for a couple of beers and one sandwich (particularly if you order lobster-which is very expensive all through Denmark). Go just once for lunch if only to be amused by a four-foot-long menu: and at lunchtime you won't feel out of place if you happen to be wearing jeans and an open leather vest.

Most likely—if you go in summer-you will snack while wandering around Tivoli Gardens. Sample everything. Not too far away, right opposite the main entrance of the Central Railway Station, you will find a smørrebrød "take out" shop that never closes. Prices are reasonable too, about \$1 a sandwich, and you can also buy soft drinks at the Favoritens, Vesterbrogade 5. It's a great place to know about if you get hungry after the restaurants close.

Copenhagen has no shortage of restaurants and you'll likely discover favorites of your own. If you happen to be walking on Strøget—Denmark's shopping street for pedestrians only—a good lunch place is KAR, Frederiksberggade 24 (Strøget is a collective name for several streets that more or less run into one another). Very modern. Good food. Reasonable.

Pam Pam, Town Hall Square 4, is where to go for a hamburger and quick grills. It's reasonable, and open from 11 a.m. to 2 a.m. Another good place for a hamburger is the Caravel coffee shop located on the ground floor of the Sheraton.

Most people drink beer with their meals—either Carlsberg or Tuborg (breweries in town).

GENERAL SIGHTSEEING

Copenhagen is quite small and very easy to walk. When you arrive, secure a free map from any hotel service desk and mark the listings in this article. You can then walk from place to place within minutes.

As far as general sightseeing

goes-you'll want to visit Tivoli Gardens several times. Apart from this I suggest you take a bus tour of Copenhagen when you arrive-not only to acquaint you with the city proper, but as a means of seeing such favorites as the Little Mermaid. Buses depart at scheduled hours from Town Hall Square (in front of the Palace Hotel) and the tour takes two-and-a-half hours. Price is about \$6 and tickets are sold at most hotels. There are also tours of the breweries-but you can do them on your own, if you wish.

The only other tour I suggest is the Castle Tour of North Zealand. It takes all day but it's very interesting and affords an easy way of seeing the Danish countryside—as well as a couple of fascinating castles. First you will visit Frederiksborg Castlenow a national museum maintained by the Carlsberg (beer) Foundation. Afterwards, lunch in Fredensborg-if you wish, at a beautiful old inn called Store Kro. Here you can gorge yourself on smørrebrød. After lunch there is time to walk on the grounds of Fredensborg Palace, the summer residence of the Queen. Then Kronberg Castle at Elsinore. This castle served as the setting for Shakespeare's "Hamlet" and here you will see the longest room in Europe. Price, excluding lunch, is about \$10 per person.

BARS

There's no shortage of gay bars in Copenhagen—regardless of your tastes. On Studiestraede, about 5 minutes from Town Hall Square, you'll find:

Cosy Bar, Studiestraede 24. Go through a small gate and up a few steps. One large room, dimly lit and almost dingy—but very popular after 1 a.m. when the Masken Bar across the street closes. Good age range and ideal cruising atmosphere. Opens at 10 p.m., and closes at 5 a.m.

Masken Bar, Studiestraede 33. A mixed bag of gay types and ages. Occasional fag hags at the bar. Pub atmosphere—warm and cheery. Very popular and noisy—but lots of friendly conversation. Best 10 p.m. until closing at 1 a.m.

Just off Studiestraede you'll find the Can-Can, Larsbjørns-straede 12. Very bright and seedy atmosphere. Used to be popular, but no more. There are few hustlers in Copenhagen because gay sex is so open and readily available—but if you want to buy rough young stuff this is the place. After midnight is best.

Practically in the shadow of Town Hall is Copenhagen's most popular gay bar-a disco called Madame Arthur, at Lavendelstraede 15. Unlike most dance bars cruising is great here. All ages, all types and always crowded right up until closing at 5 a.m. But don't arrive before midnight (it opens at 9 p.m.) because things don't pick up until then when the Why Not across the street at Lavendelstraede and Mikkelbryggersgade closes. (It reopens when Madame Arthur closes at 5 a.m. - and everybody who is still up and around heads there for breakfast.)

It's a 15-minute walk but worth going to the Pan Club, Nybrogade 28. Two floors, for on certain nights one of the bars is reserved for lesbians. It's very crowded on weekends. Dancing but good cruising. Mostly hip types. It's owned and operated by a gay group.

Here and there, other bars in town are:

Fortuna Bar, Vestergade 4. Down an alleyway and upstairs. Dancing from 8:30 p.m. on. Only fair.

Club Intime, Allegade 25. A campy old woman plays the piano. Only fair.

BATHS

Copenhagen's main gay baths is the Sauna Club Amigo, Studiestrade 31-A. It's open from 3 p.m. until 5 a.m. In addition to the usual pleasure there are gay flicks and a color TV. The age spread is good but tends to be youngish. Small membership fee plus admission.

Another gay baths in town is the Ami-Club, Danasvej 39. It's open Monday thru Saturday, 5 p.m. until 1 a.m. Closed Sundays. No membership, \$4 admission. Here's where local studs go: there are few tourists.

Still another is the Adonis Sauna, Nansensgade 25, which has lost favor with a lot of guys who now go to the Amigo. The action can get heavy, but the place is dark and lacks cleanliness. Join at the door the first time you go. Opens late after-

The København Bad (Copenhagen Baths) is a big operation at Studiestraede 61. It's essentially a straight baths and great if you enjoy looking. The baths are very popular in Scandinavia and many young straights go regularly, either for steam or for a bath. You might enjoy the

place for diversion.

Get a second-class ticket (about \$2) and go downstairs. The attendant will give you a walk-in locker-which is yours while you're there. He'll lock your valuables in a drawer after you change. Use the large steam room and cruise if possible. When you're ready to go back to your cubicle the attendant will open the door electronically . . . so-without a key to come and go as you wish-you'll more or less have to do your cruising outside your door or by sitting nude inside with your jaws hanging open so passersby will get the message. The straights are wise here, so it's likely you'll get a lot of trade . . . especially if you go around 4 p.m. and stay until closing at 7 p.m. Tip the attendant . . . he'll remember the next time you visit.

FILM CLUBS

Copenhagen's "porno street" is called Istedgade. To find it easily, enter the Central Railway Station and exit via the door on Istedgade. The porno shops start here and go for several blocks. Most of them are straight but many sell gay magazines and show gay films. To view them you "join" a "club" -- amounting to a single admission of around \$3. For gay action films the best place in town is the Homo Shop, Istedgade 36, up a flight of steps. Here you will find a small bookshop stocked with lots of gay magazines-mostly picture books pumped out of Hamburg which feature raunchy young types with tiny cocksand an adjoining "theatre" that seats 20 people for viewing the films. The show lasts about two-and-a-half hours before the films repeat—and there's always hot action in the seats. In fact-some people never even bother looking at the screen. And the owners of the place love it because it helps draw bigger crowds. Types and ages varybut you're bound to find at least one or two guys who turn you on . . . and if you happen to hit a dull hour—the films are steamy. The place opens around 11 a.m. and closes at 1 a.m.

In summer the Homo Shop operates a small bus that leaves the shop at 11 a.m. for Amagelfaelled—a wooded area about 20 minutes from Copenhagen, where there is a gay section for nude sunbathing and lots of sex in the bushes. The bus operates June through September, and pickup for the return is around 3 or 4 p.m. The fare is about \$5.

There's another gay film club called Laramie, Abel Cathrinesgade 14 right off Istengade. Try it. At Gay Kino, still another film club at Teglgardsstraede 16, you can view gay porno and get a massage(!) from young studs who man the place.

OUTDOOR CRUISING

Copenhagen is very much like New York . . . you can't walk a block without passing a gay guy. The streets adjoining the gay bars are good meeting places. So is Town Hall Square-particularly near the steps leading to the underground john in the middle of the plaza.

In summer only, especially when ships are in port, Langalinie Promenade in the vicinity of the Little Mermaid is cruised. But this is a distance from the heart of town. So is Amorparken, a park at Blegdemsvej and Tagensvei which is cruised late at night. Action on the spot.

Also in summer only, a wooded area 20 minutes from downtown Copenhagen by commuter train becomes a big nighttime meatrack. Take the "S" train (there are stops in town on Vesterport-near the Pan Am office-and in the Central Rail-

way Station) to Charlottenlund, a suburb of Copenhagen. Walk towards the shore in the direction of the aquarium. On this main road you will soon see a "castle" (it looks more like a large house) on the right. The building is now used for offices and the surrounding gate is never locked. The aquarium lies just beyond the castle-closer to the water. Go through the gate. Now, facing the front of the castle—walk around to the right side. Just behind it you'll see old sheds which probably served as stables years ago. Cruising begins here and goes as far as the aquarium. Much sucking and fucking in the bushes—but more

tourists than locals.

Keep in mind that summer nights are short in Denmark; sunset is around 11 p.m. and sunrise around 3 a.m. It never gets pitch black so you can always see what you're doingbut the short night gives you only four hours of fun in the woods. Moreover, the last "S" train is around midnight—so familiarize yourself with the local bus route in case you want to get back to town before the trains start running again later in the morning. I suggest you go out for an afternoon and case the place before attempting any nighttime activity. Charlottenlund has changing rooms on a small beach where you can sunbathe. These rooms are cruised-and though sex on the spot is difficult, it is nonetheless possible.

Amagelfaelled, mentioned above, is the daytime version of Charlottenlund . . . a nude version at that.

The most notorious john in Copenhagen is in the underground passage in Town Hall Square (between the two news kiosks). Cruised day and night (never closes). Meet at the urinals and leave. Occasional action, but risky, since sex in public is against the law. Don't attempt to use the private stalls in the next room for sex.

The john on the platform of the Vesterport"S" train station is constantly cruised from late morning until the trains stop running around midnight. To use it you needn't purchase a train ticket (but never attempt to ride the trains without a ticket . . . there's a stiff fine if you're caught) . . . just take the escalator down, and make a sharp right (the john is under the stairs). The room is small but has two private toilet stalls with translucent glass doors-thick enough so that it isn't possible to see what's going on inside. Sex there is constant. Be mildly cautious, however, as sex in public rooms is, I repeat, against the law.

If you meet someone here and do not want to go to his place or yeurs, but want more privacy—go upstairs and cross the street to enter the rear of the SAS air terminal. There's a large john downstairs—and when the coast is clear you can enter one of the private stalls. Take care when you leave, as there's no way of knowing who's outside.

There are several other public johns in town that are cruised, but the only one really worth mentioning is a small "piss house" on a street called Gothersgade, at the intersection of Landemaerket. It's outside the gate surrounding a park called Kogens Have. Lots of cruising at the downstairs urinals. Some action on the spot, but a great meeting place for humpy locals. The john closes at 10 p.m.

OTHER GAY DIVERSIONS

Live sex-shows are now illegal in Copenhagen—a consequence of the government's inability to collect taxes from operators. Along Istedgade you will still see signs advertising them but you will usually find that once you bite, the guy who takes your money will whisk you off to some secret location for the show. And if there's a raid while you're there you won't get your money back. Moreover—most of these shows are straight.

A business called Man-To-Man (M.T.M.) is all things to all people. Over the years it has provided live sex shows, orgies, etc., etc. Located at Schachsgade 9 (near Nansensgade), M.T.M. provides all kinds of services . . . for a fee. There are private live shows and orgies;

S&M parties for two or more; massage in your own hotel room; escorts; etc. On Thursday thru Saturday a group called "Scandinavian Leather Men" can be found at No. 9 after 10 p.m. For details ask at the Homo Shop or call 12 98 40.

The Copenhagen Show Service, Frederiksberggade 38 (telephone 11 40 04) provides escorts as well as house service.

SIDE TRIPS

There are three very worth-while side trips you can take. The first is a visit to the small town of Dragor —about 20 minutes by taxi from downtown (it's near the airport). This fishing village has many winding streets and quaint houses. It's an easy way to see a bit of old Denmark without going too far. There's a good restaurant in the town hotel—the **Strand**—which overlooks the busy dock.

The second excursion involves a 35-minute hydrofoil ride to Malmö, Sweden—across the sound from Copenhagen. Have lunch in the basement of Town Hall (expensive)—which has a vaulted ceiling. Then walk around town. There's a gay bar, the **Gay House**, Per Weijersgatan 8. it's not worth an evening away from Copenhagen—but if you stay overnight you will certainly want to visit.

There are two baths worth visiting—both straight, but opportunities do occur. They are Simhallsbadet, Regimentsgatan 2 (try the sauna and changing rooms); the Rorsjobadet, Drottninggatan 5. The johns in the Central Railway Station and in Gustav Adolf Torg—a plaza—are cruised and afford the usual opportunities. You can do the johns and the baths in an afternoon—and at least see a little bit of Sweden in the process.

You'll find that the hydrofoils get pretty crowded with commuters from Malmö who work in Copenhagen, and people who live in Copenhagen and shop in Malmö. Prices for staples are so much lower there. For example, a pound of coffee costs more than \$3 in Copenhagen, but only \$1 in Malmö. So be sure and

arrive early for the ride in either direction.

If you're in town for a long stay in summer, go out to about 50 km. north of Copenhagen. Drive, or go by train, to Hellerod, where you board a private train. When you get there walk from the parking lot for about 30 minutes through the forest or along the beach. Nudity everywhere, but the farther you go the gayer it gets. The forest behind the gay section is a meatrack.

This, then, is gay Copenhagen, a special favorite of almost all gay guys who know Europe. If you don't travel I hope this feature has provided a greater understanding of our Scandinavian friends—and if you do travel I hope you will come to know and love Copenhagen and its handsome people.

Bare And There! America's Swinging Nude Beaches

Currently there are fewer than 100 nude beaches in the United States. Although, theoretically, this averages two per state, some states have none... many have a few... a few have many... but the overall picture, until recently, has been one of broad, general areas where nude bathing thrives, rather than turn-right-at-the-next-corner for a nude beach near home.

Typical of such areas are (1) the long West Coastline, where California numbers the most beaches; and (2) the Atlantic Coastline, along which are strung some fantastic beaches all the way from New England to Florida. But what is more heartening is that Mid-America is also getting into the nude swim of things, and you'll find skinny-(also chubby-) dipping in such states as Colorado, Minnesota,

New Mexico and Texas. This is all the more surprising when one reflects that these states all lie in the so-called 'Bible Belt' where hellfire-and-brimstone evangelists such as Billy Graham and Billy Joe Hargis (who recently fell from grace when his bisexuality was discovered) still inveigh against nudity as if it were Original Sin. The difficulties experienced by naturists in advancing their cause have been enormous, and sweet is their victory.

Of the nude beaches mentioned, not all are gay. Indeed, the all-gay beach is the exception rather than the rule. But as surely as night follows day. wherever enlightened people gather for nude swimming/sunbathing there will be an enclave-perhaps only a tiny nucleus at first-gathered around a favorite dune here or there, where like seeks like, and sparks begin to fly. Soon, word of mouth brings gay others to meet the 'pioneers', and in less time than it takes to strip to the buff, a nude gay colony is formed.

PATTERN AND TREND

There are two specific, yet quite different, examples of this rise of nude beaches: one on the West Coast, the other on the East Coast. Torrey Pines State Park, alias Black's Beach, alias Bare-ass Beach-to give it the full treatment—lies just north of San Diego towards La Jolla, on Highway 101. It is located deep within the Park near the base of the golf course. Straights began coming here long ago for the all-year sunning and swimming. Gay guys were actually Johnnycome-Latelies. Now there is such an intertexture that one can distinguish another only by a cruisy wink. Although the straight/gay nudists get along well, there are the die-hards who would—if they could—prevail on the authorities to ban nudity entirely. They're outnumbered. however, and Bare-ass Beach goes on its merry way, unperturbed.

New York's Fire Island is another, yet quite different, example. It is now the world's largest summer gay colony. Yet it didn't begin that way. Originally it was a haven for noted writers, painters and others in the arts who built homes here and came each summer for nude sunning and bathing on Fire Island's unparalleled stretch of beach.

During the 1940s, however, Cherry Grove's small nucleus of gay people began to attract others. Straights, who were initially affronted by nudity, held their noses as they moved past the meat rack to The Pines, next door, or on to other areas of this long, skinny island. Soon The Pines attracted its own gay types-the wealthier and the sedately giddy. They built gorgeous homes, and their yachts in the marina are eye-catching. Now, all along the island, people of diverse sexual preferences live compatibly, and nudity is no problem. Fire Island is perhaps the supreme example of 'sexual democracy' in this great land of ours.

The pattern/trend continues. Just a few miles farther down the Atlantic Coastline, East Hampton—rich in history dating to the Revolution, and once the summer stronghold of the rich and rigid (in thought, not phallus)—has nucleized as gay. It's a pretty big 'nucleus', too, because East Hampton's gay population is now second only to that of Fire Island. However the nude aspect is still 'dip-a-pinkie-inthe-water' by comparison . . . there's not much of a 'splash' yet. Still, it shows trend, for what is happening in this formerly hidebound resort is being repeated elsewhere in the country. The pattern is plain . . . the trend swift.

TRUTH WILL OUT

Emerson said that "Once the door opens just a crack to let in the truth, it can never be shut again." The same may be said for nudity. Nudity is healthful and natural, and nature is such a compelling force that injunctions, restrictions, and an excess of prudery cannot long prevail against it. This was demonstrated during the past summer season at Provincetown when the older townspeople—having

been alarmed at the enormous increase in nudity, particularly gay nudity, the previous year—brought pressure to bear to ban all nudity. This surprised everyone who knows and loves this heavenly place, because P'town and Truro Beach represented the first bastion of expressive freedom in the United States.

Despite frantic efforts of the police to 'stamp out' nudityand there were numerous busts as well as much 'infiltration hassling'-there was enough Yankee daring and ingenuity in the gay contingent to outwit them at every turn. Whether this took the form of 'going underground' for the nonce (finding secret areas for nude bathing/ sexing), or what became a typical ruse of wearing a long tank-top with nothing beneath (which complied with the antinudity regulations, but, when wet, made a nuder/gayer impression than actual nudity might have done!), 'truth' prevailed, and P'town was, in the main, as of yore. Ambientially, it was a helluva lot more exciting!

With pattern and trend thus in mind, we should like to list all the nude beaches in the United States that we presently know about. If we miss some that you know about, please drop us a line, describing them in as much detail as possible. As we have noted, some are gay, some largely so, but most are straight. Nonetheless, it's easy to spot our gay brothers anywhere, and so by making an effort at communication we can contribute to the success of such beaches, and the proiliferation of others. Here, state by state, is the 'bare and there' of it.



ARIZONA

Tucson:

Reddington Pass. Drive out to the Tanque Verde Guest Ranch and ask for precise directions on how to reach a cluster of lovely waterfalls and natural pools not far from this establishment. In general, one follows Tanque Verde to a dirt road, and thence along that road to a path, continuing for about two miles or less to this sudden paradise.

Sabino Canyon. When the rains come to Arizona it's a time for nude rejoicing. Nudists head for this canyon just north of Tucson to swim in the newly/naturally-formed pools.

CALIFORNIA

Bia Pine:

Middle Palisades. Follow the main road in the center of town to West Mountain—a distance of about 25 miles. Here's a stream that nudists love. Big Pine is roughly near the entrance to the Eureka Valley area up north of San Francisco.

Big Sur:

Pfeiffer Beach. A totally carefree beach on the Big Sur coast. Breathtakingly beautiful and isolated.

Bolinas:

Bolinas Lagoon Beach. A beach only. No swimming because of a sewage draining at this point. Good only during the lagoon season. Sunbathing is at the mouth of the lagoon. If you're up in the general direction of the Sonoma Valley, around Santa Rosa, give it a whirl.

Davenport:

Near San Jose is Red, White and Blue Beach. The beach is 4½ miles south of Davenport. Privately owned; an entrance fee is charged. Dogs and cameras are prohibited (à la the Ilê du Levant in France), and the ambience is on the Palm Beach side.

Gaviota:

Gaviota Beach. Sunbathing, swimming and clam digging.

Half Moon Bay:

San Gregorio Beach—what else! A fabulous place dear to the gay guys up San Francisco way. Nine miles south of the town of Half Moon, this frantic place has long been the favorite

of California nudists. Action in the caves!

Hesperia:

Deep Creek Hot Springs. This is in Apple Valley in the San Bernardino National Forest. A small stream, surrounded by little pools, runs the length of the canyon. A special favorite of every nudist for really cool skinny-dipping.

Los Angeles Area:

Zuma Beach. Also known as Pirate's Cove. This legally nude beach draws more than 30,000 bathers/sunners on weekends. It's quite small for such a large crowd, but somehow everyone makes out and it really doesn't seem too crowded. Sometimes there's action on the rocks.

Malibu:

Point Dume Beach. Lying just north of this famous movie colony is this popular nudist beach. In spite of the hassling common to Los Angeles proper, the law visits here sometimes and just warns bathers to "cover up." So bring along a hankie.

Mammoth:

Hot Creek. A family-nudist type place, an extension of Highway 395, with its famous hot springs. At night the younger crowd activates this nudist haven. Use caution . . . occasionally the fuzz comes around.

Mount Baldy Village:

Bear Canyon. In the famous Mount Baldy Winter Sports Area, north of, and midway between Pasadena and San Bernardino. A part of the Angeles National Forest. This nudist place is a small stream, dotted with little pools, and extends the length of the canyon. A delightful place.

Pacifica:

Devil's Slide. A private, and legal, nude beach. Five miles from the center of Pacifica. An entrance fee (also parking fee) is charged. Very gay and some action.

Point Reyes National Seashore:

Limantour Beach. A beautiful beach surrounded by rolling hills. The scenery along here is mind-blowing, and so, often, are the bodies. Not good when the temperature is chilly . . . too much wind. Not far from Santa Bosa.

Russian River:

The beach along the river a half-mile from Mirabelle Park is very hip—much nudity and a favorite of gays. Action too.

Sacramento:

Paradise Beach. Lots of nudists, particularly gay nudists, at this great beach. Best during the day. At night it's risky.

San Diego:

Torrey Pines State Park . . . or Black's Beach . . . or Bare-ass Beach—whichever you prefer. It's incomparable, and was discussed earlier in this article. A don't miss, if you're out this way.

San Luis Obispo:

Pirate's Cove. The name isn't patented, so this is not related to another beach of the same name, described under the L.A. heading. A wonderful all-nudist beach with the calmest surf; also some very un-calm gay guys. It's idyllic!

Santa Barbara:

Devereaux Beach is adjacent to Isla Vista, and just north of the U. of C. of S.B. The students would like to know more about sex than just the birds 'n bees bit. Come and teach.

More Mesa Beach. An allnudist beach, backed by white sandstone cliffs as far as the eye can see. You'll find gay guys among the dunes. But even without connecting how can you miss with 16,000 nude bathers? Santa Cruz:

Hole in the Wall. Huge granite rocks . . . stiff winds on some days. But worth a visit if you are up this way.

Santa Catalina Island:

Off Long Beach, if you're in a boating mood. Two coves on the northwest side of the island.

Summerland:

Lots of gay guys on this nude

beach. Think 'Santa Barbara'. It's 6 miles south on Highway 101. The fuzz often cause trouble here. Much hassling at times. But it's worth it to meet the thousands of nude bathers.

Venice:

Yes and no. There are times when part of the beach is nude ... others when the law bears down. Check, before you get too interested in it. A bodybuilders' paradise ... great bods. Most times the nudists don't give a damn, and go their own way—like fuck the fuzz. But check it out before diving in.

Ventura County:

Rincon Beach. An 'understated' nude beach. Something you might like to discover for yourself. Selective nudes. Lots of interesting nooks in which to play hide-and-seek. A special haven for the **shy** nude.

COLORADO

Glenwood Springs:

South Canyon Hot Springs. The natural hot springs of this nude paradise are the great attraction. Come, and get squeaky clean, or vice versa. No hassling. Off Interstate 70. This is in the midst of a winter sports area between Grand Junction and Denver (nearer Grand Junction, however). Lots of young guys make it here.

FLORIDA

Fort Lauderdale:

Dania Beach. Drive south on U.S. 1, left on A1A, then left on the ocean for ½ mile. Don't miss! Meat rack. Everything. Daytime is best.

Key West:

Grassy Key. Very popular. Nudists. Hustlers. The works. **Miami:**

Virginia Beach. The gay section is wild. Turn off garbage
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road opposite the Seaquarium, drive right on beach to the gay area. Check our gay guide "Private Stock." Nudity and sex in bushes. Exercise caution.

New Smyrna Beach:

Turtle Mound. Have you ever seen a turtle mount? This is one of the oldest nude beaches in Florida. Come and join the fun. It's not all geriatric water follies. Lots of youngayguys too.

Sarasota:

Lido Beach. Topless gals began it all. Straights followed. Now gay guys.

Siesta Key. Lots of deserted stretches of beach along this Gulf of Mexico area. Come and find what other gay guys/nudists are doing.

Titusville:

Canaveral National Seashore. With more than 20 miles of beach here there are plenty of secluded spots for nude bathing and sunning. Most find it better to stay away from crowded areas so the fuzz won't come and spoil everything.

HAWAII

Maui:

Makena Beach on the island of Maui is like paradise anew. Lots of nudity among the bisexual guys who camp out here . . . and happily do it for some friendly conversation and a smoke.

MASSACHUSETTS

Boston:

L Street Beach. As Bostonian as the bean and the cod. Nude bathing by men on this public

beach. For some reason the women prefer to swim clothed in another area. No doubt the Lizzie Borden influence. You know . . . 'Cause you can't chop your poppa up in Mass-s-sachusets!

Ipswich:

Crane's Beach. This one's for the cranes. Too many cops on patrol. Still, things do change, so give it a looksee if you get this far. It's crowded; lots of nude swimmers; but you have to hike about a mile along the beach before you get to the business end.

Martha's Vineyard:

Jungle Beach. At the edge of Chilmark, and relatively hard to reach. This past summer nudity was caught in the soundwaves of the Truro Beach hassle. But try again if you're up this way.

Zach's Beach. Between Chilmark and Gay Head, reached by a climb down steep cliffs. Probably worthless, but give it a try.

Newburyport:

Plum Island. This beach is about 20 miles from Boston and is principally a wildlife preserve just south of the town of Newburyport. The island is a little over 8 miles long and in its very secluded areas there is much nude bathing/sunning. Don't fail to go at least once when you're up this way. Quite deserted and has a special nude 'Eden ambience'.

Provincetown:

Herring Cove Beach. Left, in the dunes. Sex too. Fabled beach with much to recommend it. Check the P'town story earlier in this article. Gay.

Truro:

Brush Hollow Beach, to give it its proper name. On any day in summer there are at least 16,000 nudists here. This is the beach where all the hassling began. By next summer everything should be back to normal.

MICHIGAN

Door County:

The Dunes. All along here are lots of remote, beautiful areas for nude bathing. Green Bay has fine swimming. Also Washington Island, off the tip of Door County, is nudely active.

Traverse City:

Pentwater. A nude beach

south of Traverse City on U.S. 31. Very popular in summer.

Sleeping Bear Dunes. A long stretch of Lake Michigan just off U.S. 31. Also very popular.

MINNESOTA

Minneapolis:

Lake Calhoun. Some cautious nude bathing here. If you like tall, blond Swedes, here's where you'll find 'em.

St. Paul:

A gay and straight nude beach on the east bank of the Mississippi. Like its California namesake, it's called **Bare-ass Beach**.

NEVADA

Lake Tahoe:

Here's a muchly-gay nude beach in this area of 'Calneva'. It's called Paradise, and it sure as hell is. Several readers have recommended it, and we pass it along to you. Follow Highway 28 south past Sand Harbor to Marlette Creek Bridge. Watch carefully, for the road is not well marked. Just past the bridge you'll note parking areas on each side of the road, from which a trail branches off. Follow the trail to the left of the creek; cross the creek; then go left again on the trail. The nude area is at the north end of the beach and rocks. A very worthwhile diversion if you're making the Lake Tahoe scene.

NEW MEXICO

Jemez Springs:

Spence Hot Springs. If you're visiting historic New Mexico, by all means stop off here for the nude bathing . . . legal Sunday through Wednesday. Off Highway 44 in the Santa Fe National Forest.

NEW YORK

Amagansett:

Asparagus Beach. Amagansett lies just south of East Hampton (it actually adjoins it) and is somewhat farther down Long Island toward Montauk. Like its nude neighbors, Amagansett is taking it all off.

Brooklyn:

Riis Park. This lies in the Borough of Brooklyn, and is the nudest/gayest public beach in America. The gay section is close to the fence, to the left of the bathhouse. But then, how can you miss with 50,000 gay guys?

Fire Island:
Nuff said!

Manhattan:

A wooden beach, would you believe? The piers and pilings around the huge World Trade Center are great for sunning nude and for cruising like crazy. More pier than beach, but worth every moment you spend there . . . particularly during sunny weekends. Also try Pier 51 just south of 14th Street.

Jones Beach. Actually not part of New York City. It's nearer the town of Freeport on Long Island. It can boast of having the cleanest sand of any beach on the Atlantic Seaboard. A very gay crowd makes up a large contingent of the 100,000 or so bathers here. The nude gay area is one mile east of parking lot #9. Also a bit farther on—about a mile past the Tobay Beach parking lot. Nudity on the beach; sex in the dunes.

South Beach. This also is not part of Manhattan. It is actually on Staten Island. The south end is the nude gay end. Well worth a visit.

New Paltz:

Low Falls. New Paltz is an old college town. Drive north on Routes 44/55 until you see cars parked, then ask someone how to reach Low Falls. Although it is not an essentially gay beach, its nude bathers include lots of humpy college students.

NORTH CAROLINA

Stokes County:

Dan River Beach. Not far from Winston-Salem or Greensboro. Very popular with nudists. Gets a young crowd.

Ocracoke:

Ocracoke Island. A long skinny island with Pimlico Sound on one side, the Atlantic Ocean (Raleigh Bay) on the other. Topographically, at least, it's like New York's Fire Island. A nudist paradise in a favored wildlife preserve . . . wild sea oats, wild horses, and noted as the home of the snowy egret. The nude bathing area is on the northern part of this remote Outerbanks Island. North Carolina's nudists love it. Come and join them! It's coastally north of Wilmington.

OREGON

Cougar Reservoir:

The Hot Springs. This great place is high above Cougar Dam. Nude swimming most of the year. Oregon has a rather cold climate and these hot springs can get everything warmed up nicely. The location is 30 miles southeast of Eugene.

Eugene:

Mount Pisgah. A beautiful bird sanctuary southeast of Eugene. Used to be a favorite place for glider enthusiasts. Now the skinnydippers are here in force. The beach lies along the Willamette River. Once this was polluted . . . now it has been cleaned, and at this writing was quite safe. No hassling at present, but some legislation is due up for a vote soon. Check.

TEXAS

Lake Travis:

Hippy Hollow. A nudist haven peopled mostly by University of Texas students who come here from Austin for the nude bathing (and hijinx). Some really great humpyhungs here, although this is a general nude beach . . . not overtly gay.

UTAH

Salt Lake City:

A favorite meeting and gay action place is at the beach in the sprawling city. Directions: Drive out North Temple to a dirt road ½-mile past the Salt Air Café. If you can't find it, stop in at the café and ask specific directions.

VERMONT

Wilmington:

The Gorge. Lies just over the border from Massachusetts. A beautiful naturist area. Waterfalls and pools add to the lush beauty. Everyone enjoys the nude bathing.

WASHINGTON

Black Diamond:

The Gorge. This one is 'terrain-ically' a bit difficult to

reach. You'll need heavy walking shoes to scramble down the cliffs to the beautiful clear water and excellent nude bathing below. Green River is the body of water. About 30 miles southeast of Seattle.

Grayland:

Grayland Beach. This one is about 60 miles west of Olympia, the capital of Washington. Good in summer only because of the climate—unfailingly cold and damp. You'll swim in the Pacific and there are lots of dunes where nudists gather.

Seattle:

The Swimming Hole. On the west shore of Lake Washington. This is a beach appealing mostly to the very young and athletic. Much spectacular diving. Take U.S. 10 toward Bellevue. Motorists often think they're in Australia with kangaroos leaping across the road. But it's really only young divers getting up speed for distance as they run to the edge of the cliff!

WISCONSIN

Sun Prairie:

The Quarry. Off Route 151 and about 11 miles northeast of Madison, this is a favorite nude swimming area of the University of Wisconsin students. Flocks of 'em! The land is privately owned, and although the law has been lenient, there is always much pressure in Madison to 'do something about those pesky nudists'. Some day they will, no doubt . . . but gay guys will find a way, never fear!

Recipes From Around The World

Gathered by The Editors

Nature may have taught you the virtue of thrift, and though you love to entertain you do so for a few guests at infrequent times. Or you may be a natural spendthrift, entertaining many, and often, yet who now feels that

in these pinch-pocketbook times you can't afford to entertain as lavishly as of yore. Things, you think, look bleak . . . bleaker still as the holiday season approaches. What do do? Double, double, toil and trouble . . . Tricky Dicky burst the bubble.

May we put a silver lining in your cloud? How? Invite all the guests you'd like to have and give 'em a really 'sock-it-to-mebaby' Christmas punch! An unusual punch that will do as well—even far better—than all those fancy, expensive cocktails

you've always served.

A punch is **the** most convivial drink because everyone is drinking it. It is also the least expensive because you buy a few store-label brands in bulk, mix in bulk, and serve in bulk (instead of having to stock Scotch, Bourbon, rye, gin, vodka and various expensive liqueurs such as Kahlua, Drambuie, and so on). Another saving is in time. Spending less time in the kitchen gives you more time for fun 'n games.

At this time we should like to give you recipes for three exceptional punches—one English, and two German—none requiring a cash outlay of more than \$25 for twelve to fifteen guests. How's that for thrift? The first punch is traditionally British/Colonial Indian.

BOMBAY PUNCH

Place a big chunk of ice in a handsome punch bowl. Now add these bulk ingredients: 1 pint of brandy . . . 1 pint of sherry . . . 3 ounces Maraschino liqueur . . . and 3 ounces curacao. Just before serving pour in 1 quart of club soda and 1 quart of champagne. Have slices of fresh lemon and lime in reserve for garnishing. Twelve to fourteen guests can feast their eyes and their palates on this. A good imported Greek or German brandy is less than \$6 a bottle, and as for the champagne use an American brand. Far less costly, and mixed with other potables who knows that you haven't used Dom Perignon? Use American sherry (medium), and an inexpensive curacao. All fired up together this makes a smashing

punch. Thriftip: Use wine-glasses of smaller size, rather than heavy, eight-ounces-to-the-drink punch cups. Your punch will go farther (and you'll get more mileage from your guests later on!).

WEINACHTSBOWLE (Christmas-night Punch)

This magnificent punch requires more doing—two days of preparation, in fact. But it's not at all complicated, and whin your guests see the ravishing picture it makes on your diningroom table or buffet you'll know that it was worth the effort to create something so unusual and special for them. Here again, serve the punch in pretty fluted wine-glasses, rather than in punch cups.

On the day before the party you'll need . . .

1 pint of strawberries—fresh and hulled. Slightly less than ½ cup of sugar. Get from your pharmacist or herb store enough woodruff (dried) to yield 1½ cups. The German word for woodruff is Waldmeister (your pharmacist may know it only by that name). Also 1 bottle of light Moselle wine.

On the day of the party you'll need . . .

1 quart of strawberries—fresh and hulled. Also 3 bottles of the same light Moselle wine. A bottle of champagne. The wine and the champagne should be ice cold. And plenty of shaved ice.

Blending procedure: On the day before, put the first day's strawberries in a bowl with the sugar, sprinkled on. Steep the woodruff in 2 cups of the wine and set it aside at room temperature. Pour the remaining wine over the sugared berries and set them in the refrigerator.

On the day of the party clean the fresh strawberries and chill them. Also chill the punch bowl. Then just before serving the Weinachtsbowle, strain into the cold bowl the wine in which the woodruff was steeped. Strain the wine from the sugared strawberries into the punch bowl also, and discard the woodruff and yesterday's strawberries. Now add the fresh berries and the 3

bottles of light Moselle wine, and the bottle of champagne (a full bottle... not a half-bottle, or a split). Pack the punch bowl in a bed of shaved ice. Also the glasses. In each glass of the Weinachtsbowle served place a couple of strawberries. Prosit!

(Of course, frozen, unsweetened strawberries that have not been packed in juice may be used. Fresh ones, however, have more zest and tang. Also, if your pharmacist or herb store is out of woodruff, you may obtain this herb from Aphrodisia, 28 Carmine Street, New York, N.Y. 10014. Or from Kiehl Pharmacy. Inc., Herb Importers, 109 Third Avenue, New York, N.Y. 10009. Westerners may order from the San Francisco Herbs & Natural Foods Company, at 367 Ninth Street, San Francisco, California 94103.)

KALTE ENTE (Easy Cold Duck)

A simple recipe, easily made in seconds. A very good punch that can be remade as more guests arrive than you anticipated. To each bottle of Rhine wine and dry champagne (a full bottle each), add 1/2 cup of California Burgundy wine and 8 lumps of sugar saturated in the juice of 2 freshly-squeezed lemons. Have all these ingredients as cold as possible. Delish! Your quests will love this convivial drink so you'd better have enough wine, champagne and ice. Remember, Rhine wine is inexpensive (even California or New York State 'Rhine') and so are domestic Burgundy and domestic champagne.

Atlanta . . . The U.S. Center for Disease Control has alerted world health authorities to a new strain of penicillin-destroying gonorrhea. Spectinomycin, an


