Vanishing Venice In Neptune's Grasp

Before Neptune claims Venice for his bride—and she's sinking so fast as soon to be in his watery clutch—gay people who have never seen her should include Venice in their next possible European itinerary. Every moment another millimeter of indescribable beauty disappears.

Assuredly Venice is not the gavest city in Europe-nor in Italy-for in five days one can encompass its gay life and start all over again. Yet there are such miracles of sublime glory here that anyone with a love of beauty-and who feels a poignant sadness that it's all going to disappear-will find this city incomparably enriching. So after you've done the Harry's Bar bit. plus a few other gay bars . . . sighed on the Bridge of Sighs ... visited the Palace of the Doges . . . cruised the Lido, and fed those ravenous pigeons in the Piazza San Marco, a day should be set aside for an experience you will treasure . . . the art experience of Peggy Guggenheim's Museum.



New Yorkers and visitors to New York are well acquainted with her Uncle Solomon's Guggenheim Museum on Fifth Avenue... the one some say looks like a butter-tub in search of an English muffin. For a long time Miss Guggenheim and her uncle were estranged. Then in 1969 she consented to place on exhibition in Uncle Sol's "garage" as she calls it, 125 pieces from her collection. Long an expatriate from the United States, she found New York depressing, and has never returned. As she says, "America is all flat . . . the houses are exactly the same and in New York the people are all the same. The country is so big and impersonal and very savage now."

Miss Guggenheim's Museum is also her home; a home that simply became a museum-a palazzo on the Grand Canaland the public can visit this breathtaking place free on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday afternoons. The current worth of her collection is \$20,000,000, which is not by any means stupendous as museum-worth goes, but it includes some priceless works: six Picassos. thirteen Max Ernsts, a Juan Gris, two Braques, and one or two each by Brancusi, Pollock, Klee, Mondrian, Tobey, Moore, Marini, de Chirico and Miro. As you have divined, her Museum's take-off point is post-impressionist. But equally as fascinating is how she has hung her collection to make every inch of space set off each work like a fine jewel in an overall setting that catches the heart in wonder. So please don't miss the opportunity of seeing palazzo, paintings and particularly Miss G herself . . . she's quite a gal . . . and a real camp.

As she has often said, her first marriage was to Laurence Vail. described in her 1946 memoirs as "King of Bohemia." Then he departed and she had a string of later lovers, one of whom-John Holms-died while having an operation on his wrist. Another was Douglas Garman, writer turned Communist partisan. As she says, "My last legal marriage was to Max Ernst, a surrealist painter and refugee German (it was the time of World War II), which is why there are more Max Ernsts in her collection than works of others.

Of the more than 260 works of art in Miss G's Museum, many were bought from the artists themselves at a time when the Germans threatened Paris and every painter wanted to get out as quickly as possible. Many were unknowns, and their paintings bought for a song, and have since become priceless. In this respect she reminds us somewhat of Gertrude Stein whose famous collection was largely of works by unknown painters who became great.

She says that upon returning to Europe after the war she searched for a home in Veniceshe loves the city more than any other on the continent-and discovered the Palazzo Venier dei Leoni, which dates to 1749. It is located a little downstream and across the canal from the Piazza San Marco, midway the Accademia and the Salute. She spent three years turning the one floor, cellars and garden into a unified work of art. The visitor to the Museum is at once delighted by the airy spaciousness of its overall effect. The garden-entrance is through a handsome lacy metal gate-is cool and inviting, with many sculptures and a quite spectacular view of the Museum interior. its walls bright with canvases. In the cellar are collages by her first husband, and other constructions, and one room is devoted to the primitive works of Miss Guggenheim's daughter Pegeen, who is dead.

What pleases Miss G most is, as she says, "the fact that young people love to come here even before going to St. Mark's . . . young people interested in this particular era of painting, and who find inspiration here." Possibly the first thing the visitor to her Museum will discover is the lack of 'two-of-a-kind-ness' . . . nothing repetitive or imitative . . . honest craftsmanship and inspired dedication pervade the

When you visit this lovely Museum on the Grand Canal you may run into Miss G sunbathing on the roof, or she may have chosen that particular time to go for a ride in her own private gondola . . . the only remaining private gondola in all of Venice.

So go . . . before Venice goes down the drain!

Beirut

Big and cumbersome skyscrapers rise back-to-back along the shores of Beirut in sort of an extravagant confusion of steel, glass and cement. What was once an uncluttered Mideast paradise, a marvelous spa for weary round-the-world travelers, has unfortunately become just another congested jungle. Yet Beirut is still the most popular city in the Mideast.

The hotels are big and elegant, and the nightclubs are raw and sexy. It is certainly not a city that gently caresses your senses. but instead it explodes before you in a kaleidoscope of frenzied activity and con games. It's a man's city, where the games are played hard and for big stakes. Strong character is needed in order to survive its violent climate that liquefies you with the speed of an Osterizer. This is probably due to the war which has eroded some of the hospitality of the Lebanese and left them uncomfortably greedy for your money.

Every scheme known to man since the dawn of civilization is tried here with all the brashness of Hamburg's St. Pauli district. If, for example, you feel a little dizzy after coffee, chances are good that your coffee had more than caffeine in it. But this, unfortunately to some, is one of the many games the Mideasterner likes to play in order to loosen your hold on your money. Staying ahead of these games is the challenge of a Mideast vacation. It is this type of challenge that makes worldly travelers stop here and gorge themselves on pleasure before flying off to the next city on their globe-trotting adventure. Experienced travelers will know what new travelers must learn: how to select wisely from the pleasures without being punished. This is the art of traveling in the Mideast; this art must be particularly sophisticated if you are to survive here without scars.

For years Beirut enjoyed the reputation of being one of the best cities in the world for shopping. Although some fabulous goods are still available here, their prices are now outrageously expensive. Wise shoppers, in consequence, will head for Damascus, only a few hours away by car, to do their bargaining in Syria's fabulous bazaars, rather than spend their money in Lebanon on inflated-price goods.

There are several shopping tips to remember as a first-time tourist in this part of the world. Although the better shops in Beirut discourage bargaining, you must always test your salesman to see if you can force the price down. If you are determined to buy, you should first drift from shop to shop and do some comparative bargaining. No matter what you're going to buy-whether it's a luxurious Persian rug or a Chinese-made tablecloth—never deal with anyone but the salesmen. Guides usually get a large percentage of the sale just for pushing you into any given shop. It is much wiser to get that money back as a price reduction from the shopkeeper than to give it to some parasite.

My favorite shop in Beirut is still Asfar Brothers in the elegant St. George Hotel. Every imaginable thing from brass trays to valuable old coins is sold here. If you are interested in Persian rugs, I suggest that you avoid Hassan Maktabi and Brothers Ali (both the Free Port and Rauche branches). This firm is irresponsible and slow at shipping rugs. I paid them an enormous air-freight bill to have my two rugs sent to me, and to date-two months later-I still haven't received them. My letter and cable, and even the American Embassy in Beirut and the Lebanese Consulate in New York, haven't been able to jar this supposedly respectable establishment into sending me the rugs. So don't buy anything you can't take with you. Exception: Asfar Brothers.

If you want to see the sights of Lebanon (Baalbeck and Byblos are two of the many), avoid

Lebtours (Lebanon Transport). They have been known to cancel tours on a whim without notifying you. When you arrive to board their bus (which is many miles from the center of the city), they will quickly excuse the cancellation, then brazenly try to sell you another tour. My experiences on several of their antique buses convinced me that they were more interested in my money than in serving me. Since they have a monopoly on organized tours in Beirut, the only way you can avoid them is by taking taxis. This, though, isn't expensive. Lebanon is a small country, and if you forego the private cab, and take instead a service (a share-a-cab), you will have a colorful and inexpensive journey to your destination.

Like all Mideast countries, men seem available everywhere. It doesn't require effort to find someone. It does take effort to screen them, though. Everyone seems to be looking for a payoff, and the smart gay, realizing this, can cut through a lot of conversation by finding out exactly what his partner is after, before committing himself. Beirut is one of those few countries where one must always be alert, always sensitive to every nuance of behavior, before diving into bed with some super-butchlooking Arab. If a traveler is alert through screening everyone carefully, he will be rewarded with a fantastic romp in the bed with a well-hung Arab who knows exactly how to part your ass.

Because of the war and Lebanon's prosperity, many Arabs from all parts of the Mideast have moved here to find refuge and even success. Consequently, all types of men drift along the streets of Beirut in search of a living. Many refer to Beirut as "Little Paris," and perhaps it is, to some. To me, Beirut is still the Mideast . . . tough, exciting and wide open, with none of the beauty of Paris to give it style.

Beirut isn't a city where gays will have difficulty finding activity. Those who find the mood of the city uncomfortable should stick close to the bars and

swimming-pools of the better hotels. (Some of these are the Carlton, Continental, Riviera, Palm Beach, St. George, and Phoenicia. The Palm Beach and Continental have a reputation for attracting gay activity.) You will meet international types in such hotels and won't feel so reluctant about inviting them to your room for a little exercise. But such hotels can be expensive; their prices comparable to those of New York and Paris. A nice budget hotel (about \$10 per night) is the Semiramis (next to the very elegant Hotel Alcazar). It isn't gay, but it is perfectly located and quite comfortable.

For outdoor night cruising, there is the stretch in front of the Riviera along the water on the Avenue de Paris. Most of the gays here drift from this section to that in front of the hotels Phoenicia and Alcazar on the Rue du Sour. Avenue de Paris is quietly cruisy by comparison with the hectic action around the Phoenicia. But beware: those cute, well-assembled boys and men in tight pants who flash melting smiles are all determined to get paid . . . one way or another. Even a brief conversation with one will cost you if you aren't courageous enough to tell them no and walk away.

The area from the Phoenicia-Alcazar to the Hilton Hotel is very interesting. Taxi drivers and strollers are eager to do anything for a quick romp. This is particularly true around the Phoenicia-Alcazar area where cruising seems more direct and wild. Near the Hilton it is quieter. Men sit in the cars or drive around the area, but not in the frenzy of the former area. This may change, though, when

the Hilton—newly built—gets going full swing.

There is a john near the Hilton in front of the American Export Lines. To reach it you must take the stairs to the water. The stairs don't go all the way down, and end at the entrance to the john. Although dirty, smelly and dark, it is always busy. If you wait long enough, you will meet all types here.

On the Avenue de Paris between the American Embassy and the Riviera Hotel there are two outdoor johns. Although they aren't particularly gay, they can be cruisy on a warm evening when gays and hustlers are taking one of their many oceanfront walks. In the Place des Martyrs there is a john but it isn't particularly busy; but it may be worth a stop. Both this

john and that on the Avenue de Paris are clean and unoffensive. This also applies to the john on the Rue de Phenicie (near the Martinez Hotel). To find it you must make a sharp left on Phenicie at the end of the street, and it is immediately to your right.

The Place des Martyrs is worth your time if you want rough action. You should select a café in the Place and have a tea and cruise the men around you. Many stop here to smoke waterpipes and to converse with friends. The atmosphere is so manly and exotic that you will probably come just sitting here. staring at the men. The bazaar is nearby. Many times for amusement. I would walk through the narrow, congested streets and bump into strangers and gently grope them. I would do this as though by accident. Several times, though, because of such brazenness, I got propositioned. Warning: Watch your wallet! These Arabs are very good pickpockets.

Incidentally, the movies near the Place des Martyrs are worth a visit. This applies to those few on Rue Basta (which is near the Pan Am office). Rue Basta is the street leading into Basta before you go under the overpass. These movie theatres aren't gay—at least not as we know them in the States—but they can be cruisy.

There are two baths in Beirut worth mentioning. The baths in the Continental Hotel (best on Sunday afternoons only), and the Bain Turk at 19 Rue Kasti. To find the Bain Turk, take Rue Basta to the overpass. Then you should climb the stairs to the overpass. This should be Avenue General Fuad Chehab.

Follow this street one block to Kasti. It is especially clean and nice, and which most gays refer to as the Basta Baths. Both are mixed.

The Hotel Martinez on Rue Phenicie (close to the Hotel Phoenicia) gets some cruising in the snack bar. Hustlers and gays have been known to sit outside and cruise strangers walking along the street. The Rue Phenicie has many bars and girlietype show lounges, and most of the tourists and super-butch Arabs spend considerable time here. If you want to watch the flow of traffic and enjoy a coffee or sandwich at the same time in elegant comfort, go to this snack bar.

Rue El Hamra is another street which is interesting and, perhaps to some, more elegant because the shops and hotels are mostly modern and slick. It is the Champs-Elysées of Beirut and it is often cruisy at night. There are so many bars and nightclubs and restaurants in the area that you literally need a

guide to know where to go. There is a gay bar in the area called the George and Dragon. Have a taxi drive you to it as it is difficult to find by yourself. Another bar is Raoucheh (pronounced Raw-shay) in the Raoucheh area near the Continental Hotel. Again go by taxi—and be sure the driver knows the place before you get in.

The Strand Bar in the Strand Hotel on Rue Hamra is a very nice place to go. It is mixed, but since everyone is so bisexual in the Mideast, they all seem mixed. If you sit outside in the Strand Café you can watch the traffic on the street. Like Martinez, it is worth the price of a sandwich or beer or whatever.

Nelson's Inn

Near the Strand Hotel, off Rue Jeanne d'Arc (a block off Rue Hamra) is the Hotel Bedford. The Nelson's Inn (pub) which is in the Hotel Bedford, attracts a nice crowd, as well as its share of hustlers.

Since the Mideasterner loves his sex, all it takes to get him interested in you is a smile. So smile, whenever you're in the mood. You may get more offers than you can handle.

Washington, D.C.

Washington is no longer that city on the Potomac wedged tightly between Virginia and Maryland which everyone tries to escape on weekends. A new loyalty has emerged in recent years and residents are spending fewer weekends in New York and more in D.C.'s super bars and baths. The fear of being "discovered" no longer is causing panic, and more gavs-who once protected themselves behind barricades of propriety are now knocking down these barricades and dancing into the streets and bars. Motorcyclists. politicians, businessmen, hippies and football heroes are all getting stoned on a new philosophy of "Let's do it together!" Isolation is now a dated philosophy. The Gay Switchboard (phone: 387-3777) and the Mattachine Society (363-3881) have helped bring it together. As though this weren't enough. there is the Metropolitan Community Church (The First Congregational Church) at 10th and G Sts., N.W., where Pastor John Barbone tells how to keep it together every Sunday at 3 p.m.

In spite of this change, Washingtonians are always conservative. They dine at 8 p.m., go to bed at 11 p.m. and work five days a week at ordinary government jobs. Although it is a small town with a "southern" tone, it is nevertheless a progressive town. The Human Rights Law which was passed recently could never be law now if it weren't for the forward-thinking gavs here. Because of this new law, gays can no longer be barred from jobs or housing because of sexual orientation. Furthermore, any gay, sixteen or older, cannot be arrested for sodomizing with another consenting gay in the privacy of his home. Although many gays feel, and justly, that this is long overdue, it is nonetheless nice to know that conservative, southern Washington has seen fit to pass such legislation.

To insiders, this isn't surprising. Some powerful and prominent politicians are gay (not to mention the large chorus of ordinary government employees who surround them!) and it was always just a matter of time before those gays stepped out of their closets long enough to legislate laws. Although Washington isn't "Anything Goes," New York "I Don't Care" gay, it is nevertheless alive and fun. The most popular gay bars are still in the slums because some gays are still reluctant to flaunt their lavender colors in public. Nevertheless, these bars are stylish, imaginative and sinful ... maybe not freaky and daring as in New York or San Francisco, but still "with-it" in a sort of conservative, southern way.

GEORGETOWN/ FOGGY BOTTOM

There are three main areas of gay interest, Georgetown/Foggy Bottom, downtown, and on the Southeast/Southwest side. Both Georgetown and Foggy Bottom have always had (at least in recent years especially) a reputation for being the area in Washington. Old and expensive Georgetown is very popular with a variety of types, from hippies

to the elegant. Its streets, which are jammed with traffic and pedestrians, are cruisy and amusing from early afternoon to early morning (especially in the summer). Here are the main places in Georgetown and Foggy Bottom:

Georgetown Grill, 1329 Wisconsin Ave., N.W. This bar is small, giddy, cruisy, active and sometimes very interesting. Although it is in the heart of Georgetown and has been here for years, it doesn't attract heavily from the area. Consequently, it gets all types . . . sometimes the limp-wrist and bleached-blond types. It is open daily fron noon to 2 a.m., and on weekends from 1 p.m. to 3 a.m. I wouldn't recommend the food unless you're very hungry.

Sundown, 3040 M St., N.W. This is a new bar which didn't catch on as a gay bar, and now has opened its doors to the public as a mixed discotheque. There are two bars and a huge dance floor (d.j. and jukebox). Gays can dance together here: such a decision is left to them. Since the bar is pushing hard for a mixed crowd, this may not always be comfortable . . . unless the gays are extremely liberated. Breakfast is served from 1 a.m. to 4 a.m. (\$3.50 for the buffet). Open daily (except Monday) from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. At presstime we learned that the Sundown had closed temporarily. Very likely by now visitors to Washington will find it open.

For outside cruisers, there are several popular areas. Dumbarton Street is especially cruisy at night. The area is Dumbarton (at Wisconsin) to 30th to N to Wisconsin to Dumbarton, and all the streets within this rectangle. Sometimes the streets get wildly

gay, and I have always wondered how it is able to continue. Since it is an affluent, residential area, it is watched by vice, but that still doesn't stop activity. You can either walk or drive this area. For best results, walk!

Another popular area is the Black Forest. This wooded area starts at P Street Beach (not a beach, but a clearing used for sunbathing by the gays during the summer) at 23rd St., N.W. and extends to M and 26th St., N.W. All you need to do to find the magic path which leads through the Black Forest is follow the creek south. I would recommend that you visit the area only during the day, because at night it gets rough. Also, I would suggest that you avoid being too free and available here. The vice have made many arrests here.



P Street Beach

Only a few blocks from P Street Beach is **Dupont Circle**. The Circle itself (the area around the fountain) is occasionally cruisy, but usually it gets some raunchy types . . . heads, panhandlers, and the like. The john at Dupont Circle also gets a strange mixture of types, but sometimes—during the daylight hours especially—you can make some interesting contacts. Lots of construction is going on in the area, with new office buildings shooting up all the time, and

some well-assembled construction men come here for quick solutions to **burning** problems.

Lambda Rising, at 1724 - 20th St., N.W., is the first gay bookstore of its kind in Washington, D.C. Its owners refer to its purpose frequently-a "celebration of the gay experience." Lambda Rising carries gay liberation publications, not pornography, stocking over 600 titles (perhaps the "hardest" material available is our own QQ Magazine). Specialty jewelry, records, cards and stationery, and apparel are also sold. Part of the proceeds go to support the Washington Gay Switchboard, already referred to. They're open from 11 a.m. till 9 p.m. Earth Works, a store in the same building, sells everything for smokers . . . except grass! Also, earthenware, underground comic books, and the like.

In Georgetown, there are two restaurants that attract a mixed

crowd. These are the Paramount Steak House at 1227 Wisconsin Ave., N.W. and Mr. Henry's at 1225 Wisconsin Ave., N.W. Both are mixed. The Paramount Steak house at 1519 17th St... N.W. is especially popular with gays. The latter is a very earthy restaurant with saucy waitresses whom the customers love. It is probably the gaver of the two Paramounts. The one in Georgetown is rather straight and conservative in comparison with the other. The food is acceptable.

Mr. Henry's is very popular during cocktail time. The bar is lined with all types from leather to businessmen who meet and mingle around the bar. The food is tasty. Hours are from noon to 2 a.m. and to 3 a.m. on weekends. They have shows, but this is mostly of straight interest. The food prices are very reasonable, usually under \$5.

DOWNTOWN

Downtown Washington used to be very popular, but in the past years—with the opening of the big bars in the slums—it has lost its real importance. Yet for those who don't like to travel great distances to make contact, downtown offers a wide variety of places with enough general appeal to make them worth your time.

Louis Cocktail Lounge at 305 9th St., N.W. is particularly favored by the leather/western crowd. Although many dress in leather here, there are enough who wear more conventional attire. Louis is open every day from 8 p.m. to 2 a.m. and on Friday and Saturday until 3 p.m. Above Louis (entered through the bar area) is The Barn. Although The Barn has the same

hours as Louis, it is closed Monday through Thursday. On Friday and Saturday nights from about 10:30 to 1 a.m., a drag show—the "Stardust Follies"—is featured. Then there is a \$1 cover charge.

At 9th and Pennsylvania Ave., N.W. there is the Hideaway. This bar is below the Hickory House Restaurant. To enter you must use the corner entrance to the restaurant and descend to the basement. The Hideaway has always been favored by the young. Since the drinking age is 18, even for wine and beer, many are here who are too young to buy hard liquor (age 21). The hours are from 4 p.m. to 2 a.m. and on weekends it is open until 3 a.m.

Eagle, 904 9th St., N.W. This is probably the leather/western bar in D.C. To enter, you must have the proper clothes. But this doesn't mean you have to be butch, although they try to emphasize such a tone by their advertisement. The food is good, and dancing, of course, isn't permitted. Apparently it's not

butch enough for the S&M types who dig the whips and chains.

At E and 11th Sts., N.W., there is the Harrington Hotel. Although this isn't a gay hotel, the john in the basement is very busy (when the vice isn't hotly after gays) and many gays stay in the hotel. Since it is inexpensive and you are free to bring tricks to the room, it can be a practical place to stay. Another feature of this hotel that makes it interesting to gays is the bar of the Pink Elephant. All types here-black and white, white collars (at least those with ring-around-the-collar) and construction men ... for thirst quenching. It can get rough, because a few do it for money and will insist.

Carroll's Tavern, 510 9th St., N.W., like the Pink Elephant, usually attracts almost anything. It has been around for many years and attracts some devoted drinkers. Most of them are older

and look their age. No dancing, but a jukebox, however. It seems to be always open.

The Brass Rail, which is in the heart of the 25-cent flick area, is probably the dive in the city. If you really like crawling through the gutter this is where you can crawl. It's located at 809 13th St., N.W.

Around the corner from the Brass Rail is the Naples, 1227 New York Ave., N.W. Like the Brass Rail, it draws from the bus station crowd. Naples has improved its appearance by remodeling, but that's about all that has been improved.

Near it, at 1215 New York Ave., N.W. is **Dolly's.** They once had go-go boys, but now the boys have gone, yet the crowd remains gay. This is a good place—like the Brass Rail and Naples—to pick up hustlers... if you like them a little raunchy and rough. The best time to go is in the early evening from about 8:00 onward.

For steambath lovers, there is the Regency 413 L St., N.W. Although it is being advertised as more of a social club than a baths it still gets action. Not a great deal, but enough. It had some problems with the police a few years ago, and it is finally beginning to recover. The police charges were dropped, incidentally, after an exhausting court hearing. The Regency is private with a \$15 a year membership. This membership, though, is payable in installments. Prices are usually \$2 before 5 p.m. and \$4 after 5. The first visit is \$6. and the full amount goes toward membership. After that, they

add about \$1 to the regular charges, toward the membership. Everyone gay is welcome, after a brief interview. Weekends are best. Sundays are catching on.

Metropole Cinema Club

Next to the Regency is the Metropole Cinema Club at 411 L St., N.W. I must warn you that this area of L Street is very tough. Although parking isn't a problem (lots of space on the street and in the parking lot across the street), if you leave valuables in your car, they may not be there when you return. Membership at the Metropole is

\$1 per year and the movies cost \$5. This theatre and the **South-west Twin Cinema** on the south-west side in the Waterside Mall at 4th and M Streets, are the only two gay movie theatres in Washington. The latter, though, is in the new southwest side redevelopment area, and it is generally a comfortable area to visit, although it has had its problems too. Admission at the Southwest Twin Cinema is \$5. No membership.

The 25-cent skin flicks on 9th between Pennsylvania Avenue and G Street, N.W. are a good place to start if you want to make some contacts in the cubicles. There are several more on New York Avenue, N.W. (between 12th and 13th Streets) and on I Street between 12th and 13th, and one on I Street between 14th and 15th. I must warn you, though, while there is much cruising and mating here, some of these places have cameras or other devices to watch what goes on. Before you do anything, take a look to see if there are any cameras or mirrors reflecting your activities.

There are johns in the city which get the usual amount of action. Besides the john in the Harrington there are johns in the Martin Luther King Library; Grevhound and Continental Bus Stations; Woodward & Lothrop department stores downtown, and in Chevy Chase); Sears on Wisconsin Avenue (this one, however, has quieted down; vice, you know!); Howard University Library (basement); and the libraries of Georgetown and George Washington Universities. It is wise to have a story ready at the university libraries. Sometimes the guards ask for student identification.

SOUTHEAST/ SOUTHWEST AREA

I don't like this section of the city except in the area of the Southwest Twin Cinema. For the most part it is dangerous and very rough. This is Washington's slum area. Although it isn't as bad as New York's, it can get pretty wild at night. Eighth Southeast is part of the Capitol Hill redevelopment area. and may not seem to be so bad, but unless you are accustomed to rough areas, believe me, be alert here. This applies especial-Iv to the other bars that are scattered in the warehouse area. They are very popular and very but they are very dangerous . . . once you are outside in the dark streets.

There are three places of male gay interest on Eighth Street. They are:

Gatsby's Plus One at 529 8th St., S.E. The first section of the Plus One is a restaurant and bar. and in the rear is a private club called Gatsby's. To enter Gatsby's you must have a membership. This is the local discotheque and every Thursday to Sunday they have drag shows . . . usually at 11 p.m., 1:30 and 3 a.m. Hours are from 5 p.m. to 2 a.m., and Monday through Thursday from 11 a.m. to 2 a.m. (Friday and Saturday until 6 a.m.). On late weekends, breakfast is served and only soft drinks after 3 a.m. Food in the Plus One runs about \$3.95 to \$8.95. Lunch about \$3. Open daily.



Gatsby's Plus One

Towne House at 506 8th St., S.E. is a small cocktail lounge and restaurant. It's open from 6 p.m. to 2 a.m., Monday through Thursday; on Friday and Saturday to 5 a.m. Dinners are served until 11 p.m. and sandwiches

from 11 to closing. A pleasant, casual place to stop for something to eat. The crowd, though mixed, is mostly gay.



Towne House

Horseshoe Saloon, 430 8th St., S.E. This is the leather/western bar in the area. Although it isn't heavy leather like Louis and the Eagle, it still attracts some chain and whip types who play seriously. The atmosphere is very masculine, as the name implies. Ten saddles are used for bar seats and the bar is horseshoeshaped. There are other suitable decorations such as long horns. wagon wheels, and the like. Everyone is welcome, regardless of dress. Hours are 4 p.m. to 2 a.m. Saturday from noon to 3 a.m., and Sunday from 2 p.m. to 3 a.m. No dancing. Open daily. Young crowd . . . from 21 up.



Horseshoe Saloon

In the warehouse district the places of interest are:

Grand Central, 900 First St., S.E. This is the newest of the super bars. There's a disco-

theque up front with a large oval-shaped bar with overhanging plants. Dancing under all this lush vegetation are go-go boys. The mezzanine overlooks the bar. Also on the mezzanine are slides of nudes and simulated-sex films. There is a restaurant called the "Casbah" which is decorated like a lively African oasis of palm trees and wild animals (stuffed, of course). Dress is casual. Hours: 7 p.m. to 2 a.m.; on weekends until 3 a.m. Food prices range from \$3.95 to \$8.95 (reservations not necessary, but if in a group you should call). I prefer this bar of the three super bars in the area. Management tends to be much nicer here than at the Lost and Found. Peak hours on weekdays are from 9:30 to 10:30 p.m., and on weekends from 11.30 p.m. to 1 a.m.



Grand Central

Pier Nine, 1824 Half St., S.W. The crowd at the Pier Nine isn't too much different from that at the Lost and Found and Grand Central. Most of the gays drift from one to the other. Pier Nine, since it was bought by the Lost and Found, has become a discotheque. The only food served here is of the hamburger and pizza variety. They have three dance floors, good lighting and a generally young crowd. Hours: 7 p.m. to 2 a.m. weekdays, and until 3 a.m. weekends. Closed

Monday. Sometimes an entrance charge. Nothing definite at this writing. This may be because business isn't so good, and until it improves they don't want to run away those who still remain loyal.



Pier Nine

Lost and Found, 56 L St., S.E. I don't like the Lost and Found, and personally find management unreasonably rude. This bar is a good example of what happens to some gay bars when they become too successful. They are nasty and discriminating. I recommend this one only to those who don't mind being taken as long as they're seen at the right places. The food here is good (with reservations a must for dinner) and the bar is always crowded, it seems.

Waaay Off Broadway Theatre

At 55 K St., S.E. is the Waaay Off Broadway Theatre. Every day except Monday there is a live show with curtain time at 8:30 p.m., Tuesday through Friday. Show time on Saturday

is 7 and 10 p.m., and on Sunday at 3 and 8 p.m. Tickets: \$4 to \$10. The theatre is set up cabaret style and directly behind the Lost and Found. Beer, wine, and champagne only. Since this is owned by the Lost and Found management you may want to skip it . . . if you are turned off by the Lost and Found attitude.

Washington Square at 1345 Half St., S.E. is a new complex with baths, bar, and hotel facilities in the area called the Cascades.

There are also two swinging black bars in Washington. One is the Fox Lounge, 3253 Mount Pleasant, N.W. and The Third World Restaurant and Bar at 221 Riggs Rd., N.E. The Third World also has great soul food, plus a band.

The Club East Baths, incidentally, is part of the national chain, and it is the most popular baths in the city. Weekends and Wednesday (from 7 p.m. to 1 a.m.) are the most popular times. Lockers are \$4, and rooms \$6; on weekends everything costs \$1 more. Membership only.

Well, this pretty much covers Washington. I hope you find it as colorful on your next visit as I have painted it.

Gay Tucson By Jerry Daniels

Since 1555 travelers have been visiting the peaceful desert-valley city of Tucson for play and health. The city of Tucson, today, stretches across the hot desert like a supine and humpy god, dotted at the fringe by many resort and dude ranches. Because the climate is such a major attraction, one's immediate impression of Tucson is that everyone is just visiting for health and play and the only true residents are the Indians who have occupied the land for centuries.

Besides hot and dry climate. Tucson has other attractions which keep the flow of people constant. The most noteworthy, aside from sports and other outdoor recreation, is a movie set, Old Tucson. In 1939 Columbia Studios constructed a replica of early Tucson for a movie "Arizona." Since then called over fifty movies and television shows have been filmed on this set. If you have always wanted to live in yesteryear, that superbutch era of gunfights and stagecoaches, this may be your opportunity to slip into the past. The entire saga of frontier days is dramatically brought to life, just like in the movies, in living color.

Gay life, unfortunately, isn't a major attraction. Although Tucson has a large gay population for a city its size, many of the gays hide their interests under a shroud of Puritanism. Many of these are Northerners who come here for the climate and easy living. They are mostly gays who are forced by their middle-class circumstances to deny themselves the pleasures of gay freedom in order to maintain their jobs and image in a straight, conservative community. If they have to sacrifice sex life, this they seem to feel is the modest price they must pay for the privilege of living in such a delightful climate.

Although it is a city made up of older gays, many young gays live here during the school year and attend the University of Arizona. These young gays seem to be particularly responsible for the boom in bars which is beginning to be felt in Tucson. Until recently very few but the notorious would attend the bars. But the young have changed all this by blatantly shocking the conservative residents by frequenting the bars. Their attendance is primarily responsible for the growing bar scene in Tucson.

At this writing there are only three gay bars open, with two scheduled to open by early 1975 and others being considered for the future. The Graduate at 23 W. University has been around the longest. Best time for a visit is usually from 11 p.m. to 1 a.m. (These hours seem to be true of all bars.) The Graduate attracts an older crowd from about 25 up. On my visit I found the crowd to be very mixed in age, with very few older men. There seems to be a nice collection of those in their twenties, thirties and a few in their forties. It opens at 3 p.m. and closes at 1 a.m. daily. On Friday, Saturday and Sunday it opens at 1 p.m. When I was in Tucson, management was planning to extend the bar into the next-door building and have a discotheque with a d.j. on Wednesday, Friday and Saturday nights. By now the addition should be completed and the discotheque open.



The Graduate

At 2921 N. First Avenue, there is the **Stonewall Tavern**. Since the drinking age is nineteen, the crowd here is very young, usually between 19 to 21. This bar is primarily a dance bar, and on Wednesdays there is

a beer special. A dollar is charged at the door for admission, and beers are then only five cents per glass. Sunday is the big night, and everyone seems to pack the bar then. It is open daily from 10 a.m. to 1 a.m. and on Sundays from noon to 1 a.m. Brunch and buffet occasionally.

At 4227 E. Speedway is a new bar called the **Zodiac**. Age here is anywhere from 20 to 35. There is a rotating dance floor with mirrors which pick up the light reflections. On Fridays and Saturdays there is after-hours entertainment (a live band with singers).

A fourth bar, the Twelfth of Never, at 345 Sixth Avenue, is just opened. It is a downtown cabaret show-bar with live entertainment and dining. Management is billing it as "Tucson's First Bisexual Bar." Because there aren't enough gays to support this huge bar, mixed types are encouraged to come.

The fifth bar will be called the **Libido** and will be on North Campbell. This bar will also try to reach out for a mixed trade and is also making claims to be the biggest bar in Tucson. But talk is easy. Time will tell what this one will be like.

At 345 E. Toole Street there is the **Black Door Lounge.** This downtown bar attracts some very interesting straight and gay men . . . many too manly and rough for the gay bars. All types—blacks, whites, and Mexicans—pack in here. At Main and Speedway there is another mixed bar which is a haven for the bisexuals looking for a casual gay contact. Most of the men who head here are generally nice and liberated. If you have time, and are looking for some

place like it, drive out here.

Another mixed bar is in the Congress Hotel at 311 E. Congress. The bar which is mixed has an older crowd. Gays head here almost any time, so it's difficult to define the best hour. Although it isn't the busiest, it will do nicely when you don't want to wander too far from downtown. This is also a recommended hotel. It isn't anything special, but it is clean and attractive. Singles are \$6.60 and doubles are \$8.70. If you should like a television, the charge is \$1 more. There is also the YMCA at 516 N. Fifth. It has some activity.

For outside cruising, there is Walgreens at 44 N. Stone downtown. Standing outside or wandering east and west on Congress (also downtown) during the day can be worth your time. Another area is Catalina Park at Fourth Avenue and First Street. At night, though, the park can be rough. There are the usual rough hustlers and reports of beatings. Himmel Park at First and Tucson (one block off Speedway) is very cruisy all the time. Every type heads here, from students to old men. The john at Himmel is used for private meetings since the doors lock from inside and intrusion is prevented. Another john which attracts activity is in the small

park at Seventh at First Street. If you have any doubts, read the graffiti on the wall!

Between Campbell and Stone on East Speedway during the school year is the area to pick up hitchhikers. Most of them are students hurrying to or returning from class. Since the Univer-

sity of Arizona has a busy mall (particularly near the Student Union and Liberal Arts buildings), many of these strapping young studs know what it's all about.

If it weren't for the students, Tucson would probably be just another conservative city. But because of them, the city can really swing. Why don't you head there and join the fun?

Salt Lake City By Steve Ordel

Very close to downtown Salt Lake are the mountains that, by their enormity, miniaturize the city. At first glance the city seems toy-like and unpretentious next to the great mountains. It is almost as though the city were the threshold to the universe, with the mountains and sky stretching ahead into eternity. Less beautiful, yet impressive, is the Mormon Temple. This huge, six-spired edifice stands prominently above a high wall that surrounds the Temple as though the wall were but a mere fence. If you have dreams

of entering the Temple, you will

be disappointed. To step inside you must be a member of the faith in good standing. But a tour of the 10-acre Temple Square is possible. The Mormons, who are friendly and gentle, are always eager to encourage visitors to learn about their faith and its history. Their only concern is that you show the same respect for their faith as they do. Temple Square, which is the symbolic heart of Mormonism and the heart of Salt Lake City, is the pivotal point of all sections of the city. From this point outward the city spreads. uncluttered and clean, almost as serene and beautiful as the city's setting itself.

Gay life in Salt Lake is quite relaxing. There aren't any major crime, police or rough-trade problems to worry the gays. In this sense it is the ideal city. Nevertheless, gay life is still discouraged. It is something that exists, and everyone knows exists, but which every straight ignores. The Mormons seem to feel by ignoring it, it may go away, Instead, it flourishes, But it doesn't flourish visibly. The Mormons insist on discouraging public activity and scrupulously watch public places. For a concession they have allowed gays to enjoy their bars and baths. But Liberty and Pioneer Parks, whose johns are often cruised, are carefully patrolled. The Greyhound Bus Terminal (occasionally referred to as the Blue Puppy here) has very active security guards who will record license numbers and befriend gays in an effort to get information. It is not unusual afterwards for the security to then call home and notify your family. The park police have also been known to do the same. Consequently, most of gay life remains indoors.

Before getting to the bars, I would like to mention accommodations. Perhaps the most impressive hotel is the Utah, which reminds me of an elegant French resort hotel. Of course the rates are high here (about \$25 for a single). Less expensive, but very nice, are the many motor lodges which dot the city (Howard Johnson's, Ramada, Holiday and the like). The rates are usually about \$15 for a single, and most of them are centrally located. I would recommend that before leaving your home town you should check the major motel chains for accommodations and prices, unless, of course, you're like me and prefer to make your selection upon arrival.

The bars in Salt Lake are conveniently within walking distance of downtown. On Fourth, near the Union Pacific Station, there are three bars. The Club 15 at 15 South Fourth West is a conservative, friendly bar popular with the over-twenty-five professional types, and although there is a "Private Club" sign on the door, it isn't private. Gays are always welcomed. The sign is used to discourage straights or troublemakers. It is necessary in

Salt Lake, because of the liquor laws, to bring your own bottle (mini bottles available) before arriving at the bar. Set-ups are 50 cents and draft beer is 35 cents at the Club 15. Of course, there is dancing. The hours are from noon to 2 a.m.

A few blocks north at the corner is the Sun Tavern (1 South Fourth North). This bar has the same hours as the Club 15. Most of the crowd from the two bars moves back and forth at night, although the Sun Tavern is the preferred hangout for young hippies and heads, the far-out contemporary types. On weekends, some straight hippies will visit because of the loud sound. The bar is huge, with three large rooms and a patio. There are plans to expand into the next-door building and provide more room for dancing and cruising.

At 66 North Fourth West is Perky's. Although this is primarily a girls' bar, many gay guys head here. During the day many interesting railroad men from the train station visit for a friendly beer. They aren't supposed to be gay, but the talk is that they are available, or at least interested enough to listen to your pitch. At night, though, it is mostly girls. The owner of Perky's owns a resort at Echo Lake. This resort isn't totally

gay, but many gays—girls and boys—come here. The usual outdoor activities are available at Echo Lake including camping, water skiing, swimming, picnicking and so on. No housing, however, is available. For information you should contact Perky at Perky's or Mac at Club 15. Hook-up and visit prices are one dollar.

In the shopping area of Salt Lake at 147 South State is the Lounge (sometimes called the Radio City Lounge). This bar attracts the same types as the Club 15. Mostly older and conservative, in general. It was a very popular bar before the Club 15 opened, but since, it has lost some of its popularity. Now it is slowly regaining it. Hours are from 11 a.m. to 2 a.m.

Round-Up

If rough trade excites you, the place you want is the Round-Up at 279 West Second Street

South. Although there have been fights and problems in the bar, and the police are watchful of activity here, it can be cruisy. It is best, it seems, at night.

There are two baths. The most popular is the Club Baths (open 24 hours) at 727 West Seventeenth Street South. This Club isn't part of the eastern Club chain, but the West Coast Club chain. Since it is the newest of the Club baths, it is the nicest. It is located in a warehouse and factory district, and there is always ample parking. The bus transportation in Salt Lake is an embarrassment to the city. In order to reach the baths by bus you must take a State Street bus to Seventeenth Street and walk west about seven or eight long blocks. Taxi service, round trip. is about \$6. Room prices during the day are \$4 Monday through Thursday; on Friday and Saturday and on all nights, rooms are \$5. Lockers are \$2 during the day and \$4 during the night. Although the Club isn't private. they are selective about whom they admit. It may be wise to stop at the Club 15 and ask Mac there for a recommendation.



Club Baths

The Wasatch Baths at 840 North Second Street West was once popular before the Club opened. Now its popularity has dwindled. Since it is stateowned, it gets a mixed crowd of straights and gays. The facilities aren't clean and barely adequate. Since it is mixed, you will have to be careful of what you do and where. Although management knows what goes on here, they prefer not to witness it. Money for the baths, incidentally goes to the underprivileged children. I wonder if this means you can write your visit off as a tax deduction.

Outside of Salt Lake is a bare-ass beach. It is a little difficult to find and many require assistance from some locals, although my instructions for finding it make it sound easy. You should take North Temple to the Salt Air Café (which is supposedly run by gays). Onehalf mile past the Café on Temple is a dirt road on your right. If you take the well-traveled dirt road and follow it to where all the cars are parked, you should be there. If you have any problems, you can ask Tiny for directions at the Salt Air Café. It is suggested that you go on a breezy day to avoid the mosquitoes and flies. Because certain prominent people cruise the beach, it is supposed to be safe.

Incidentally, if the Mormon Church happens to turn you off, you will be happy to know that there is a Metropolitan Community Church at 870 West Fourth Street South.

So plan a visit to Salt Lake City now. I'm sure you'll enjoy your visit as much as I did mine.

Gay Tulsa By Ron Litton

Oil is big business in Tulsa. Since its discovery, the city has attracted businessmen and adventurers who are quick to recognize the value of "black gold." It was in nearby Osage County, a land of timber and prairies, where the discovery of oil first made Indians and white men millionaires overnight. Be-

sides oil, the county is rich in wildlife, and it has a natural beauty which has instantly made it a photographer's paradise . . . a vacationland Eden.

The men of Tulsa all look as though they belong in this rugged setting and are only visiting the city for a few beers and some easy action. There is, therefore, a very western feeling to Tulsa with cowboys and Indians almost everywhere. It is a wealthy city, much more visibly wealthy than Oklahoma City, and the men who fill it are so well put-together, so handsomely masculine that it takes restraint to avoid approaching them. Restraint here is particularly necessary since sodomy is punishable. Because most of the bars are private, there are few problems here. The streets, though cruisy, are usually avoided by local gays, but many eager straights and out-of-town gays wander them for some quick action.

The bar scene, in many ways similar to the scene everywhere, is still different, more conservative with many more men. In fact, it is sometimes difficult to believe you are in a gay bar because of the natural masculinity of the men. Most of them aren't that put-on-western, talkfrom-the-side-of-the-mouth type of masculine common in butched up bars in larger cities. Instead, they are so natural and wholesome in their masculinity that it becomes an instant turn-on. Of course, there are the fems who flit about, but there isn't any real concentration of them anywhere. Consequently, the conversation in bars isn't as giddy as it is elsewhere.

There are eight bars. Because of the Oklahoma laws, bars which have set-ups are private. Out-of-towners are customarily screened at the door if they aren't with a member; but they can usually enter with proper identification. This may be a nuisance for sophisticated gays, but these are the laws here and no one seems strong enough to challenge them.

The two main downtown bars are the Zebra Lounge and the

Taj Mahal. At 720 S. Main Street is the Zebra, which is a quiet and conservative bar that has a reputation for being a wrinkle room. During my visit, though. I found the men very attractive with enough variety in ages to make it comfortable for anyone. Many of the gavs move back and forth between the Zebra and the Taj around the corner at 10 W. 17th Street all night. The hours at the Zebra are from noon to 2 a.m. daily: Sundays from 2 p.m. to 2 a.m., and Fridays and Saturdays from noon to 3 a.m. No dancing.

The Taj is a very cozy and comfortable bar where some of the humpy-looking, straight-appearing men go. It isn't very large. In fact, it is narrow and small, but it still packs them in and keeps the bartenders really moving. Hours are from noon to 2 a.m. daily. No dancing. Happy hour is from 4 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Neighbors in the same building at 1611 E. 11th Street are the Door Lounge and the Club. The door Lounge boasts, with a little too much exaggeration, that they have all young bartenders. This may seem true in the dark lighting of the bar, but if you turn up the lights, you'll discover otherwise. The Door gets a mixture of ages, usually the same mixture as the Taj and Zebra. Unfortunately, it isn't as popular as the other two. Hours are noon to midnight daily and noon to 2 a.m. Saturdays. Strictly beer.

In the rear of the building, past the parking lot, is the Club. The club usually attracts an older crowd, but since it is so close to the Door, it can get a nice mixture of ages. This is a private dance bar with stained-glass windows, old gas chandeliers and shutters. Charming! Hours are from noon to 2 a.m. and on Fridays and Saturdays until 3 a.m.

Those younger gays who enjoy a noisier setting should head for the **Friend's Lounge** at 1716 E. Third (at Utica). Every type heads here . . hustlers, hippies, rednecks, fems, girls. It is a potpourri of everything imaginable in the Tulsa gay scene, and everyone is welcome here without any concern about membership. Shows given every Friday night from 9:15 to 11:30. There

is a 50-cent cover charge on show nights. Beer only. No dancing. Hours are from 11 a.m. to midnight daily and on Saturdays until 2 a.m.

At 1221 Memorial (between 12th and 13th Street) is another bar called the Club. It is directly across from the miniature golf course. Very popular with the girls and boys, especially on weekends after 11 p.m. This is where the young crowd goes for dancing. It is open until 3 a.m. on weekends and 2 a.m. on weekdays. Membership necessary (\$2 per year). If you go with a guest, you can usually get in free.

Another gay bar which gets guys and gals is Mama D's (Outside Inn) at 1108 S. Lewis. The crowd, though, is mostly gals. A mixed, South Sea atmosphere lounge is the Bamboo at 7204 E. Pine. Mostly college-age boys from the neighborhood or the Spartan School of Aeronautics visit. Weekends best. Beer only.

The main outside cruise area downtown is Main and Fourth to Main and Ninth to Boulder and Ninth to Boulder and Fourth. The action moves around and in and out of this area at night, but it is watched by vice, so be careful. There is the usual car cruising and walking. Other cruisy areas include Mohawk Park, north of the zoo and in and out of the johns; Woodward Park, around the john and rose garden (some hard drug problems here), and finally Keystone Park. The latter at the Washington Irving Cove is where gays head for swimming. It can be cruisy, although it isn't a gay area. Nonetheless, it is a beautiful wooded place . . . a restful spot to go for sun and nature.

There is only one really gay book store, and that's located at 1346 E. 11th Street. This book store is called the Body Shop and is cruisy, but like the downtown cruise area is also watched by the vice. The Tulsa Book Store at 620 S. Main Street isn't as obviously gay as the Body Shop, but some very handsome men look at the films here. Once there must've been some heavy cruising here, because the management has a sign on the wall: "No Cruising Allowed!" Be discreet here.

Many nice hotels and motels are scattered throughout the downtown area. An elegant, but thin-walled hotel is the Fairmont-Mayo. Other nice places to stay are the Holiday and Downtowner.

Since Tulsa is in rugged man's country, there is a great deal of outdoor recreation for the visitor. So if you want a man's vacation . . . go to Tulsa. You'll like it!

Kansas City

When I lived in Missouri as a student in the late fifties, I had some exciting times in Kansas

City. Although I never liked the city physically, and can still remember the pungent smell of the stockyards on a windy day. my memories are nevertheless good ones. Some people still think of Kansas City as an overgrown cowtown, which it seems downtown, when you move through the crowds of visiting cowboys from the Southwest, the wheat farmers from Kansas and the oilmen from Oklahoma. And while in my opinion the city isn't one of the finer-looking places in the country, it does have many handsome parks and boulevards, and lovely residential areas

Two of the most interesting of the many shopping centers in Kansas City are the Country Club Plaza and Crown Center. The Country Club district, which is internationally famous as a model of city planning, has homes and stores in harmony with its surroundings. European art objects and fountains beautify street corners and make the Plaza a great place to visit and to forget the strangle of downtown. Another area equally pleasant is the Crown Center by the cruisy Memorial Mall. The entire glass and steel development has a New York-contemporary appearance which does magic to the ordinary look around it.

To the unaware. Kansas City straddles two states (Kansas and Missouri) with the Missouri River separating the halves. Since the two states merge so easily, the river is an unsatisfactory boundary. The flow between the states seems even and constant. There is a western flavor to Kansas City because of its proximity to the western frontier; consequently, all types of men meld together easily. For the majority, gay life in Kansas City is open and varied. It is particularly a great place to meet and to mingle with Wild-Wild West-looking, strapping guys from everywhere. For the affluent, though, gay life is clannish and rather too cultivated. An aging scion of a great banking family dominates the social scene and makes it difficult for a newcomer without

satisfactory qualifications to become a part of the privileged circle.

Kansas and Missouri are still a little like the Deep South. When I was a student from the North, I first noticed this in its attitude toward blacks. Unfortunately, white prejudice toward the blacks hasn't changed much since. Blacks are still viciously discriminated against, and in retaliation they have resorted to petty counterattacks. I had a black cab driver completely ignore me and pick up a black man a few feet away; I had a black bus driver close the doors in my face, then drive off amused . . . as well as a host of other petty annoyances during my visit. Those white gays, therefore, who are accustomed to making it with blacks may be disappointed here. If they do make out, it may be due largely to their exceptional luck or looks or both.

Perhaps the best-known drag revue in the Midwest is in Kansas City at Jewel Box, 3110 Main Street. (Unless I mention otherwise, all bars and gayinterest spots are in Missouri, not Kansas.) The revue is usually an extravaganza of good lighting and costuming and funny camp. Although business isn't as good as once because the management can't afford really top shows, seeing the revue can be a great way of starting off your visit to the city. A mixed straight and gay crowd visits. Many of the straights go to laugh at the gays, but if you ignore them and some of their asides, you will have a pleasant time. There is only a \$1 cover charge on Friday/Saturday, and a one-drink minimum (drinks average about \$1.50 each). Except on Sunday, when it is

closed, there are three shows given: at 8:45, 10:20 and 11:55 p.m. Reservations are particularly necessary on Fridays and Saturdays for the last two shows.

In a charming redeveloped area of Broadway there is a bar called the Red Head (4048 Broadway) that's popular with the chic. Although the age range varies, it seems to attract mostly older gays who seem to prefer this bar because they can enter and leave quietly through the back entrance. It is attractively decorated in French Provincial, which is a little to heavy for my taste, but nonetheless suitable for its elegant clientele. Hours here are from 5 p.m. to 1:30 a.m. daily. Closed Sundays.

Another bar that attracts the nicer Kansas City crowd is the Jug Lounge, 1822 Main Street. This bar, unlike the Red Head, attracts primarily a young dance crowd. There is a d.j. and some wild sound here. It also gets some good cruising as well. The gays who lean against the wall hand-rail are usually very ready for a little groping. Hours: 4 p.m. to 1:30 a.m. daily; Sundays from 2 p.m. to 1:30 a.m.

At 4334 Main Street in an interesting English Tudor buildis the Dover Fox. Some gays said that when it first opened it was pushing too hard for the young. college crowd to the exclusion of others. This may still be true. Nevertheless, I found the gays present to be both attractive and talkative . . . in an elegant sort of way! It can be a nice stand-up cruise bar, though. Dancing. Hours are from 4 p.m. to 1:30 a.m. daily except Saturday when it opens at 2 p.m. Closed Sundays.

In the Country Club Plaza at 333 West 47th Street is the **Side Door**. Although it isn't strictly gay, during the afternoons (from about noon until 4) it gets a mostly nice gay crowd. Afterwards, it is basically straight. If you're shopping at the Plaza (and some of the major stores are located here), this can be a pleasant place to stop for a drink.

At 3314 Gillham Plaza there is a comfortable, middle-class-conservative bar called the **Tent**. It usually gets an over-35 crowd that mingles quietly and easily with the other customers. Closed Sundays. It is open the rest of the week from 4 p.m. to 1:30 a.m.; on Saturday, though, from 2 p.m. Dancing.

Downtown by the YMCA is the Ivanhoe Cabaret (but it's

often called just Cabaret) at 1014 Oak. The back bar has dancing with a d.j. and the front bar is elegantly rustic. There's a nice voung crowd (black and white). At this writing the bar is not as popular as the Jug or the Dover; but in Kansas City that's no serious problem. The gays here are very fickle. They will frequent a bar for some time, then desert it for its competitor . . . then some months later return to the first. Hours at the Cabaret are 11 a.m. to 1:30 a.m., on Saturday from 1 p.m. to 1:30 a.m., and on Sunday from 1 p.m. to midnight. Shows occasionally. Food is available and the prices run from about \$3 to \$6.

The two bars that get the rough hustler, at-your-own-risk crowd are Suzy's at 1114 McGee and the Patio at the corner of Eleventh and Oak. Both are very close to the Continental Trailways Bus Station and YMCA. Suzy's serves authentic Mexican food . . . if you are brave enough to try it. Both are mixed with straights and gays.

In Kansas is **Pete's Pub** at 2550 W. 47th Street. This mostly-girls' bar used to be very popular with the boys when it was open until 3 a.m. Then the gays would come here when the Missouri bars closed at 1:30 and remain until closing. It is now a private club that gets a few

Missouri gay guys and the ones who aren't known are screened at the door. There is only a cover charge when the management wants to discourage someone from entering. Closed Sundays. Hours daily are 5 p.m. to 1:30 a.m.

There are three movie houses showing hard-core porn: the Strand Art Theatre at 3544 Troost; the Rockhill Adult Cinema at 4614 Troost; and the Danish World at 105 E. 12th Street. Admission at all three is \$4, and there is the usual activity. The Strand is closed at present, and will open soon under a new management. What will happen then isn't known at this writing. Watch yourself on Troost Street. This is a rough neighborhood.

Near the Jewel Box on Main Street are a few straight book stores; one is the Playpen, at 3325 Main. It has the only 25-cent gay movie and private rooms, and a cruisy corridor. The others have back rooms like a dark maze with all sorts of interesting corners to squeeze into with someone special. There is a great book store downtown called the Time-To-Read Newsstand and Book Store at 7 W. 12th Street. Full stock of gay publications, and cruisy.

The two baths in the Kansas City area are the Club Midwest. 19 W. 39th Street, and the AAA Baths at 9922 E. Truman Road (Independence, Mo.). The Tri-A is closed on Wednesdays and holidays. It isn't very popular any more with the gays, although some go here. Usually very mixed. Hours are from 2 p.m. to 11 p.m. The Club Midwest which is part of the eastern Club chain, has taken most of its gay business. Membership at the Club is \$2 a year. Room and locker rates are \$5; for military and students it is \$2.50.

The meatrack is by the YMCA at 10th and Oak. Some very nice-looking hustlers and roughs stand around here and look sexy. When I was in school, the YMCA at 404 E. 10th was the wildest Y in the Midwest. All types can be found here, even those who aren't registered,

cruising the halls. The traffic isn't as heavy as once, but some good cruising goes on here. It is a very raunchy Y, so don't expect much as far as comfort goes.



At 10th and McGee to 11th and McGee (in front of the Continental Trailways) there are the usual hustlers and roughs. Another popular cruise area is the Memorial Mall at 27th and Main. It is dangerous, though, at night (muggers and vice), but during the daytime it can be cruisy and safe. The john near the Mall shouldn't be overlooked. It gets the usual action. Swope Park is also very cruisy, but very dangerous at night especially. It is located in a very tough black area.

The Country Club Plaza was always very popular with a nice crowd, then the crime wave came, and now the police are everywhere watching. The popular cruise area here is near Jack Henry Clothing Store. Bernard's on the Plaza is a popular 24-hour restaurant that gets a nice mixed crowd after hours. The food isn't bad.

If meeting interesting men is uppermost in your thoughts, your chances are good in Kansas City. Anything from cowboys and farmers to businessmen and students gather here on weekends when the city is thickest with visitors; the bars really swing . . . like the best cities anywhere. So if you're thinking about a holiday, it may be fun to give Kansas City a whirl.

El Paso, Texas Juarez, Mexico

El Paso is a mixture of three cultures-western, Indian and Mexican-but mostly Mexican. It is a city of color and excitement with intrigue running very thickly beneath its thin surface of respectability. Because El Paso is so close to the Mexican border, some of the many Mexicans who live in the city have crossed illegally into the States. These few work at nearly starvation wages for dishonest businessmen who exploit them by promising them proper papers: others sell themselves on the streets to whomever will buy. Aside from a few new and streamlined high rise, El Paso is an ordinary-looking border city, and like most such border cities it gushes a lustfulness which other cities its size lack.

In almost shocking contrast to the city is the fabulous El Paso airport. La Placita, compactly tucked in a corner of the busy airport, is probably the most impressive shopping area of the city. The arts and crafts of three cultures are sold here, and browsing through the many shops is made easy by the relaxed atmosphere which is gently created by the strolling Mariachis, the waterfalls and the gazebo. Another interesting shopping area is La Villita in the 600 block of North Oregon. Over 24 quaint shops and restaurants are jammed into this charming downtown shopping village that was built at the turn of the century.

For all types of Mexican goods, many visitors cross the border into Juarez. But here. bargaining is the rule. Juarez, which is only 40 cents away by local bus from El Paso, is a typical Mexican border town with raunchy shops and unappealing food. Tourists who wander through this town unescorted at night, will be exposed to some rough treatment by the corrupt local police and hustlers who fatten their wallets by exploiting tourists. I would thus recommend that you go during the day, and stay in the main areas. There is a certain wild and corrupt spirit to Juarez which shouldn't be missed, so it is worth a visit. It's an experience unlike anything you can savor in the United States. But it is always best to be wise. The name of the game is money . . . your money! If you aren't careful, you will end up paying heavily for pleasures never delivered. Also, if you should go, don't come back with liquor without checking Texas duty laws. Visitors returning from Juarez have to pay Texas duty on all liquor. I guess this is enforced to keep Texas liquor stores in business. Therefore, liquor may not be much of a bargain for you here.

In Juarez there are three baths and one bar. Banos Roma at Calle I. Mejia 881 Ote., and Banos Jordan at 557 Delgallado Norte, plus Banos Lourdes at 16 de Septiembre 581 Ote., are the three straight baths that gays head for. They aren't clean, but they do have cubicles for privacy. The hours are from about 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. with the busiest hour being about 4 p.m. Jordan and Lourdes are more popular than Roma, incidentally.

The Olimpico at 222 Lerdo Avenue is across from the post office on the main bus line to Juarez. Gays usually to to the Olimpico in groups after hours. It would be advisable to do the same. The police occasionally raid this 24-hour bar when they need money and will hold customers in their filthy prisons until you pay off. It can be an expensive and uncomfortable experience if you aren't careful. I understand that when you travel in a pack the police are less likely to bother you.

In El Paso, there are five bars. The **Pet Shop** at 207½ San Antonio is the largest and liveliest. There is a d.j. occasionally and a plexi-glass dance floor, and two bars, one for the lively young and another for the aging conservative crowd. The Pet Shop attracts a typically gay crowd of nice people from the

humpy young to the attractive old. On Sundays there is a beer bust (from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m); all the food and beer that you can put down is available for only \$1.50. Incidentally, this is the only mixed-drinks gay bar in El Paso. Hours are from 6 p.m. to 2 a.m. daily.

By the railroad tracks at 411 E. Franklin Street is Club Pigalle. This bar usually attracts the older gays. Some are very butch and rough in a tameable-looking sort of way. The bar isn't really raunchy, yet it isn't exactly nice. It is in-between and can swing from night to night in either direction. Occasionally there is a drag show with a 75-cent admission charge. Hours are from 2 p.m. to 2 a.m. Dancing. Pool.

The third bar is called the **Apartment** at 815 Myrtle. A nice crowd of gays and straights come here. But it isn't as popular as once because of its bad location. Nevertheless, it is a nice place to go to have a drink and be sociable with a friend or lover. It is best during the late afternoon and early evening hours.

Near the Apartment is **Le Milord Bar** at 606 Magoffin
Street. This is a mostly Mexican
bar, and if you don't know
Spanish, you may have difficulty
communicating. It isn't much of
a bar, but it can be a pleasant

place to go for a change . . . if you have a weakness for Mexican men! Both the Apartment and Le Milord open about 4 p.m and close about midnight.

And finally there is the Plaza Hotel Bar, at Oregon and Mills. But like all nice hotels, gay traffic varies too much to be predictable. The best time, though, seems to be during the early evening.

The main cruise area in El Paso is the San Jacinto Plaza. It is in the center of the city and is surrounded by Main, Mesa, Mills and Oregon Streets. The park and john have much movement and eyeing. There is a cross-section of types here and it is best at night. During the day soapbox orators come here and preach their gospel. Also cruisy is Memorial Park on Grand Street. Most gays drive here, then walk around. Cruising is spotty, but most of the johns are usually dependable. Also cruisy is McKelligon Canvon Park. To get there, you should drive along Alabama Street to McKelligon, then follow McKelligon to the nearest john. At the pavilion, gays sunbathe and cruise. The john here is cruisy.

Although there aren't many bars in El Paso, you won't find yourself short of men, especially if you stay at the YMCA (USO branch) at 315 E. Franklin Street. You have three distinct and interesting cultures to select from in this very lively border city. Go!

Oklahoma City

It was quite a surprise for me, when I arrived in Oklahoma City, to see oil-well derricks everywhere. Almost everyone here seems determined to get some of those oil royalties by digging in the backyard. Many wells are dry, while some are still supplying enough oil to meet costs; yet that hasn't stopped anyone from dreaming about someday striking it rich in the backyard.

Oklahoma City is a huge city which is spread out across an enormous expanse of land. It is almost impossible to move about the city without a car, since public transportation is irregular and taxi fares are high. Nevertheless, OK City is a great place to visit because there isn't any harassment by Vice. When Vice does become a nuisance, it seems to be mostly around election time.

Although the city isn't particularly attractive physically, it is changing and beautifying itself with a modernization campaign which may make it the most attractive city in the state. Robert S. Kerr Park downtown and the extravagantly beautiful Myriad Convention Center also downtown are two of the many new developments which are bringing beauty to a city that has faded a little by neglect. Although the city is a little provincial with none of the obvious worldliness of the East. it still charms the visitor.

There is a cowboy and Indian flavor to OK City. The minute you enter the city and see the handsome mixture of Indians and cowboys who live and love hard here, the drumbeats of the past start pounding in your

heart. Most of the men are friendly and attractively healthy; they talk and smile easily and look as though they should belong in the movies. I had the feeling that there were feminine gays around, but when I looked at what was in the bars or on the streets, I had my doubts. That may be because this isn't a city for fems. It is a masculine city made up of men who make their living doing a man's work.

The gay bars are spread out thinly in this huge city, and without a car it requires effort and money to reach them. Once you do, though, you won't be disappointed. There are only two bars downtown, but both are mixed. These two bars are the Mirror (Lounge) Club at 14 N. Hudson, and Sweet Leona's Lounge at Harvey and Sheridan.

The Mirror Club, like most bars in Oklahoma, is private. (Because of the liquor laws, a bar that serves set-ups can't be open to the public; therefore, such bars must be private. At this writing, the law is only casually enforced, and out-of-towners can usually enter without any problem. If you don't bring a bottle, beer is all you can buy over the bar.) The Mirror attracts a crowd of winos, hustlers and other similar types. No dancing.

attracts the same crowd as the Mirror. Most of them, after cruising unsuccessfully Sheridan Street or the arcade next door, head here for a few beers. I suppose that 'raunchy masculine' will sum up this crowd well.

Another mixed establishment is the Box Office Supper Club at 2335 N.W. 12th Street. Although the Box Office was once gay, it is now going straight. The restaurant caught on with the straights because the food is so good, and now there is a mixture of both gays and straights here. The food can be expensive with prices starting at \$5.50 for a Chateaubriand, but the average meal costs about \$7 per person. There is a trio which plays nightly. Private, of course, but guests are welcome at no extra charge. Hours are from 6 p.m. to 11 p.m. Closed Monday. It is necessary to dress nicely, although coat and tie aren't necessary. No beer on sale here.

At 1724 N.W. Sixteenth Street is the Sixteenth Street Club (sometimes called the French Quarter). This bar shouldn't be confused with another bar called the French Quarter, which is straight. From what the bartender at the latter bar said, they want to keep it that way. The Sixteenth Street Club isn't listed, to my knowledge, in the phone book. It is private and attracts a nice gay crowd. Hours are 6 p.m. to 2 a.m. Closed Mondays.

Our Place at 1302 N.W. Pennsylvania is mostly a girl's bar, but many guys head here. There is a comfortable and homey atmosphere about the bar. No dancing, though. According to local law, I understand, before dancing is permitted in a bar the management

must have at least a room to rent. Hours are noon to midnight and Saturday until 2 a.m. Beer only.

At 2201 N.W. 39th Street is Tessie's Circa Club. A middle-age-nice crowd comes here. Although there is some western music on the juke box, very few, if any, of that type come here. Hours are from noon to 2 a.m. daily. Beer on tap and set-ups.

The young, very humpy crowd usually heads for the **Rusty Nail** at 3616 N.W. 23rd Street. Once some of the tough straights wandered in here and roughed up the gays, but not anymore. There is some good cruising here. Mostly men, though a few women visit. Hours are from 2 p.m. to 2 a.m. daily. Dancing.

The Crescendo Club at 2805 N.W. 36th Street gets an even mixture of gay men and women. This is a nice bar that attracts a middle-class-nice crowd. It does not have any extreme types, and it is a little like being in a comfortable and straight bar from all appearances. Private, but anyone gay and not roughlooking can enter without any problems. Hours 5 p.m. to 2 a.m. daily.

And finally there is the **Road House** at 9625 N.E. Expressway. This is the largest bar in
the area with two floors for
dancing and drinking. All types

come here, from fems to superbutch. On show nights, it attracts a mostly older crowd. The shows which are occasional are not particularly exceptional, but they are entertaining. Usually the Road House attracts a young crowd. This bar is open every Friday, Saturday and Sunday night from 5 p.m. to 3 a.m. Set-ups. Next to the Frontier City Amusement Park.

For the 25-cent arcade movie lovers, there is the **Arcade** at 227 Sheridan Street. The movies here are all second-rate, 1940-vintage tease films; a real turnoff if you are accustomed to hardcore. But the arcade is cruisy. Unlike most arcades, there isn't any back room that is suitable for making contact. This is a look-and-smile-only cruise place.

The outside cruise area downtown starts at Walker and Sheridan by the bus station and runs on Sheridan to Sheridan and Robinson by the Tivoli Inn. The bus station, incidentally, is hot and cruisy. Mostly winos, hustlers and roughs work this area. Other cruise areas include Lake Hefner by the south side of the lake (johns especially) and the Will Rogers Park by the picnic area (johns also). There is also a YMCA at 125 N.W. 5th Street, but there is very little action here.

With these places in mind and a car to transport you, you should have an easy time making contact during your visit to OK City. I'm sure you'll agree after a vacation here that it is the nicest city in Oklahoma.

Thriftips Inexpensive Train Travel Abroad

When you figure the cost of a summer vacation in Europe it may come as a shock to discover that from 40% to 60% of your total budget is earmarked for intra-country transportation . . . and if foreign gasoline prices continue to rise—mini-car rentals also—that 60% will rise.

So this year why not give the Iron Horse a whirl? Buy a pari-mutuel ticket and you'll have a sure winner. He'll whisk you through Europe at a merry clip, and you'll come home with your winnings (alias Savings) intact.

The trick is to to forget 'first class' and think 'second' like most European travelers do. There's no stigma to secondclass rail travel. The difference is about the same as first-class and tourist-class on an American plane. It's the same plane, at the same altitude, going at the same speed. The only difference is a little more room in first, plus a free cocktail, perhaps, or an extra pat of butter on your rewarmed roll. Besides, you'll meet many more interesting people in second than first (there being more of them), and that means a lot of gay guys, too, since who of us is not doing his share of budget-tightening these days. So in tabulated form, here are some European train-travel tips that can save you a bundle.

Get railroad timetables for each country you plan to visit

from that country's national Tourist Office here in the United States. First, because such timetables are up-to-the-minute correct; second, because they are printed in English, rather than in that country's language; and third, because if you wait until you're over there a local railroad station is sure to be 'fresh out' of them.

Also such timetables supply a wealth of information about getting from place to place. To wait until you're there before inquiring can consume precious time that could be better spent in other 'pursuits' (like cruising. for example!). The International Union of Railroads publishes a very fine, comprehensive guide. listing major trains in every country in Europe. Any country with a Tourist Office in the United States will stock this guide. And it's free. A good bet is to write French National Railroads, 610 Fifth Avenue. New York, N.Y. 100020. Or if you're in the city, stop by and pick up a copy.

Know rail fares in advance. Knowing the exact price of a second-class ticket before you plunk down your money is very wise. The language problem can cause an honest mistake to be made that can cost you a great deal. Have ready, in the currency of whatever country, the exact price of your ticket to wherever. Any later hike in fare can be easily adjusted. For example, if you are in one city in France and want to go secondclass to another, by consulting your timetable you'll know the exact fare without asking. Just go to the ticket window, mention the name of the city you wish to go to, plunk down the correct number of francs, say "Deuxieme classe," and you're off! No problem.

What about the Eurailpass? Is is really worth the sizeable sum asked for it? Only if you are Constant Gadfly, flitting hither and yon. Of course, the more one thinks of it, the rosier the picture is of unlimited travel through thirteen countries for one flat fee. But are you really planning to travel that much?

Gay guys, particularly, like to get the lay of the land (if you'll excuse the expression) of one place before dashing off to greener pastures. So if this prints out y-o-u, forget the Eurailpass.

Look at it this economical way. The least expensive Eurailpass. valid for 15 days, costs \$130 at this writing. Yet the fare from. say, Paris to Rome, is only \$40. So if you have a Eurailpass this means you'd have to use up \$90 worth of clickety-clacking to get your money's worth. Consult your itinerary. Do you have many places listed? If not, pass up the Eurailpass. Note: the Eurailpass, also the BritRail Pass, is sold only in North America . . . such passes are not available abroad. The BritRail Pass is a good buy, however. Prices for adults range from \$44 (for 8 days' travel, economy class) to \$127 (for one month, first class). Since one who visits Great Britain likes to see as much of the country as possible, the advantages of BritRail Pass are obvious. A day here . . . a picnic in some charming spot . . . a few hours between trains in some hallowed or historical place . . . a dash over to Oxford and Cambridge . . . perhaps an evening of Shakespeare at Stratford-upon-Avon, and so on. Yes, one can really save a great deal of money with a BritRail Pass. Another important note: If you should lose, or have stolen, your Eurailpass or BritRail Pass. neither is replaceable nor refundable. Keep it safe in your passport wallet.

Overnight travel can save you still more money. Buy a couchette-a simple, basic berth that costs only \$6 a person, regardless of whatever class you may be traveling in, or how far you are going. You'll miss a lot of pretty scenery, perhaps; but then you may also miss some pretty dreary strectches. Even Steven. You don't get the world for your six bucks, however. The fee includes blanket-and-pillow, but no sheets, no washing facilities, and no privacy. Each compartment has either four (if first class) or six (if second class) couchettes. Since gay guys abroad are addicted to the couchette (why not, the very word is sexy!), you will find that gay adventure may be part of the deal. You just never know who may wind up sharing beddy-bye with you!

Bring along some food. Some European trains have buffet cars; some have quite elaborate dining cars and the food is often grand luxe. Some have something in-between. More often such meal cars are crowded, with additional long lines of passengers waiting to be fed. Even more often such cars are detached from the train for no understandable reason. Something vaguely 'union', usually. So take along a small basket of goodies . . . at least some fresh fruit and some wax-wrapped sandwiches with a hearty filling, plus a bottle of wine. And if you can't eat all you've brought, share a banana and/or the rest of your wine with some humpy number. Food taken aboard a European train on which one travels second-class makes a terrific cruising ploy!

Travel light. This is important if you are traveling on one of those crack trains that are 'faster than a speeding bullet'. Getting your luggage aboard is no problem. Lots of porters to help. But getting it off at some stop midway two termini can be difficult. Often the scheduled between is less than two minutes. So you really have to scramble and heart-in-mouth it. Travel with an airplane-type bag, with just basics and a spot for your poppers and cock ring. The lighter the better. You'll really appreciate drip-dry and wash 'n wear.

Johns. If you think American train plumbing leaves lots to be desired, don't expect less primitivity on European trains. While on some trains the plumbing is palatial, on others it is far less so. So take along some extra tissues (invariably the john is out of toilet paper)., and some moist towelettes. Our popular Tawashi is also a good idea to take along for genital cleansing, especially after you've had some wild

Eurotrain trick. Also, if you use an electric razor, take along a converter. The train's voltage will not be the same as is standard in the United States.

European travel by train is not only economical, but the 'social' advantages are enormous. Give it some thought. It's a whole new 'switch' . . . pun intended!

Gay Dining New York's Palace By The Editors

Proof of the Pudding is a restaurant on New York's Upper East Side, very popular with swinging singles and widely known to others by its gutsy sales-pitch, "May we seduce you for lunch?" Now its owners have opened a newer, posher restaurant a little farther east-The Palace—and its sales-pitch might well be "May we screw you for dinner?" Indeed, many may feel they have been. 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a non-existent piece of lint from the handsome beige carpet . . . banishing an imaginary insect (perish the thought!) . . . perhaps smoothing a many-timessmoothed tablecloth . . . re-rerearranging a fork.

The Palace is strong on authenticity. For example, there is no 'menu', but l'escriteau, and the language, as the waiter is quick to point out to the cum summa laude graduate of a six-week Berlitz crash course, is 'original' or Old French, which might seem to modern French what Chaucerian English is to modern speech. Quel snobisme!

If it weren't for all those 'iron fist in velvet glove' tippables and other little annoyances such as first having to write formally to The Palace for reservations so that you could "express your preferences in advance," the fifty bucks one spends for a meal would not seem so scalpable. At first only the really-altogethers knew The Palace's unlisted telephone number. Just knowing the number was itself a status symbol! Now we can offer you this deathless information. It's 355-5152. Write it in blood (young boy's blood, preferably) in your most secret diary.

The two great plus marks for The Palace are that the chef formerly commanded the kitchen at Lutèce, until the advent of The Palace, the most expensive restaurant in the United States. Another plus is the food. It's divine . . . though certainly not fifty-bucks worth of divine.

Your fifty-dollar excursion in gourmet dining would include a whiff or two of caviar straight from Iran or the Soviet Union . . . lobster and artichoke vinaigrette . . . oysters dotted with caviar This should whet your appetite for the soup, after which comes the deuxième or petite entrée, such as a zephyr de sole Catalane, or soft-shell crabs in caviar butter (so much caviar sounds gluey-gooey, but it's served in such little freshets and splashettes that it's more of a garnish), or oysters a bit tiddly from their bath in Pernod or Champagne. This is the end of Act I, and before Act II you get

the releve—something like fruit sherbet to give you a second wind, or to "clear the tongue" as liverish Londoners used to say. On with the roast. The racks of veal or lamb are exquisite. The lamb is just faintly pinky inside. Or you might prefer capon with at least one full-size truffle per square millimeter.

There are simply too many of chef Claude Baills' inspirations to list in this brief review. But something paean-like must be sung to his salad of Bibb lettuce with tiny shards of celery, leeks and fennel, with a dressing that is unforgettable. Desserts seem to be on a never-ending parade. They arrive precisely on schedule in a kind of wheelbarrow made of spun sugar. (New York's newest and most elegant pátisserie-Lenôtre-is now offering instruction in how to make flowers and designs from spun sugar, so this is by no means an original idea of The Palace). The mousses at The Palace are incomparable, particularly the chocolate and strawberry. The mousse au chocolat is of such a heavenly texture it could only have been whipped with a wire whisk in the hand of an angel. and practically floats onto your tongue. Following this another cart arrives with Cognac, Armagnac and various liqueurs and digestifs.

In short, there is an excess of everything at The palace . . . an excess of interior design, service, gimmicks and food. If the food were not of such unsurpassed greatness one might feel the whole thing a theatrical put-on . . . a gustatory charade. But when you've eaten the very last crumb (if you can get that far!) of all that has been set before you, or wheeled in, or otherwise presented with more kitsch than panache, you'll perhaps feel that, in the main, you've invested in an experience. If you look at it as an investment you may find the pain of parting with upward of \$100 a little less painless.

The Palace is located at 420 East 59th Street; admission only by reservation; hours Monday

through Saturday—6:15 to 10:30 p.m. The restaurant is closed on Sunday. Credit cards: American Express, BankAmericard, Master Charge, and Diners Club. Oh yes, the dinner is a three-and-one-half-hour marathon. Don't expect the blue plate special.

estimated that nearly the entire country will have repealed their sex laws within two years.

Atlanta... Governor George Busbee signed into law a few weeks ago what is considered the toughest obscenity law in the country. It is primarily aimed against hardcore pornography and already most of Georgia's porno stores and movie houses have been closed. Georgia is such a progressive state, Atlanta such a modern city, and one which has been growing by leaps and bounds. It is difficult to comprehend this step backwards in civil rights.

Sacramento... The bill legalizing all sexual acts between consenting adults in private that has just been signed by Governor Edmund G. Brown, Jr. is being challenged by numerous groups. Informally called a "Bill of Rights for Homosexuals," the measure repeals prohibitions as old as 103 years governing the private sexual behavior of consenting adults 18 years and over. It takes effect Jan. 1, 1976—provided the opposition fails in its defeat tactics before then.

San Francisco ... Mayor Joseph Alioto has for some reason long resisted pressures brought upon him to appoint a gay representative to the Human Rights Commission in his city. Just recently the City Board of Supervisors passed a resolution 'urging' Alioto to appoint such a representative as soon as a vacancy occurs. It is believed he will act positively on the issue.

Miami . . . The sodomy law forbidding "Unnatural and lascivious behavior" in Florida was recently declared unconstitutional in connection with a case involving 21 men on trial for sodomy. The men were among 64 arrested early this year at the Club Baths of Miami. Thanks to the expert legal defense for the men provided and paid for by the Club Baths chain all charges have been dropped and the ruling should benefit many others.

Hollywood . . . The Federal Government has stopped funding the Thousand Oaks Anti-Obscenity Prosecution Guidance Center. Since 1973 the government has spent over \$350,000 to finance the Center's six-man staff in its collection of information and exhibits used in antiporno trials and legal seminars.

New York . . . The American Psychiatric Association has refused a request by eight dissident psychiatrists for a new vote on whether "homosexuality per se" should be listed as a mental illness. The dissidents charged that a vote taken last year upholding the decision of the Association's trustees to delete the listing of "homosexuality per se' as a mental illness was improperly influenced by a letter signed by top Association leaders conceived of and paid for by the National Gay Task Force.
