



Psychiatrist, bailsman, bondsman, host and friend, Frank Powell is as much an Atlanta institution as the peach in the West Peachtree address of the homey lounge that bears his name. Frank, or Kathryn as he's known to a few hundred of his closest friends, opened the first area lounge to feature female impersonators 'way back in '64. It was

here, at The Joy, that he put stars in the eyes of the likes of Phyllis Killer and her Darling Daughters, Ernestine Brown and Rhonda Blake. And not so very much later, he made it perfectly clear that such "second rate acts" as those of former school friend Paul Lynde—or Madam and her fey companion Wayland Flowers—would never make it..!

Frank is quick to say that after opening his first Gay bar, The Red Head Lounge in Kansas City, he had an inkling that neither his travelling salesman's job nor the ministry (he'd been ordained to preach after graduation from Bob Jones University) would be his true calling. And, logically enough, found that if the skirt fits, you wear it.

Over the next 14 years he opened The Cove, The Sweet Gum Head, Between Places, Ms. Garbo's, Payton Place, The County Seat and, on January 1, 1978, Frank Powell's, the talkiest place in town.

"Most any evening, the "regulars" like Rose and Tressie; the Chicken Plucker and Mother; Ursula and Lurch and Frank are gathered 'round the main bar swapping tall tales and never missing a chance to 'out-wag' each other. The real wonder of the place is you can hear it all. Like the bartender when he says, more to himself than to anyone in particular, "I've been selling things for \$10 an inch for years." And Frank calls out, "Yeah, and the MOST you ever got was fifteen bucks..!"

Then a nervous stranger (it was his 1st time in the place), who's fiddling with his mustache and acting like maybe he shouldn't be there in the first place, brags that he could have gotten married several times. A beard in the corner laughs and asks, "What ever happened to him, honey?" and breaks the ice.



"Cavanaugh [Richard Cavanaugh, editor-in-chief of CRUISE magazine -Editor's note.] won that one," Frank muses. "I lost out on the Sportswear." With a twinkle in 'her' eye, "Mother," one of the regulars, chides him about the time he invited a small group of only 1000 or so of his close, personal friends to meet his friend Paul Lynde, and the old fart failed to show.

The *piece de resistance* of the winter season was the night Atlanta writer/composer Don Tucker plunked down at the piano to entertain his fans with hits from his two plays. Next thing you know, this has triggered the memory of the time Frank performed Atlanta's first Gay "marriage" at Buddy Clark's house. "Here Comes the Bride" was recorded and Charlotte Cain gave "her" away. There were flowers 'till you got tired at looking at them all and fancy guests and a catered reception afterwards. "Allison and Travis were together six or sever years," Frank remembers, "but 'she' was a show 'girl' and all that traveling was just too much." No children, no alimony -poor Allison!

And so it goes in the House on the Hill. Not a show-place for 'twinkies,' Frank's attracts the kind of professional crowd that thrives on an intimate, friendly, party-like atmosphere. A few drinks and they wander upstairs for supper in the cozy 12-table dining room where chef Bruce Jones serves "classic and devised" fare. Not to mention all the deep-fried chicken livers you can eat along with salad and choice of two veggies for only \$3.50. As 300 pound Bruce tells it, the only guest who wasn't 'done in' by the second helping was "only as big as a minute" and chomped his way thru four servings.

The dining room's imaginative menu always has a second special, a Delmonico steak, tasty fish, fowl and meat dishes. "Our aim is to serve good food at a modest price," Bruce says. "We hope to be open for lunch soon

"The Cecil B. DeMille Award:" D. Layton Gregory of the Club Atlanta. Comedy Performer: Tiger Lil.


Show Director of the Year: Micky Day. Special Award: Howard Brunner, director of live Gay plays.

The crowds that remain will miss


Hugh; he is a truly talented gentleman and we wish him continued professional success.




