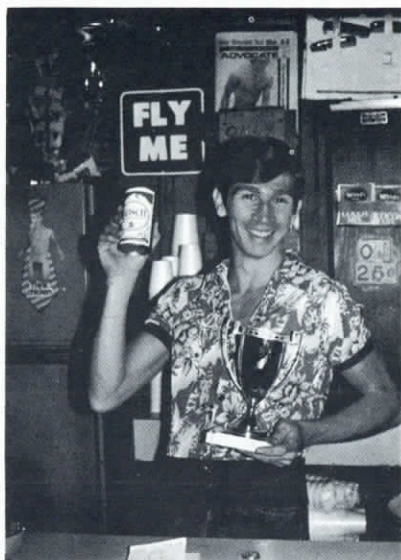
"If I only had a lover..." We've all felt this emotion at one time or another. The "Goose" lady and Hollywood conditioned us to the "happy ending".

giving in more than the other, but it has been my experience that the one who is always giving in, if he's bright and clever enough, will be getting his way in the end (no pun intended). The partner who begins to give in because "I love him so much," had better pack his bags and begin building himself up again. It had been my personal experience that to "give in" all the time will probably be construed as a sign of weakness by the other partner.
