**WHAT IS THE  
COURT SYSTEM**

In brief, The Court System is social community-service organization. When the system originated in San Francisco over 18 years ago, it was strictly 'camp' fun and from that beginning we derived our 'camp' titles...i.e. 'Emperor and Empress' (those who serve for one year as the presidents of our organization); 'Coronation' (a gala function held once yearly at which time we elect our new officers); etc. As the elected officers of our organization, our primary goals are to further relationships with organizations and businesses within our community, to hold functions and fundraisers for the enjoyment of the community, to raise money for charitable organizations, and to help those in the community who are in need of our assistance.

The Imperial Court de Fort Worth has been in existence for over five years and is the oldest and largest Court in the state of Texas. Most major cities in the Western United States

and Canada have a court system in their community. In California alone there are approximately 32 courts. So in essence, we are a chapter in an international organization. Our monarchs attend coronation throughout the country and Canada representing and sharing in furthering relations with outside communities. No one associated with our organization personally receives any monetary gain from money raised at our functions. The money goes directly back into the community as outlined above.

Perhaps the best aspect of our organization is that it is open to anyone and everyone. The Court encompasses the entire gay community, and is composed of both appointed and unappointed members, who share equally the same privileges and responsibilities. There is absolutely no discrimination as is evident in that our members represent every aspect of society, both gay and straight. A persons gender, lifestyle, or mode of dress has no bearing whatsoever on acceptance in our group. **Everyone is welcome!**

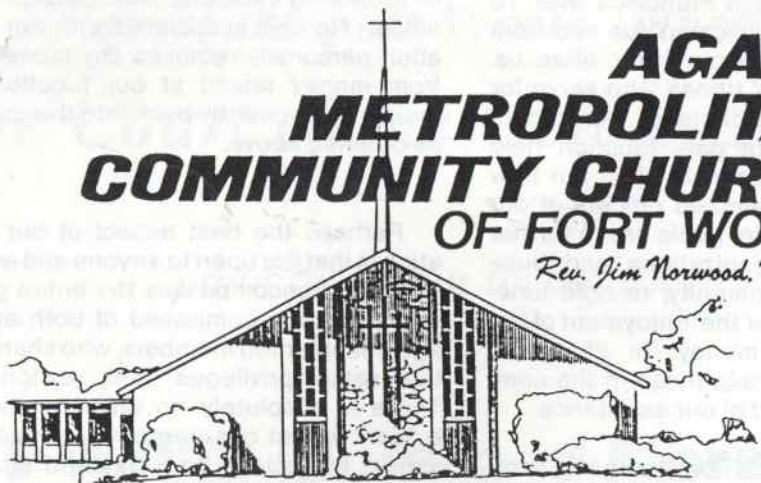

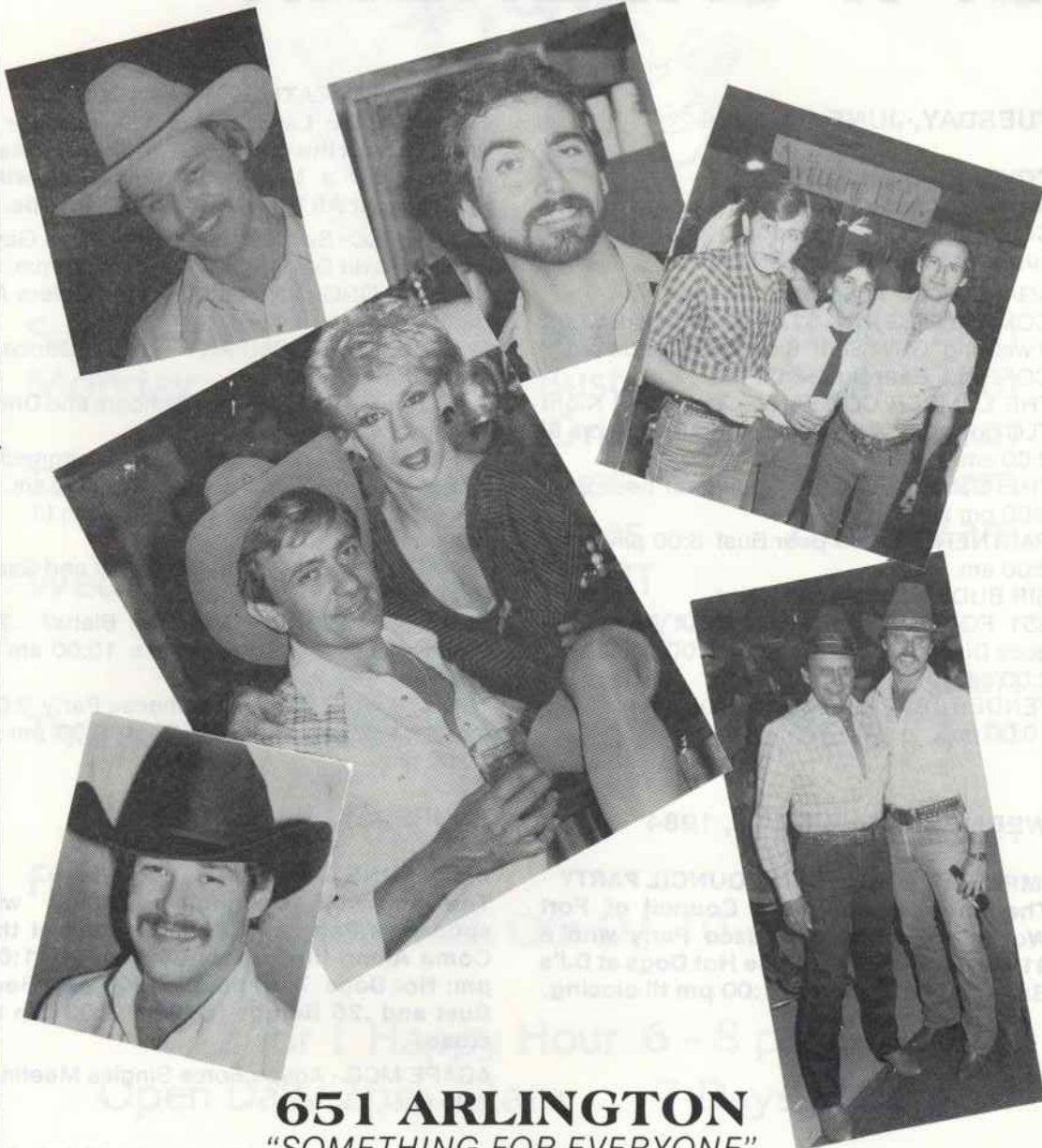

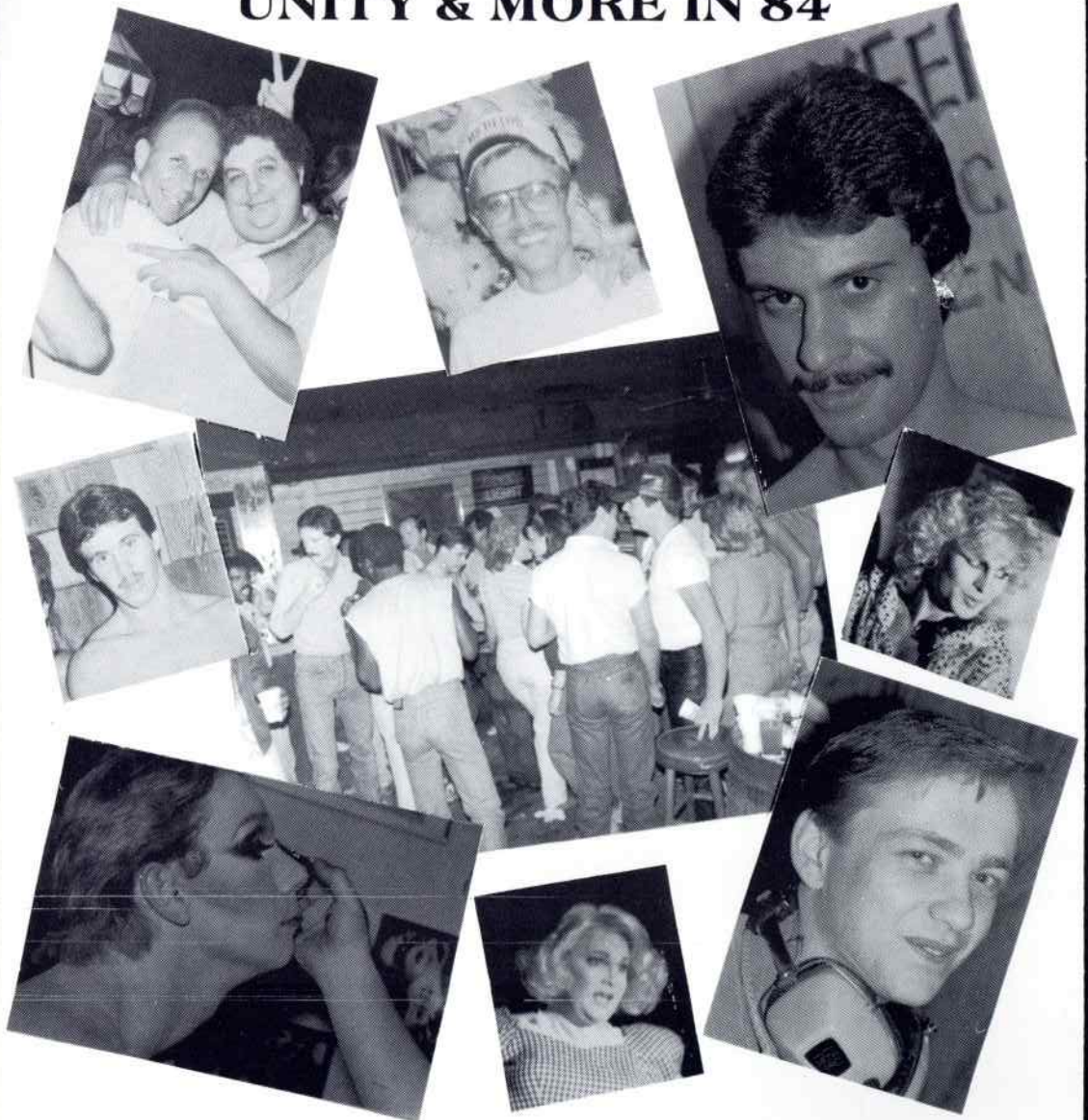
