Betty Bear

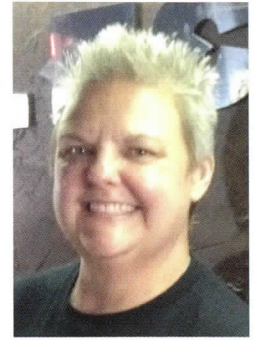

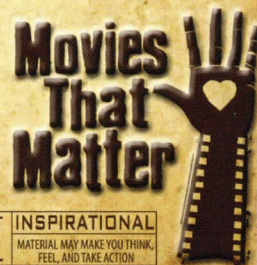

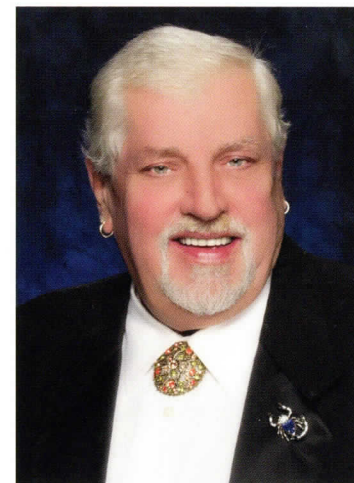


Candi Carroll, aka Randy Moore

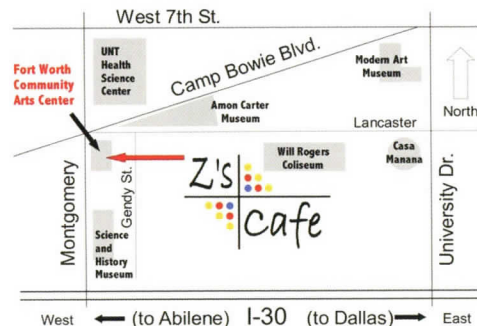

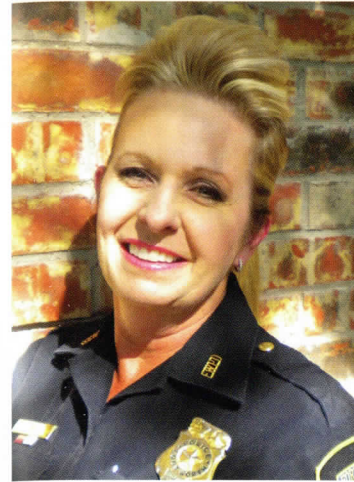

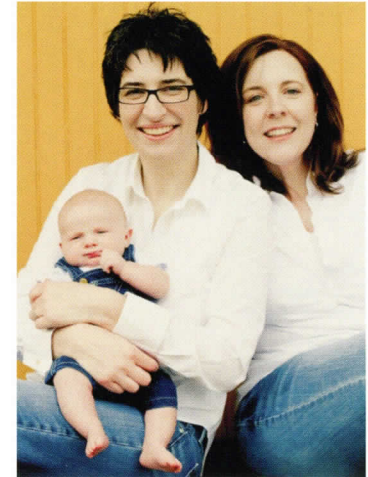


Sgt. Kathi Jones

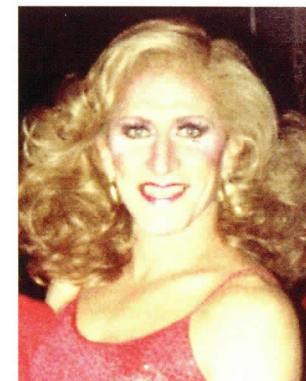

ABOUT THE AWARD

With a sense of community, selflessness and dedication, Raina Lee, aka Gary Taylor, defined his place in Tarrant's GLBT history. His talent for the art of female impersonation drove him to many successful endeavors and the level to which he poured his heart and soul for charitable fund-raising is unparalleled. 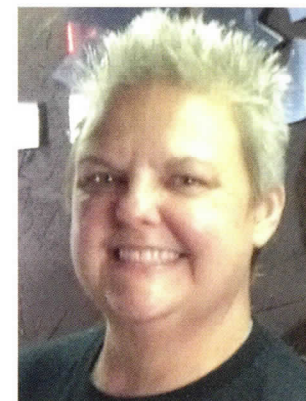

Todd spent 18 years as a journalist for the *Star-Telegram*. In 1998, he co-founded QCinema, for which he served as Artistic Director for the past 14 years. He was one of the founders of Fairness Fort Worth and his media and leadership efforts after the Rainbow Lounge raid earned him the titles Community Advocate of the Year by the Tarrant County Stonewall Democrats and the first LGBT Person of the Year by the *Dallas Voice*. Next June, he celebrates 20 years with partner Doug Hopkins.

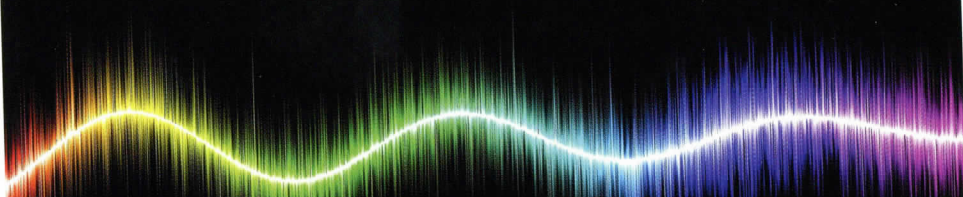


Mari Taylor

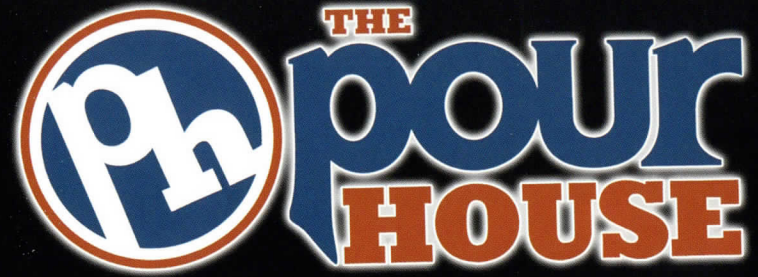

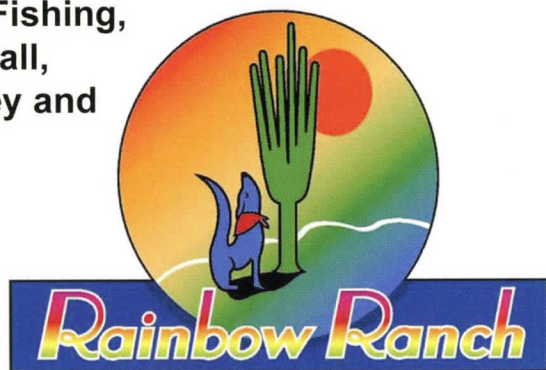

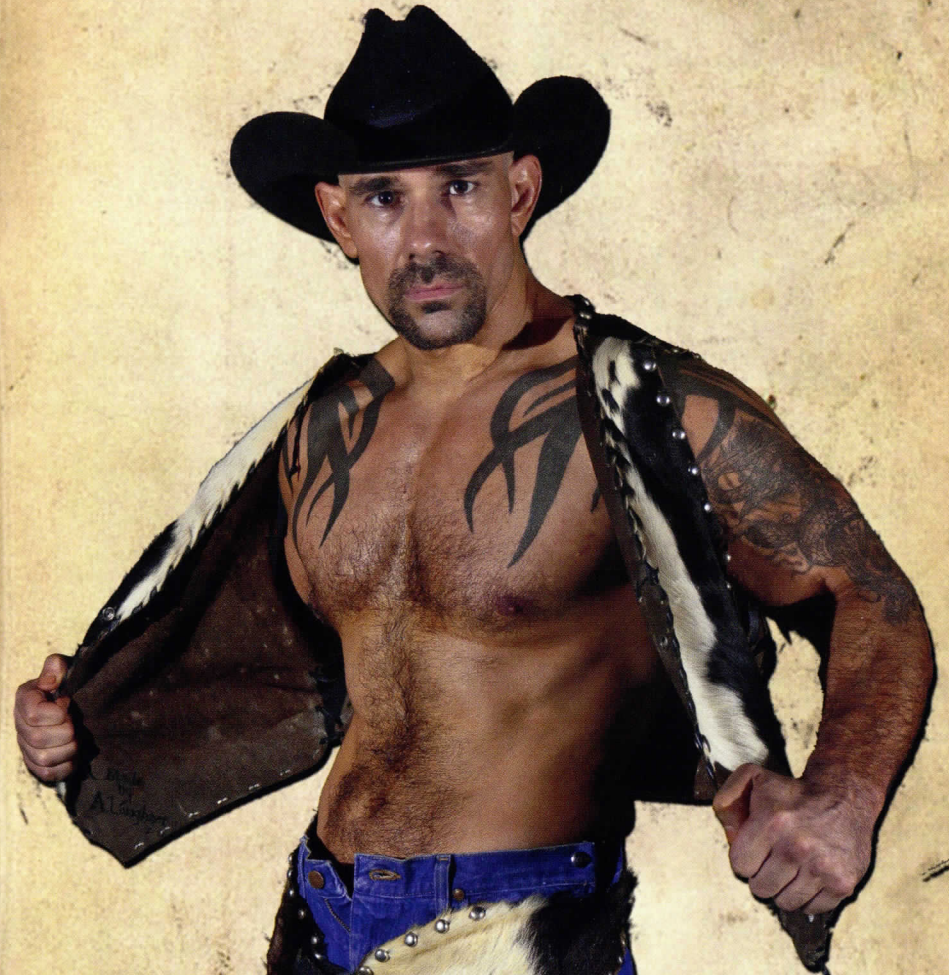
