National HIV Testing Day huge success for Montrose Clinic

On Friday, June 27, 1997, Montrose Clinic conducted 258 HIV tests using the new oral HIV-1 testing system made by OraSure. The Clinic offered free testing from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. and distributed free T-shirts, water bottles and condoms. This testing drive, in honor of National HIV Testing Day, was the most successful in Clinic history.

"We are very pleased with the number of people who participated in National HIV Testing Day," said Katy Caldwell, Executive Director of Montrose Clinic. "We were able to reach a large number of people with testing and counseling that traditionally have not taken advantage of our services. Many of who fall into one of the fast-growing at-risk population: women."

According to the Centers for

Disease Control, HIV infection is the third leading cause of death among women ages 25-44; the leading cause among Black women in the same age group.

Ponette

Movie Review

Ponette (Victoire Thivisol) is a pre-schooler who is hurt in an accident which kills her mom, the driver. Ponette seeks to construct an idea of death. She is offered many ideas. Adults offer the usual. Children offer more creative ideas. It is only in a perfection of magic realism when her mother visits her, Ponette discovers not what death is but what life is. The definition is not what one would expect from a movie that won the major Catholic film award.

The screenplay of Director Jacques Doillon was not written until he had carefully constructed focus groups where pre-school children talked about death and acted in skits set by Doillon. From these children he drew his story and all the children in the cast including Thivisol as Ponette.

Thivisol is a superb actress who handles every scene with aplomb. Boy, can she cry — and you will too. I hope her gift is not just a kid-acting thing. But, she's only in kindergarten.

The adults are background characters
