## 'Crime Against Nature' Repeal Debated

Busloads of religious fundamentalists came to the state legislative building in Raleigh September 27 to urge the Criminal Code Revision Study Committee to keep the current sex laws on the books.

In response, seven speakers urged the committee to abandon laws that prohibit private sexual acts between consenting adults.

The committee is studying a new criminal code proposed in 1981 by the North Carolina Criminal Code Commission. The earlier commission, which was created in 1969 to review the state's criminal laws, recommended that state laws prohibiting adultery, cohabitation and "crime against nature" not be carried forward into the new code.

Committee meetings normally are sedate occasions, attended only by the 12 committee members, their staff and a small group of lobbyists. On September 27 the committee hearing room was packed with almost 200 people, many wearing big red badges proclaiming "Keep Crime Against Nature" or "No Revision in Sex Laws". Many had brought babies and children for the day-long meeting.

The Rev. Grant Price began the parade of fundamentalist speakers by proclaiming, "We strongly condemn homosexuality." Referring to the Biblical story of Sodom and Gomorrah, Price said, "The same afflictions continue to plague us today. Homosexuality has destroyed every nation that has gone over to it. We have only one alternative — Repent!"

Mary Johnson of Buies Creek said that she had searched the proposed criminal code to find the laws that are currently on the books.

"Crime against nature, fornication and adultery, and persons of the opposite sex occupying a motel room — they are all repealed," Johnson said. "I feel betrayed."

Johnson quoted articles from Boston's *Gay Community News* and the *New York Native* that she said showed that "homosexuals want to engage in sex in public" and have sex with young children.

"How can law enforcement officials protect families and children if the crime against nature law is abolished?" she asked. When Johnson finished, she asked those who agreed with her to stand. Most of the crowd, which had apparently been invited by Johnson, stood — and then left with her.

Eric Prevatte, who said he represented the Lumberton Chamber of Commerce and nine churches, said that his concerns were child sex

abuse, child prostitution and pedophilia. Prevatte quoted a Charlotte *Observer* story about a pedophile who, according to Prevatte, said that "pedophilia is just another sexual orientation."

"When we remove the crime against nature law," Prevatte said, "we legalize homosexuality and bestiality anywhere that they want to do it."

Hank Vandergriff said that "repealing crime against nature could be construed to legitimate that particular lifestyle."

Vandergriff said that because he was young and slender, he was often approached by homosexuals. "I have been the subject of harassment by homosexuals," he said, "even to the point of being lured to people's apartments — padlocked in people's apartments."

The Rev. Coy C. Privette, executive director of the Christian Action League, a statewide conservative religious lobbying group, said that changing the "crime against nature" law could "open the doors of our state to deviant behavior."

Mike McIntyre, an attorney and chairman of the Young Democrats in the 7th Congressional District, also urged the committee to keep the "crime against nature" law.

He said that although "homosexuals represent only 10% of the population," they burdened society heavily. He quoted "statistics" that purported to show that gays are responsible for almost all of the sexually transmitted diseases in the United States.

"Homosexuals are 20 times more apt to molest children than heterosexuals," McIntyre also said.

Rev. Larry Griswold of Roanoke Rapids said the "crime against nature" law should be retained to prevent the spread of homosexual behavior. "We're a farming community," he said. "When we sow corn, corn comes up. In Atlantic City they sowed gambling. And do you know what's happened in Atlantic City?"

Crime prevails. When the law of God is perverted, crime will prevail."

After eight speakers opposing changes in the "crime against nature" and other sex laws, the first speaker came to the stand to support the proposed changes. John Boddie, a Raleigh attorney, said that the legitimate concerns of the previous speakers were all dealt with in the proposed code. Various sections of the code, he said, punished sexual assaults, sex with minors, public sex, bestiality and kidnapping.

"The issue before this committee is whether to carry forward into a new code the current laws dealing with cohabitation, adultery and crime against nature," Boddie said. "If these laws were to be fully enforced, we would be incarcerating a majority of the population of North Carolina."

The fundamentalist crowd erupted in boos and hisses, and the committee's co-chair, Senator James Edwards of Granite Falls, reprimanded the crowd for its outburst.

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## Charlotte CRC Studies

The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Community Relations Committee has voted to study homosexuality as a first step toward taking action on a list of seven recommendations proposed by a Charlotte gay man who says he has suffered harassment, according to stories in the Charlotte *Observer* and *Q-Notes*.

Several months ago, Gilbert Dale Cornelius submitted his recommendations to the committee. Cornelius, a former college English teacher, has often written pro-gay letters to Charlotte newspapers, some of which have been quoted in *The Front Page*.

At that time, Cornelius addressed the committee, testifying about the harassment he has been subject to since childhood. He explained how the verbal abuse made him feel "rejected by the world" and "isolated." Dr. Sherman Burson, chair of the committee's Human Resources Subcommittee, described Cornelius's address as "articulate."

Cornelius closed his address with seven recommendations to the committee:

- To actively seek two representatives from the gay community to sit on the committee.
- To encourage input from gay/lesbian individuals.
- To speak out as individuals and as a committee to address antigay incidents.

• To urge all appointed citizen committees to include gay men and lesbians.

• To support broadening existing antidiscrimination ordinances to include gay men and lesbians.

• To develop educational programs about the damage caused by antigay abuse.

• To design a program that would help parents learn not to condemn gay children, but rather to rear them with love and acceptance.

On August 9, Cornelius sent a letter to the committee describing an August 6 incident in which he was hit, kicked, and called "faggot" by a man after Cornelius refused to give him a cigarette while waiting for a bus. Cornelius said that the city bus driver did nothing when the verbal abuse continued after he boarded the bus. Instead, the driver said to the men abusing Cornelius, "You guys are so funny; I'm enjoying it."

In the same letter, Cornelius talked about growing up "in the 1950s — a hard time" and being "a bright young man [who] was called queer." He recalled how, returning home for a college vacation, he learned that a high school friend had been imprisoned for homosexuality. "Now," Cornelius said, "I was not only anxious, but frightened as well."

Because of the letter, the Community Relations Committee, at its August 29 meeting, passed a motion to adopt the recommendations of its Human Resources Subcommittee. As a result, it will hold a fact-finding meeting on September 19 to define "the condition of homosexuality." Clinical and academic psychologists will be invited to address the full committee.

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# Mall Troubles

Two of the men arrested in the undercover police operation at Raleigh's Crabtree Valley Mall have had the charges against them dismissed, according to a story in the *News and Observer*. Both men had been charged with committing a crime against nature (a felony offense).

A prosecutor said that the charges were dropped because the evidence showed the men had not violated the law.

Assistant District Attorney R. Thomas Ford dismissed the charges without presenting any evidence. In an earlier interview, Ford had said that an undercover police officer stationed in a mall bathroom had arrested the two men after seeing them standing in a stall with the door open.

The dismissal notice that Ford filed in court said, "What they did is not crime against nature."

Defense attorneys for some of the other 37 men arrested in the undercover operation have charged that the police used entrapment. This argument was not raised in the cases that were dismissed.

The *News and Observer* story printed the names, ages, and occupations of the two men. It noted that one of them, who works for the state Department of Public Instruction, had been suspended from his job without pay.

The other man is an elementary school teacher from Carteret County. At the time of his arrest, the *Carteret County News-Times* ran a front-page story about the "probe of alleged homosexual activity and harassment of teen-age boys." The story gave the names and other details about both men.

It quoted the superintendent of the Carteret County schools as saying that the local school board was not going to take any action against the teacher, who had "a record of working with us without any blemishes that we know of."

The superintendent, T.L. Lee, said, "We're simply waiting on court action. We don't feel there is any action justified without substantiation. In America, you're innocent until proven guilty, and we're taking that stand."

In a related story about harassment in malls, the *Gastonia Gazette* reports the claims

of several young men that they were evicted from Eastridge Mall for being gay.

Theron Hatten, 18, said that he and four friends were told by mall security guards to leave the mall and not come back for two months, because they were gay.

"We weren't doing anything wrong," Hatten said. "We were picked on simply because we're homosexual."

The mall security director, Dick Warner, denied the claim, saying, "We don't get into that sort of thing."

Hatten said he and his friends, who had just left a restaurant, were only talking to each other. "Maybe we offended someone by something we said. But we didn't try to provoke any problems. We would have apologized to anybody we might have offended."

Warner declined to say exactly what the offense was, merely saying the young men were "involved in some kind of disturbance."

Hatten says three security guards told him and his friends that other shoppers complained they were "getting loud" and ordered them to the mall office.

"It embarrassed us," he said. "Everybody was looking at us like we were a bunch of criminals or something."

At the mall office, the five were told they were being thrown out and were asked to sign a document suspending them from the mall for two months. They said they were not given a copy of the statement even though they asked for one.

"We signed it because we didn't want to cause any more trouble," said Larry Williams, who had moved to Gastonia from New York City four months ago.

Williams and Hatten said they and other homosexuals have been harassed by mall guards who followed them around on other occasions.

Warner said Eastridge has a trespass warning, which it issues to people who are "creating a disturbance or doing anything in violation of the morals policy at the mall." State law gives mall authorities the right to evict people from their property.

Warner said the mall issues the warning for "any number of things — arguing, screaming, yelling across the mall."

Subcommittee chair Burson observed that, before the subcommittee seriously considers Cornelius's recommendations, members want to learn more about homosexuality. "We need to be better educated," he said.

At the same meeting, the committee will seek a legal opinion about North Carolina's "crime against nature" law.

Responding to some members' concern that having a fact-finding meeting might seem like support for gay rights, committee chair Leon Riddick pointed out that the action is not an endorsement of Cornelius's recommendations. Riddick said, "We are standing on neutral ground now."

Some gay activists who attended the August meeting were pleased by the action. Don King, a founder of Queen City Quordinators, said, "I'm glad to see a fine group like CRC, which I have a lot of respect for, begin to look at this."

King told an *Observer* reporter that job discrimination against homosexuals is frequent: "In some cases, people don't get

promotions or lose their jobs because they are gay." King added, however, that physical harassment of homosexuals is rare in Charlotte.

On Wednesday, October 3, at a meeting held at the Covenant Presbyterian Church, the CRC welcomed written statements concerning job and housing discrimination, police mistreatment and public harassment.

Realizing that most gay men and lesbians — because they must protect present jobs — were not in a position to reveal every detail, the committee worked with King to assure that identities were protected. While including as much detail as possible in relating cases when harassed, fired, coerced into resigning or held back from promotion, gay men and women were instructed to put their name and phone number on a separate sheet clipped to the report.

King then coded each report and each name sheet with a number, giving the committee only the reports. If particular cases of discrimination needed more attention from the committee, King said, he would willingly act as a go-between.

The results of this recent meeting were not available at press time.

## Politic-tic-tic ...

## First, The Good News

Or at least semi-encouraging. You recall the 1983 ruckus over Gerry Studds, the Democratic representative from Massachusetts whom the House censured for his affair with a 17-year-old male page. When accused, Studds admitted that he was gay, but did not apologize, cringe, or whimper: a real real man.

In September, Studds faced his first voter test since the censure. Seeking renomination for a seventh term, he was challenged in the primary by two other candidates. One of them, Plymouth County Sheriff Peter Flynn, said he had decided to run as he watched the new conference in which Studds admitted his gayness. Flynn asserted that the affair was "nothing less than a case of child molestation."

Despite what one columnist said might be "this year's most vicious campaign," Studds remained popular, even among conservative groups, who wisely looked at his public voting record and not at his private habits. As a result, Studds won an easy renomination.

The final election, however, might not have such a happy ending. The Republican party and fundamentalist groups have targeted Studds as a particularly vulnerable candidate, and plan to spend lavishly to defeat him. Needless to say, Studds's private life will once more become a matter of public discussion.

Some of the public discussion has already appeared in the Greenwood, S.C., *Index Journal* (9-18). The paper printed a piece about the primary race by nationally syndicated columnist Robert Wagman. Obviously sympathetic to Studds, Wagman is appalled by the campaign against him, which was "marked by innuendo, intolerance, and slogans and bumper stickers whose contents can't be printed in a family newspaper."

On the same page was an *Index Journal* editorial commenting on Wagman's comment that "the campaign against Studds is marked by a lack of decency and fairplay." The editorial then mentions the case of a high school student who was dropped from the National Honor Society because she was pregnant, but who pressured school officials into readmitting her. The editorial draws the obvious but tedious connection:

"Decency? Honor?"  
"These two samples provide interesting glimpses of society today. But what do they indicate? Increased understanding and tolerance of human conduct that was once frowned upon? A breakdown in old-fashioned morality? What?"

I choose answer N1. Guess which one the *Index Journal* chooses. It continues:  
"Oh, well. There couldn't be a better time [than an election year debate over religion and politics] to think about decency and honor ... and what they stand ... or stood for." [Note: their ...s, not mine. I think it's called a "pregnant pause." Another argument for abortion.]

OK, *Index Journal*, let's not talk "decency" and "honor." Let's talk "stupid." "Stupid" is not understanding that a politician's private life is irrelevant to his or her public life. "Stupid" is not realizing that a student's pregnancy in no way invalidates the grades that got her into the honor society. "Stupid" is corrupting good words like "decency" and "honor" when what you really mean is "narrow-minded adherence to timid, oppressive bourgeois values." So let's not deal with hard words like "decency" and "honor" until we get "stupid" squared away.

## Sailor Gets Borked ...

So much for the semi-victory. Now on to a substantial defeat, and intimation of worse in the future.

In 1981, James L. Dronenburg was unwillingly, albeit honorably, discharged from the Navy. A Korean linguist and cryptographer with a top-security clearance, Dronenburg had served for nine years, with an unblemished service and many citations for his outstanding performance. Despite all this, however, the Navy kicked him out. His offense: simply doing what sailors throughout history have been so well known for. He had repeatedly engaged in "homosexual conduct" with a seaman recruit in a Navy barracks — and I doubt that "homosexual conduct" means doing Ethel Merman imitations.

Dronenburg filed suit, charging that the Navy's policy of mandatory discharge of all homosexuals violated his constitutional right to privacy. But the U.S. Court of Appeals panel in the District of Columbia, in a 3-0 decision, ruled against him: "We can find no constitutional right to engage in homosexual conduct and, as judges, we have no warrant to create one."

The ruling is, as the *New York Times News Service* story (9-18) noted, "the broadest and most ringing repudiation a federal appeals court had given to the view of some libertarians that laws penalizing homosexuality are unconstitutional."

Of course, homophobes cheered the decision. The Aiken, S.C., *Standard* (which should be required by law to add "Sub" to the front of its name — truth in advertising, like "cheese food") smugly states (8-29): "The decision would seem to be a setback for homosexuals seeking more enlightened and compassionate treatment in our society, but it is hard to see how the court could have ruled otherwise." No, it's simple: they could have said that sexual orientation is none of the government's business.

That seems bad enough, but it gets worse. You see, the court's opinion was written up by Judge Robert H. Bork. Bork was appointed to the appeals court by Ronald Reagan. Bork is on Reagan's "short list" of potential Supreme Court nominees. In other words, if Reagan gets re-elected, we will probably get Bork, and opinions like this, for the next several decades.

Just in case you needed another reason to vote against Reagan.  
The opinion is a masterpiece of ignorant bigotry masquerading as common sense. In fact, Bork explicitly cites common sense as a sufficient basis for his opinion: "The Navy is not required to produce social science data or the results of controlled experiments to prove what common sense and common experience demonstrate." In other words, Bork will rely on his stereotypes and myths of homosexuality, rather than actually seeking facts about individual gay men and lesbians.

And what does Bork's "common sense" tell him? "The effects of homosexual conduct within a naval or military unit are almost certain to be harmful to morale or discipline." Nonsense, of

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Boddie asked the committee to consider scientific studies on human sexual behavior in deciding what percentage of the population engaged in oral sex and other practices made criminal in North Carolina. He said that references to such studies were cited in a paper the North Carolina Civil Liberties Union had provided to committee members.

"If these laws are not to be fully enforced," Boddie said, "this legislature will be inviting selective enforcement. If these laws are put back into the criminal code, this legislature will be abdicating its responsibility to decide what acts will be crimes in this state."

Ann Frazier of Roanoke Rapids, a well-known anti-abortion lobbyist, told the committee that Boddie had almost convinced her. However, she urged the committee to retain the "crime against nature" law to "protect our children."

Judy McNeil of Hillsborough, representing the North Carolina Chapter of the National Organization of Women (NOW), urged the committee to repeal all laws prohibiting private, consensual, adult sexual behavior.

"North Carolina NOW urges the General Assembly to repeal the crime against nature law," McNeil said.

David Jolly of Durham, representing the Lesbian and Gay Health Project, told the committee that the alleged statistics cited by McIntyre on child molestation were inaccurate. "Ninety percent of these children are girls molested by heterosexual men," Jolly said.

Jolly also told the committee that gay people often don't seek proper health care because they fear that their physicians will inquire about their sexual practices.

"At present for gay people, it means admitting we are committing a crime each time we make love," he said.

Jolly called the "crime against nature" statute "an archaic law that violates the principle of individual liberty."

Leo Teachout of Rocky Point, current president of the North Carolina Human

Rights Fund, told the committee that the Criminal Code Commission had "demonstrated a great deal of foresight in drawing the conclusion that this unenforceable and archaic law is unnecessary in securing order in the state."

Maintaining the law in the criminal code would be wrong, said Teachout.

"This law violates the principles of individual liberty on which our nation was founded, and it supports and encourages discrimination in our community," Teachout said. "The peaceful, private activities of consenting adult citizens should not be the business of the government."

All sexually related activities that are the legitimate concern of government are covered by other specific sections of North Carolina law, Teachout said. Rape, forcible sodomy, child abuse, prostitution and public sex are all dealt with by other laws, he said.

"As a single parent who is raising two children, I am especially concerned with assuring that my children are safe," Teachout said. "If I felt that a crime against nature law was necessary to protect my children, I would certainly support it. But this law would not provide any more protection than current child abuse laws and could provide the basis for attacks on them as adults, so I oppose it."

Rev. June Norris of St. John's Metropolitan Community Church in Raleigh told the committee that she resented "the efforts of those who would impose their moral standards on others."

"I remember the words of Jesus, who said, 'Let those without sin cast the first stone,'" she said.

Rev. Norris said that the gay people in her congregation were "hurting" as a result of discrimination brought on in part by the "crime against nature" law.

Rev. Lynn Guerra of Charlotte's Metropolitan Community Church also spoke before the committee, telling them "I am a Christian and I am a Lesbian."

Father H. C. Mulholland of St. Michael's Catholic Church in Cary said that churches had prospered in the United States largely because of a strict separation of church and state.

Father Mulholland said that in his own church it was considered a sin to engage in oral or anal sex outside of marriage but that it was not a sin for a married couple to do the same thing.

However, Father Mulholland said, "As we have seen here today, there are a variety of opinions on this issue, and the fact one church or one sect believes in the rightness of a thing is no reason to make it law."

"I urge this committee not to carry a crime against nature law forward into the new code," Father Mulholland said.

After a short break the committee reassembled to discuss the proposed revisions. In the discussion none of the members referred to any law other than "crime against nature" even though the fundamentalist speakers had

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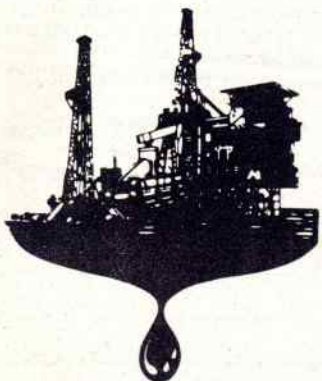

also criticized the repeal of the adultery, fornication and cohabitation laws.

Rep. Joseph B. Roberts III, D-Gaston, said that he liked the distinction Father Mulholland said the Catholic Church made between acts within marriage and acts between unmarried persons.

Roberts moved that the committee direct its staff to draft a new law leaving the "crime against nature" law just as it is but excluding private acts between a husband and wife.

Sen. William Martin, D-Guilford, moved that the staff also draft a new "crime against nature" provision that would exclude private consensual activity but deal with harassment or repeated solicitation for the purpose of performing oral or anal sex.

Butch Zimmerman, a district attorney from Lexington, said that he liked the "crime

against nature" law just as it is and he wanted to see a draft keeping current law.

The committee then voted to have the legislative staff draft three separate proposals: (1) leaving the law like it is, (2) excluding private acts between a husband and wife and (3) dealing only with harassment or repeated solicitation for the purpose of performing oral or anal sex.

The committee also voted to put the new provision in Article 46 of the proposed code, the article dealing with riots, civil disorders and public disturbances.

The day after the hearing and meeting, several committee members told a Raleigh *News and Observer* reporter their concerns about a revision in the sex offense laws.

Sen. Dennis J. Winner, D-Buncombe, who was not present for the meeting September 27, said that controversy over changes in sex laws had doomed proposals to revise the criminal codes in other states. "I'm afraid that's what's going to happen here," he said.

Rep. Roberts told the reporter that legislators could not go around with "built-in applause meters" to gauge public opinion on the issue. Pointing out that it is technically a crime for an unmarried man and woman to live together in North Carolina, Roberts noted, "If that were strictly enforced, there would be very few people left to run society."

Rep. Timothy H. McDowell, D-Alamance, who had sat silent at the September 27 meeting, told the reporter, "We ought to try our best to bring (criminal laws) into the 20th century."

Observers at the meeting said they expected the draft provisions to be discussed at a committee meeting in November after the election.

course. A good blow job, given or received, is wonderful for the morale. Ask any truck driver at any rest area. Or any sailor. The judge has obviously not had enough "common experience" in the right places.

Bork's "common sense" tells him that the presence of homosexual liaisons in the Navy would "make personal dealings uncomfortable where the relationship is sexually ambiguous." But, if sailors could be openly gay, there would be no ambiguity. One sailor could say, "I'm gay, I think you're hot, so how about it?" and the other sailor could say, "Sure" or (less likely) "No thanks." No ambiguity, no discomfort.

Bork also contends that permitting homosexual conduct would, "given the powers of military superiors over their inferiors, enhance the possibility of homosexual seduction." If Bork worries about sexual harassment, he'd better also guarantee that no heterosexual in the government has any position of authority over any person of the opposite gender. You know how heterosexuals are.

Furthermore, the specter of "homosexual seduction" is basically a product of hetero fear/fantasy, corresponding to nothing in reality. The fantasy puts all the "blame" on the homosexual "seducer," and leaves the straight "victim" free to enjoy the experience without taking any responsibility. Or, as Judy Garland once sort of sang to Clark Gable's picture, "You made me rim you, I didn't want to do it."

Bork also claims that condoning homosexual activity would "generate dislike and disapproval among many who find homosexuality morally offensive." Probably, but so what? Who cares if the homophobes get upset? Catering to homophobia is the same as catering to racism or anti-Semitism. It doesn't matter that the homophobe can invent "moral" reasons to defend his irrational hatred. The Klan will gladly explain the "morality" of lynching blacks. Hitler thought that gassing the Jews was supremely moral. The racist, the antisemite, and the homophobe are the ones who are morally offensive. Why deny us our right to love in order to protect their "right" to hate?

Bork himself is offensive, not only in his substance, but also in his style, which at one point becomes intolerably smug. He notes that the Supreme Court has established the right to privacy in cases relating to marriage, procreation, contraception, family relationships, and child rearing and education. Then he adds: "It need hardly be said that none of these covers a right to homosexual conduct." Sounds like "I'm straight and you're not, so nyah, nyah." Do we really want a Supreme Court justice who says "Nyah, nyah"? The choice is yours.

Bork's conclusion is wrong. Consensual homosexual conduct is completely analogous to these heterosexual activities: like them, it is a private matter, and should be protected like them. There is no area in which the government can legitimately discriminate between homosexual and heterosexual.

This, of course, is capital-T Truth. Unfortunately, the Truth doesn't matter. What counts is Bork's opinion, which has the force of law. Bork says, "Let there be only straight sailors!" and, behold, a reality gets smothered under a right-wing fantasy of Clean, Upright, American Manhood.

... We All Get Borked, and Borked, and Borked ...

But, if Bork makes it to the Big Bench, the setback to gay rights is only the beginning of what we can expect — at least according to the gleeful predictions of George Will, nationally syndicated columnist and overeducated fascist. In a piece on the Dronenburg case (9-17), Will sees Bork's opinion as an assault on the whole concept of constitutionally protected privacy. This is a delicate issue, because the Constitution does not explicitly protect privacy. Previous court decisions have merely inferred a right to privacy from other existing rights.

It is also an explosive issue, because the concept of privacy was the basis of the Supreme Court decision that overthrew state laws against abortion — or, in Will's smarmy phrase, "the fact that in 1973 the Supreme Court discovered a constitutional right to abortion."

According to Will, "Bork's analysis is broadly majoritarian, deferring to the discretion of the community's popularly elected branches of government as they make choices about activities that shall be, on moral grounds, regulated." That's the problem with education: it lets fascists like Will cloak despicable thoughts in high-flying language.

To translate his sentence: "Bork favors mob rule. He will not use the power of the Supreme Court to stop local governments from passing laws that impose the superstitions of ignorant but vocal pressure groups on the rest of society."

In particular, Will smacks his lips over the possibility that the Reagan court, under Bork's leadership, will reverse the 1973 abortion rule: "His analysis is an intimation of how a reconstituted court could, on majoritarian grounds, disestablish some freshly minted constitutional 'rights' and restore the community's right to make moral choices."

Translation: If Reagan's foreign policy doesn't blow us all back to the Stone Age, then maybe his Supreme Court appointments will take us back at least a few centuries, to when straight white men made the moral decisions for everyone else.

Will's dismissal of "freshly minted constitutional 'rights'" (he's referring to the abortion decision) does not take into account any possibility that our concept of freedom and rights has grown over the centuries. But, cynic that I am, I believe there is such a thing as moral progress.

The Founding Fathers, while very wise, had some blind spots: like their assumption that "citizen" meant "white male." Over the years, America has discovered "new" forms of oppression — "new" because they weren't understood before — and has worked to remove them.

One reason America continues to be great is that the American Revolution is not yet over. At any given time, there are still new meanings to be found in our basic concept of "freedom." Once it seemed natural that blacks and women couldn't vote. Now it seems unnatural. Now some think it natural that abortion and homosexuality are seen as "immoral." It will not always seem so. The continuing American Revolution will bring us all our rights.

Still, the revolution could be delayed by those who want to stop and even reverse our moral progress. A Reagan re-election and Bork appointment could delay our rights for another generation.

But, hey, the man's gonna make us all rich — at least until the deficit comes crashing down on us. And that's worth a few decades of oppressive Supreme Court decisions, right?

### Wimps for Justice

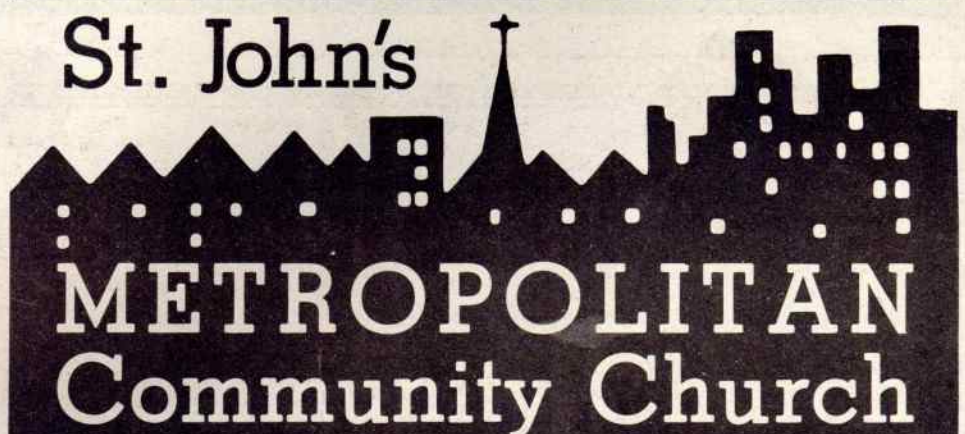
A few issues ago, we discussed one dirty rhetorical trick that the Republicans are using. Because the Democrats set up a quota system to ensure adequate representation of gays and lesbians within their party, some Republicans are trying to spread the fear that the Democrats intend to impose hiring quotas on all public and private employers.

Unfortunately, the smear campaign is working. Evidence comes in a letter to the Columbia, S.C., *State* (8-21), from A.T. Chalk, who begins with the Democratic party rules and leaps to the incorrect conclusion: "It seems the Democrats intend to bring about legislation that would force gay men and women to be hired in the 'workplace.' A school is a 'workplace.' So is a hospital and the military."

Right. And gays already work in schools, hospitals, and the military, and everywhere else, too. We're not asking for quotas — we just want to work where we're already working, only openly.

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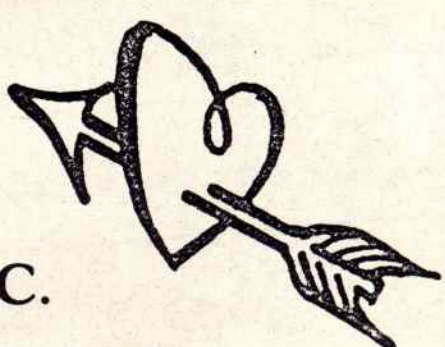
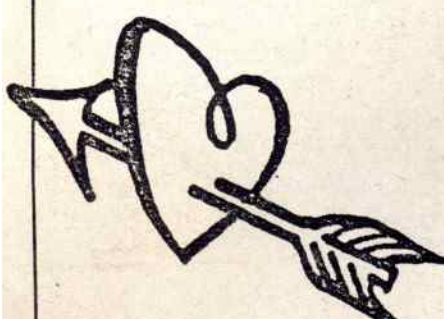

Chalk sees this fictitious "quota rule" as being consistent with the supposed character flaws of the candidates: "I know Mondale had promised every little splinter group almost everything it has asked for and, from a weak person like him, this is not surprising. And, as we learn more unpleasant things about Ferraro and her family, maybe it's not surprising in her." He's a wimp, and she's a crook. They're both capable of anything.

This is another cliché of the campaign: Mondale's "weakness" or "wimpiness" versus Real Man Reagan. The cliché even sneaks into discussions of the Democrats' acceptance of gays and lesbians. For example, it comes up in an open letter from Bob Hede to Richmond County Democrats, printed in the Rockingham, N.C., *Journal* (8-6). It begins, "Do you realize that your party has caved into pressures from gay rights activists?"

Note the phrase "caved in." This is how the homophobes describe the Democratic action of extending full recognition to gays and lesbians. They assume that no party could actually believe in the rightness of gay rights. So the Democrats must have wimped out. It takes Real Men Republicans to keep the rough, tough gay activists in their place.

Needless to say, all this can be seen in a more positive light: not as wimping out, but as righting an old wrong, as taking a step forward in moral progress. This perspective is excellently expressed in a letter from Rick Hunter to the Winston-Salem *Sentinel* (9-19):

"By supporting gay and lesbian civil rights, the Democratic Party would encourage the passage of legislation that would help guarantee gays and lesbians the freedom to work at a job without fear of losing it simply because of their sexual orientation.

"More than that, it would enable gay people to enjoy the freedom to be themselves and to live a more rewarding life. Lying and hiding are no way to go through life. Once gay people become more open and visible, old fears and myths about homosexuality will start to evaporate. More and more people will be surprised to find that they actually have always known many gay men and lesbian women. ... They will find that the vast majority of homosexuals are happy, healthy people who desire the same freedom that the early American leaders desired when they signed the Declaration of Independence — the freedom to pursue happiness. As long as that pursuit doesn't hurt anyone or take advantage of anyone and is done with an understanding of responsibility, no one in America should be denied the liberty to enjoy life as he or she pleases.

"When it really comes down to it, most everyone in this country would discourage the needless mistreatment of any American citizen. By supporting gay and lesbian civil rights, mistreatment of a lot of good folks is what the Democratic Party is trying to eliminate."

A letter from Wayne M. Walker to the Charlotte *FT2Observer* (9-20) says the same thing, although unknowingly:

"The 1980 and 1984 Democratic Party platform was and is for gay rights. Walter Mondale and Democrat D.G. Martin are for gay rights. Gay rights means the legal right for men to marry men and for women to marry women and the legal right of the 'couples' to adopt children. It means school teachers will have to teach children that homosexuality is an acceptable and alternative lifestyle."

Well, gay rights means more than this, but it certainly includes these. There's no reason against gay-gay and lesbian-lesbian marriages (although why anyone would want to is beyond me). There's certainly no reason such couples can't adopt children. And, since one-tenth of all schoolchildren are gay, it would be good for teachers to acknowledge the fact and tell them that they, too, can lead a healthy life.

Walker's final two sentences are marvellously succinct:

"If you want gay rights, register and vote Democrat. If not, register and vote Republican."

Thanks, Wayne. Couldn't have said it better myself.
