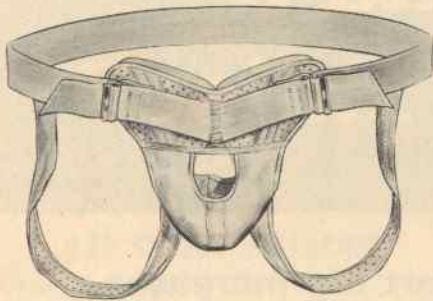

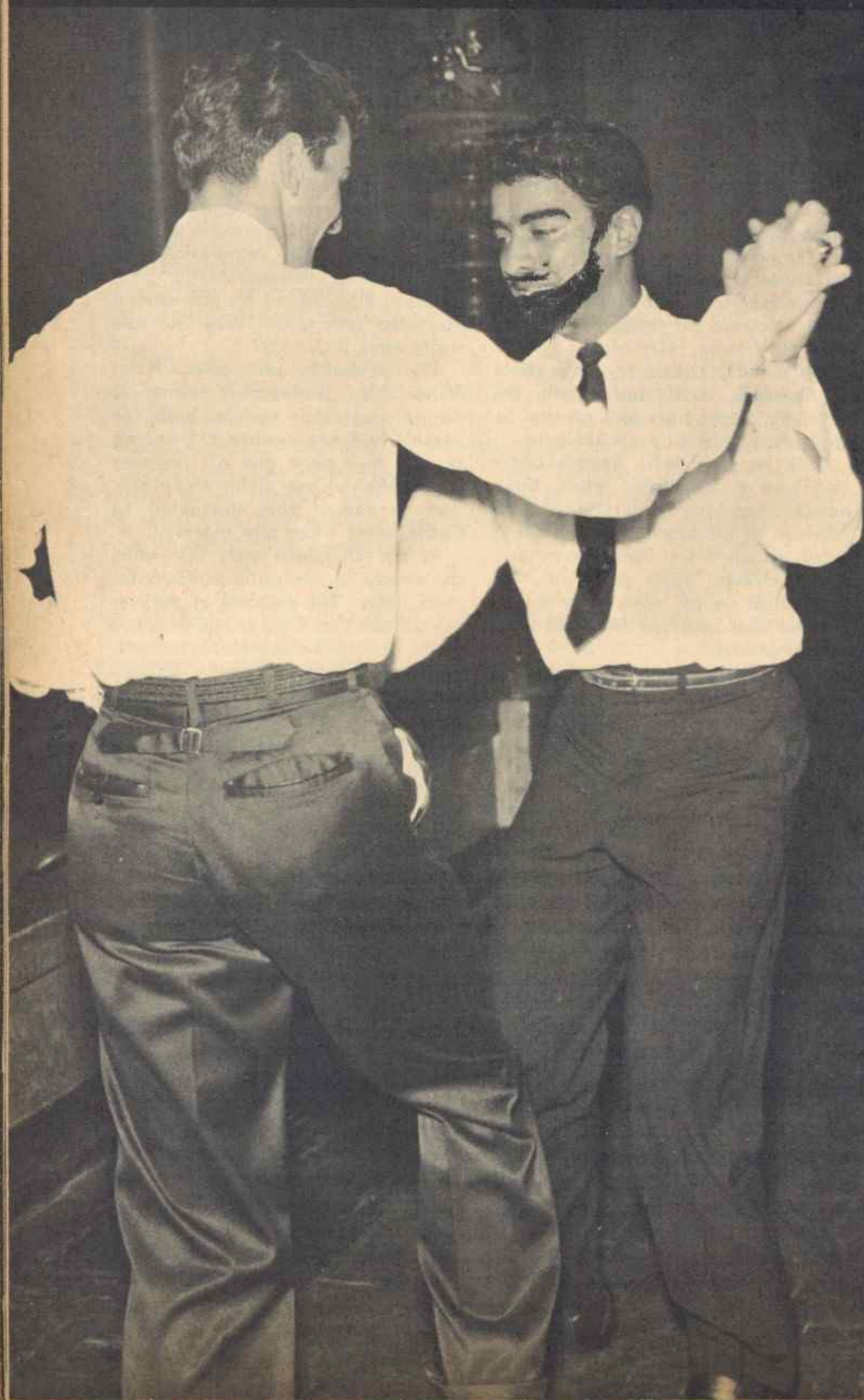

# MORALITY

**L**ORD Alfred Thompson Denning, the London judge who investigated sex and security aspects of the Christine Keeler scandal, found nothing wrong with British morals.

Of Christine, the auburn-haired callgirl who slept indiscriminately with men of all colors and social positions from Lords and Cabinet ministers to Negro pimps and dope pushers, Lord Denning said:

"Let no one judge her too harshly."

His views on England's *Dolce Vita* set were equally charitable.

They were set forth in a 50,000 word report that whitewashed Prime Minister Macmillan and his government. A bombshell that turned out to be a dud, the report rehashed the Keeler-Profumo case without naming any new names. But it did contain some spicy details.

For example, Lord Denning wrote:

"There is a group of people who hold parties in private of a perverted nature.

"At some of these parties, the man who serves dinner is nearly naked except for a small, square, lace apron around his waist such as a waitress might wear. He also wears a black mask with slits for eyeholes. He cannot therefore be recognized by any of the guests.

"Some reports stop there and say that nothing evil takes place . . . This may well be so at some of the parties.

"But at others I am satisfied that it is followed by perverted sex orgies, that the man in the mask is a 'slave' who is whipped, that the guests undress and indulge in sexual intercourse one with the others, and indulge in other sexual activities of a vile and revolting nature."

## Haw! His Lordship Saw No Evil There

Despite these revelations, Lord Denning concluded there "has been no lowering of moral standards among Britons in public life."

This is the **UNCENSORED** story the Denning report failed to tell.

Christine Keeler showed the world that England is not as sexless as it sometimes seems to be.

The Profumo Affair also prompted Britain to take a long, hard look at its own morality. What it saw was far from reassuring.

"Are We Going Sex Crazy?" thundered a banner headline in the *London Daily Herald*.

"Are Virgins Obsolete?" asked the conservative *New Statesman*. And the *Daily Express* devoted a full page to informing its readers: "How To Spot A Homo."

Even the British Broadcasting Corp. got into the act with sex-spiced programs that included a lecture in favor of premarital intercourse, a discussion of homosexuality, a play about an abortionist and other adult shows that kept Britons glued to their radio and TV sets.

Dr. Ernest Claxton, assistant secretary of the British Medical Association, announced that one in every six babies born in Britain is illegitimate. In London, he added, two of every three babies born to girls under 21 are conceived outside marriage.

This startling report was noted on the sexed-up TV show *This Was the Week That Was*. Crooned TWTWTW singer Millicent Martin:

Don't you weep my little baby  
Cause you haven't got a dad.  
Go to sleep, my little baby,  
Things aren't really quite so bad.  
There's no reason any longer

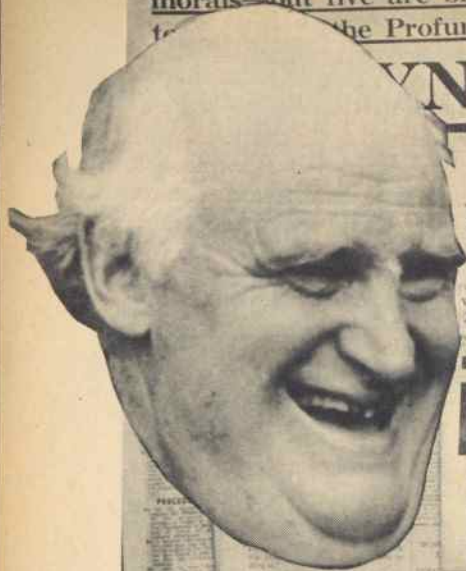

Why you ought to feel so blue.  
The World is full of bastards  
Just like you.

The Archbishop of Canterbury, writing in the *Sunday Times*, put it another way:

"Today there is in our society an immense outbreak of preoccupation with Venus. There is a dwelling upon sex: the sex problem, the adjustment of sex, instruction for sex, adventures of sex, stories of sex, what to do with sex, brighter and better sex."

His conclusion was that Britain is in the throes of a Sex Revolution. Other clergymen, doctors, newspaper editors and Government officials agree. A group of English Quakers even went so far as to condone premarital sex relations "where there is genuine tenderness..."

But nowhere in all the flood of stories, programs, sermons, lectures and statements on England's "new morality" did anyone mention the key word — **PERVERSION**.

The **UNCENSORED** story is that England's Sex Revolution is really a revolt against normal sex relations!

The percentage of homosexuals, sadists, masochists, exhibitionists and other sexual deviates in London today is higher than any other city in the world. Sex perversion not only is rotting Britain's moral fibers but also is undermining its national security — and consequently the security of England's Allies.

Britain's most shocking spy scandals — the Burgess-MacLean elopement and the William Vas-sall affair — both involved homosexual relations.

These cases were so sordid that the Profumo Affair at first looked like a return to normalcy. But the deeper investigators dug, the dirtier this one became.

It started out as a triangle romance in which Christine Keeler shared her bed with War Minister John Profumo and Capt. Evgeny Ivanov, a Soviet intelligence agent. Then it was disclosed that Christine's sponsor, society osteopath Stephen Ward, had asked her to pry defense secrets out of Profumo. Then Christine's bosom buddy, Mandy Rice-Davies, told of rolling in the hay with such distinguished clients as Lord Astor and American actor Douglas Fairbanks. Fairbanks denied it; Lord Astor didn't.

#### A Saga of Sex and Spies

Sensation piled on sensation in the saga of sex and spies. Then the story of orgies between play-boys and prostitutes branched off into dark, twisted tales of depravity.

Curvaceous Mandy described a bizarre party at which dinner was served by a man wearing only shoes, socks and a black mask. The nude waiter, Mandy said, wore the mask to cover one of the most famous faces in Britain.

Other girls said Stephen Ward had a two-way mirror installed in his bedroom door for use in "peak-aboo parties." From the bedroom, it looked like an ordinary mirror. But from the living room it was a window through which guests watched couples make love — normal and abnormal — in Ward's bed.

To these perversions — exhibitionism and voyeurism — was added still another, flagellation.

Fifty years ago, English psychologist Havelock Ellis (author of *Studies in the Psychology of Sex*) reported that sexual flagellation among British adults "is the most frequent of all perversions."

Testimony at Stephen Ward's vice trial proved that the situation hasn't changed.

A honey-blond Austrian girl, identified only as "Miss R." said Ward seduced her and later introduced her to "a woman named Marie Ella who gave very strange parties."

"He said they whipped girls and that Marie Ella whipped girls and so on," the witness continued. "I never went to one of Marie Ella's parties."

#### "Whip Me, Dearie, I Love It"

Weirdest tale of all was that told by Vickie Barrett, a convicted prostitute. She said Ward picked her up on the street one night and took her back to his apartment to have intercourse with a man who was waiting naked in the bedroom. She returned to the apartment about 30 times to entertain Ward's friends.

Many customers, "mostly middle-aged or elderly", wanted Vickie to whip them. So she stripped to her undies and high-heeled shoes and lashed them with a horsewhip or cane, conveniently provided by Ward.

The price for this service, Vickie testified, "was one pound (\$2.80) a stroke."

Though Vickie was a convicted streetwalker, the judge ruled she was not to be considered a prostitute except on occasions when she had normal sex relations for pay.

Sexual flagellation is not a crime in Britain, where upper-class children are often punished by whippings from their governesses, school teachers and headmasters. This childhood chastisement frequently becomes an adult luxury.

The high incidence of homosexuality can also be traced to the upbringing of the British male.

English boys from good homes go to all-male schools and all-male colleges. On graduation, they enter jobs reserved for young bachelors. They join clubs from which women are barred. For many upper-crust Englishmen, their first sexual experience is a homosexual one.

Centuries ago, the French began calling homosexuality "*le malaise Anglais*" — the English sickness. This description is even more suitable today.

The case of Guy Burgess and Donald MacLean provides an extreme example of what can happen when British boys get together.

Their backgrounds were remarkably similar. Both came from wealthy families; attended Eton and Cambridge University; joined the Foreign Service and became high-ranking diplomats. Their only basic

difference was their attitude towards women.

Burgess, a screaming swish, had nothing to do with the opposite sex. MacLean had normal sex relations as a young bachelor and later married an American girl, by whom he had three children.

Guy and Don became lovers while they were stationed at the British Embassy in Washington. They joined Washington's international fairyland and were on gay terms with several limp-wrist lads in the U.S. State Department.

Soviet agents quickly spotted their abnormal relationship. Through sex, cash and blackmail, the Russians turned them into valuable spies who obtained defense and diplomatic secrets of both Britain and the U.S.

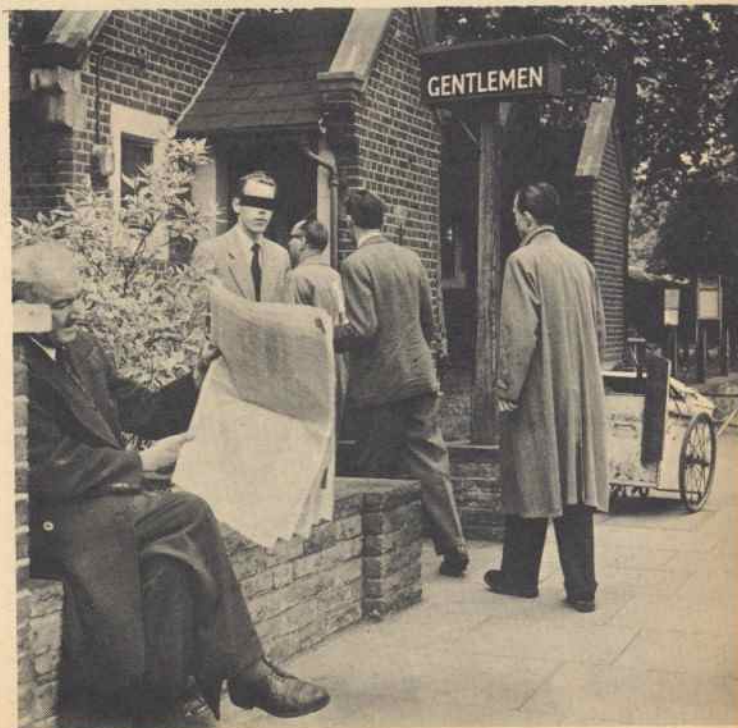
Their fey friendship was encouraged by Harold (Kim) Philby, an old boy friend of Burgess. While at Cambridge, Philby carried on simultaneous flirtations with Communism and homosexuality. He later joined M.I.6 — Britain's foreign intelligence service — and won the Order of the British Empire for his espionage work in World War II.

He transferred to the Foreign Service after the war and was sent to the British Embassy in Washington First Secretary and Chief Security. But the man responsible for weeding out spies and sex deviates was himself a Red agent and homo.

In 1951, as Scotland Yard and British Intelligence were closing in on Guy and Don, the two diplomats suddenly swished across the English Channel and vanished behind the Iron Curtain.

Their defection set off an explosion in Parliament. A Labor M.P. rose in the House of Commons and accused Philby of being the tipster who advised them to leave the country.

Harold Macmillan, then Foreign Secretary, cleared Philby of any suspicion of treason or of being "the so-called 'third man,' if indeed there was one."

Philby resigned from the Foreign Service, but refused to disavow his friendship with Burgess. Though by this time he was suspected of both Red and lavender coloring, no action was taken against him. He returned to newspapering, his original profession, and went to the Middle East as correspondent for the *Economist* and the *Observer*.

Burgess and MacLean, meanwhile, were living together in Moscow. They shared an apartment until MacLean's heavy boozing and Burgess' flirtations with other boys broke up their romance. Two years after they defected, MacLean was joined by his wife and children.

After Don returned to his family, Guy acquired a Russian boy friend — a handsome young ballet dancer. But the ravages of drink and sex perversion had begun to take their toll.

Last August 30, Burgess died of heart disease in a Moscow hospital. He was 52. At his bedside when

death came was one of his first lovers, Kim Philby.

Philby, 51, dropped out of sight last January in Beirut, Lebanon. Until then, he had maintained his contacts in the British Foreign Service. On the night of his disappearance, he was to have attended a dinner party in the Beirut home of a British Embassy official.

Instead, he went to Cairo and there boarded a jet for Moscow. Six months later, the Soviet press disclosed that he had been granted political asylum and Russian citizenship. Only then did the British Government admit he really was the "third man" in the Burgess-MacLean affair.

Philby's defection came on the heels of a sex-spy scandal involving still another diplomatic deviate, William Christopher Vassall.

Vassall's brother, Richard, had been convicted of molesting an 11-year-old boy. And Bill himself had all the earmarks of a simpering faggot. Yet the British Admiralty hired him and its security branch cleared him for foreign service and the handling of government secrets. He eventually became a trusted clerk in the Naval Attache's office at the British Embassy in Moscow.

Only one of his co-workers, a woman, guessed his shameful secret. She notified his superiors, but her suspicions were ignored.

His weakness was not ignored by the Russians, however. A Soviet agent, employed in the British Embassy as an interpreter, got chummy with Vassall and introduced him to fellow faggots. One night in 1955, Vassall attended a dinner party arranged by his new pal.

"I was plied with very strong brandy," Vassall later recalled, "and soon I found myself engaging in several compromising actions with two or three other men on a divan."

His homosexual horseplay was filmed by Soviet agents, who blackmailed him with the pictures. Before long, Vassall was a full-fledged spy. Sent back to London in 1956, he continued feeding British secrets to the Reds until he was arrested last year and sentenced to 18 years in prison.

"He was trapped by lust," said Attorney General Sir John Hobson at his trial, "and cash kept him a prisoner."

During the trial, it was disclosed that the Reds had an appropriate code name for Vassall. They called him "Miss Mary."

Less than six months after the Vassall scandal, England was shaken to its rock-ribbed foundations by the Profumo Affair with its overtones of sexual perversion. The shock waves from this sensational case obscured several less dramatic but equally sordid events.

For example, a prominent British official, Under Secretary Mortimer Bennitt of the Ministry of Works, was fined 25 pounds (\$70) for flirting with men in a public lavatory.

Police Constable Sidney Smith, on plainclothes duty near the lavatory, testified he watched Bennitt follow men into the washroom and saw him smile at them. When he smiled at Smith, he was arrested.

Around the same time, a high-ranking Navy officer resigned from the Admiralty staff after being bounced from his part-time post as assistant scoutmaster of a Middlesex Boy Scout troop.

A Labor Member of Parliament demanded to know why the officer was not court-martialed "following information which indicated unsatisfactory conduct in a youth organization."

M.P. Marcus Lipton accused the Admiralty of trying "to hush up an embarrassing situation."

In the Midlands town of Boston, police broke up a teenage vice ring and accused 40 men of participating in sex orgies with 18 schoolgirls, aged 13 to 15.

One girl of 14 admitted having intercourse with 10 young men, including several on the same night. She told police she and another girl, also 14, were competing for the highest sex score.

In a suburb of industrial Birmingham, several homeowners formed a "vigilance committee" to break up sex parties between local English girls

and West Indian Negroes. In London, as a result of the Christine Keeler revelations, Scotland Yard began cracking down on Negro vice racketeers who were luring teenage white girls into prostitution and teaching them all kinds of perversions.

And in Liverpool, three men pleaded guilty to performing perverted acts with a young girl from the time she was eight until she was 12. One of the men took photos of the child which came to the notice of Scotland Yard when they circulated in London.

In the midst of all these sex scandals, a senior official of Britain's Ministry of Education came out in favor of premarital sex relations — perhaps figuring it was better for boys to learn about girls than to experiment with other boys.

"Allowing for its crudities," declared writer V. S. Pritchett, "the sexual revolution has been one of the few blessings of this century."

Among those who disagreed was Dr. George Morrison Carstairs, professor of psychological medicine at Edinburgh University.

"The popular morality is now a wasteland," he said. "It is littered with the debris of broken convictions. A new concept is emerging of sexual relations as a source of pleasure, but also a mutual encountering of personalities in which each explores the other and at the same time discovers new depths in himself or herself."

No matter who wins the Great Sex Debate, one thing seems certain — Britons are discovering new depths of sexual depravity! (End)
