21.06 CASE GOES TO APPELLATE COURT IN JANUARY

THRF Seeking Individuals, Groups To File Friend of Court Briefs.

AUSTIN — The challenge to section 21.06 of the Texas Penal Code reaches the appellate level in January, when attorney Patrick Wiseman will present oral arguments against the state's anti-sodomy statute.

21.06 prohibits sexual relations between consenting adults of the same sex, effectively criminalizing homosexual conduct. The maximum potential punishment is a fine of \$500 as well as conviction of a crime involving moral turpitude.

The case against 21.06, *Morales et al. vs. the State of Texas*, is sponsored by the Texas Human Rights Foundation [THRF], which located the plaintiffs and has covered court costs and attorney fees. It was originally filed on April 12, 1989. The five co-plaintiffs are Tom Doyal, Charlotte Taft, John Thomas, Pat Cramer and Linda Morales, who is lead plaintiff.

The hearing in January will be the first opportunity THRF has had to present legal arguments for the abolition of 21.06 in a Texas Court of Appeals.

THRF Staff Litigator Pamela Oglesby explained that THRF is now preparing for the presentation of its case before the Court of Appeals, and is looking for individuals and groups who are willing to prepare and file "friend of the court" briefs supporting the argument that 21.06 should be declared unconstitutional. Individuals

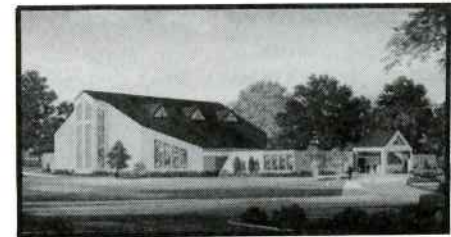
Section 21.06 was declared unconstitutional by District Judge Paul Davis on December 10, 1990. That ruling was appealed by Texas Attorney General Dan Morales earlier this year.

THRF Director of Development Suzy Wagers stressed the importance of winning the case against 21.06 at the appellate level. "Obtaining a trial court decision in our favor was a significant victory. However, we are seeking further legal resolution of this issue. An appellate court ruling would be binding through the entire state."

MCC DALLAS SEEKS \$800,000 FOR BUILDING FUND

At 11.5%, Church Bonds Will Pay Twice as Much as Interest Currently Being Offered at Banks.

DALLAS — The Metropolitan Community Church of Dallas began over 21 years ago when 12 people formed a group called "The Circle of Friends." It has evolved into what is today the largest church in the United States ministering primarily to gay and lesbian people.



In 1990, MCC Dallas' former facility on Reagan was sold to the Dallas Gay Alliance, and now houses the Gay and Lesbian Community Center. The church is cur-

rently in the process of building the Cathedral of Hope near the corner of Cedar Springs and Inwood.

To date, the church has raised \$1.2 million, enough to purchase the land and complete the design. A building permit has been issued by the city of Dallas and construction is set to begin.

The church is in need of an additional \$800,000 to complete the new facility, and rather than seek the money through donations, they have opted to ask the community for a "loan" by issuing 800 church bonds in denominations of \$1,000 each.

The bonds will pay 11.5% interest, which is twice the amount banks currently offer. The interest will be paid to the bondholder semiannually (every six months) and their entire investment will be returned to the purchaser when the bond matures.

The new church, the centerpiece of which will be a 57-foot-high cathedral, will be dedicated to the memory of all people who have died of AIDS. Bond purchasers are invited to designate the name of someone special to them to be engraved on a permanent bronze plaque.

The church bonds are both a compassionate and wise investment, not only because they will honor the memory of loved ones and help build the Cathedral of Hope, but because they are a savvy business investment in the gay community. For more information, contact John Lochner at (214) 526-6221.

SECOND 'LIVING TRIBUTE' TREE PLANTED IN LEE PARK

Replaces Tree Which Mysteriously Disappeared From Nursery.

DALLAS — In 1988, Alan Ross appeared before the Dallas Parks and Recreation Board [DPRB] and requested permission to furnish and plant a tree and make other improvements in Lee Park to honor Dallas' AIDS community. The tribute was to be funded by contributions made through the Dallas Tavern Guild. The original tree, a 20-foot deodar cedar, was planted in January of 1990 at a site just east of Arlington Hall in Lee Park.

Several months later, Ross appeared before DPRB seeking approval for the

wording on a plaque that was to be part of the memorial. The plaque was first conceived to include the words "gay," "lesbian" and "AIDS."

Through numerous appearances before the DPRB, Ross eventually came to a compromise that eliminated "gay" and "lesbian" from the wording on the plaque, but allowed for the use of the word, "AIDS." Final approval for the compromise plaque came in June of this year.

During this period, the original tree died. Fortunately, it was guaranteed. Ross then contacted Lambert's Nursery about a replacement tree and ordered it.

The replacement tree arrived and was kept at the nursery, awaiting planting in the fall. At the end of October, Ross contacted the nursery to make final arrangements for the planting, and was informed that the tree was not there. When he asked why, they told him that "some women from the Dallas Tavern Guild had told them they 'did not approve of the tree' and that it could be sold to someone else." Obviously, no such visit by representatives of the Tavern Guild had ever taken place, and Ross was never informed. He found out about it only when he went to the nursery.

When he appeared in front of the DPRB, they were "sympathetic and expressed shock over the situation," Ross told TWT NEWS. He said he believes that the incident was initiated by the Dallas Southern Memorial Association, but has no proof. "The Dallas Southern Memorial Association wields a great deal of influence over the Dallas Parks and Recreation Board, primarily because Lee Park honors Confederate General Robert E. Lee," Ross said.

"It seems to me like more than just a coincidence that the day after I appeared before the Dallas Parks and Recreation Board, representatives of the D.S.M.A. contacted the Parks Department, claiming that members of the gay community had 'poisoned two trees in the park' near the statue of Robert E. Lee," Ross said.

After being advised by Lambert's that another species of tree might flourish better in the Dallas climate, Ross opted for a 15-foot Elderica pine, the same type of tree being planted at Dallas City Hall. The new tree was planted on Friday, December 6.

Dedication of the plaque, originally scheduled to coincide with Dallas' observance of World AIDS Day on December 1, has been rescheduled for March 15.

"By then, 2,400 daffodils will be blooming. They were planted to represent the 2,400 people who have lost the battle with AIDS in Dallas," Ross concluded.

LONE STAR BAND TO ELECT OFFICERS

*Self-Nominations Being Accepted
For Board Positions.*

HOUSTON — The Lone Star Symphonic Band will be electing officers for its 1992 Board of Directors at its annual meeting on Monday, January 14, at 7:30 p.m. at the Metropolitan Community Church of the Resurrection, 1919 Decatur.

The board oversees the progress of the band and promotes community involvement and goodwill. The band is actively recruiting nonmusicians (including women) and individuals who have not previously been associated with the band, and self-nominations are now being accepted. No prior board experience is necessary, but previous community involvement is desirable. The board meets once monthly, and holds a out-of-town

retreat weekend each summer.

The Lone Star Symphonic Band is recruiting musicians, regardless of degree of expertise, to join them every Monday night (resuming January 21) in rehearsal at MCCR.

Among activities the band has planned for the coming months are marching in the Mardi Gras parade in Galveston with the Krewe of Regina on March 1, a concert to benefit MCCR in March, the annual Pride Week Concert and an old-time concert for the Heights Festival next summer.

The Lone Star Symphonic Band is a member band of Lesbian and Gay Bands of America and will join the organization in Washington D.C. for the 1993 March on Washington, and in New York City in 1994 for Gay Games IV.

AUSTIN'S OCTOPUS CLUB RAISES \$44,886 FOR PAUL KIRBY FUND

*"Fun"-Raisers Help Area PWAs
With Emergency Financial Needs.*

AUSTIN — High above the lights of Austin, on top of the Westgate Building, 1991 Octopus Club hosts and hostesses gathered recently for a champagne toast to celebrate the conclusion of the charity group's hugely successful third season.

The Octopus Club is made up of concerned people who want to help others and have fun doing it. Members throw a series of "fun"-raising parties each year, and the money donated by guests goes exclusively to AIDS Services of Austin's Paul Kirby Fund, which helps meet the emergency financial needs of people with AIDS.

The type of party thrown is up to those organizing it, and thus members have a chance to use their creativity and initiative to raise the money in their own style. Fund-raisers have ranged from elegant dinners, art events and keg parties to auctions, sport events and dances. The smallest party raised \$56 and the largest brought in \$6,265.

In its first year, The Octopus Club raised about \$10,000 for PWAs, last year the group brought in \$28,000 and this year has

HARRIS COUNTY AIDS CASES TO SKYROCKET

Hospital District Report Says Spending on Disease May Jump to \$104 Million in 1995.

HOUSTON — A report issued recently by the Harris County Hospital District estimates that the district will see a threefold increase in AIDS patients by the year 1995. The number of patients testing HIV-positive is expected to increase even more.

According to the report, the number of patients with AIDS will rise from 1,731 to 5,124, and the number of those who are HIV-positive will increase from 3,118 to 16,017.

The report also estimated that the hospital district may have to increase its spending on AIDS to as much as \$104 million by 1995. It is estimated that the district will spend \$19 million on HIV and AIDS this year.

Approximately 40% of the district's patients are black, 14.2% are Hispanic and .2% are Asian-American, meaning that over half of all patients are members of minority groups.

TEXAS GAY REPUBLICANS GEARING UP FOR PRIMARIES

Membership Drive Part Of Effort to Counter Anti-Gay Forces in Party.

AUSTIN — The Log Cabin Club of Texas, a political organization dedicated to advancing gay and lesbian causes within the framework of the Republican Party, has launched a statewide membership drive as part of efforts to counter anti-gay elements within the party.

The Log Cabin club of Austin was part of a coalition of Republican groups that helped to remove the anti-gay language from the Travis County Republican Party platform in 1990. Several members have been elected precinct chairs, and Log Cabin members have been officers of the Austin Lesbian/Gay Political Caucus.

The first Log Cabin club was formed in California in the late 1970s to express Republican opposition to the Briggs Initiative, a statewide ballot petition seeking to ban openly gay people from teaching in public schools.

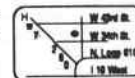

Don't Throw Away Respect

Dear TWT:

The other day, I had the misfortune of witnessing a terrible thing within our community: hate. Here's the story.

I was out with a friend for a night of dancing and bar-hopping. On the way to one of the bars, we came across what looked to be a mob, centered around a clean-cut young man with a Bible. No big deal, nothing new.

As we waited for the light to change for a chance to cross the street, it occurred to me that the mob was being very vocal with the young man.

Some of them called him "faggot" and "queer" and one of them, I remember, said, "You're just here because you wanna get fucked up the ass."

The leader of the mob was a loud-mouthed young man, and I'm using the term "man" loosely. He flung his hair around and snapped his fingers like a cheap drag queen doing insult comedy. His only pause was one to accept the approval of his audience. The one line of his dialogue that I still remember was, "You ignorant fucking bitch! Wake up and smell the coffee."

Personally, I was shocked and for a brief moment, I was ashamed to be gay. I was ashamed because I had made a vow to stand up in defense of anyone who was being victimized by such ignorance, but I never thought that the first time I came across the scene, the ignorance would be the product of a group of vicious, foul-mouthed gay men.

Isn't this type of behavior exactly what gay men and women have been fighting against for centuries? How could this happen? The man didn't have a gun or bat, nor was he using profanity. He didn't take a menacing stance and he didn't change his point of view. If anything, I suspect that his views of homosexuals now include the words "vicious" and "degenerate." Check the true meanings in the dictionary.

I guess that my message is this. Many lives have been lost trying to earn the pitiful amount of respect we have in this world. Hell, if nothing more, we have some of that respect in 2½ blocks out of the tens of thousands in Dallas. And even that is questionable. Please don't make it worse.

On a more personal note, what made me really angry was what I saw the next morning on the way to the store. There he was, the obnoxious leader of the mob, waiting for the bus, wearing the same clothes and raccoon coat from the night before. He doesn't even live in our community.

To him I ask: Do you feel that you made a contribution to better the lives of gay men and women? I don't think so.

To the rest of you, a message. As gay Americans, we must not lower ourselves to the level of those who would harm us, physically or verbally. Be firm, use the right forum for your views and above all, don't take away what little respect we have in this world.

GLAAD Tidings

The official unemployment records read, "This employee is being terminated due to a violation of company policy. This employee is gay." And now a respected network news program has reported the injustice.

Earlier this year, the corporate headquarters of Cracker Barrel, a chain of over a hundred restaurants throughout the South, issued a directive instructing its managers to fire any employee on the spot "whose sexual preferences fail to demonstrate normal heterosexual values."

And the managers did just that. Loyal, highly competent workers were asked if they were gay and immediately fired if the answer was yes based even on the appearance of being gay. Local gay communities and chapters of the direct-action group Queer Nation called for a boycott and picket lines at Cracker Barrel restaurants.

On November 29, ABC's *20/20* did a story on the situation, called "Whom Do You Sleep With?" The segment gave the facts as outlined above. By basing their report on the stories of three gay people who were fired, *20/20* gave those affected a voice, and raised awareness of the extent to which lesbians and gay men face discrimination on the job.

Reporter Tom Jarriel talked with Cheryl Sommerville, a fired cook, and Sandy, who was introduced as her companion and sexual partner of ten years. The couple were shown not only on the picket line, but also at home doing family things: washing the dishes, playing with their puppies.

The report stressed the point that when Cheryl was asked by her boss, "Are you a lesbian?" she was, in effect, being asked to choose between her job and her lover, and that by affirming that she is a lesbian she made the moral choice. Sommerville described the Queer Nation pickets as nonviolent, "like Gandhi and Martin Luther King."

Sam Hare, one of the gay men who was fired, gave Jarriel a good answer to his question about sexual orientation: "Why would I choose to be in such a minority where people are going to discriminate against me? ... Do you have a choice about being heterosexual?"

The segment itself was an education for non-gay people, including, apparently, the reporter himself. Jarriel's commentary included the following: "Surprisingly, firing people solely because they're homosexual is not illegal. Only four states have laws banning the practice. Sexual preference is not covered by federal civil rights laws."

"AIDS after all was a disease of inner-city junkies and gay fashion designers, weirdos who live on the fringed edge of society, and people leading more bizarre lifestyles than the nice, upstanding group I call my friends."

These bigoted words are from a column by Valerie Tamis in the *Ridgewood* (New Jersey) *News*. She was musing over the fact that, now that Magic Johnson has tested HIV-positive, AIDS is a concern for people in the suburbs, too; and not just for the "rag-tag, sorry-looking crowd" that she saw at the ACT UP demo at President Bush's summer home. "Sadly," she added, "everyone now does know someone with AIDS."

Tamis' column, aptly titled "Wandering," is yet another example of the media's widespread differentiation between "nice, upstanding" people and "weirdos on the fringe" when it comes to AIDS/HIV, though most examples are not this simplistic. Austin and at Louisiana State University in Shreveport.

"I would like to return to teaching in the future," says Chris, "particularly if I am able to pursue a doctorate degree in psychology. Right now I am enjoying living and working in Austin."

Although he enjoys dancing and socializing in the clubs, Chris is a non-drinker and encourages moderation in others, particularly during the holidays. "Abusing alcohol and other drugs can lead to tragic consequences, from accidents on the road to

unsafe sex. Have fun but don't lose your judgment. Be careful."

As for his holiday plans, Chris plans to visit his parents in Aspen, Colorado and hit the slopes.

"I'm going to Aspen for Gay Ski Week, which should be a blast. I hope everyone in Texas has a wonderful, peaceful Christmas and New Year's."

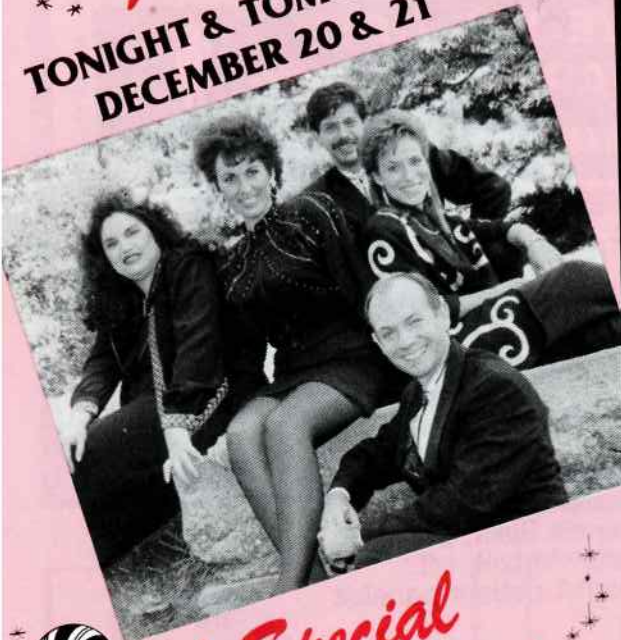

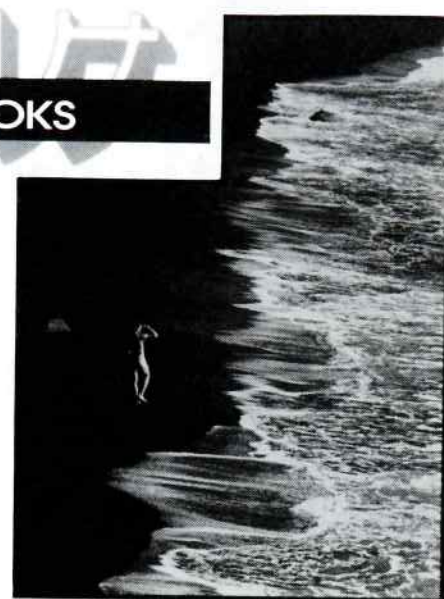
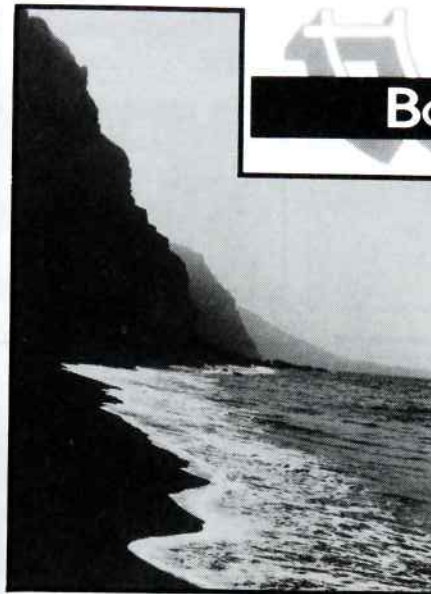

VULCANO

Vulcano by Alan Bonicatti; Amethyst Press, No. 102, 70-A Greenwich Avenue, New York, NY 10011-8307; \$32.50; softbound cover.

Even if you have almost finished your holiday gift shopping, there is something else you want for the man-lover in your life (or in your heart!). It is *Vulcano*.

There is an island aggressively thrusting itself above the cobalt waves of the Atlantic Ocean. Giant slabs of lava cantilevered against the sky. Primeval vegetation crawling over the arid landscape, a palm shrouded in the mist. This is *Vulcano*.

This is powerfully sensuous male imagery. This is black and white photography that explores the archetypal theme of man's struggle with nature, his solitude, his expression of sexuality and search for spirituality.

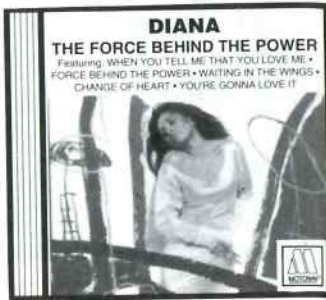
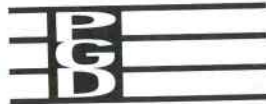
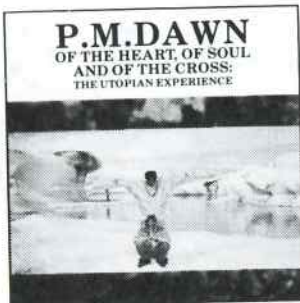
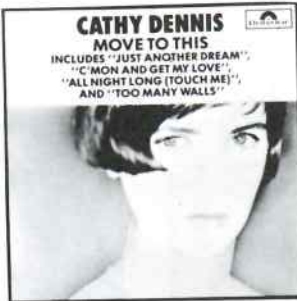
Photographer Alan Bonicatti resisted the Canary Islands until his resolve was broken by the tempting photograph of

another artist. Then, in one two-week trip, he, an assistant and his model explored and recorded El Hierro and the landscape they found to be "between lunar and alpine," the Scottish-looking pastures, Swiss-looking forests and African-looking hills.

Five centuries ago, this island was the most Western point of the known world. When Columbus sailed past it, it was still called Valverde, or Green Valley. On his return trip, he found it devastated by a volcanic eruption, and he renamed it El Hierro, or The Iron.

In Bonicatti's vision, the island has regained some of its verdure, but its soul remains volcanic. His photographs reveal the sense of supernatural struggle between shifting light and shadow, the naked male against the unyielding earth, man and nature, sex and image, spirituality.

The conclusion of the artist is that man's greatest strength is his fragility. This is the paradox of *Vulcano*.
