



# TOP NEWS STORIES OF 1991

In this last edition of TWT NEWS for the old year, our editorial staff, following tradition, has taken its annual look back into the 91st year of this century.

On the following pages are the top ten news stories of 1991 — a chronicle of the year's most important news developments from the perspective of the gay and lesbian community of Texas. These stories were selected on the basis of how they related to issues of greatest concern to gay and lesbian people in Texas.

TWT NEWS wishes a Happy New Year to all of our readers across the state of Texas.

#### HATE CRIMES ON THE RISE IN TEXAS

The obvious choice as the Top Story of 1991 has to be, regrettably, the rise in antigay hate crimes against members of our community as evidenced by its appearance in nine issues of TWT during the past 12 months. Beginning with the July 4 issue, and running frequently through the end of the year, the horror of murder and physical injury inflicted on our community by individuals opposed to our very existence continued to garner NEWS headlines.

Reports of this increased violence broke, initially, in our capital city of Austin where four men were attacked in separate incidents by a total of 38 men. In the first incident, two men were victimized at the corner of Fourth and Colorado, where as many as eight men attacked the pair using broken beer bottles—directly across the street from Austin police.

The second attack took place at the corner of Third and Lavaca where two men, both masculine in appearance, were set upon by up to 30 men yelling racial and anti-gay epithets.

Both incidents, which occurred between March and May of this year, served as the catalyst for the formation of The Austin Gay/Lesbian Antiviolence Coalition, chaired by Stewart Gallas. The Coalition, at the outset, was working to open a dialogue with the City Manager's Office, the City Council and the Austin Police Department to help find solutions to the unprecedented rise in violence against Austin's gay community.

July found Houstonians reeling from the effects of the senseless attack upon three members of the Bayou City's gay community. In this incident, the young men were walking to their cars after leaving a Montrose area nightclub when they were jumped by two carloads of 10 adolescents after they verbally acknowledged knowing the location of a well-known area club. Using two-by-fours studded with nails, the accused assailants pursued all three men, ultimately killing banker Paul Broussard.

The incident triggered a backlash from Houston's Montrose area, where over 1,000 gay and heterosexual residents marched through neighborhood streets picketing, chanting and slowing traffic.

Houston leaders were quick to respond by issuing calls for stronger hate crimes legislation in Austin, as well as by implementing increased undercover police programs in Montrose in an effort to curb the violence before it occurs. And, while the state government was slow to act, Houston plainclothes officers learned, first-hand, the extent to which members of the gay community have been victimized as they, too, were attacked by individuals who assumed that they were gay. The undercover operation, dubbed "Vice Versa" and thought to be the first of its kind, made national headlines and focused media attention on the many facets of hate crimes nationwide.

In spite of increased efforts by both community and elected officials to stem the growth of this outrage, two more gay men fell victim to acts of violence born of bigotry and ignorance. In Houston, Phillip W. Smith was shot to death in an aborted robbery attempt, simply because he smiled at his attacker. Meanwhile, in Dallas, two men were attacked in Reverchon Park while quietly eating a meal. They were severely beaten while their assailants finished the meal they had started. Thanh died while his lover, Hugh Calloway, was hospitalized with complications resulting from his injuries.

Thus far, no convictions have been made in any of the cases, and state law requires *only* that hate crimes be

documented.

# STATEWIDE "WALKS" HELP FUND AIDS SERVICE ORGANIZATIONS

While hate crimes challenged Texas gays, the state's citizenry continued to face obstacles to their very existence with the unrelenting onslaught of AIDS on its victims. But, armed with a sense of spirit and resolve that seems inherent in our community, gays, lesbians and heterosexuals literally "walked a mile"—and ofttimes more—to help find a cure for this dreaded disease.



Beginning on October 6, Dallas' Oak Lawn Community Services (OLCS) Life-Walk, with close to 1,000 participants, raised in excess of \$80,000 and, because of corporate sponsorship which resulted in no expense to OLCS, was able to direct all of the proceeds to AIDS-related services at the Center.

Two weeks later, on October 20, Austin held its fourth annual, and most successful, effort, "From All Walks of Life," sponsored by AIDS Services of Austin (ASA). Capital city tallies listed over 3,500 participants and over \$163,000 in proceeds which were additionally distributed, through ASA, to ALLGO (Informe SIDA), Austin Immune Health Clinic, the C.A.R.E. Unit and the Waterloo Counseling Center, among others.

And, finally, on November 3, Houston staged its third annual "From All Walks of Life" benefiting AIDS Foundation-Houston. The event virtually doubled 1990's totals with over \$80,000 in receipts.


The three city's totals, in addition to funds raised by San Antonio's first-ever walk, raised over \$320,000 in the fight against AIDS.

# DALLAS CITY COUNCIL VOTES FOR ZONING CHANGES

In yet another obstacle to the gay community's quest for life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness, Dallas City Council approved zoning changes, known as the "Oak Lawn Plan," which will fall on dance club owners who will be required to provide more parking space for their patrons.



Although the ordinance includes 37 other points, such as noise reduction and landscaping, the main thrust will require dance club owners to provide one addi-



tional parking slot for every 25 square feet of dance floor space. Previously, the requirement was for one parking space per 100 square feet of floor space.

In addition, bar owners will now be required to re-apply every two years for a special use permit to remain in business. The bar owners vehemently objected to this provision, claiming that they would be under the continual threat that their businesses could be closed at the whim of a hostile city council.

Heightening the tensions was the perceived abandonment of Oak Lawn representative Lori Palmer's constituency by Ms. Palmer, who, prior to this incident had unanimous support from Oak Lawn business owners and residents alike. Ms. Palmer supported the Oak Lawn Plan.

The controversy becomes more problematic as other cities across Texas began preliminary exploration of similar restrictions affecting entertainment-oriented businesses in general and gay bars specifically.

#### RICHARDS TAKES OATH OF OFFICE

At 12:14 p.m. on Tuesday, January 15, Dorothy Ann Willis Richards moved to the podium at the South Capitol Entrance in Austin to be administered the Oath of Office, thus becoming the 45th Governor of Texas, and the first woman to hold the office since Ma Ferguson's term almost 60 years ago.

In an event witnessed by the official representatives of 35 countries and the governors of four Mexican states, the oath brought to a close 18 months of often bitter politicking in one of the most controversial election campaigns seen in Texas.

In remarks which outlined her plans for the next four years. Governor Richards declared:

"Today, we have the vision of a Texas where opportunity knows no race or color or gender-a glimpse of the possibilities that can be when the barriers fall and the doors of government swing open. Today, we have the vision of a Texas with clean air and land and water...a Texas where a strong economy lives in harmony with a safe environment. Today we have a vision of a Texas where every child receives an education that allows them to claim the full promise of their lives. Today. business is nurtured and valued ... where



good jobs are plentiful...where those in need find compassion and help...where every decision is measured against a high standard of ethics and true commitment to the public trust.

"Tomorrow, we must build that Texas." Hoping that "that Texas" is to be one for all Texans, Lone Star gays were conspicuous in their presence at all five inaugural galas, and at the People's March on the Capital Building.

#### GLEN MAXEY WINS STATE HOUSE RUNOFF

The fifth biggest news story in Texas was out of Austin where Glen Maxey, chief lobbyist for the Lesbian-Gay Rights Lobby of Texas (LGRL), won the runoff in the Texas House District 51 race. His victory makes him the first openly gay official in the history of the state of Texas.



Maxey received 3,034 votes, or 54 percent, to 2,576 votes, or 45.9 percent, for his opponent, lawyer David Rodriguez, to fill



the seat vacated by Lena Guerrero. Maxey appeared to have won most of the precincts with the heaviest turnouts.

Although the fact that Maxey is gay never became a campaign issue, the last few days of the race did take a nasty tinge as the two candidates traded charges and countercharges concerning tax records and residency requirements.

The 51st District has traditionally been represented by a Hispanic politician, but after some of Rodriguez' problems came to light, even some Hispanic community leaders began urging voters to choose Maxey.

# HOUSTON POST FIRES JUAN PALOMO

Juan Palomo, the metro columnist for the *Houston Post* who caused a sensation when he revealed that he was gay, was dismissed from his job. The event was seen by some to be a severe expression of anti-gay sentiment and a direct violation of First Amendment protection by the *Post*'s editors.



Post officials insist that Palomo's dismissal had nothing to do with his homosexuality, despite the fact that Palomo's disclosure that he was gay was censored from a column he had written denouncing Houston banker Paul Broussard's murder.

The news of Palomo's firing brought a swift reaction from many in the community. The Houston tribe of the national gay and lesbian group Queer Nation staged a demonstration the same day in front of the high-rise condominium residence of Charles Cooper, Post senior vice-president and editor. In addition, Post reporters began circulating a petition asking that Palomo be reinstated. Officials at the

newspaper indicated they would consider talking to Palomo.

(Palomo has since been reinstated at the *Post*, but his column now appears on the Editorial page.)

#### QUEER NATION COMES TO TEXAS



Queer Nation, a gay activist group with chapters, or "tribes," across the nation, is organized in Austin, Dallas and Houston this year.

Queer Nation is a group of people helping to sensitize the heterosexual community about homosexuals. They deal with homophobia and gay and lesbian rights, as well as the AIDS issue.

The focus of their efforts, thus far, have been to introduce Queer Nation and individuals to the dominant culture and media with as many provocative local events, protests and invisibilities as they can possibly arrange.

In addition, the tribes have attempted to explore ways to support the legislative agenda of the Lesbian/Gay Rights Lobby during the 1991 legislative session. And, the group has explored "direct action" ideas used elsewhere in the country, such as kiss-ins at various county clerks' offices and heterosexual clubs, and outreach efforts to homophobic churches.

#### TEXAS ATTORNEY GENERAL APPEALS 21.06 RULING

As many observers had expected, Texas Attorney General Dan Morales appealed State District Judge Paul Davis' decision in the case of Morales, et al v. State of Have An Affair to Remember!

Texas in the matter of Section 21.06 of the Texas Penal Code.

Section 21.06, the state's sodomy law, makes it a Class C misdemeanor for consenting adults of the same sex to have what is referred to as "deviant sexual inter-

course." In his decision, Judge Davis declared the law unconstitutional from the bench. His written order blocked the state "from arresting, prosecuting or otherwise enforcing" Section 21.06.

In his motion for appeal, Morales said, "Our obligation is to defend the laws of the state when they are challenged. Our goal

is to seek a determination once and for all on the constitutionality of this particular law." The Texas Human Rights Foundation (THRF), which is paying all court costs and attorneys' fees, filed the original challenge to the law in 1989.

THRF's Legal Coordinator Margaret Tucker said, "We welcome this appeal, An appellate court victory would clearly establish a statewide precedent on the unconstitutionality of Section 21.06. The upcoming appellate court battle is crucial in insuring equal rights for gay and lesbians in this state."

#### TEXAS GAYS MARCH ON AUSTIN FOR EQUAL RIGHTS

While 30,000 might have appeared to be a hefty number to beat, that was the exact number organizers of the second March on Austin hoped to top as they urged the state's gay community to show their pride by coming forth in record numbers to demand equal rights and protection under the law.

With an agenda that included demands for new laws protecting gays and lesbians — as well as persons living with HIV, ARC and AIDS — recognition of gay unions and passage and enforcement of hate crimes legislation, the March on Austin Executive Committee hoped that, through unified participation, the community could make their views on issues of importance to the gay and lesbian population known, both on the state level and nationwide.


Some announced events included a showing of the NAMES Project Quilt, a gala banquet reception and concerts and plays presented by local and national talent. In addition, presentations by Urvashi Vaid, Executive Director of the National Lesbian/Gay Task Force, and Larry Lingle, President of the Houston Gay and Lesbian Political Caucus, highlighted the march to the capital.

#### TEXANS CELEBRATE GAY PRIDE

Celebrations of gay pride round out TWT's Top Ten news stories, as festivities across the state showed the world, and ourselves, who we really are.

Dallas led the way, with traditional Razzle Dazzle Dallas events, plus the addition of Gay Day at Six Flags and the Maple Avenue Carnival. In Ft. Worth, Austin and San Antonio, parades, carnivals and picnics were the norm, with special new features including chorale concerts and art exhibits. And finally, in Houston, festivities began with the Pride Awards banquet and culminated with that city's "Feel the Music" parade and Star Nite '91 after a week of concerts and theatrical performances.

All in all, Texans illustrated just how great gay pride still is, some 22 years after Stonewall, the birth of the gay rights movement.

Do we not hurt the same as you when we lose the one love of our life?


We are not something that you can love for a while and then throw us away as if we never cared.


Yes, we are human and our needs are true, because all we want is to be the same as you.

### **NEW YEAR'S EVE** THROUGH THE YEARS THIS WEEK IN TEXAS


DECEMBER 31, 1976: Food and Fun became the order of the day, as clubs across the state offered a traditional fare of cocktails and party favors, with the addition of blackeyed pea and cornbread buffets at midnight, such as that offered by the Misty Blue Club in Odessa, and champagne breakfasts like that served at the Old Plantations in Dallas and Houston. And drag at the Depository II in Houston with Jerry Vanover, Tiffany Jones, Eartha Kitt and Donna Day.

DECEMBER 31, 1977: More of the same, but the addition of gorgeous cover boy, Kendall, offering a celebration of a different sort....

**DECEMBER 31, 1978:** Cover charges got bigger, but then so did the promises and allusions to more bang for the buck offered by a plethora of clubs across the state. From the "Lots of Surprises" at Arlington's Mad Hatter and Inside/Outside to the "Special" Surprise at The Barn in Houston to the "Surprise" guests at Dimension Three in Dallas and Ram Rod Tavern in Houston, it was no surprise that Texasexuals were surprised.

DECEMBER 31, 1979: Balloon drops and drag with only one bar, Sunset Boulevard in San Antonio, offering both. More importantly, the highlight of the Boulevard gala was "a surprise expected return to the stage of Miss Jahonau Reis (in) her final performance with male organ.'

DECEMBER 31, 1980: Theme parties, such as "Old Year's End" at Babylon in Houston, proved to be de rigueur. In addition, "Breakout '81" at Alcatraz in Dallas, "Armageddon" at The Different Drum in Houston and "Country Caravan" at Red River Crossing in Austin all proved to be the places to be as Texasexuals entered the new decade.



DECEMBER 31, 1981: My, how things have changed in ten years...The OP in Houston presented "The Show of the Year" as Tiffany Jones, Big David, Jerry Vanover and Kitty Keye "remembered the Red Room with old hairdos, old songsold queens!" The Conference Room in Dallas presented C&W songstress Dena Kave. Private Cellar in Austin held a Hero and Outlaw Contest. The Other Place in Fort Worth presented a special show starring, among others, the late Raina Lea and Bette Sheba. Zodiac in Corpus Christi offered to "let you escape for the New Year's weekend." The Copa in Beaumont presented the Mr. and Miss New Year's Eve contests with "cash prizes to the winners of all three categories." Ernestine headlined at Astraptes in College Station and Sunset Boulevard, "the Showbar of the South," presented Donna Day, Pauletta Leigh, Sabrina Ross, Naomi Sims plus the newly crowned Miss Gay Dallas Tasha Kohl and "Miss Gay Rest Area Emeritus" Alice Phallus in a "Gayla Salute to Broadway."

DECEMBER 31, 1982: TWT NEWS lamented over the verdict and appeal of the 21.06 case and reported on the first five deaths in Texas attributed to AIDS. Tootsie was the gayest picture of the year, but showbiz's Jack Varsi awarded his Best "Actress" award to John Lithgow for his role in The World According to Garp. Varsi named Mel Gibson "Sexiest Hunk of 1982," but had a tie for "Biggest Tits in the Movies" between Dolly Best Little Whorehouse Parton and Arnold Conan the Barbarian Schwarzenegger.

DECEMBER 31, 1983: Individual clubs added more and more "traditions" to their lineup of party events, including The Copa's every-hour cash drawings in Houston, the first-ever Masquerade Ball at Faces in San Antonio, and the Ms. Thang Awards at The OP in Dallas. But the biggest addition to the lineup of holiday diversions was live performances by disco artists such as Taka Boom at Rich's in Houston and Jayne Edwards at The Ritz in Galveston.


DECEMBER 31, 1984: JR's Dallas' annual Black Tie Affair was the place to be, while the Round-Up offered a C&W Hoedown. Freda Payne appeared at Studio 4 and Patrick's welcomed "another class act," Bentley's Restaurant, to Dallas. Rascal's in Houston presented Samantha Samuels while across town, BRB kicked

off the year with singer David Houston. Miss Charlotte's presented Mundo Earwood and the Copa featured Jimmy James in concert. Sir Bud's in Fort Worth hosted "Odyssey: A Journey into a New Year." Cahoots in San Antonio welcomed patrons to their 1st (and last) annual Red and White Ball. In San Antonio, the Mustang Band helped ring in the new year at Snuffy's.

DECEMBER 31, 1985: Picture this: the culmination of ten years of New Year's Eves...You dress up in a costume (or in drag), go to your favorite club for their theme party, pay a huge cover charge and get all sorts of party favors and "surprises." Then, at midnight, you watch a drag show on one stage and a live performance by a disco artist on another, and are hit in the head with a barrage of dropping balloons as you eat blackeyed peas and combread while waiting for the drawing for your free trip to Cancun where you can spend the money you just won in an hourly cash drawing. And, in case you were still hungry, a champagne buffet at 4 a.m. Tradition. That's basically what Texas clubs were offering. Tradition.

DECEMBER 31, 1986: Oh, what AIDS hath wrought. Where the magazine's ads once beckoned fun-loving gays to hours of decadence and non-stop partying, more and more clubs offered alternatives, such as a quiet evening around the piano at John L's Entertainment Extravaganza in

Dallas, or the dancer stage at JR's in Houston. Even more indicative of the change was the sight of a scantily-clad phoneline Santa offering the safe-sex alternative to a midnight dance-floor coupling.

DECEMBER 31, 1987: The Eagle Nest in Dallas had Butchella throwing her recovery beer bust. The Brazos River Band performed at-where else?-the BRB in Houston, Dallas' AIDS Resource Center. OLCC and PWA Coalition hosted "Back to the Future," a huge disco and laser light extravaganza. La Cage Bookshop in Dallas had a lunch hour rental special: You could rent movies for 75¢ each. Chapultepec in Houston offered complimentary holiday breakfasts. In San Antonio, Paper Moon's New Year's Eve Party included a costume contest. The No. 1 video was Fascinated by Company B. In Austin, progressive dance club Westend invited you to experience "another piece of progressive culture during Westend's phenomenal 56-hour New Year's Party."

DECEMBER 31, 1988: New Year's Jockey Shorts contests, such as the one at Across the Street in Fort Worth, Dallas' own version of Times Square at JR's and the Village Station...and even *more* of that other stuff.

DECEMBER 31, 1989: Gay 90's parties. This was, after all, the last New Year's of the decade. Oh yeah, and all that other stuff.

DECEMBER 31, 1990: 'Bout Time in Austin presented tons of fun with a Masked Ball. In Houston, Martha Wash was the special guest at Rich's New Year's Everybody, while across town, revelers at Miss Kitty's "danced out the decade." Four gorgeous male dancers and Moet French champagne were the highlights at JR's and Heaven. New Year's Eve marked the beginning of "a new dance experience" at the Wave in Dallas. San Antonio celebrated country and western style with a Hoe-down at the Silver Dollar Saloon.

DECEMBER 31, 1991: It hasn't happened yet. It can be whatever you want it to be. A quiet evening at home with someone wonderful. Or a night on the town, at one of probably a hundred exciting events around the state, surrounded by the people who make you feel special.
