Last spring, I ventured into a world so horrible that it would have scared a drag queen right out of her hair. I committed (reluctantly) to organizing a "group" vacation for myself and eight of my closest friends, including my sister, my aunt and my husband. Planning travel for relatives is an absolute no-no, and it meant I'd have to relax my golden rule against ever booking any travel for relatives. Never! That's it! Cut and dried!

At a dinner party one evening, another travel agent, a friend of mine, mentioned that it would be a great idea for all of us to rent a villa for a week in some tropical paradise. He had just received a videotape featuring gorgeous oceanfront homes in Puerto Vallarta. Without thinking, I volunteered how fabulous it would be for such good friends to get together once a year for a little R&R in a different exotic destination. Within seconds, I was lassoed into researching properties and finding the perfect villa for our "dream" vacation of 1996. Right! For everyone else, maybe, but for me it would be a logistical nightmare!



At best, it was like organizing trained poodles. The first obstacle I encountered was trying to get everyone to settle on a week, then hoping that everyone could get vacation time for that week. Just when all seemed right with the world, someone would dash all our hopes with a scheduling

But after weeks of infighting, of shouting "It'll never get here!", we finally headed south of the border.

There was Juan, the houseboy, standing there at the top of the driveway with a welcome margarita. Remembering the first night isn't easy, but all wasn't lost...we brought along a video camera to record the entire escapade for posterity.



Prior to our arrival, I had faxed the tour company with a grocery list of preferences for the weekly menu. Waiting for us were Coronas, Kahlua, chips, freshly made guacamole and pico de gallo, tortillas, tequila and margaritas. And that was only on the first day...At our request, the cook made us breakfast and dinner each day. After the

first two days, it was time to pay the cook for the weekend's meals; with much trepidation, my husband (our interpreter) confronted us with the bill. Surprise! A piddling \$13 each for two days' worth of liquor, meals and snacks! We just couldn't believe it.

The maid and the houseboy were equally congenial. After they'd cleaned up the daily messes, we found our clothes laundered and folded perfectly, and fresh flowers from the garden dotted the bedrooms and dinner table. Juan kept our palace palatial with such care that we wondered if we could either move in with him or take him with us. Mornings were the best: eggs cooked to order, bacon sizzling in the kitchen, fresh-brewed coffee, mangoes, cantaloupe and juice all awaited us upon awakening. By the time the clock hit double digits (10 a.m.), Juan was busy making us daiquiris with fruits fresh from the market. Fresh green sauce and salsa, daily with chips and tortillas, margaritas or kahlua, what more could you ask for. Well...

There was the beach, shopping, the beach, sightseeing and the beach. Not to mention the bars — three of them, with bustling crowds almost every night. Shimmering Fingertips,
Drag Superstar
Frank Marino
Reaches for More with a
Fascinating Autobiography*

His Majesty, The Queen (The Frank Marino Story); by Frank Marino, with Steve and Cathy Marks; MSW Publishing Co., Ocala, Florida; autobiography; hardback; 1997; 271 pp.; \$22.

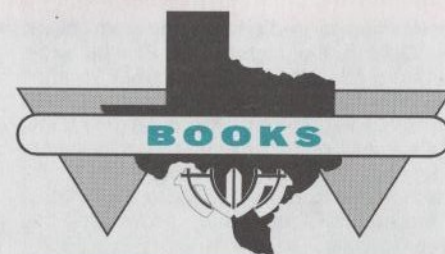
Frunk Marino's life has been anything but ordinary and dull. Just before his 18th birthday, he dressed as Diana Ross to enter a Halloween lip-sync contest in New York City; he won Best Costume.

Fifteen years later, Marino is still dressing as Ross...and Fran Drescher...and Joan Rivers...and many others. And he's gone way beyond Best Costume. He's become one of the world's most famous female impersonators, star of "An Evening at La Cage" at the Riviera Hotel in Las Vegas and winner of numerous honors, including "Best Female Impersonator" in the 1996 Las Vegas Entertainment Awards. A couple of years ago, he was named "Showgirl of the Year in Las Vegas," the first male ever to win that title.

What drives a person to perform three shows a night, six nights a week, 50 weeks a year? To spend an hour designing the perfect face each night, and an hour and a half later taking it off? To make sure everything is perfect, from gown to hair to shoes to accessories?

"I want to be the best at whatever I decide to do," Marino explains in his just-released autobiography, *His Majesty, The Queen*. "If I couldn't be a female impersonator anymore, I don't know what I'd want to be....I'm a businessman by day and a female superstar by night. The reality may be that I am a man, but the illusion is that I am a woman! With the whole world at my fingertips, I still keep reaching for more."

That "more" is a major reason for Marino's book. A superb self-promoter who has the talent to match the hype, the author had just celebrated his tenth anni-

versary on Vegas' Strip and signed "a new multimillion dollar contract guaranteeing my appearances on stage through the beginning of the 21st century." He felt the time was right to tell the world his story, as books and motion pictures are the main goals left for him to conquer.

And this is an absolutely fascinating book, easy to read and hard to put down. In a plain, straightforward, honest manner, Marino details growing up in New York with his godparents and their family after his family died; his discovery of his talents as a female impersonator and his blossoming career from New York to Florida to Las Vegas; becoming the first impersonator ever targeted in a legal action by the actual celebrity when Rivers, whom he'd developed a friendship with, turned around and sued him for \$5 million in 1986; the talk shows and celebrities and fickle fortunes of fame, from glorious highs to terrifying lows, as when his car was vandalized or his home robbed and ransacked.

Marino also is candid about the loves of his life, from the high school teacher who gave him timely emotional support as a friend to his current partner, Shannon Schechter (whom he took to McDonald's for their first "date"). The author is matter of fact in the way he tells his story, going for honesty and the facts, and not sensationalizing at all. "I, as a rule, am not usually open about my sexuality, or for that matter my sexual preference," Marino explains. "Don't misunderstand my statement. If someone has the balls to ask me, I will tell them the truth. I just don't flaunt my choices."

His Majesty, The Queen opens with a step-by-step description of how to turn oneself into a diva the Marino way ("Becoming a goddess is as much a state of mind as a look.") There also are hundreds of pictures and drawings, ranging from

celebrities to to-die-for outfits and gowns. "Getting the pictures to fit where the story needed them to fit was hell," Marino told **THIS WEEK IN TEXAS** in a phone interview from his Vegas home last weekend. (Yes, he's just as personable and friendly in conversation as he comes across in his book.) "It took me more time to place the pictures than to write the book — and it took one year to write."

Marino said he had just returned from appearances in San Diego and Los Angeles, and that he has near-future trips to San Francisco and New York scheduled — no easy task, since Tuesday is his only day off. Hawaii is in his summer vacation plans, and Texas will see him in December: he annually takes part in a holiday benefit at Village Station in Dallas. So far there are no plans for a book tour with stops in Texas, though he is eager to revisit the Lone Star State, "especially Austin and San Antonio, two cities I've never performed in."

Marino puts out a quarterly newsletter on his scheduled appearances, latest news and much more through the Frank Marino Fan Club; 8524 W. Sahara; Suite

236; Las Vegas, NV 89117; memberships are \$15. Autographed copies of his book can be ordered from the same address for \$22, plus \$3 in shipping and handling.

"Dressing in female clothing is really nothing new," Marino says in *His Majesty, The Queen*. "After all, if you look back through the years since the introduction of television, there have been many men who dressed in drag. Uncle Miltie loved to dress as a female; before him, 'The Keystone Cops' had episodes where the escapees dressed as women to avoid being caught. Recently, even stars like Patrick Swayze and Wesley Snipes did an entire movie in drag. Robin Williams did *Mrs. Doubtfire*, and what about Dustin Hoffman in *Tootsie*?"

"Dressing in drag is entertainment. Being good and getting paid for it is talent."

Frank Marino is talented. In his shows, he doesn't just lip-sync anymore; he does a 20-minute comedy monologue, and some singing and dancing, too. And now he's revealed writing talents with his first book. Can the TV shows and movies be far off? Don't bet against Marino. It's just another goal, another role to be studied and mastered by "His Majesty, the Queen."

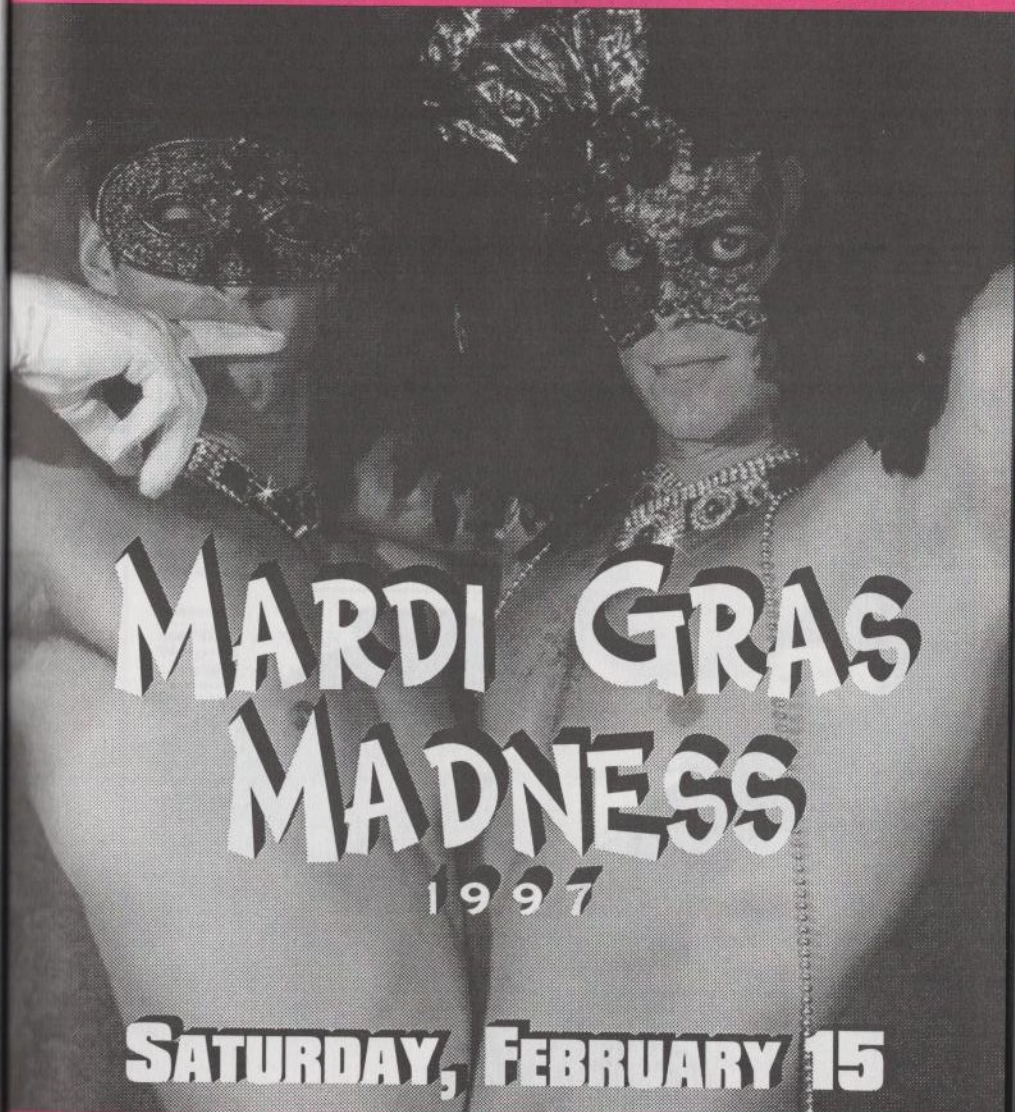

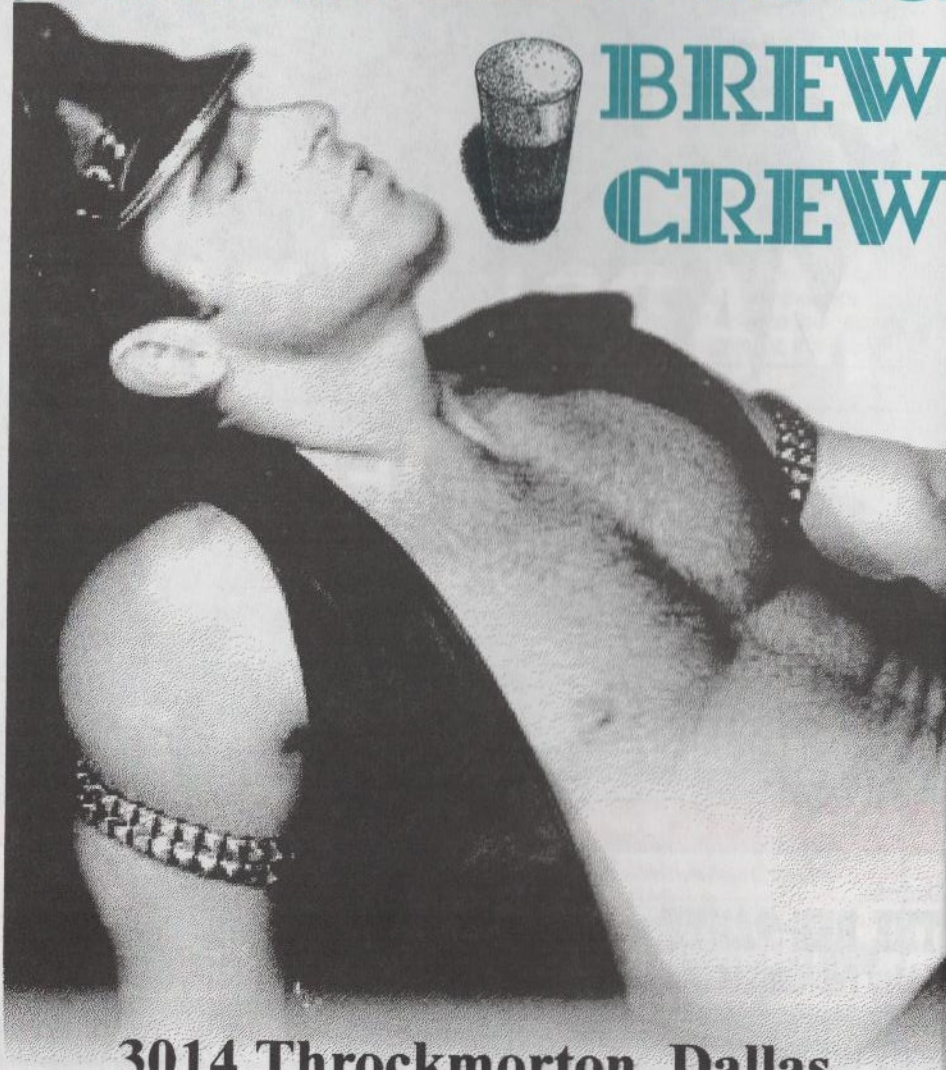

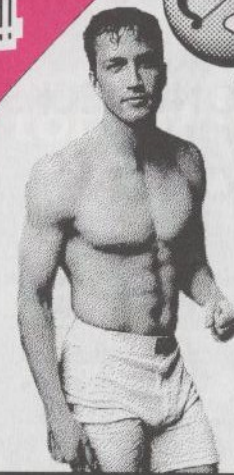

One of my favorite dance records of all time is by **C-Bank**. The title of the song is "One More Shot." I remember going out during the early eighties and dancing to this record and thinking, "Wow, this is really different!" I sort of put it in the same musical category as "I.O.U." by Freeze and "Looking for the Perfect Beat" by Soulsonic Force, which had come out earlier that same year and the year before, respectively. What I didn't realize at the time was that songs like this were paving the way for a new genre of dance music that would later be known as "freestyle" (though I wouldn't really say that it sounded like the freestyle of today). But if you give them a good hard listen, you'll definitely get a hint or two. At any rate, I'm telling you all this to let you know that there are now fabulous new remixes of "One More Shot" as well as "I Won't Stop Loving You," another C-Bank classic now available as a 12-inch courtesy of the girls at Next Plateau. And if you really want a treat for your ears, pick up the full-length CD *C-Bank's Greatest Hits*. Ouch! This one's marvelous!...

If hi-NRG is your flavor, then I've got two smart little tracks from the folks at Miami's Max Music for you. The first is by **Redemption** and features vocals by disco diva **Evelyn Thomas**. The title of the track is "Tell the World," and surely one of the highlights of this double 12-inch is the Ian Appell mix, which adds the perfect amount of oomph to an already great NRG track. And if the Latin stuff works for you, you'll certainly fall out over Max's release of "The Speak Up Mambo (Cuéntame)" by **The King of Mambo** — hot, throbbing, Latin house on the energy tip at its best. (Now we can all get over that Ricky Martin record, eh?)...

When it comes to cornering the market on great releases, the boys over at Arista are truly cleaning up. In the '96 year-end edition of *Billboard*, Arista captured top honors for everything from their Country division to R&B and Dance. Across the board, sales and chart statistics show that Arista is phat! What better way to start off the new year than by releasing new mixes of some of their past smashes. How 'bout

this Rollo remix of **Snap's** "Rhythm Is a Dancer"?...or new mixes of **Barry Manilow's** "I'd Really Love to See You Tonight" by Tony Moran (aka Husband); "circuit queens" are going nuts for this stuff! And speaking of husbands...those fine young lads **No Mercy** are back with a brilliant followup to "Where Do You Go" entitled "Please Don't Go" (not a cover). I think it would be safe to say that these boys really have it GOing on. You go, girls!...

Now I know you're waiting for me to tell you all about the new **R.E.M.** single. Okay, it's called "Electrolite" and we'll talk more about it later. Since we're on the subject of cute boys, I figure you'd like to know about my favorite new R&B cute-Latin-boy group,



Nuflavor. Sublime R&B ballads and harmonic pop melodies intertwined with unspoiled freshness best describes the collection of 11 tracks found on Nuflavor's self-titled debut album through Reprise. This project was produced by Gary St. Clair (All 4 One) and José Quintana (Luis Miguel). The quartet is made up of **Frank Pangelinan** and **Jacob Cinceros** (both baritones), **Anthony DaCosta** (a tenor) and **Rico Luna** (alto). Believe me when I say these guys are headed for Gold. One listen to their rendition of the Journey classic "Open Arms" — which, incidentally, is the song that got them discovered — and you'll surely be hooked. The first single, "Sweet Sexy Thing," shipped to Crossover and Top 40 radio this week, so we'll undoubtedly be hearing it on the airwaves soon. And yes, there are dance mixes on the way. For certain, this is the finest album I've received in recent years. Says tenor DaCosta, "We sing soulful, positive music.

GRANTS BY HOUSTON'S HOLLYFIELD SUPPORT GAY, AIDS ISSUES

Foundation Awards Nearly \$25,000 To Eight Local, State Groups.

HOUSTON — Eight organizations on the front lines for gay issues and the welfare of those with AIDS are sharing in nearly \$25,000 awarded by the local Hollyfield Foundation last week. Formal presentation of the grants was made at a reception held Wednesday, Jan. 29, at the foundation's office.

This is the second year funds have been awarded by the Hollyfield Foundation, which was created in 1994 by the late Jay Hollyfield Jr. The foundation's 13-member board chose the recipients from among 20 proposals received last summer.

The Texas Human Rights Foundation will use the \$5,000 it received to fund its statewide toll-free hotline that provides assistance to gay and HIV-positive people with legal problems. THRF President Hector Garcia, who was in Houston to accept the Hollyfield award, noted that the legal hotline has handled over 10,000 calls since its inception.

The Houston Area Teen Coalition of

Homosexuals received \$4,000, which will go toward underwriting the group's newsletter distributed to school counselors and students.

DiverseWorks, a nonprofit art center, received \$1,000 toward its "School's OUT"

project, which supports young gay performing artists.

A toll-free national helpline that provides assistance on gay-related youth issues was the beneficiary of a \$2,000 grant to Out Youth Austin.

Two agencies that work to alleviate the problem of housing for people with AIDS in the Houston area also benefited. Steven's House, a intermediate care facility for people with the disease, will apply its \$2,980 award toward computer and newsletter expenses. The AIDS Housing Coalition of Houston, which focuses on providing shelter for homeless people through its TLC House, will use its \$2,000 for telephone service and cleaning supplies.

The Center for AIDS, which works to spread knowledge about AIDS treatments and research, received \$2,500 for a series of community forums it will be presenting this year.

The 1996 Houston Black Tie Dinner, which supported the national Gay and Lesbian Victory Fund and 12 local and state organizations, was awarded \$5,000.

'JOURNEY' OFFERS SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT FOR PEOPLE WITH HIV

Austin/Travis County Program Believed First of Kind in State.

AUSTIN — The Austin/Travis County Mental Health and Mental Retardation Center's Community AIDS Resources & Education Program has started a new outpatient substance abuse service for people with HIV called "Journey." The program, which is funded through the City of Austin, is offered free of charge.

"This is the first time anyone's tried anything like this in Austin, and as far as we know of, in the state," said Jenny McFarlane, C.A.R.E.'s counseling coordinator. "It's very nontraditional. It's not abstinence-based, like some programs are.... That might not be realistic or helpful to someone living with HIV. It's more holistic, nutritional, educating the participant on theories of addiction and dealing with it. We do both group processing and one-on-one counseling."

"Journey" coordinator Leigh Bray has been with C.A.R.E. for about a year, since

coming to Austin from East Texas; she has been involved in this kind of work since the late 1980s, and is very enthusiastic about the new program's potential.

"The minimum we'd like to see someone stick with the program is eight weeks," Bray explained. "You can stay longer. You can also switch to two hours a week, or after-care work. The programs we offer are Level III, which is a minimum of ten hours a week — you can do that two days, Monday and Wednesday, five hours each; and Level IV, which is two hours a week, and considered supportive — they don't need so much, just someone to bounce things off."

"As far as I know, there's a program somewhat like 'Journey' in California, and one up by the Great Lakes; but they're both inpatient. Programs at places like Charter, Triangle, while they will accept HIV-positive clients, the groups are mixed and not specifically targeted to them and their unique situation and needs. We try to offer an extremely open and nonjudgmental group."

There are currently about 12 participants in "Journey"; everything is strictly confidential and tailored to the individual. The program meets from 9:30–11 a.m. Mondays and Thursdays and noon–5 p.m. Mondays and Wednesdays or 5–7 p.m. Mondays and Tuesdays. Bray said there is talk of adding a Saturday drama therapy session.

C.A.R.E., located at 1633 E. 2nd St., offers free HIV walk-in testing from 8 a.m.–7 p.m. Mondays and Tuesdays and 8 a.m.–4 p.m. Fridays. Services are free and strictly confidential; a person will be given an anonymous name if he or she desires. been made as of press time, Luna is preparing to make an announcement about

seeking a fourth term on City Council.

In last Tuesday's edition of the *Dallas Morning News*, Luna told Christopher Lee, "I've expressed my interest and willingness to go to Washington. Clearly, the opportunity to...have a substantive impact on housing and neighborhood development issues across the country is something that's hard to say 'no' to."

As chairman of Dallas' Housing and Neighborhood Development Committee, Luna has the experience necessary to fill this position in the Clinton administration.

The assistant secretary position is one of two open positions in the federal housing agency, which has five assistant secretaries in all.

At press time, Luna had not announced his plans for Dallas City Council.

HOUSTON GAY PAC BACKS BELL IN CITY COUNCIL RUNOFF

HGLPC Holds Candidate Fund-Raiser This Sunday; Balloting Set for Feb. 15.

HOUSTON — The political action com-

mittee of the Houston Gay & Lesbian Political Caucus voted last week to endorse attorney Chris Bell in a special election runoff for Houston City Council at-large Position 4.

The group's PAC had backed Ray Hill, a civil rights activist and former president of HGLPC, for the first round of voting on Jan. 18. The runoff is set for Feb. 15.

The committee heard speeches by both Bell and his runoff opponent, the Rev. James Dixon, before voting overwhelmingly to support Bell.

"Chris Bell has worked hard to develop real and lasting relationships with our community and clearly views us as his equals and not second-class citizens," Lane Lewis, President of HGLPC, said in a statement the group issued last Friday.

"We worked hard for Chris when we endorsed him in 1995 and we are going to work even harder this time," Clarence Bagby, Board Chair of the Caucus's PAC, said. Bagby added that HGLPC planned to mail out at least 20,000 endorsement cards to targeted households urging voters to back Bell.

HGLPC is holding a reception and fundraiser for Bell this Sunday, Feb. 9, from 5-7 p.m. at the Moose Cafe, 1340 W. Gray.

Bell had already been endorsed for the first round by Log Cabin Republicans-Houston. Steve Walker, President of the African-American Lesbian/Gay Alliance, whose PAC also supported Hill, said his group would decide this week whether to issue an endorsement for the runoff.

Dixon and Bell finished first and second, respectively, in first-round voting to choose a replacement for outgoing Councilmember John Peavy; Hill finished fourth.

Early voting runs through next Tuesday, Feb. 11.

DALLAS CLINIC STUDYING DRUG FOR KAPOSI'S SARCOMA

*12-Week Double-Blind Protocol
Will Look at Topical Medicine.*

DALLAS — A new study being conducted at the Nelson-Tebedo Clinic is testing a new investigational drug for HIV-positive patients living with Kaposi's sarcoma. The topical research treatment involves a 9 cis retinoic acid gel, a clear substance applied directly to a person's lesions. The

drug is manufactured by Allergan, the company funding the study.

According to LaMont Douglas, RN, the Research Nurse/Study Coordinator for this project, volunteers are needed to assist in their research.

In order to meet preliminary qualifications, volunteers must be HIV-1 positive; have at least three lesions on the skin of sufficient size to monitor; have not had prior systemic treatment (such as chemotherapy) for KS within the previous four weeks; be at least 18 years of age; not have any malignancy (including KS) likely to require systemic treatment during the course of the study.

"If a person meets these criteria, then they need to call me for further evaluation, including a physical and reviewing their medical history," said Douglas.

Once a person qualifies, they begin a 12-week program which is a double-blind study. Some participants will receive the actual drug and others will get a placebo, but neither the volunteer nor the staff will know who is on the actual drug. Following the study, however, everyone participating will receive the actual medication. Study-related medical assessments and laboratory tests are also included.

"It can't hurt to participate," Douglas said concerning those who will be getting the placebo, "because everyone will eventually be given the actual drug."

Douglas also hopes to get as many participants as possible. "The more people we get, the better. With a larger sample, the research will be more accurate."

MEETING PLANS FUTURE OF NEW AUSTIN BLACK GROUP

*AAGLT to Focus on Gay,
Lesbian and Transgender Issues.*

AUSTIN — Over 20 persons took part on Jan. 26 in the first meeting of the African American Gay/Lesbian/Transgender group, which was held at Cornerstone community center.

The majority of the town meeting involved a hearty discussion of issues specific to African-American gay men, les-

bians and transgendered people, and planning for future get-togethers. Austin writers/activists Sharon Bridgforth and Ana Sissett gave the meeting's keynote addresses, and there was a showing of the National Black Gay/Lesbian Leadership Forum's video *We Have a Legacy*.

Decisions coming out of the town meeting included: future efforts to hold monthly AAGLT community support meetings; agreement on the need for multigenerational family-oriented social/cultural events; and the need for a more formal future town meeting whose invitees would include community members and allies. This first gathering was attended by representatives from a couple of groups, Out Youth Austin and the board of directors of Cornerstone.

AAGLT also hopes to publish a monthly calendar of cultural, social and recreational events that can be jointly attended: The group's long-term goals include the formation of an agency administered by, and for the community needs of, African-American gay, lesbian and transgendered people of Central Texas, and the presentation of biannual social/cultural events open to a wider range of participants.

HOUSTON SHELTER FOR HOMELESS MEN WITH HIV TO EXPAND

*AIDS Housing Coalition Plans
Low-Income Apartments with
Grant from National Foundation.*

HOUSTON — AIDS Housing Coalition Houston, an agency that focuses on providing housing to homeless people with AIDS, last week announced expansion plans that include new low-income apartments for people with the disease. The plans were made possible by a recent \$100,000 grant from a national foundation.

Matt Locklin, founder and Executive Director of AHCH, said his agency had already received a portion of the funding awarded by the Rath Foundation, based in Wisconsin, and had provided the foundation with documentation necessary to secure the remainder.

Locklin said AHCH has purchased the two-story building at 117 Tuam which currently houses the TLC House shelter (and has until now been leased) as well as an adjacent empty lot. The total bill for the land and house was around \$154,000; the balance of the payment on the house was financed by Frank Plischke, a local developer, and others, as well as Del Fullen of Commonwealth Land Title, who donated his professional services.

Locklin added that AHCH is looking for an architect or designer with expertise in commercial or multi-unit property development to volunteer his or her time to help

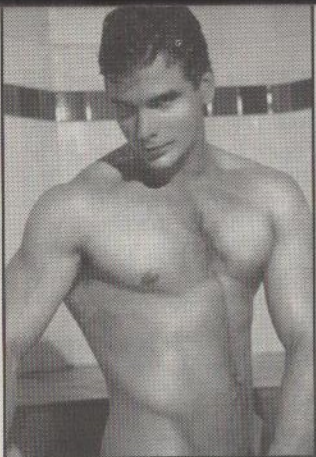
with the groundwork for the new facility.

TLC House, which was founded in 1994, has served nearly 150 residents as a six-bed/90-day emergency shelter. AIDS Housing Coalition Houston, the nonprofit organization that operates the facility, claims a success rate of 60% in placing residents back in independent living situations. Locklin said the residence, which currently accepts only HIV-positive men, will be able to extend its services to women when the expansion is completed sometime in 1998.

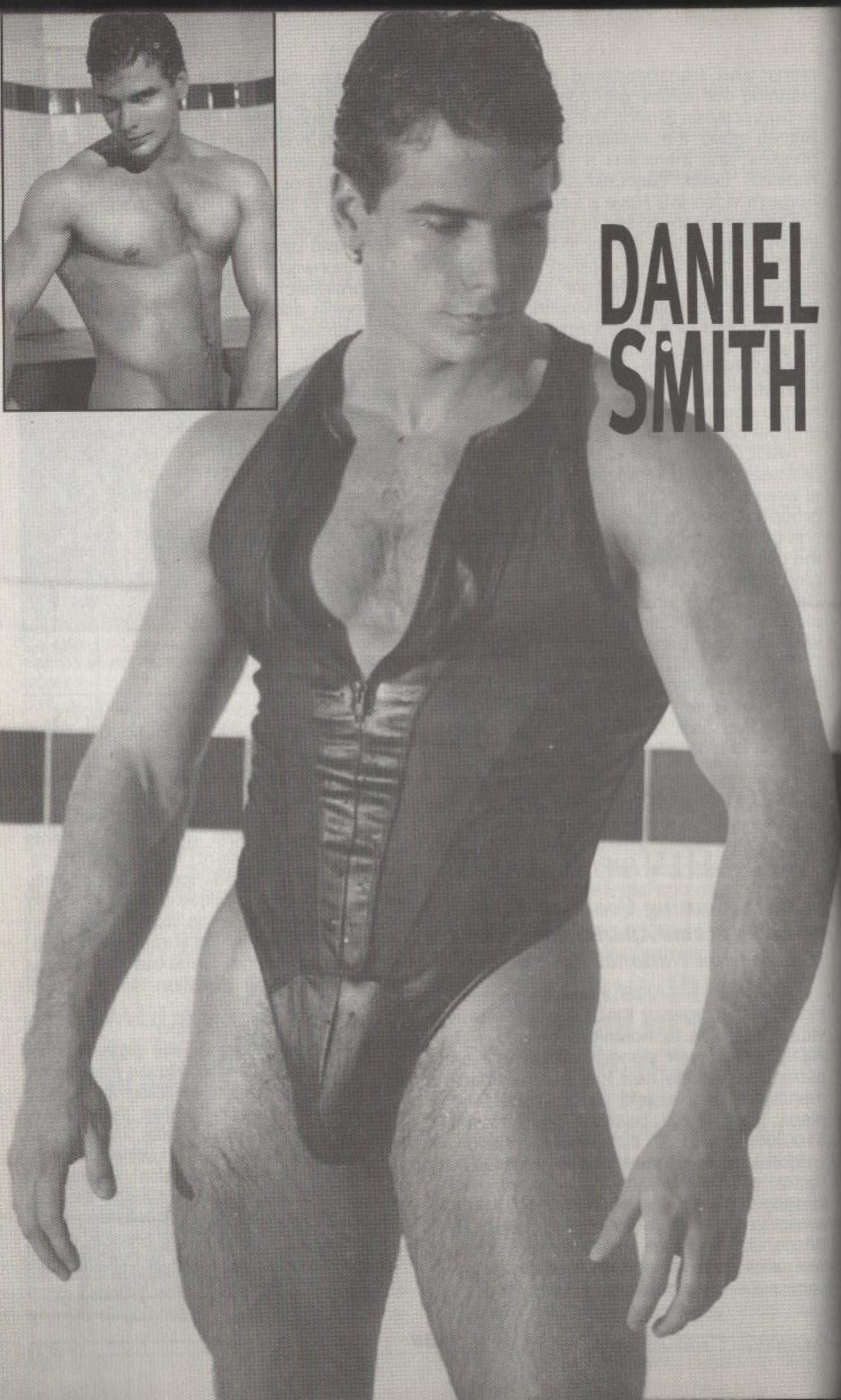
