



### A 5 5 1 D E N I A L DEATH OF AN ANARCHIST

ere's the scenario: Mickey and Judy and the gang have the barn and oodles of talent, but what to do with it? Should they mount a big Broadway-style musical? Maybe a nice drawing-room comedy? A mystery-thriller? "I knowl," says Mickey. "Let's do a satirical comedy about Italian politics written by the Nobel Prize-winning contemporary Italian playwright Dario Fo, translated and adapted from the Italian by Richard Nelson! It'll sell like hotcakes!" "Golly", says Judy.

"Golly" indeed. But that's just what Rebecca Udden and her hearty band of players at Main Street Theater have gone and done. And darned if they weren't right! Oh, there were some pitfalls – we'll get to those later –but the instinct was there.

The play, a sort of absurdist farce, is based on an actual incident. On the night of December 12, 1969, a bomb exploded and killed sixteen people at the Agricultural Bank in Milan, Italy. At the same time another bomb went off in Rome, and a third was found, unexploded, at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. A man called Guiseppe Pinelli, a known anarchist, was arrested and charged with the crime. While being interrogated at the station, he jumped out a fourth-floor window and was killed. The play is a recreation of the events of that interrogation.

Act one opens with a man known in the program only as "Suspect" (Jeff Johnson) being brought in for questioning by Inspector Bertozzo (Joseph E. Hudson). It seems the Suspect is certifiably crazy – in fact is proud of it– and has committed a list of crimes and impersonations that fill several files. The Inspector is striving manfully to get to the bottom of it all, and keeps having to deal, not only with the facts as he perceives them, but with the very personal "reality" of the suspect. Being the humorless bureaucrat he is, (think Herbert Lom's

"Chief Inspector Dreyfus" in the Pink Panther movies) he cannot do it, but, aided by his bumbling assistant, the "Officer/Sergeant" (Todd Greenfield), he forges ahead.

It's this duality of what is real and what is perceived that is the engine of the play. "Suspect" simply sees things one way; the Inspector and his cohorts another. The question for the audience becomes, "Who is right?"

The center of the action is Jeff Johnson's "Suspect". Rarely on stage is an actor given such carte blanche, and it's every actor's dream. Not only is there so much opportunity for upstaging, he is actually directed to upstage, and it's a glorious candy store. There is not a moment onstage for two hours that all attention is not focused on Johnson. Well, that's not exactly true, because then it would be more or less a monologue. The other actors do take the stage occasionally, but they must fight for it, and that they succeed is an indication of their ( and the director's) skill.

Hudson's weary, put-upon "Inspector" is a perfect foil and Greenfield's clueless "Officer/Sergeant" adds another dimension. In the second act the cast is expanded as the "Captain" (John Kaiser) and the "Chief" (Robert Leeds) are bamboozled by the suspect, who convinces them he is a judge reviewing the case. It's a joy to watch them trip and fall all over themselves and each other in an attempt to place the blame. Add the crusading "Reporter" (Ginny Lang), and the mix is complete.

But in the end it's Johnson's show. He pulls every stop on the keyboard. He snarls, he spits-literally-he crawls and rolls and limps; he is a graduate *cum laude* of the Ministry of Silly Walks. And he handles props brilliantly, including a bit with a glass eye that you won't believe.

The performers benefit greatly from the



very effective set, designed by Shane Merchant. It's one of the best I've seen at that location, which has two very problematic supporting columns on the stage. And Director Steve Garfinkel moves his actors through it with precision.


Which brings us to the pitfall. While 'Anarchist' is a comedy -and a very funny one -it is firmly rooted in the Italian tradition of political satire, and perhaps no politics in the world is more complex than the Italian. Now that doesn't mean that Americans can't understand it, although some of the subtleties may be lost. The problem is in the topicality of the material. Certain events are spoken of; references are made that are dated. The playwright recognized this, and some of these references were updated for American audiences, with his permission. Unfortunately, he gave permission in the script to make further changes when necessary, and it is here, in my opinion, that he set a dangerous and irresistible trap. The danger is, you never know who will be in the audience. As I settled in for an experience in Italian theater, set in Italy and populated by Italian characters, I was constantly jarred by American, and even Texan, references. Well-meaning attempts. I have no doubt, to help the audience along, but for me it was disrupting. Early in the first act, the "Suspect" is accused of impersonating a psychiatrist, and charging the exorbitant sum of 20,000 lire for a session. Everyone is outraged but me, and anyone else in the house who might happen to know that 20,000 lire is about \$15.00. A bargain. Later, as the Suspect rants about the injustice of the justice system, he makes an unmistakable reference to the Oregon case. It stopped the action cold, as did a lame pun involving Tom DeLay. My advice? The next time you are tempted to rewrite the work of a Nobel Prize-winning playwright, think long and hard and then don't do it. "Nuf" said.

Accidental Death Of An Anarchist is a funny, no-holds-barred take on what passes for sanity at the close of our century. and is well worth a look.






Just in time for ABBA's 25th reunion our Ufriends over at Almighty in the UK are at it again with another Abba cover from Abbacadabra. This time out it's "Mama Mia." The track carries on in typical Almighty fashion-full-blown, glorious, and vocal-driven with all the production fanfare that should surround a track like this. You know the song already and I'm sure that your original is all worn out and full of popcorn, so this one's probably a good investment.

After the demise of BMG's Ariola Dance label last year, we've been wondering what would be the next effort from Hannah Jones. We're glad to report that the diva has signed to East Side in the UK and has just popped out a rousing rendition of the Jean Carne disco classic "Was That All It Was." The production is over-the-top and Jones delivers one of her finest performances to date on this peak-hour monster. Remixes by Love To Infinity and Rhythm Masters will work your nerves. And the other good news is that it comes from her upcoming, yes upcoming, June album Coming Back For More. What a great summer this is going to be!

Speaking of divas, there's a new single from Candi Staton entitled "Love On Love" that is really the tea. It's already getting radio and massive club support in the UK. Those in the U.S. who are getting the imports are already familiar with this title as well. The track was also a hit back in 1990 by E-Zee Posse on More Protein (Boy George's label). Staton is set to release an album this spring entitled Outside In. 





# "Fluid Enough"

I think April is a very exciting, special month. The change of the seasons from the doldrums of winter days to the cheer of springtime is happening now. Those of our friends who live in the north, fearful of those love handles and bellies that grew out of a snowbound winter, are getting their exercise programs jump-started. Summer is just around the corner!

As athletes, we should always be thinking about proper fluid replacement (especially if you live in a rather warm, humid climate). The absolute most important nutritional concern you should have before, during and after exercising is replenishing the vital fluids your body needs to perform. If not, you're physical performance can be severely hindered due to lack of hydration. And it all begins with good old H<sup>2</sup>O.

Water is vital to every cell in the body. Approximately 60% of your body weight is water. As you exercise, that water is lost through the skin as sweat (to cool the body) and through your lungs as you breathe. If you do not replenish this loss of fluid, you can become dehydrated. Lots of bad things happen to the body when it has a lack of fluids. When you become dehydrated, you have less blood circulating through your body than you would normally have. So, this means that if there is less circulating blood, then the heart will pump less blood. That all important life giver called oxygen will be depleted from the

blood and consequently, the muscles will receive less of it. Oxygen is a necessary product for energy production in the muscles. This is when exhaustion sets in and your performance suffers. It's amazing that as little as a 2% reduction in body fluid during exercise will effect your performance. This "process" will sneak up on you before you know it. I know of lots of clients that wake up, have a cup of coffee, and then come to the gym and work up a good sweat. This isn't very smart. Actually, it's very dangerous. The body can't perform at its optimum level unless it's well hydrated. If you are wondering why you just don't have enough stamina in the morning. maybe its because you aren't fluid enough. So, drink before, during and after physical activity. That is the very best way to prevent dehydration. Now you know when to drink, but how much and what?

One trick to find out how much fluid you will need is to weigh yourself before you exercise. Then weight yourself after. For every pound you lose after the workout, you will need to drink 2 cups of fluid to rehydrate your body. Also check your urine color. That's right! Your urine should look clear or resemble weak lemonade. If it's a dark gold color, like apple juice, then you are dehydrated. Don't let thirst be your guide to drink. If you are thirsty, then you are already dehydrated. According to the Clinical Reference Systems, most people

do not become thirsty until they have lost 2% of their body weight. That's enough to decrease your performance. And if you drink only enough to quench your thirst, you may still be dehydrated. A good rule of thirst is to keep a water bottle when you work out and drink throughout the workout about every 15 minutes.

I usually bring a liter bottle of cold spring water to the gym. By the time I'm finished working out, the bottle is almost empty. Always remember to drink before, during and after!

Now you know when to drink and how much. Now the question that everyone wants to know is WHAT to drink? Are those sports drinks really good? Are they worth the money, or is water just as effective and

less expensive? What should a sports drink have in it?

Researchers have found that a drink that has 6 to 8% carbohydrates (sugars) is best absorbed by the body. These drinks are as rapidly absorbed as water and have the added benefit of providing the muscles with the extra energy that water just doesn't have. This extra energy can delay fatique and may improve performance. If you slurp down one of these sports drinks, you are actually allowing the blood glucose levels in your body to stay at a constant level, even though the muscles may be depleted of energy. Because the "stores" of readily available energy are full, the muscles can produce energy at an accelerated rate. Thus keeping you at peak performance throughout your workouts. Drinks that contain less than 5% carbohydrate were found to not improve performance. Conversely, drinks that contain more than 10% carbohydrate often have a negative effect. Sodas and some fruit juices can cause abdominal cramps, nausea and diarrhea, and can actually hurt your performance.

Sodium also seems to play a key role in our ability to retain fluids. Salt is an electrolyte that helps maintain proper fluid levels in the body. It is a vital element we all need. Researchers have found that a drink with 6% carbohydrate and 110 milligrams of sodium is absorbed faster in the body than plain water! If you think sodium is something to watch out for, you're right. Focus your attention on the salt shaker, the soda and the potato chips. Gatorade, and other sports drinks have about as much sodium as a cup of 2% milk. Here's how to remain fluid enough through your worksuits.

Drink at least 16 ounces of fluid 15 to 30 minutes before and 8 ounces every 10-15 minutes during physical activity.

 Drink a beverage that has 6 to 8% carbohydrate concentrations with some sodium and other electrolytes, like chloride and potassium. Stay away from caffeine and carbonated drinks, because they can have a diuretic effect. They can give you gastrointestinal upset and decrease fluid vol-

 Find a drink that's easy to drink. Cold and sweet is easiest to drink. If all else fails and you don't have a sports drink, go for a bottle of good, clean water!



### HCFA ENFORCES MEDICAID REIMBURSEMENT FOR AIDS WASTING DRUG

NAPWA Applauds Ruling On Serostim®

TEXAS - Under pressure from the National Association for People With AIDS [NAPWA] and members of the HIV/AIDS community, the Healthcare Finance Administration [HCFA] has reversed an earlier statement that allowed the state of Texas to deny Medicaid reimbursement for Serostim®, the first biotechnology drug ever to be approved for the treatment of AIDS wasting, based on a loophole in the U.S. Social Security Act.

HCFA now confirms the clinical benefits of Serostim, a recombinant human growth hormone, for use in fighting this life threatening condition, and will require Medicaid reimbursement for the drug by all states effective April 5, 1999. Texas, with 20,000 HIV cases and the fourth largest HIV population in the U.S. welcomes the new ruling that affected approximately 5,000 sufferers across the state.

HOUSTON - The Houston Comet's point guard, Kim Perrot will speak to Lesbians In



Don "Ducky" Housen (June 14, 1941 - February 20, 1999)


