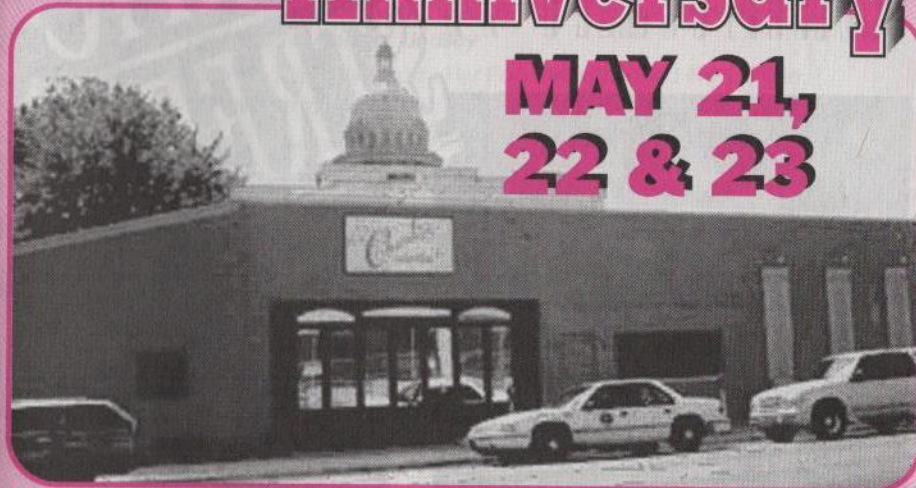

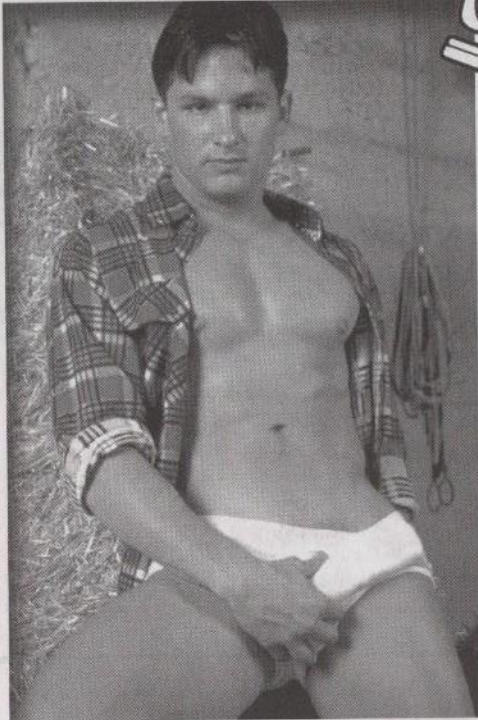

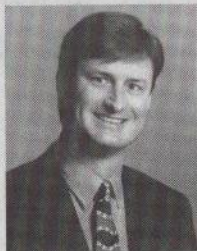

## 10 Things I Hate About *Star Wars* (and a few reasons why it 's still worth seeing)

If you're planning on waiting in line hours for tickets to *STAR WARS: EPISODE I - THE PHANTOM MENACE* this weekend, I feel your pain. Well, sort of.

Even though I had the privilege of seeing the movie a little more than a week in advance of the opening, I still had to sit in a crowded theater for over two hours to guarantee my seat. (I know in comparison to what some fans have gone through, mine's no real sob story, but it's all I've got). Without my consent, I had become a victim of the *Star Wars* hysteria that I had tried so hard to avoid. So, for 120 minutes I read magazines and psyched myself up for this celluloid event. When the lights dimmed and the "please do not video tape this movie" announcement was made, the energy of the crowd went into hyperdrive. Soon, the music swelled, the Lucasfilm logo and that really cool slanty text appeared on-screen, and out popped my goosebumps. I had been taken in.

Unfortunately, it wasn't long before I wished I had sold my pass to one of my co-workers for his \$500 offer. But rather than spending the rest of the movie imagining how many pairs of underwear from the International Male catalog I could've bought with 500 bucks, I tried to embrace the phenomenon flashing before me.

Herewith is an itemized list of why you might be underwhelmed, too.

### 1. **May the force-feeding be with you.**

Few movies live up to their action-packed trailers and fast-food toy blitzes, let alone months of marketing overkill telling you how much you want to see a particular movie. *Menace* will undoubtedly thrill die-hard fans who are munching their popcorn in Boba Fett costumes, but the rest of us will find the strength to move on with hopeful anticipation of this summer's other offerings.

### 2. **Am I watching *Toy Story* or what?**

Using computer animation to enhance scenes is one thing, but there are some moments in the film where it appears that everything is digitally produced, creating an unrealistic, cartoony effect. I was beginning to think 'Buzz Lightyear' would appear to battle the Dark Side.

### 3. **I Love Looping.**

Despite extremely advanced technology used to make this movie, there are still scenes where the dialogue looping is way off.

(You know, when the mouth moves one way and different words come out') At least there were no shots of the boom microphones at the top of the screen. These examples lead directly to'

### 4. **Muppet Menace.**

So, why are some of the aliens still muppetized? When the vast majority of characters are digitally created, the few aliens that aren't products of a mouse and keyboard really stand out. Case in point, the prominence of two alien bigwigs whose mouths merely function in two modes: open and close. Perhaps Lucas was at-tempting to show that these aliens are so advanced that the words form before they exit their mouths, but I would really like to see some lips moving. This isn't Howdy Doody.

### 5. **Where's Barney?**

Filled with gee-whiz acting by pint-size Jake Lloyd (Anakin Skywalker) and a few friends, some of the scenes are just one purple dinosaur short of saccharin overdose. Making Lloyd a central character will at least guarantee a few million in ticket sales to the elementary school set, but couldn't Lucas have found a child star who could act.

### 6. **Rerun of the Jedi.**

OK, so this is all taking place in the same galaxy as the previous trilogy, but would it be too much to ask that Episode I unfold in all new places? We spent much of *Star Wars* on the desert planet of Tatooine, and a great deal of this movie is spent there, as well. Plus, the climactic lightsaber battle between Darth Vader and Luke Skywalker in *The Empire Strikes Back* makes the one in this movie with Obi-Wan (Ewan McGregor), Qui-Gon (Liam Neeson) and Darth Maul (Ray Park) seem all too familiar, complete with our hero dangling below his enemy. I guess the rest of the planets are non-lightsaber zones. And *Return of the Jedi's* Ewoks? Substitute the long-eared new character Jar Jar Binks and his fellow citizens for the little furry guys and you've got a final battle with more than a little déjà vu.

### 7. **Scenes from a Maul.**

This is the bad guy touted as 'far more evil than Darth Vader', Darth Maul is a red-faced demon who hardly has enough screen time to even be a threat. (However, I have seen Park's picture in magazines and he is rather hot out of make-up, if that's any consolation).

There are a few 'surprise' plot twists this time around, but you need only keep your eyes open to catch them far in advance. Nothing will ever top 'Luke, I am your father' when it comes to revelations, so don't even try.

## 9. Something Old, Something Borrowed, Something Old...!

Get ready for lots of familiar faces in the crowd. I think bringing back the likes of R2-D2, C-3PO, Jabba the Hut and Yoda (to name a few) is meant to evoke great feelings of nostalgia for those of us with fond memories of the first movies. At least it's not as sad as the last time the original Brady Bunch cast got together.

## 10. Premature Emancipation.

There's nothing worse than a climax coming too soon. The mandatory final battle for freedom ended with a bit of a whimper, in comparison to the tension and suspense of the first trilogy's. Maybe a little less time could've been spent on the redundant pod-racing scene to pump up the lackluster finale.

## And now, the good news...

It may come as a surprise that I can still recommend seeing *Phantom Menace* after what I've already written. It is a good movie on its own, it's just in the shadow of the classic trilogy that it falls short. It will thrill a new generation of *Star Wars* fans, but I guess the shortcomings of *Episode I* are really a reminder that I'm getting old.

## Queen Amidala's Hair and Costumes.

Drag queens around the world will soon have follicle envy when Amidala (Natalie Portman) steals every scene with her daring 'dos and fabulous frocks. Halloween should be great fun this year with all the reproductions.

## Brave New Worlds

Even though many scenes take place in some old haunts, Lucas has created some exciting new planets and cities, namely the underwater world that's home to Jar Jar Binks and friends. The scenes here are fresh, original and represent the type of magic you expect from Mr. Lucas and his team.

## Boba, Hope

Finally, the best thing about *Episode I* is the possibilities it sets up for the next two films in the series. The movie ends with a feeling of hope and prosperity, but lots of loose ends, rumors of a heavy presence from bad-boy bounty hunter Boba Fett in the next film and the promise of even more exciting innovations in moviemaking technology, mean that the best is yet to come.

But just in case, I'm taking offers now for my screening pass to *Episode II*.

**A**s Christian groups such as Focus On The Family and the Center for Reclaiming America take out full-page newspaper advertisements that claim lesbians and gay men can be "cured" of their sexual orientation through reparative therapy, it is apparent that some factions of Christianity are in a battle to eliminate homosexuality. How such battles can manifest to create real consequences of pain and loss in real people's lives is superbly illustrated in Stuart Howell Miller's *Prayer Warriors: The True Story of a Gay Son, His Fundamentalist Christian Family, and Their Battle for His Soul* (Alyson Publications, 224 pages, \$13.95).

This author's diary of mental anguish and grief offers as hard evidence the products of bigotry, homophobia and intolerance. At the same time, *Warriors* provides inspiration of hope as Miller comes to terms with his life, his family and his God.

That major gay right of passage—coming out to one's parents—is never an easy task, so Miller was particularly methodical when he outed himself in 1992. During a visit to his hometown of Nashville, he first told his brother and sister-in-law, in what he calls the "preliminary round." Then, armed with literature for parents of gay

children, Miller, then 26, told his parents, "I'm gay. I've known it for a long time and I wanted you to know." Since he had dropped hints over the years (once telling his mother never to ask him about dating women), Miller was unprepared for his parents' surprise reaction. Yet the real surprise for him was not their intolerance or refusal to accept the truth—it was their "solution."

"God is going to take care of this," Miller's father calmly told his son. "The first thing we need to do is to acknowledge the fact that you're homosexual. And then we can begin the process of change." Although a stunned Miller maintains his composure as he explains that his sexual orientation is innate, his parents are steadfast as they refer to their son's "lifestyle choice" and begin a psychological war on his heart and mind.

Soon after his return to Los Angeles and his job at the Gay & Lesbian Center, the author learns that his favorite aunt has disowned him.

"You...went back to your sweet little lifestyle and left the rest of us to wallow in your sin," she writes her nephew. "Did you really expect us to have compassion on you? I'm not Jesus!" Again, however, it is Miller's parents and his father in particular who pack the biggest wallop in what Miller calls "a self-righteous, eight-page, typed, single-spaced rant." A self-appointed theologian, the author's father offers his own interpretation of the Bible as Divine Truth and tells his son he is fighting for his salvation. Miller's father explains that he has assembled 27 "prayer warriors" who have a collective mission: to "petition the Father to rescue" Miller from himself.

Through chilling and obsessive prose, the mind-set of a fundamentalist with delusions of grandeur is revealed. "This will not be stealthy jungle warfare but battle out in the open, exposing the forces of evil for who and what they are," he says, words reminiscent of dialogue from *The Exorcist*. "The Lord views men lying together as abominable and worthy of death. Since we don't live under a Theocracy we are not obliged to carry out the sentence." Thankfully, Miller had nurtured solid friendships,

often with co-workers, both in Los Angeles and in Nashville.

But as the strain of his parents' war continued to haunt him and his friends couldn't empathize, Miller felt hollow and alone. "They didn't know that a fundamentalist Christian will cut off his arm if he believes its God will," he reveals in a spiral of depression, anger and self-doubt. "And that's the situation I felt I was in. I had become an appendage, a rotting limb to be healed or amputated." As the prayer warriors continued their letter-writing campaign they enlist the pen of Miller's 12-year-old sister, Abby, who tells her brother that God "can either change you or kill you." While every letter from each warrior conveyed the same message of hatred, it was Abby's note that devastated Miller. Writes the author: "If my father's letters hurt and my mother's letters hurt, Abby's nearly killed me."

Instead of anger, however, Miller finds peace and forgiveness through the teachings of the book *A Course In Miracles*, new age guru Marianne Williamson and his own private prayers. In the process, the young author becomes a better man. "God, help me to forgive," he writes. "Teach me what forgiveness means. Show me how to love again."

Miller's lessons were hard earned as he accepts his insecurities as well as total responsibility for how he views himself. The revelations should strike a cord with lesbian and gay readers who are estranged from their families. "The most frightening thing about letting your family go," Miller writes, "is that suddenly you have no one to blame."

*Prayer Warriors* is non-fiction; hence, there is no happy ending in the traditional sense. The last chapter does not end with Miller enjoying Thanksgiving dinner with his parents, lover in tow. As it chronicles the frightening odyssey of the author, *Warriors* reveals the emotional damage that can be inflicted on loving individuals by those who profess to love them the most.

"I realized I would probably never have a close relationship with my family again," Miller writes in the final chapter. "But I was blessed with incredible, loving friends, and I let them become the family I longed for."

## "Body Basics"

You probably haven't given much thought to how your body manages to function and operate the complex systems that require movement. From the time you pull open that door to the gym, sign in, get a drink at the juice bar, warm-up, stretch, work out, cool-down, stretch and push the door open (as you exit the gym), a rather complex system of millions of messages and motions occur inside your body. We take for granted the fact that about a million electrical impulses fire in our neurological system in the span of a second. That's an idea that's almost impossible to fathom. Even within the short time it takes you to scratch your nose, a whole series of complex events have occurred that represent the miracle of human movement.

So, just how do your muscles, tendons, ligaments and bones function together to create movement? How does the body respond to exercise? Why do muscles increase strength and size as a result of exercise? Discovering the answers to these questions will help you perform an exercise program with a higher degree of precision and expertise. In your quest for the best for yourself, knowledge is power!

Every muscle is actually a wrapped package, containing other smaller wrapped packages of long, slender cells known as muscle fibers. The outer wrapping, called fascia, turns into a tendon at both muscle ends. This strong, rope-like tissue attaches from both ends of the mus-

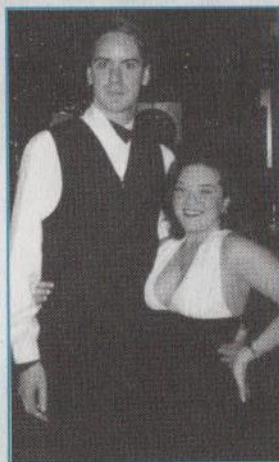
cle directly to the bone. Where the tendon inserts over a joint (like your elbow) is referred to as the insertion point. In the arm, the insertion site of the biceps muscle is in the forearm near the elbow. The bicep begins with its tendon on the humerus (upper arm), where it originates. When the muscle contracts it pulls on its two tendons (the insertion and origin) causing the attached bone to move, and voila...your arm bends!

This process does not happen independently. The brain must first signal the motor units of a specific muscle to contract or relax. This process requires millions of chemical transfers to occur. By the way, the heart, you know, is a muscle. However, it contracts with different, highly specialized motor units other than skeletal muscle.

Another important body part required for movement is the ligament. They are tough, elastic type bands that connect bone to bone and help stabilize a joint making its movement smooth. Ligaments help guide how the bones move in relationship to each other. Nerve receptors in the ligaments and tendons send impulses to the brain, to help regulate the intensity of muscle contractions. Fluid-filled sacs, called bursas, lubricate and cushion your tendons as they slide back and forth over your bones. Tendons, ligaments and bursal pads take longer to adapt to activity than do muscle, and as a result, these connec-

tive tissues are particularly vulnerable to inflammation, tears or other injuries. Terms we hear frequently like tendonitis, a torn ligament, bursitis and "tennis elbow" are ways to describe injuries to these tissues. So, now you know the "body basics" of how muscles work and understand the basic components that make the body move. With this information in hand, it's easy to understand how the body responds to exercise. When you lace up your cross trainers, enter the gym and push that barbell up from your chest, your body is responding to orders from your brain to move your muscles. As soon as these movements begin, a number of rapid changes take place throughout the body.

Your working muscles immediately start to burn more energy. During a brisk walk, your muscles may use 15 to 25 times more energy than they may use at rest. During intense, short anaerobic effort, like a sprint, your muscles may need up to 120 times more energy than at rest.

In its race to deliver more blood to your muscles and other body tissues, your heart immediately begins to beat faster. During intense training, your heart rate may rise to 150 beats per minute or more. Compare that to 70 or 80 beats per minute as a resting rate and you've almost doubled your hearts work during exercise! This, as you know, does not happen on it's own, but by a complex chemical reaction. The brain, in anticipating an extreme event, causes the body to produce epinephrine (adrenaline)

which gets released into your bloodstream causing the heart to beat faster. Stressed muscles also cause the heart to beat faster. They send impulses through their nerve receptors to the sympathetic nervous system, which in turn tells the body to make adrenaline.

The average heart pumps about 5 liters of blood per minute at rest. That amount may increase to 20 liters per minute during vigorous exercise. Blood vessels relax, capillaries open up, and veins constrict, allowing more blood to flow and pass through these structures. Your lungs begin to expand, you breathe more deeply and as a result, oxygen, that all-important "giver of life," is increased and passed to the tissues that need it most. About 12 pints of air pass in and out of the average person's lungs every minute. That number will increase to 200 pints per minute during vigorous exercise.

Your ability to burn calories increases dramatically also. The amount of calories you are burning at any one time refers to your metabolic rate. That rate may go up anywhere from 4 to 40 times your resting rate, depending on how hard and long you exercise. It is known that your metabolic rate will increase and stay that way for one hour following aerobic exercise. After resistance exercising (lifting weights) there's a big difference. Your metabolic rate could stay elevated up to 9 hours following a workout! If you want to lose weight...aerobic exercise and resistance training are essential.

Strength and muscle size can also increase as a result of exercise. With repeated resistance training over a period of time, protein filaments inside each muscle fiber grow thicker and more numerous, which increases the diameter of the exercised muscles. The tendons, ligaments and supporting tissue also thicken and become stronger. Waiting 48 hours before exercising the same muscle is a good idea. Main strength gains come from rebuilding of the muscle fibers between workouts so you want to wait for the repairs to occur before breaking the tissue down again. Aerobic exercise will increase the muscles' tone and endurance, but offers little muscle growth. For muscle size to increase, you need to pump up with weights!

And one more thing, stretching is vital to any exercise routine. A stretched muscle becomes lengthened over time. Stretching can improve your overall posture and balance. You should stretch after a short warm up period and do it before and after you work out...every time. Current scientific research suggests a "cold" muscle enjoys only a short-term increase in muscle length. However, it has been found to be more effective to stretch a "warm" muscle. It can stay longer, longer!

Loaded with all this information, you now can head out to the gym and exercise in a safe, effective precise fashion. Knowledge does equal power.

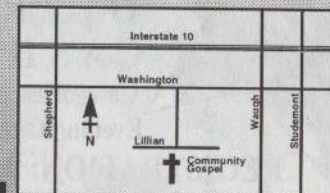

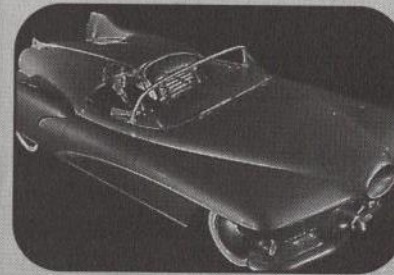

### OLYMPIA DUKAKIS SET FOR 1999 DFW BLACK TIE DINNER

*Actress To Keynote In Favor Of Childrens  
Aids Related Funding Efforts*

DALLAS — Academy Award-winning actress Olympia Dukakis will be the featured speaker at the 1999 Dallas-Fort Worth Black Tie Dinner on September 25, 1999. The announcement was made by the Dinner Committee at a special preview party last week at the Wyndham Anatole Hotel.

With several movies and theater productions to her credit, Dukakis is also an advocate of several special causes, including work with inner-city school children and fundraising for AIDS research and the fight against such children's diseases as pediatric AIDS.
