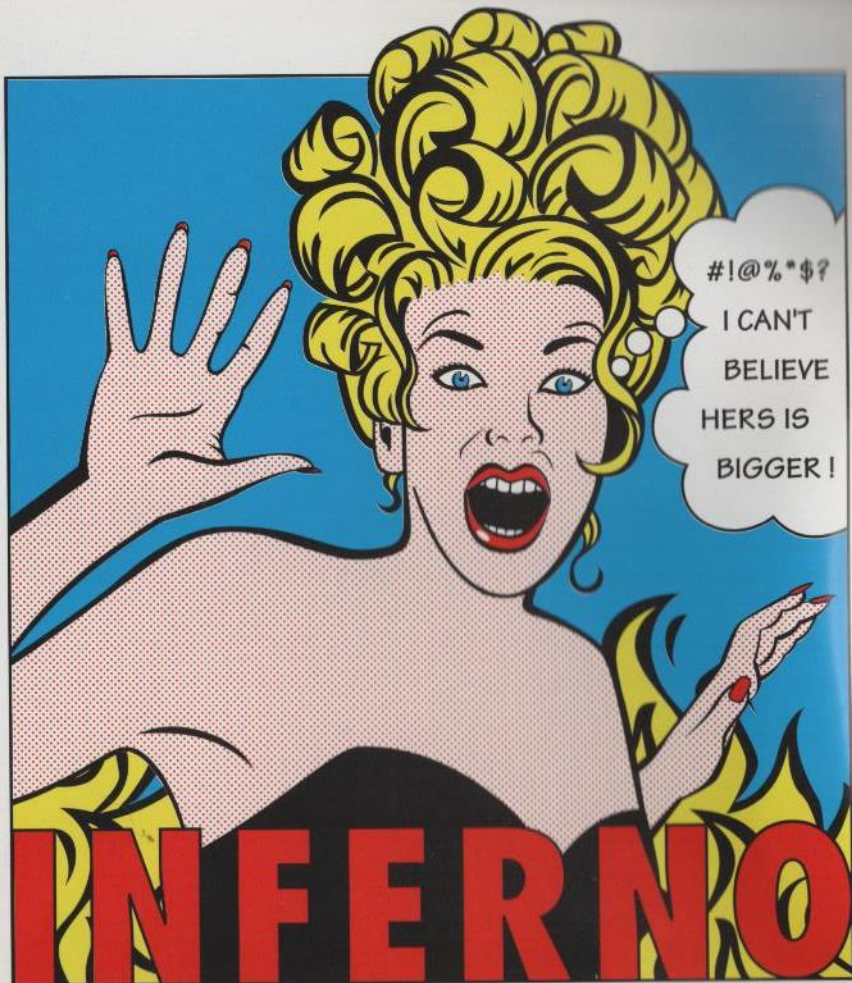

Gay Men's Health Summit Wellness, Community Building & Multi-Issue Advocacy

Several hundred gay men are expected to converge on Boulder, Colorado, from July 29-August 1 for the Gay Men's Health Summit to launch a multi-issue, multicultural gay men's health movement. The summit aims to broaden gay men's health efforts beyond its recent narrow focus on HIV prevention to include a wide array of health issues that gay men encounter.

"We are determined to transform health promotion for gay men from HIV prevention to a broader focus on wellness, community building, and multi-issue health advocacy," said Eric Rofes, long-time San Francisco community organizer and the summit's coordinator. "To bring down the level of HIV among gay men, we've got to develop new approaches to substance use, societal homophobia, and sexual health. HIV cannot continue as an all-encompassing metaphor for gay men's health. We've got to build a gay men's health movement as powerful as the movement to fight AIDS in the 1980s."

The summit will address a range of challenges to gay men's health and safety, including anti-gay violence, substance abuse, smoking, childhood sexual abuse, and eating disorders, as well as cancer, heart disease, hepatitis and HIV/AIDS.

While the Boulder County AIDS Project is hosting the summit and offering logistical support, organizers describe the summit as a grassroots effort beholden to no organizations, government officials, or major corporations. "The Boulder Summit is quickly evolving into a huge, independent grassroots effort to spur community-based organizing and activism around gay men's health," said Matt Brown of Boulder and one of the summit's organizers.

Two pre-conference meetings are planned. On Thursday, July 29, an all-day session coordinated by Philadelphia's David Acosta of Gay and Lesbian Latino/a AIDS Education Initiative will focus on health challenges facing men of color. This session is offered free to all summit registrants and will tackle difficult issues such as the relationship between racism and illness in gay communities of color, what gay men

of color have learned from HIV/AIDS that can inform broader work on health promotion, and the specific health agendas of Latino, African American, Asian and Pacific Islander, Native American, and Bi-Racial/Multi-Racial gay and bisexual men. Presenters will include David Velez of Boston's Latino Health Institute, A. Billy S. Jones, longtime health activist from Washington, D.C., and Martin Ornelas-Quintero of LLEGO.

The National Gay and Lesbian Task Force's Policy Institute will be hosting a special forum titled "Constructing a public policy agenda for gay men's health: What should our priorities be?" on Thursday, July 29 from 2:00-5:00 p. m. The forum will examine how activists can incorporate these concerns into advocacy at the local and national levels, and how a policy agenda may be moved forward. Sean Cahill, Research and Policy Director for the NGLTF Policy Institute, will moderate the forum.

While the three-day summit's program is still evolving, organizers have announced a range of events, cutting-edge research, and presentations. A series of key sessions will focus on gay men in their teens and 20's and explore this generation's relationship to sexual health and HIV, interactions with older generations, and relationship to gay identity and community. Sessions on "Empowering Young Fags," "Mobilizing Young Gay Men as Health Activists," and "Gay Youth as Health-Resilient Men," are in preparation, as will an experiential workshop confronting ageism, aging and generation gaps.

A plenary session exploring the relationship between masculinity and health in various gay male communities and cultures will break open discussion related to power, misogyny, sexual practices, and disease. An evening forum will tackle emerging subcultures of "barebackers," men who eroticize unprotected sex and debate ways in which health promotion might be employed within the bareback subculture.

Other special programming will include Eric Rofes's recently-completed slide show, "Gay Men's Sexual Civil Wars and The

Protease Moment" and a preview of a dramatic work-in-progress, Tony Valenzuela's one-man show, *Adventures of the Bareback Poster Boy*, chronicling his all-consuming struggle with HIV through his adventures as an activist, porn star, call boy and son.

A range of important research will be discussed at the summit, including initial findings on self-identified barebackers by San Francisco's Michael Scarce, author of *Smearing the Queer: Medical Bias in the Health Care of Gay Men*.

Data also will be presented on gay men's health issues from the Urban Men's Health Study, the first household-based probability sample of men who have sex with men in Chicago, Los Angeles, New York and San Francisco. Presentations from this data set concerning suicide among gay men, substance use epidemiology and connections between the experience of sexual abuse in childhood and high risk sexual behavior in adulthood will be given for the first time.

Because HIV/AIDS continues to affect many gay men of all colors and generations, key sessions will be devoted to HIV prevention, treatment, service delivery, and

communal response. Yet the summit is organized to encourage such efforts to occur within a broader context of gay men's mental, physical, spiritual, and sexual health and hence will tackle issues such as homophobia and racism, hepatitis, cancer and heart disease, eating disorders, depression and suicide, domestic violence, smoking, sex addiction, sexually-transmitted diseases, and a range of anorectal disorders. Action-oriented workshops will focus on post-summit follow-up activities, expanding gay men's health projects to areas where they are currently not under development, and the creation of a template for use by medical providers when taking sexual histories from gay men.

Among other sessions planned are "Mid-life Gay Male Sexual Replenishment: Viagra and Testosterone," "Promoting Health to Risk-Seeking Gay Men," "Health Challenges Facing Old (Gay) Men," "Is That A Nightstick in Your Pants or Are You Just Glad to See Me?—Health and Safety in Public Sex Spaces," "Not Only an Exit: Historical Attitudes Towards Anal Sex Between Men," "Health Issues Facing Homeless Gay Men," and "The Post-AIDS

Generation: Health Promotion Strategies By and For Young Gay Men." One session entitled "What Can Gay Men Learn from the Lesbian Health Movement?" will explore lessons learned from a decade of lesbian health organizing. Tracks of workshops on substance use/abuse, mental health, non-HIV sexually-transmitted diseases, activism and advocacy, HIV/AIDS, and rural gay men's health needs have been organized.

A special feature of the Boulder Summit will be an intensive focus on the health implications of the controversial party circuit, coordinated by Alan Brown, President of the Electric Dreams Foundation, a non-profit organization which promotes safer partying. In addition to a plenary session tackling a range of controversies surrounding circuit culture—gay health organizations' sponsorship of parties, drug use and sexual behavior patterns on the circuit, and body image and hypermasculinity—workshops will focus on the use of the drug GHB/GBL, the value of dance and celebration in gay subcultures, and the relationship between consumerism, commodification and health promotion.

An explosive trend in gay male sexual culture is the use of internet resources to find sex and community. Noted author and health researcher Dr. Michael Ross, a professor at University of Texas' School of Public Health, along with others will discuss research on cyberspace as a venue for counseling, research, and health promotion.

A range of other prominent health experts have signed on to participate and present at the Boulder Summit. Those seeking to register or make housing reservations should download materials from the Boulder County AIDS Project web site at www.bcap.org or contact Mark Beyer or Matt Brown at (303)444-6121 or email: summit@bcap.org. The conference site is the Regal Harvest House in Boulder and is wheelchair accessible.

The program for the summit is still in formation and additional presenters are needed in the following areas: health issues affecting Native American and Asian/Pacific Islander gay men, bears, leathermen, middle-aged and older gay men; smoking cessation programs; eating disorders; domestic violence; colon and prostate cancer; alcoholism; heart disease. 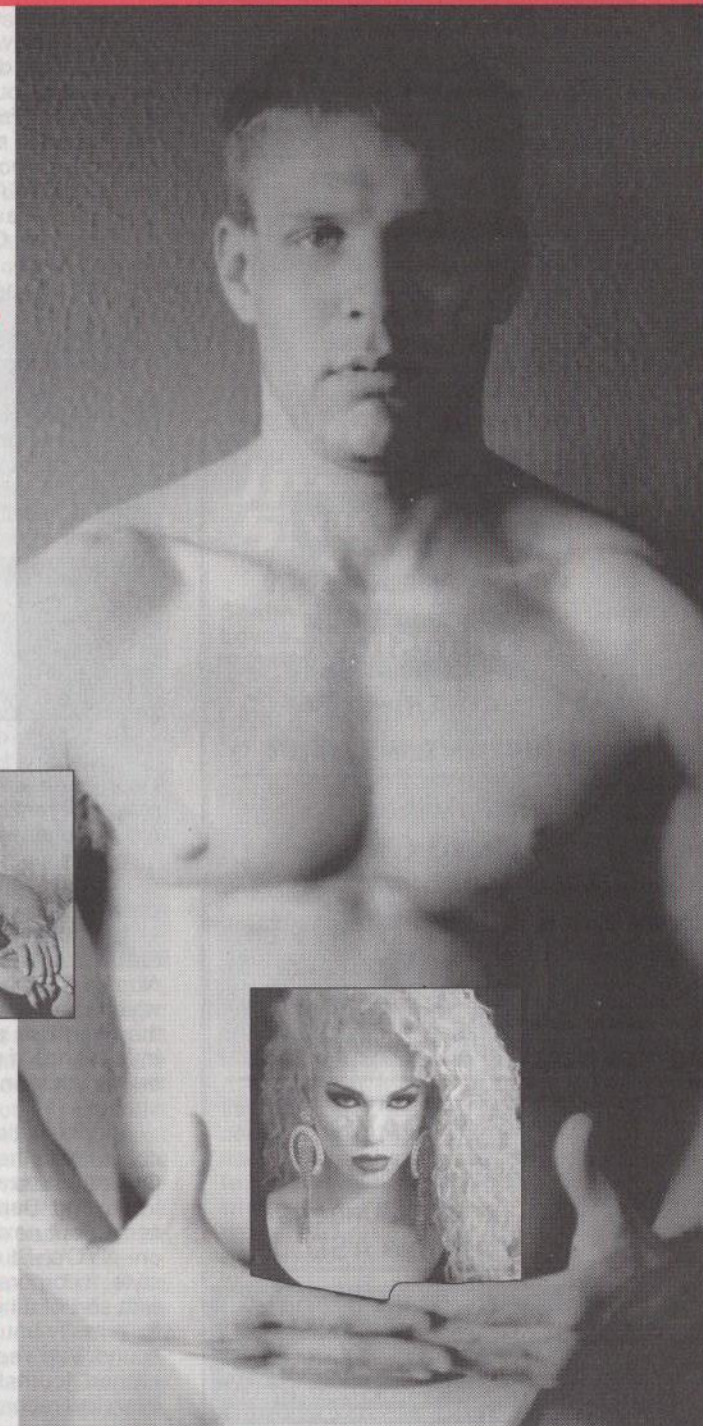

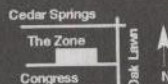

Sometimes we just need something that goes way out to the left in order to add a little drama to our listening collection. And our first selection this week certainly fits this mold. If you're really in the mood for something way out there, then check out **Frontside's** self-titled debut on TVT/Wax Trax. Frontside is a Melbourne-based DJ/producer duo made up of **Chris Arkley-Smith** and **Scott Simon**. Both emerged from the 80's ska and hardcore scene to discover the wave of dance music that was breaking ail over the globe.



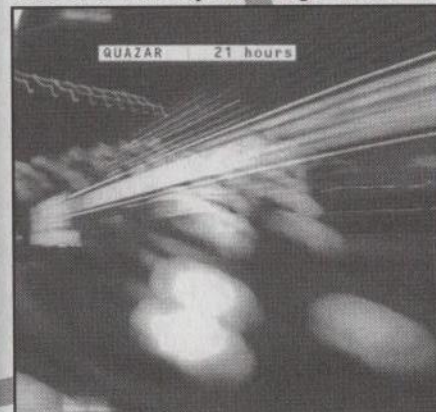
Their style comes without a cut and dry category to place them in as they incorporate everything from techno to melodic breakbeat to funky acid in their productions. Frontside creates an amalgam of sounds ranging from very hard progressive acid beats to very atmospheric and the ethereal. Highlights of the album include "Dammerung" (which was featured on **Sasha and Digweed's Northern Exposure 2**), "Mind Distortion" which is more on the funky acid tip, and the relentless pounding found in "Down In My Mind". If you're a wuss, don't bother with this one—it's only for the head-strong!

Another little tasty electronic morsel comes via the *21 Hours* album from **Quazar**. Quazar is the team of **Gert Van Veen** and **Daphne Mollee**. This piece comes out next week here in the states on NYC's Studio K7 label. Quazar's style incorporates modern club music with sort of a home-spun chillin' out vibe for a really unusual, yet oddly appealing sound. Van Veen is also quite an accomplished journalist and has utilized his interview recordings of several figures in

the electronic music scene for *21 Hours*—such as **Underworld** member **Karl Hyde** and Detroit's own **Derrick May**.

One of the notable things about Quazar is that they are actually able to go out and perform live and were actually voted best Dutch live act in 1997. Additionally, you might want to go back and grab a copy of the group's 1997 album *Flight-recorder* (way kooll) as well. Pay a visit to www.superstition.de for more information on Quazar.

If you are into collecting novelty items, then you might try out the Cleopatra label's release of *Virgin Voices: A Tribute to Madonna*. The label has enlisted the talents of a wide stylistic range of acts for

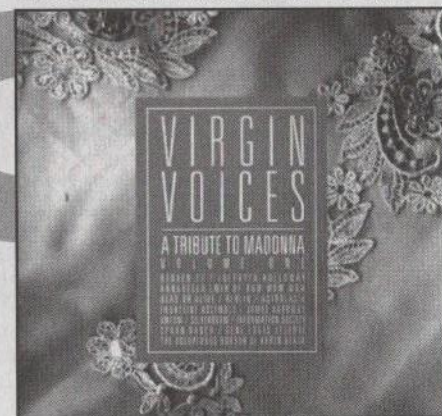


this tribute covering many of Madonna's greatest hits. While an ardent fan might find an album such as this bordering on blasphemy, I found it flattering to say the least. While my personal taste wasn't quite in line on a few of the tracks, I couldn't help but appreciate the great job that was done on pairing the right band in each case. **Infomation Society** rocks a juicy version of "Express Yourself", **Heaven 17** is a perfect choice to redo "Holiday", and **Berlin** does a haunting rendition of "Live To Tell". But I have to say that the best jobs were those on the harder tip. **Frontline Assembly** went off for "Justify My Love", **Silverbeam** nails "Bedtime Story", but my favorites have to be

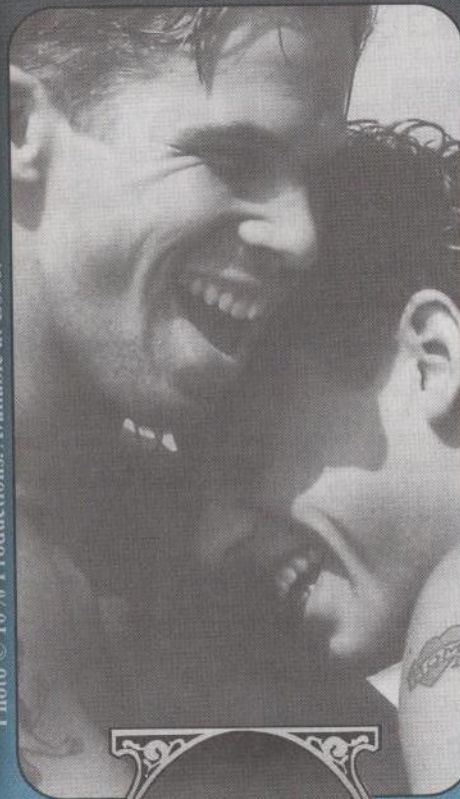

"Balls To Keep"

This past week I got an e-mail from a fellow who wrote me about his need for testosterone replacement. Since he had been castrated some years ago, he had no testicles or scrotum. Thinking about not having testicles or even a scrotum is a very difficult concept for a man to imagine. It's a subject that usually freaks guys out and sends other guys running. Castration, although an interesting subject, is not what we are going to concentrate on today; however, we are going to talk about how to keep those "family jewels" and the "jewel bag" for good.

Testicular cancer affects approximately 3 out of every 1,000 men. Interesting, huh? I never knew that before. It is the most common form of cancer in men age 15 to 35 years old. It has a higher incidence than prostate and lung cancer in men in this age group. Testicular cancer in young boys accounts for about 3 percent of all testicular cancers. No one knows exactly why testicular cancer occurs or how it happens. An abnormal growth of cancer cells in the testicle eventually causes it to become enlarged or to develop a lump that can be seen or felt. Any man with at least one testicle is capable of contracting testicular cancer. Some men are predisposed to getting testicular cancer. Those men, who as young boys had an undescended testicle (a condition where one testicle or both do not complete the natural passage from inside the abdomen down into the scrotum). If one testicle has not descended, there is a 10 percent chance of developing a tumor on the opposite testicle. Mumps, orchitis, inguinal hernia or a previous testicular

cancer in the other testicle, are all possible risk factors for developing cancer of the testicle. These tumors develop in specialized cells within the testicle tissue. Leydig cells (cells that produce testosterone) and Sertoli cells (cells that provide nourishment for the sperm) are where the tumors generally spring up. The tumors, oddly enough, are found mostly in the right testicle. If you are still with me, here's the good news. Testicular cancer is treatable and curable if found early enough. It responds very well to treatment, even if it has spread to other parts of the body.

Testicular cancer may be classified as follows. About 40 percent of all testicular cancers are seminomas. Twenty percent are spermatocystic embryonal carcinomas. Sixty percent of testicular cancer in young boys is found to be yolk sac tumor. Teratomas are found in about 4 percent of adult men and 40 percent of young boys. Something called choriocarcinoma is a very rare form of testicular cancer. The testicles, as you all know are responsible for the production of the hormone testosterone. Testosterone, has many uses. It helps makes men have deep voices, grow hair and muscles and is responsible for libido. The testicles can not be induced to produce more testosterone than normal with a supplement like Androstene (which I reported on last week). The testicles are also responsible for the production of sperm.

It is a fact, the earlier the diagnosis, the better your chances of a cure. So here are the symptoms to watch for. 1) A lump in either testicle. 2) Any enlargement of the testicle. 3) A feeling of heaviness in the scrotum. 4) A

dull ache in the lower abdomen or the groin area. 5) A sudden collection of fluid in the scrotum (this could also signify hernia). 6) Pain or discomfort in the testicle or scrotum. 7) Enlargement or tenderness of the breasts.

Remember, these signs are not sure signs of cancer. They can be caused by other conditions, like hernia or urinary infection. It is important to see a doctor if any of these symptoms occur longer than two weeks. Like I said before, the earlier the lump is found and diagnosed, the better the chances for a cure. If you find yourself in the urologists' office... good for you! You have made a wise decision. Here's what to expect. To diagnose testicular cancer, the doctor will probably run blood work. Special lab tests can detect tumor markers, or certain substances in the blood. An x-ray of the kidneys and urinary system (usually a CT or CAT scan). Ultrasonography, which creates a picture from the echos of high-frequency soundwaves bounced off internal organs may also be used. To confirm these reports, a physician may perform an inguinal orchiectomy. A procedure where some of the affected tissue is removed through the groin. If you are found to have cancer of the testicle, here are the treatment modalities you may be able to chose from with your doctor. Non-surgical treatments may be chemotherapy and radiation therapy. Chemotherapy may also be used after surgery, if the physician detects that the cancer has migrated to other parts of the body. Radiation therapy, a local treatment, treats mostly the affected tissue. Seminomas are highly sensitive to this treatment.

Although any man can get testicular cancer, it is a rare disease. It accounts for only 1 percent of all cancers in the U.S. among men. It is not contagious, no one can catch it from another person. Self-examination is your best defense against testicular cancer. Examine your testicles about once a month. After a warm shower, support your testicles with one hand and roll each one softly with the other hand. You will feel the smooth bump, or epididymis, which covers the top, back and bottom of each testicle. If you find a hard, usually painless mass in the testicle, like a pebble or a peanut, see a doctor right away.
