





### LEGS WIDE SHUT! TRICK EXPLORES TWO MEN'S QUEST FOR A LITTLE MEANINGLESS SEX

W ho needs love and devotion when there's a stunning go-go dancer ready, willing and oh-so-able to fulfill a night of fantasy-fulfilling sex? OK, so that's a trick question. But in one tight little package, that's the basic premise to the gay one-night-stand comedy, Trick.

Of course, there is a little more to the plot than that. The story centers around a young musical theatre writer named Gabriel (Christian Campbell-yes, that's Neve's brother) who needs to better understand the complex emotions about which

he writes. It doesn't help that his songs are belted out to his writing class by his over-eager, ditzy actress friend, Katherine (Tori Spelling). So, one night while at a popular bar, he catches the eye of a thong-clad go-go boy named Mark (John Paul Pitoc) and they eventually end up on the same subway. Gabriel decides to seize the moment and takes Mark home for a little naked action. That's all much easier than it sounds, as it turns out.

thanks to dozens of obstacles thrown their way throughout the night. Cold shower anvone?

This all may come across a bit contrived, but fortunately, clever writing and direction by Jason Schafer and Jim Fall, respectively, keeps Trick from turning into a made-for-the-big-screen, 90-minute sitcom. The characters actually achieve a great amount of depth through highly relatable (although extreme) circumstances and on-the-money acting by the key performers.

Campbell and Pitoc are engaging leading men who bring some awkwardly hot chemistry together. You'll know what I mean when you see the under-the-piano fantasy scene. Pitoc's ability to transcend the typical brainless dancer stereotype was an amazing feat in itself.

I'm sure by now you've heard about Spelling's much-publicized, nepotism-free role in Trick, and the fact is, whatever positive buzz she gets-she deserves. At least thanks to this great comedic role, she should never have to be one of those actresses forced to make melodramatic dribble like Mother, May I Sleep with



Danger? on TV. Oh wait, never mind.

As bitter-old-drag-queen Miss Coco Peru, Clinton Leupp threatens to steal the show, but I think that award clearly belongs to Steve Hayes, who plays Gabriel's cabaret-lovin' friend, Perry. It's this great father-figure friend who helps Gabriel realize his songs are lacking, well, oomph! And he should know, because his musical number at Eighty Eight's is the one real showstopper (just slightly above Tori's french fry fit).

"Filming that song was scary for me, though. When I went in, they told me I was going to have to sing the song a cappella

to everyone in the room. I told [the film-makers], you're going to have a lot of angry extras, but it turned out ok," Hayes told me in a recent interview, in which I was hoping to get enough juicy gossip from the set to sell to The Weekly World News and build a pool in my backyard. So, I probed Hayes for some dirt.

"I was so fortunate to have such a wonderful movie be my first one. It's a lovely, romantic, funny, delightful movie and I'm very proud of it," Hayes said. "It was a delightful shoot. Everybody had such a good time and we all liked the material so much. That makes all the difference."

OK, so I guess next summer's going to be another one spent running through the sprinklers. But it was nice to hear such good karma generated from any movie set these days.

And whether it had anything to do with him or not, it's his wonderful personality that shines from everybody in the film, making *Trick* at the top of my list of all the gay movies that have blessed us this summer. It's simple, sweet and a whole lot of fun—a great gay date movie, if ever there was one.
