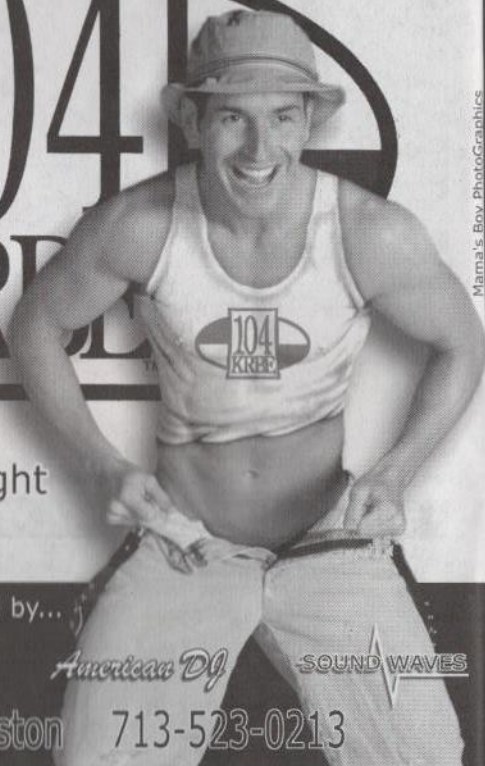

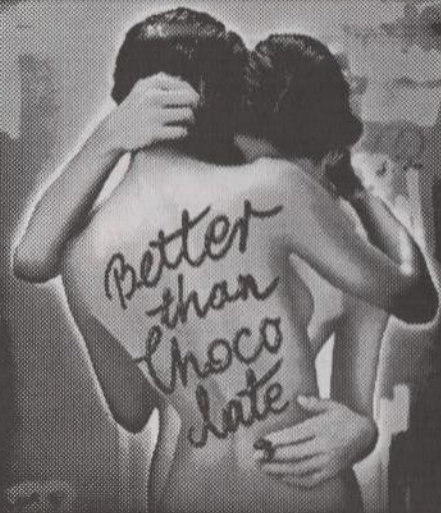

Costa Rica Part III: The Atlantic Coast

Dear TWT,

For my next weekend trip, I headed out to Limon Province on the Caribbean coast. If you take a bus or drive (again, I suggest a four-wheel-drive) from San Jose, you first go through a thick rain forest in majestic mountains. Then you're out on a long sunny stretch that ends in the city of Puerto Limon. If you fly, the little oceanside airport in Puerto Limon is where you will land.

Ah, but the drive through the rainforest is so beautiful—a bit scary, too, with all of the long haul trucks speeding by on the mostly two-lane, cliff-hanging highway. The ride takes you through one of the wildest parts of the country, which, believe it or not, is just on the outskirts of the metropolis of San Jose. Much of this area consists of the **Braulio Carrillo National Park**, a 111,000 acre protected rainforest. Everyone I spoke to recommended touring the park with a guide for purposes of safety or visiting some of the privately owned land just outside the park, rather than just pulling over to walk one of the short hiking trails that are along the highway. The folks I traveled with and I decided to stop at one of the most popular spots along the way—the Aerial Tram of the rainforest. This amazing place is full of flora, fauna and lots of rain!

The trek into the privately owned reserve involves taking a tractor deep into the forest. The destination is a little compound of thatched roof buildings, including a restaurant, a shop, a small exhibition area and a video theater. There you line up for the one mile tram ride into and above the trees. We opted for a Spanish speaking guide and I actually understood most of what was said, *que milagro!* (what a miracle). However, since he also spoke English, as well as four other languages, he was able to explain things when one of us didn't quite get it in Spanish.

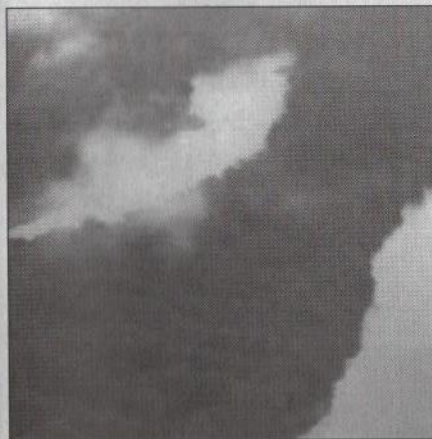
After watching an informative video, we put on our rain parkas, piled into the gondola and lifted off. At different times during the 90 minute ride we were close to the ground, hovering above the stream, climbing to the tree

tops or gliding along the canopy of the forest. Bromeliads, orchids, monkeys, toucans, ant eaters and hundreds of things I could not recognize were all around us. It seemed like dusk when we were near the ground and dawn when we were higher. It was a peaceful and breathtaking experience. After the tram ride, we headed back to the reserve's entrance. The little creek we crossed on the way in was now more like a raging river since it had overrun the road, it prevented us from taking the tractor all the way back to the parking lot. This apparently happens frequently, because nearby there is a small foot path leading up to a little suspended footbridge. We crossed the rushing water in the darkness of the rainforest—a little spooky and thrilling! Then it was on to Limon.



Limon is the least populated province in Costa Rica. With beautiful beaches that are sometimes black sand and sometimes white, it is also an area with a unique heritage. Afro-Caribbean and Chinese people immigrated to the area in the last century to work on the building of the railroad. Today, many of their and other immigrant descendants work in

fishing, shipping, farming and tourism. Costa Rica's highest concentrations of indigenous people live in the southern part of the province, the **Talamanca** region. These indi-



viduals are mostly members of the **Bribris** and **Cabecas** tribes. Since about one third of the people in the province are descendants of immigrants from Jamaica and other Caribbean islands, many people speak an English patois, as well as Spanish. We found all the locals friendly, helpful and charming.

Don't believe the negative things you may read in some guide books—**Puerto Limon** is a charming place, steeped in history, although it is very economically depressed. Its town square faces the Caribbean with a pedestrian mall covering several blocks of its main street. It has a bustling little market where many restaurants serving "tipico" foods can be found. We heard wonderful tales of the annual Mardi Gras-like festival, "El Dia de las Culturas," an October 12 holiday honoring all of Costa Rica's heritages. It is celebrated nationwide, but most popularly in Puerto Limon with a festive carnival. The parades and partying apparently go on for days, so one must reserve a room in advance. In February, there is a world renowned surfing championship on **Playa Bonita** to the north of town that also sounds like it would be fun. A little north of Puerto Limon is **Moin**, where there are independent boaters who will take you up the canals to **Tortuguero**. This is the largest nesting area in the Caribbean for green sea turtles. **Tortuguero National Park** is supposed to be a great destination for naturalists.

We decided, however, to head south. Our first stop was the National Park at **Cahuita**,

where we relaxed on beautiful beaches lined with coconut trees. Here lies what has been referred to as one of the finest coral reefs outside of Australia. We saw children doing their homework under the lush greenery on the beach. It's just the neighborhood to them! Next was **Puerto Viejo de Talamanca**, where I was reminded of Jamaica. A popular destination for European visitors, especially Italians, it's a beautiful little town with dirt roads, miles of beaches, lots of rastas, tons of cabinas, quite a few villas and the sound of reggae music everywhere. We stayed in a pretty little cabina, **Monte Sol**, owned by a very nice straight German couple. I slept under a mosquito net for the first time and loved it. The beautiful beaches of **Playa Chiquita** and **Playa Uva** are located just south of Puerto Viejo and were wonderful



places to while away the hours in the sun.

The nonprofit Talamanca Ecotourism and Conservation Association (ATEC) has an interesting little office in Puerto Viejo. There, we got lots of useful information and I used a computer terminal to check email. ATEC's purpose is to promote socially responsible tourism, ethnic pride and local ownership and management of tourism facilities. Although there do not seem to have been any lesbigan bars, per se, the bar at the hotel **Villa Paraiso** has a friendly reputation, as does **El Duende Feliz**, with its Italian cuisine. The national GLBT organization, **Triangulo Rosa**, maintains an office in Puerto Limon.

This refreshing trip was another nice break from the hustle and bustle of San Jose. Next I will tell you about several brief day trips one can make from the city. Till then, ...Fagabond!

The Berdache:

Early Native Americans Revered Their Gender-Benders

Native American tribal leaders probably smile when they hear about some controversy in the news regarding cross-dressing and gender-bending. After all, in dozens of Native American tribes the berdache [a generic term] was not only common, but was a special and revered individual who held a spiritual-advisor and/or medicine-man position.

For centuries, the berdache [N.A. French, from French bardache, catamite; from Italian dialectal bardascia; from Arabic bardaj, slave; from Persian bardah, prisoner] existed in dozens of cultures around the globe.

In the Navajo nation, it was the "Nadle," a "Winkte" among the Lakotas, "Lhamana" in the Zuni tribe, Mojave "Shaman", Potawatomi "M'nuhto," while Cheyennes called this tribal member a "Hemaneh" (half man-half woman).

Since the Native American berdache was not a "boy prostitute" [as in the earlier French usage of the term], the term has come into disfavor as being pejorative--like "fag" and similar epithets. The preferred terminology is transgendered Native American, "two-spirit person" or "true-spirit person."

In Wendy Susan Parker's article, "The Berdache Spirit," Parker wrote that the berdache existed "in almost every single North American tribe, especially in the mid-west, great plains and the southwest. A study of Indian berdache culture could teach us all a way to break out of the narrow-minded Western model of 'deviance' and allow us to appreciate the beautiful diversity of the human population in our species of human-kind, wherever they may fall along the spectrum of the beautiful gender rainbow."

Gary Bowen, in his article "Trans-gendered Native Americans," said that "probably the most famous Native American transgendered person was We'Wha, a Zuni. She was a notable craftswoman, and greatly admired by her people and by white people.

Later, when it was discovered that she had male genitalia, her white supporters continued to refer to her as a woman, and to discount the significance of her discordant genitalia, in concordance with tribal custom."

Laura Darlene Lansberry wrote, after visiting the grave of We'Wha on the Zuni reservation in New Mexico: "We'wha was born in

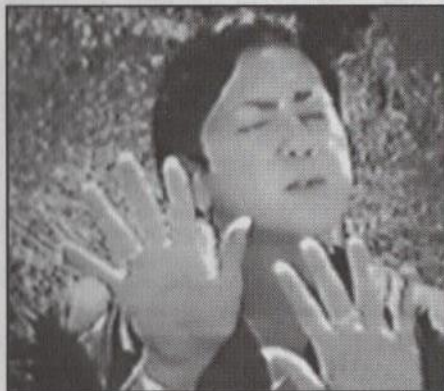

1849, 28 years after the abandonment of the Catholic mission at Zuni. It was against this backdrop that We'wha grew up, and would become the most notable and remarkable character of her tribe. The Speaker of the House, John Carlisle and other dignitaries and socialites befriended the Zuni princess in her role as ambassador of the Zuni people."

Do the berdache exist today? The person known as Cherokee Rose calls himself a two-spirit person. His father was Cherokee, and his mother Irish/Bulgarian. He said he "knew at an early age that I was different from other children."

He added that "I try to live according to the ancient ways of the Cherokee. It has taken me most of my life to understand and accept the gift of being a two-spirit person. For many, being transgendered is a curse but for me it is a blessing." Cherokee Rose

Ray Maracle, Helping Hands coordinator for Being Alive San Diego (the largest AIDS/HIV organization in the city), is a member of the Six Nations Band of the Mohawk Nation. Maracle said that "two-spirit persons were able to walk in both worlds. They were great spiritual leaders and healers." What happened to many in the past, he said, is that "white conquerors actually purged them. Two-spirited people were once hunted down and killed," he said.

Maracle said this was a common practice: "if you want to destroy a society, eliminating the teachers was the thing to do." Today, there is an increased awareness of the two-spirit person, Maracle added, and "more acceptance, especially among Native Americans who follow the traditional path."

One of the newest books on this subject is "Changing Ones: Third and Fourth Genders in Native North America," by Will Roscoe (St. Martins Press, 1998, hardcover). Roscoe is also the author of "Living the

Spirit: A Gay American Indian Anthology" (St. Martins, 1988, paperback). Roscoe's website is www.geocities.com/WestHollywood/Stonewall/3044/.

Two-Spirit People is a 20-minute color video by Michel Beauchemin, Lori Levy and Gretchen Vogel. It is distributed by Frameline Distributing of San Francisco, the only national distributor for promotion, distribution and exhibition of lesbian and gay films/videos.

Frameline's description of the video: "An overview of historical and contemporary Native American concepts of gender, sexuality and sexual orientation. This documentary explores the berdache tradition in Native American culture, in which individuals who embody feminine and masculine qualities act as a conduit between the physical and spiritual world, and because of this are placed in positions of power within the community."

Anthropologists, psychologists and historians have written many other books and articles on the subject. Check your local library or gay bookstore for more titles on this fascinating history that has been buried too long by heterosexual America.

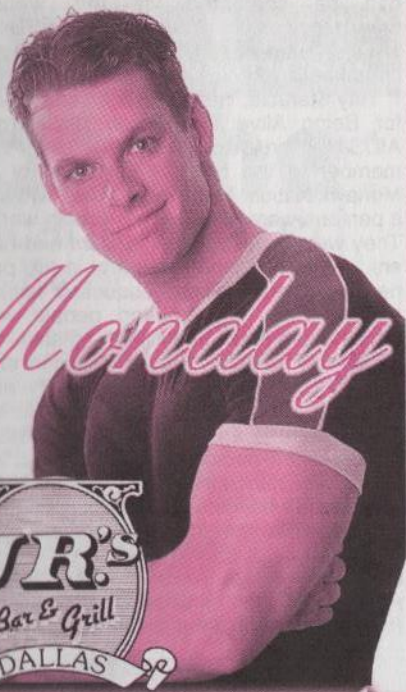

RELAX...IT REALLY IS A COMEDY
NEW GAY FILM TACKLES DIFFICULT
ISSUES WITH STYLE & WIT

There's a clever opening sequence at the beginning of *Relax...It's Just Sex* that perfectly lampoons those sanitized, gosh-golly, '50s-era educational filmstrips that many of us were shown in school to learn about the birds and the bees. Only this time around, the purpose is to educate a presumably straight audience on what gay men and lesbians look like, as well as what they do for "fun", if you catch my drift. Basically it's a warn-

the first half of the film, every indication is that *Relax* is simply an intelligently written ensemble comedy that is largely populated with gay characters. There's Vincey (Mitchell Anderson), a struggling gay playwright looking for Mr. Play Right. His eccentric, "don't-call-her-fag-hag" fag hag, Tara (Jennifer Tilly) is the group's Julie McCoy—always trying to be cruise director to their passengers. In between organizing elaborate dinner

parties and other fabulous soirees, Tara is also trying to get pregnant with her boyfriend Gus (Timothy Paul Perez), who is less than eager to be the sperm donor.

and a better companion, too.

And there you have the basic subplots, in all their complicated, Jerry Springer-worthy glory. The brilliant thing about this movie, however, is that what may sound trivial and disposable on the surface turns into a relevant, if somewhat melodramatic, piece of gay cinema magic. As gay movies have become more prominent (which I've stated several times in my recent reviews), there has been a trend toward more fluffy, easily-digestible-by-Middle-America, homophobic-friendly queer films. In other words, they've been playing it safe for a chance at mass appeal (*In and Out*, anyone?).

Relax brings stereotypical gay themes—AIDS, gay bashing, gay male promiscuity—back to the foreground with surprising effectiveness. It is, in fact, a gay-bashing scene where the movie takes its first true turn toward darkness. This scene is at once liberating for its turnabout revenge standpoint, and disturbing for its brutal sexuality. It is one of the most powerful segments of any movie I've seen in quite a while, and that's not just because it's a hot button issue for our community. The raw emotions elicited from each actor in this scene alone are spellbinding and frighteningly believable. Another rarity is the film's ability to rebound from such heavy-handedness and get back on the comic track, thanks mostly to the diversely talented cast.

Everyone delivers solid performances, but Tilly and Petty are practically perfect as the two "big names" in the cast. Much like Melanie Griffith, it's hard to accept Tilly as a serious actress because of her voice, but she proves herself more than worthy of such a meaty role. Petty is very much at ease in lesbian mode, furthering continued speculation about her personal business—but I'll leave that exploration to *E! True Hollywood Story*.

As for the film's funniest moment, I would have to give that to Megan's heterosexual coming out scene with her parents. I won't spoil it here, but it's every gay person's dream come true and a classic film moment.

Relax...It's Just Sex is a rare opportunity to participate in gay cinema's most recent evolution—complex, witty and heartfelt filmmaking. Check it out.

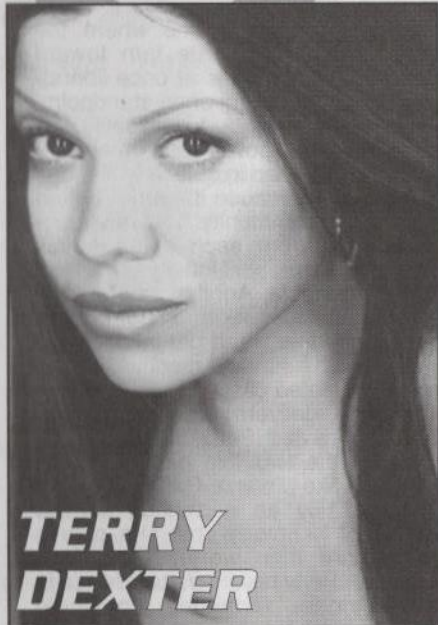

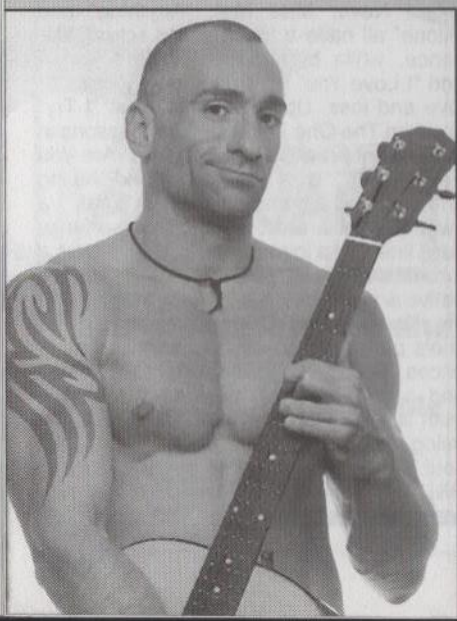

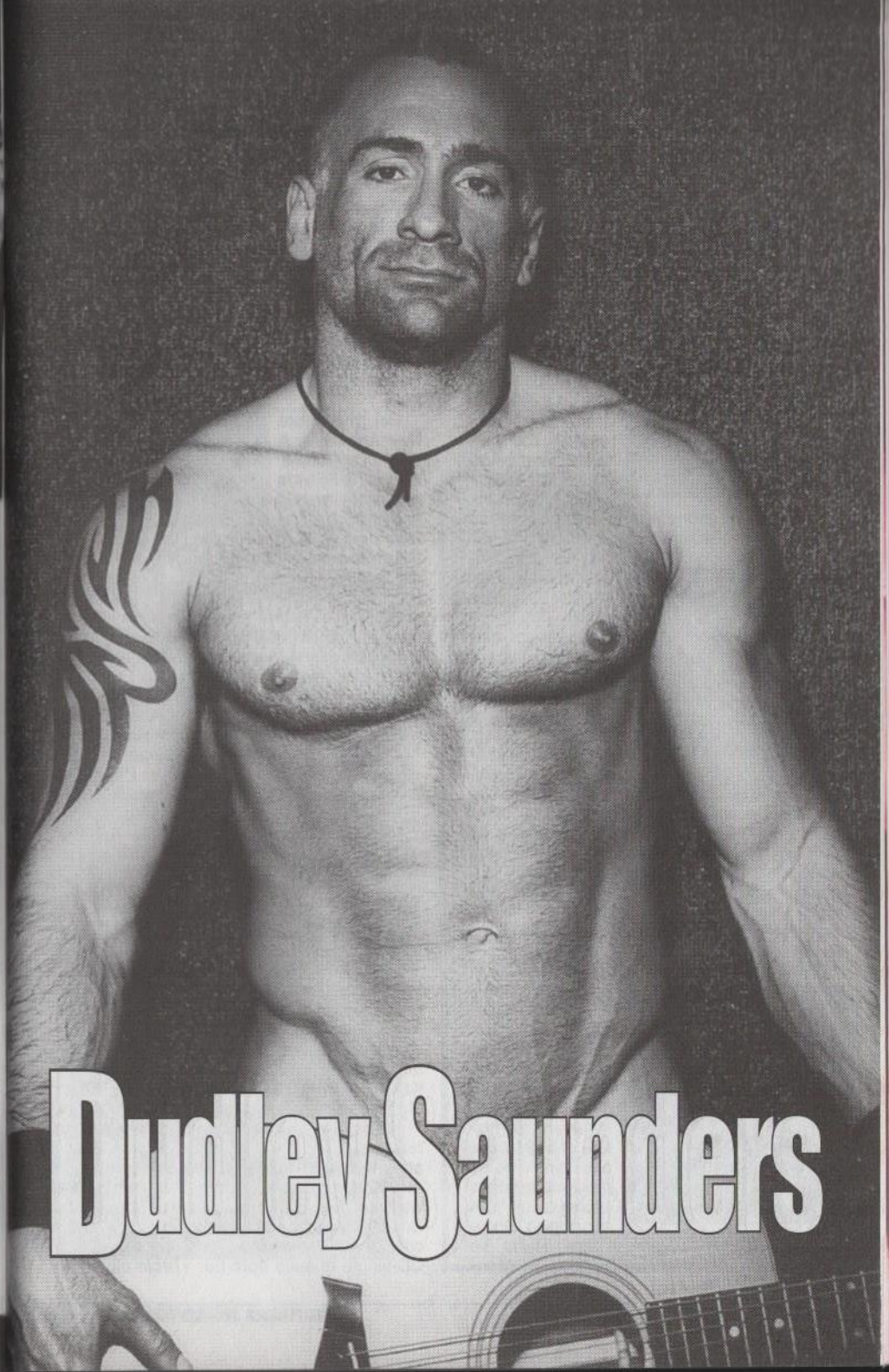

Onda Sonora: Red Hot + Lisbon is the eleventh in a series of AIDS awareness and



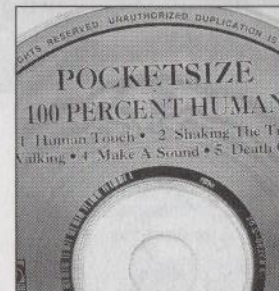
