GIRLS WHO LIKE BOYS... WHO ARE GIRLS?!

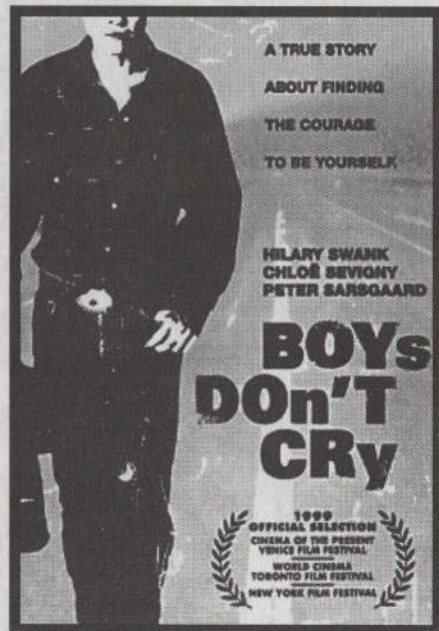
**POWERFUL DRAMA BASED ON THE
BRANDON TEENA CASE EVOKES
INTENSE EMOTIONS**

With gay comedies bombarding theaters at an amazingly high rate, I was caught quite off-guard by *Boys Don't Cry*, the tale of a girl pretending to be a boy. At first thought, it has zany *Tootsie*-esque hijinks written all over it, but nothing could be further from the truth.

On New Year's Eve 1993, Brandon Teena was murdered in cold blood by two ex-cons who had learned a deadly secret: his real name was Teena Brandon, and indeed, he was a she. Now don't worry, I'm not spoiling the ending. Much like *Titanic*, to use an elementary example, this film is presented under the assumption that you know how it will end. It's this knowledge that makes you hypersensitive to the characters and their interactions with one another, allowing you to pinpoint precise moments that will factor into Brandon's demise. It also heightens the impending tragedy when Brandon exhibits happiness and is accepted in the way he wants to be perceived.

The film starts off as Teena (Hilary Swank) is having her hair cut to look like a young man, making her transformation into Brandon complete. In order to make a fresh start as a male, Brandon heads off to Falls City, Nebraska where he immediately wins over the citizens of the mostly blue collar rural burg. The girls all love him, from Candace (Alicia Goranson), who has her sights set on him as husband material, to Lana (Chloë

Sevigny), who is also the recipient of Brandon's affection. Even the good-ol' boys John (Peter Sarsgaard) and Tom (Brendan Sexton III) welcome him into the fold as an adventurous, daredevil buddy.



Brandon's masquerade fares well for a good amount of time, with the minor inconveniences of a monthly period and the daily decision whether to stuff his

pants with a sock or a realistic dildo. However, it isn't long before things take a turn for the worse. His downfall begins when his petty criminal past comes back to haunt him and his name is published in the local newspaper as Teena Brandon and he's sent to a women's jail. From there, a domino effect of increasingly bad events shatters his false identity once and for all.

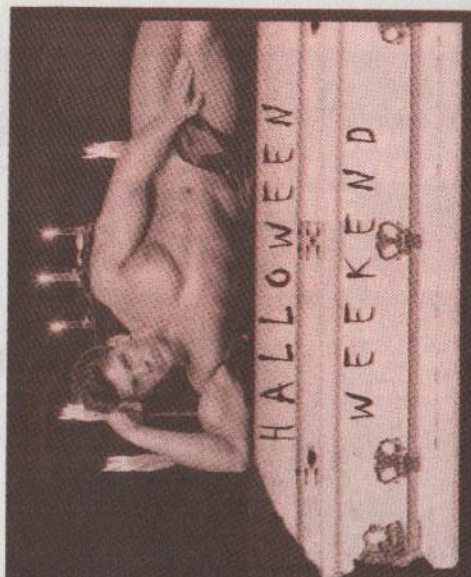
To say that Swank's performance is one of the most intriguing and heart-wrenching of the year is a huge understatement. She brings depth to the character through humor, naïveté and compassion in a very disarming manner. Stranger still, she makes a *very* cute guy, which really played with my mind. I began seeing her as a gay man rather than a lesbian, which, to say the least, is half of what the real Brandon hoped for. If the Academy has any guts, Swank deserves not only a nomination, but the Best Actress award itself. As love interest Lana, Sevigny is mesmerizing and exhibits a believability that's hard to imagine the real Lana possessing, let alone the actress portraying her.

Other notable performances come from Goranson (Roseanne's original Becky), Sarsgaard, Sexton and Jeanette Arnette as Lana's mom. The entire ensemble is eerily believable as prisoners of small town economics and closed-minded beliefs.

Writer/director Kimberly Peirce became engulfed in Brandon's story, spending years researching and interviewing actual people from the case. As with many 'based on truth' stories, she has embellished here and there, and pieced together information to propel the storyline as well as better develop the characters and their motives. Regardless, the heart of the tragic fantasy lived by Brandon Teena remains intact.

Further differentiating the film from made-for-TV-type fare, *Boys Don't Cry* utilizes innovative cinematography and haunting imagery, making it an artistic and emotional, celebratory masterpiece of the human spirit.

Boys Don't Cry begins its exclusive engagement today, October 22, at UA Ciné in Dallas and Landmark's River Oaks Theatre in Houston. The film opens on November 5 at Landmark's Dobie Theatre in Austin.

MORE STRENGTH WITH CROSS TRAINING

Lots of us work out on a regular basis, exercising and working really hard. We're in the gym every day, pumping and sweating, doing the same things over and over again. Soon we become bored with our routines and inevitably find ourselves asking the proverbial question, "Why am I *not* getting any bigger?"

Well, the answer is no secret and lies in the question. Doing the same thing over and over again gains *nothing!* Variety, however, gets you everything! That's what cross training is all about. The term cross training has little to do with the sneakers you wear and everything to do with what you actually do, and the way you do it. The text book definition goes like this, "The method of training in which a variety of exercises and changes in body positions or modes of exercise are utilized to positively affect compliance and motivation, and also stimulate additional strength gains or reduce injury risk". For our purposes, I'd like to focus on ways to build strength by giving you some tips to accomplish more in the gym.

All of us have a routine. The word itself conjures up boredom...*routine!* So if you're doing the same thing all the time, stop, or you'll never change your strength threshold. Why not change the sequence of the exercises you are already doing which will

create a new overload in the muscle. Instead of doing flat bench presses, then inclines then declines, switch them around. The fatigue pattern that is ingrained in the motor units of your muscles will be changed, causing you to adapt to a new stimulus. In turn, your muscles will grow!

Here's another tip...try changing the foundation exercises with different ones that work the same muscle group. The bench press can be replaced with push-ups or dumbbell presses. The giant pull-over can be replaced with dumbbell pull-overs. Straight arm pullbacks can be changed to dumbbell one arm rows. Think about the exercises you are doing now and interchange them with exercises that work the same muscles, but use different modalities (machines, free weights, rubber tubing etc.). Cross training even refers to changing the position of our bodies while performing an exercise. You'd be surprised how these small changes can result in big gains by recruiting different motor units. This holds true even if you are targeting the same muscle group and using similar joint actions. If you are going to try these tips, please do them safely. When in doubt, ask your certified personal trainer to help.

Cross training can improve and stimulate the body towards strength building and muscle gain. For us to train in an optimum way, it's always important, at times to provide a little shock to the body using variety. 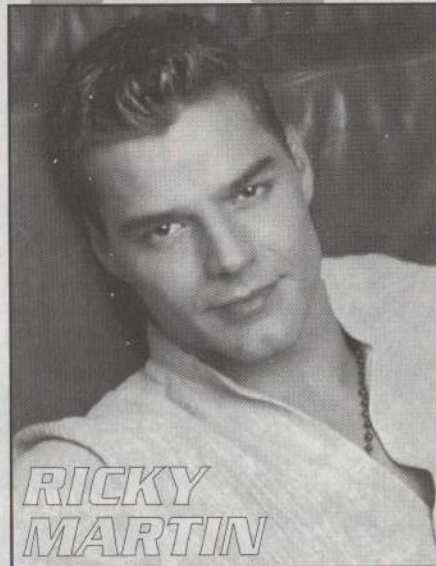

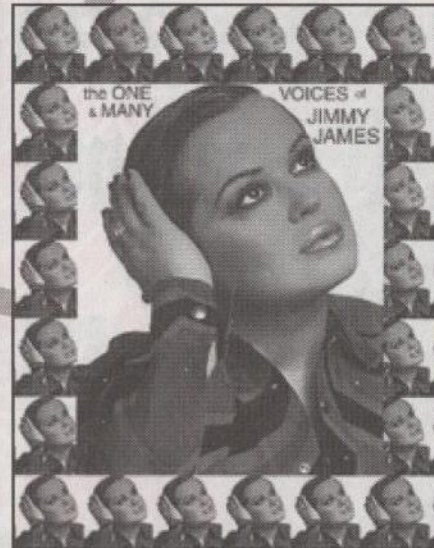

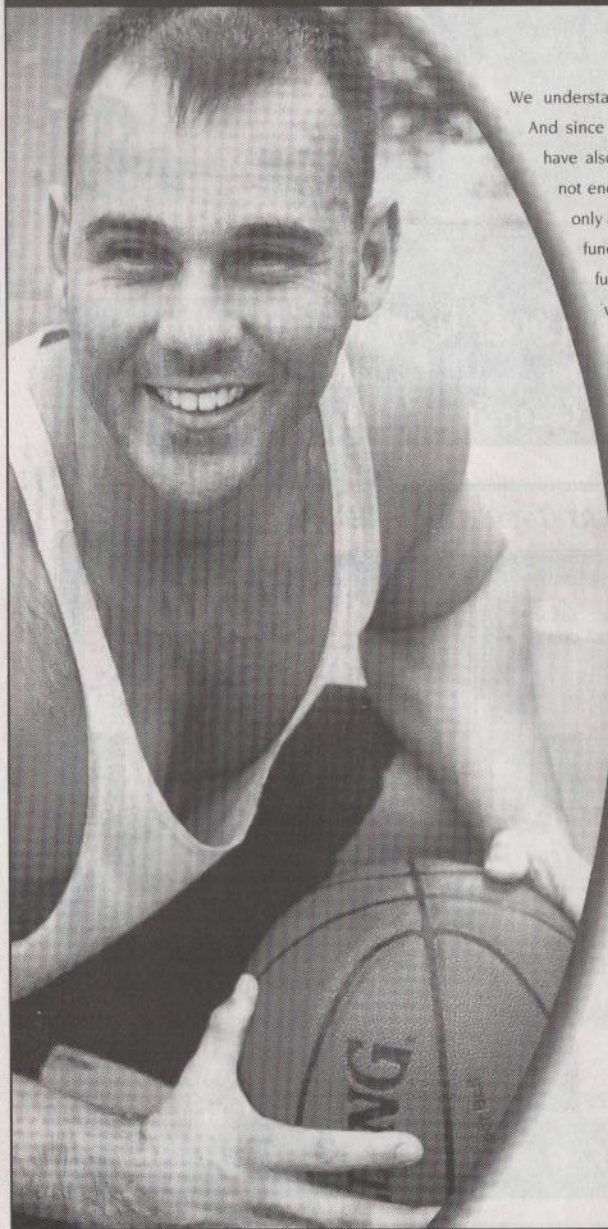

SLDN FUNDRAISER TO BE HELD IN ALAMO CITY

Fundraiser To Assist In The Fight Against Discrimination Directed At Gays In The Military

SAN ANTONIO – A key fundraising and public relations event is scheduled for November 6 at the Texas Highway Patrol Museum, 812 South Alamo St., from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. by the Servicemembers Legal Defense Network (SLDN) and SLDN Texas board member Chris Hammet.

The featured guest speaker will be Javier "Cortland" Torres, a gay soldier stationed at Ft. Campbell, Kentucky at the time of the murder of PFC Barry Winchell. Ft. Campbell

officials have announced that PVT Calvin Glover will be court marshalled on a charge of premeditated murder. Mr. Torres will be honored by the watchdog organization for his courage in the face of extreme prejudice.

Torres faced anti-gay harassment while serving and later, motivated by fear for his life, sought the assistance of SLDN which helped him come out to his command during this precarious time, provided for his safety and facilitated his discharge from the military. SLDN is currently seeking to hold accountable those who harassed Mr. Torres.

SLDN is an independent national legal aid and watchdog organization that assists men and women in the military who face persecution, hate crimes, harassment and discharge under "Don't Ask, Don't Tell, Don't Pursue." In the past six years, the organization has directly assisted more than 1,900 military service members in situations of this nature.

Terrence McNally's Latest, **CORPUS CHRISTI**

A little over a year ago playwright Terrence McNally, whose credits include *The Ritz*, *Master Class* and *Love! Valour! Compassion!*, was scheduled to begin production of his latest play, *Corpus Christi*. It was to be performed at the Manhattan Theatre Club in New York, a venue which has produced McNally's work for some time. When the news leaked that the play contained a gay depiction of Christ, the theater began to receive a deluge of hate mail, phone calls and death threats. In the face of such violent controversy, the theater canceled the production. What followed was a storm of counter-protests by such theater luminaries as Athol Fugard, Tony Kushner and Jon Robin Baitz, who threatened never to allow their works to be performed by the theater again, and to withdraw productions already scheduled. The theater reconsidered, and the performance opened under police protection, complete with metal detectors.

There was no hint of the hysteria and controversy surrounding *Corpus Christi* when it opened last week at Houston's The Little Room Downstairs Theater. Patrons and cast mingled in front of the theater in the balmy Houston October weather before the performance, and the atmosphere was quietly relaxed. The only tension came from some confusion about Little Room's new and slightly larger space and how to enter it. Once inside, all was calm.

The space, which I understand is not completely finished, affords an enlarged thrust stage, with seating one row deep in front, several rows on either side. This arrangement greatly improves the sight lines from the original space, but it places the front-row patrons uncomfortably close to the stage. This may be intentional, as it does increase the tension between the

actors and the audience. This is heightened by the device of allowing the house lights to remain on as the play begins again, very effective if the intention is to create a confrontational relationship between the audience and the actors. I'm not sure that's a good idea.

The cast of thirteen is presented one by one as "themselves", that is, actors playing a part. Then they are "baptized" by the actor playing "John" as the characters they will be playing. I found this device a little precious and difficult to keep up with, because it's only ten minutes into the play and there are already twenty-six names to remember. It gets worse, as each of the actors takes on even more roles as they double and triple other characters.

Corpus Christi is the story of "Joshua", whose birth, life and death closely parallels that of Christ. Joshua grows up in Corpus Christi, Texas, and incidentally, did the playwright. As a young gay man, he goes through the persecutions and experiences common to young gay men everywhere, with the added burden of the persistent belief that he may be the son of God. In fact, a portentous offstage voice keeps telling him he is.

Is he or isn't he? I'm not sure McNally ever really says. He avoids calling him "Jesus", but others in the cast do. In the end he is hounded for his beliefs, arrested and crucified.

A play depends upon, as any Drama 101 course will tell you, on what is called "the willing suspension of disbelief". In other words, the audience must somehow believe in what they are seeing on the stage. In the case of *Corpus Christi*, they must believe that the thirteen actors dressed in khakis and white dress shirts, moving on an empty black stage, are really Christ and his disciples

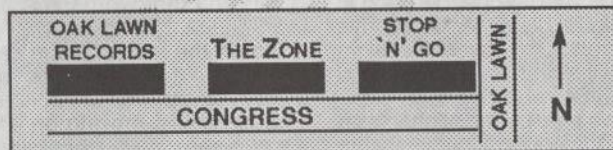

enacting the Passion. McNally recognizes the difficulty, and even has one of the actors mention it. In a brief speech at the beginning of the performance, he asks the audience to go along with it. It's a strange thing for a playwright to do, anticipating a problem like that, and in a way, daring the audience. It's risky.

Did it work? To be quite frank, I resisted it. I found myself thinking, "I'm not going to go along just because you ask me to. You're going to have to convince me." But then, much to my surprise, I found myself being taken in. Not entirely, but there were moments when the emotion of the piece got to me, and in the end, I was moved. Maybe that was enough.

And what about all the controversy? Is this play, as the opposing faction would have you believe, blasphemous? Is it sacrilegious? The answer is, of course, in the eye of the beholder, but for me, the answer is "no". It's a dramatic and straight-forward re-telling of an old story from a different perspective, and that's enough to upset some people. There are plenty of groups within a stone's throw of Little Room who would happily have thrown a

few, had they been aware of what was going on. Fortunately, their attention appears to be elsewhere this week.

The cast of *Corpus Christi* is for the most part attractive and competent, as overloaded with stage business as they are. Kent A. Davidson as "Joshua" is appealing and vulnerable. Matt Joseph as his nemesis, "Judas", is smarmy and snide. Other stand-outs in the sometimes bewildering array of characterizations were Ricky Catter as "Peter" and Tye Blue as "Simon". Director Richard Laub handled the material well. When I read *Corpus Christi*, my first question when I had finished was, "Why did McNally write this play?" I couldn't answer the question then, and I can't answer it now. And that's the problem. I can't find a motivation, and without that, it all becomes just an interesting experiment. Filling, but not satisfying.

THE WIZARD OF MONTROSE

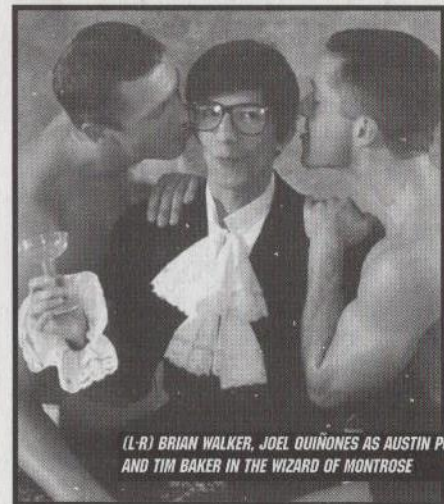
EPISODE I: THE FAIRY MENACE

In the eleven years since its inception, Halloween Magic has raised over \$500,000 for Houston AIDS charities. Halloween Magic began in 1988 as a series of private dinner parties held in the homes of individuals to raise money for Houston AIDS charities. In 1991, a group of dedicated volunteers in Houston's HIV Community, spearheaded by Roger Aucoin, decided that they wanted to put on a show and the first Halloween Magic theatrical production was staged as a culmination to the round of dinner parties. *The Roxie Horror Beauty Shop*, a breathless combination of *The Rocky Horror Picture Show*, *Steel Magnolias* and *Little Shop of Horrors*, had its world premiere at the newly renovated Majestic Metro Theater in downtown Houston. In 1992, *Hair Wars*, a sequel to *Roxie Horror* inspired by the movie *Star Wars*, was performed at the Metropolitan Multi-Service Center. *The Sound of Montrose* debuted in 1993 and *The Phantom of Montrose* in 1994—with both productions being staged at the Edwin Hornberger Conference Center in the Texas Medical Center.

The recipe for success for Halloween Magic theatrical productions was quickly established: take a popular musical, film, or play; re-write the lyrics of famous show personalities; and bring to a boil over a flame of hot camp humor. A small army of dedicated volunteers returns each year donating countless hours in preparation for Halloween Magic: writing the script, rehearsing the production, working backstage, organizing the logistics of the event, and soliciting donations and underwriting. Over the years, Halloween Magic has emerged as one of the most popular social

events in the Montrose community, attracting over 800 attendees in 1998.

Halloween Magic productions have featured the work of some of the most talented members of the Bayou City's theater community: director Robin

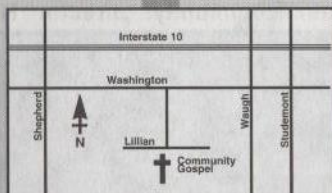
Robinson (who staged Main Street Theater's acclaimed production of *Into the Woods*); and the actors Jimmy Phillips (who won acclaim for his comic portrayal in *Box Office of the Damned* at Theater Lab Houston), Paul Nicely (*The Rink*), Jessica Calvello (*The Tragic and Horrible Life of the Singing Nun*), and Jennifer Doctorovich (*Assassins*).
