





People are always asking me what I like to listen to. And to be honest, I really do enjoy everything. Over the years what we call Dance Music has evolved and become so stylistically convoluted that it's often difficult to keep up with everything that's going on and even more so to describe that various genres and subgenres.

I know that, depending on where you live, the

nomenclature can be a bit askew at times. For example, often when I am in the booth somewhere in the South, a person will come up and ask for say the "techno" mix of a Mariah Carey record. And I don't know how anyone can possibly used the term techno in the same sentence with Mariah Carey. Techno as a genre of music has been over since about 1995 or 6. While there may be offshoots such as Trance, or techno-flavored remixes floating around on certain records, or Tech-house, techno as a genre is pretty much over with and has been for about a decade. I also find that many people who will request hip-hop are in actuality wanting to hear R&B.

At any rate, this week we are going to talk about one of my favorite genres of Dance Music, Soulful House. Some call it Deep House or Garage Music. Straight up HOUSE MUSIC is a further development of Disco and is the musical core of today's dance music and was really pioneered in the gay underground of Chicago and NYC in the 80's. DEEP HOUSE backs up its 4/4 sound with layer upon layer of synths and samples, born out of the House movement, often with Jazz-like subtones that stays away from the poppiness of some mainstream House music. And GARAGE is spedup Deep House music. The name comes from the



Paradise Garage club in New York where the sound was pioneered. Garage was an important step in the development of Drum 'n' Bass. Its characteristics are lots of bass, vocals, keyboards and sometimes even violins. These days Garage is extremely popular in the UK and amongst those whom I consider to have excellent taste here in the US!

All that being said I want to share with you one of my favorite "boutique" record labels here in the US, GLIDESLOPE MUSIC. Launched in October 2002, Glideslope Music made an instant

impression by gaining massive worldwide attention from its debut release "Daydreamin" by Bravo Mike. The intense support received from the wide spectrum of DJ's made up of bedroom jocks to some of the top internationally known headliners put the label on the map. Promising to be a home for thoughtful deep house, the label is a presence made up

of soothing and soulful sounds meshed with a modern tech edge to it.

Brian McDermott

Glideslope's founder, Brian McDermott is no stranger to the music arena. Having worn many hats in the industry, some of his credentials include editing and producing for Ultra Records, King Street Records, Strictly Rhythm Records, Todd Terry, Benn Watt, Mousse T, Boris Dlugosch, Ananda Project, Masters At Work, Ultra Nate and Joi Cardwell.

Over the past 4 years, Glideslope Music has consistently put out quality releases that have only expanded the label's visibility and caliber.



As of late, Glideslope Music scored big success with their release "Do It" by Cosmic Belt, which has caught the ears of the global DJ elite and has been licensed to Ministry Of Sound. In addition, GSM has licensed out various

other titles to several labels around the world including Stealth Records for Roger Sanchez's Release Yourself 5 compilation due out any day.

We were privy this week to be able to hear the latest 3 releases from our pals at the label. Monica Lynk's new single "Without You" comes with a ton or mixes to satisfy anyone's taste, plus the new Cosmic Belt record "Time Flies," and this wonderful EP from The Blacklight Society "The Friscoteque EP."

So if you don't want to be caught listening to the same ol' commercial stuff that everyone else is listening to, do yourself a favor and log onto beatport.com and do a label search for Glideslope...we're certain you'll be glad you did!





on his new card and gift shop in San Antonio; Sabrina Ross passing along her bejewelled headdress to
