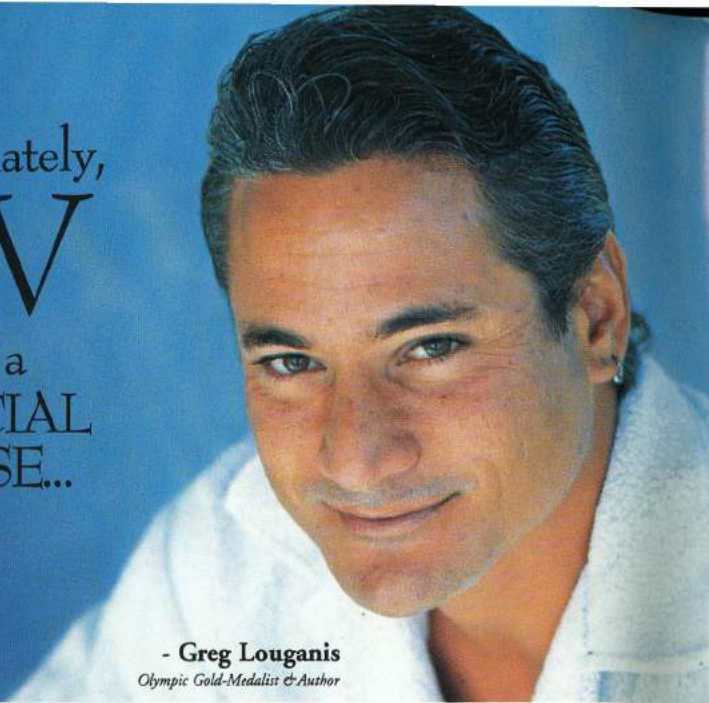

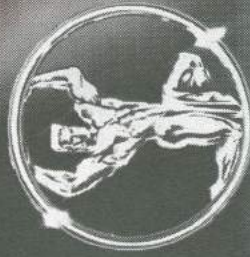

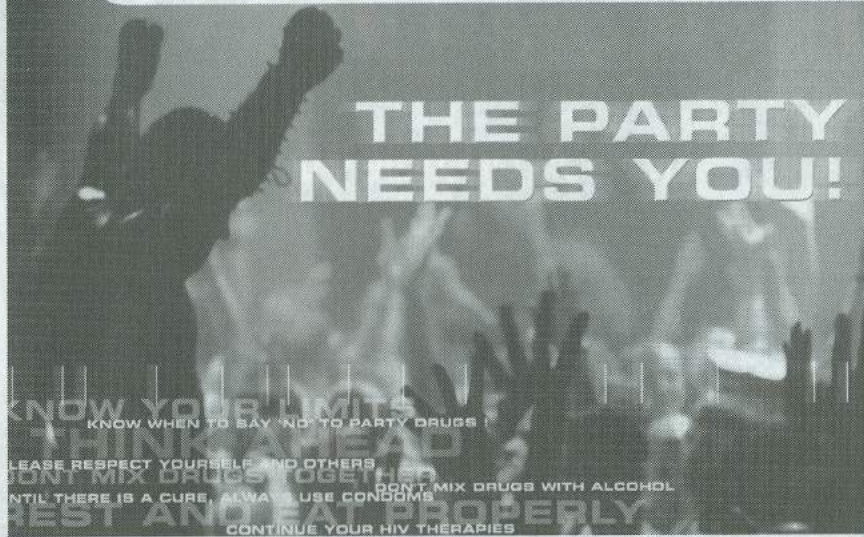

Two, Four, Six, Eight. Name One Thing Worse Than Being Straight.

The new film *But I'm A Cheerleader* sure fits the bill. And perhaps eating rats on *Survivor*, but that's where I draw the line. OK, truth be told, I have nothing against heterosexuals, but I was pressed for a rhyme and the word fit the theme of the movie. So, please no "stopstevenlindsey.com" sites or "biological error" protests outside my house. I can accept the "breeder" lifestyle choice, but I don't have to agree with it.

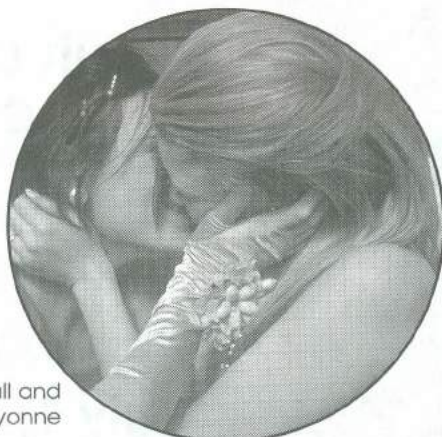
Getting back to the point of this review, I hate to say that what could've been a potentially classic gay comedy is nothing more than a transparently packaged gimmick flick. That's not to say that it doesn't have its redeeming qualities, but it does

supply a positive argument for test screenings and other methods of committee-style movie making. I'm the last person to promote the compromising of an artist's vision, but I'll discuss the negatives a few paragraphs from now. After all, I always look for the silver lining. Even if it's tarnished. Plated. And (gasp) second-hand.

I'm the first to admit that the movie's concept is the stuff of which great satire is made. There's a trendy topic, a clearly identified villain and just enough stunt casting to rival the next *Love Boat* reunion movie. At the film's center is Megan (Natasha Lyonne), a cheerleader and all-around popular girl whose friends and family conduct an intervention, genuinely con-

cerned about her apparent lesbianism. Fortunately, there's a homosexual rehab camp, True Directions, very nearby. There, Megan meets Graham (Clea Duvall) and begins to doubt being straight herself. At the helm of the conversion center is Mary (Cathy Moriarty) and her ex-gay assistant, Mike (RuPaul Charles). Together, they put the gay boys and girls through a multiple-step program to unleash their raging heteros within. If they succeed, they "graduate", their families accept and love them again, and all is right with the world.

Sounds promising, eh? Well, the movie



does start out strong with some genuinely funny, inspired moments (Lyonne's kissing scene with her boyfriend is priceless). But as each conversion step is proudly trumpeted between scenes, it becomes increasingly apparent that this is a one-joke story. The stakes are raised at each level, but it's all just variations on a theme. The girls are always doing '50s-era girlie things like vacuuming and cleaning. The boys are taught to play football and change oil. Ha-ha once, but yawn-yawn the thirtieth time. Even the ending is an anticlimactic bore. With so many great finale options just ripe for the picking, the filmmakers take the easy way out with an abrupt, predictable closing. This is what I referred to earlier when I wrote about test screenings, etc. Had a gay audience (like the one I was in at Fort Worth's Q2K Gay & Lesbian Film Festival where I viewed *Cheerleader*) been given a chance to comment on the film, I think some noticeable improvements could've been made.

For one, there is no closure on any of the characters other than Megan and Graham. Secondly, part of the premise is

just completely absurd. One of the camp's rules is that the kids are sent home if they are caught in any homosexual behavior. What kind of punishment is that? It just doesn't make sense in the realm of social commentary this film is attempting to portray.

In the starring roles, Duvall and Lyonne do wonders with the material, becoming the only two characters to really transcend the stereotypical Jell-O molds in which the others were congealed. As an ex-gay, lusting after Mary's hunky son, RuPaul is good, but a complete waste of obvious stunt casting. Moriarty went to the Cruella De Vil School of Villainy, so expect lots of hammy overacting. If only she had a handlebar mustache to curl as she chastises the campers for their queer thoughts and actions.

The movie also sports a vividly colored, campy influence in its art direction that seems desperate to evoke the style and personality of a Tim Burton film, except with a very small budget. This approach isn't problematic at all. In fact, it's rather admirable that the filmmakers did such a good job creating an overly sanitized gender-role-specific environment for their characters to play around in. However, as the movie climaxes, the personality and energy derived from the whimsical sets is whisked away in favor of a washed-out, colorless outdoor sequence. At least it fits the action.

So, all in all, *But I'm A Cheerleader* is like a three-person pyramid. The basic structure is there, but there's not enough to make us cheer. My pom-poms have gone limp.

But I'm A Cheerleader opens in select cities today, with wider releases throughout the month. Check your local listings for more information.

DEPRESSION

This past week, I have had the pleasure of receiving some very intimate and personal e-mail from many of you. I'm honored that some of you, in some way, felt touched by my "Personal Pride" column last week. Thanks for being able and willing to share your experiences with me (I'll be reprinting some of those letters in an upcoming issue). For those of you who missed it, the story was about one of my dysfunctional relationships and the experience I had of discovering just how unhealthy it was for me. I also talked about my journey towards examining my own "head" and healing myself so that I would be able, in the future, to have a healthy relationship with someone I loved. I remember that there were times throughout my adult life, for one reason or another, that I had experienced feelings of depression and despair. That awful feeling of not being able to crawl out of a depressed "black-hole" or a dark, deep ditch (a description most depressed people express). Although never debilitating for me, and somewhat infrequent, I can relate to those who experience bouts of depression. I also understand the state of being depressed and not knowing it, a more common occurrence than you would think. Depression is caused by different factors and has been diagnosed in different ways. Studies now reveal that it affects approximately 25 percent of all women and 12 percent of all men in America.

Bi-polar depression, or disorder, also known as manic depressed disorder, is treatable. It involves major mood swings

from overly high peaks to hopelessness and back again with periods of normal mood swings in-between. I lived with this disorder for a year with a past partner who was diagnosed as bi-polar. Let me tell you, it was not an easy experience. One minute he was up, the next, way down. If I looked at him wrong, he would go into a deep funk, sit on the couch for two days and watch TV. He would not eat, speak or do anything remotely human, until he came out of his very own "dark-hole" (we talked about that before). It is estimated that at least 2 million Americans suffer from this illness. It often runs in families and can be disruptive to family members and spouses, not to mention the person with the illness. Some of the warning signs you need to look for, if you think you may have this illness, are: 1) Persistent sad, anxious or

empty mood swings. 2) Feeling helpless, guilty or worthless. 3) Hopeless or pessimistic feelings. 4) Loss of pleasure in usual activities. 5) Decreased energy. 6) Irritability or restlessness. 7) Sleep disturbance. 8) Loss of appetite. 9) Thoughts about death. All of these symptoms, or one of them, may be telling you, or someone you love, that they may have bi-polar depression. Treatment, as I said earlier, is available. I'll give you some helpful phone numbers later.

Reactive and grief related depression occurs when you experience gloom, sadness or other depressive feelings that go beyond what we might call normal. When we experience loss of a loved one, a divorce or a serious illness, we all naturally may feel bereaved. These feelings are quite normal and only represent a problem when they persist for a long period of time, seem extraordinarily intense and/or continue to get worse. If you experience light bouts of reactive or grief-related depression, a therapist may make things easier for you. However, if you delve into a deep dark hole, then seek the help of a psychiatrist. They are the only ones that should be prescribing anti-depressant medications to you. Then, of course, there is general depression. This affects roughly 17.6 million Americans each year and can be described as long term, profound and constant sense of hopelessness and despair. The mood of a depressed person may be unrelated to the events unfolding in front of them. They are depressed regardless of good news. As I said before, this feeling is described as falling into a deep dark ditch that continues to get deeper and darker. Convinced they cannot crawl their way out of this hole, they continue to dig deeper with ever occurrence in life. Depression affects mood, thought, body and behavior. It is sometimes called a whole body illness because of its debilitating effects. Here are the signs to look for if you or someone you love is depressed. 1) Persistent, sad, anxious, or empty moods. 2) Loss of interest in sex. 3) Restlessness, irritability, or excessive crying. 4) Feelings of guilt, worthlessness, helplessness, hopelessness, pes-

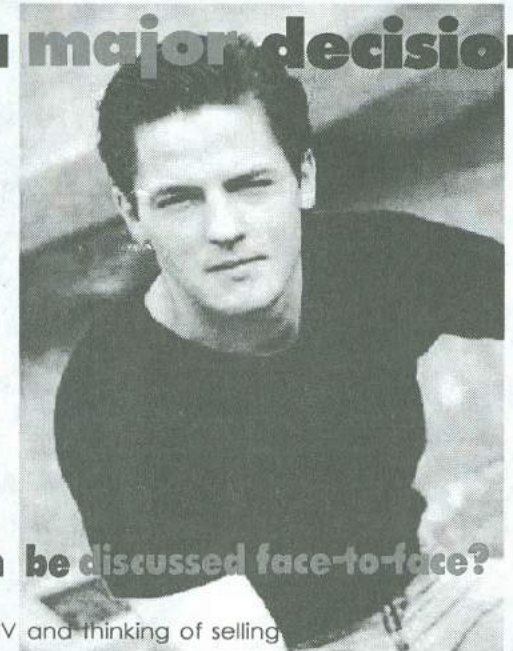
simism. 5) Sleeping too much or too little, early morning awakenings. 6) Appetite and/or weight loss, overeating and weight gain. 7) Decreased energy, fatigue, and feelings of being slowed down. 8) Thoughts of death or suicide attempts. 9) Difficulty concentrating, remembering, or making decisions. 10) Persistent physical symptoms that do not respond to treatment like headaches, digestive disorders and chronic pain.

It must be said that one or two of these symptoms does not mean you are depressed, however, if you have many of these symptoms, you may need to see a doctor. It is preferable to see a psychiatrist who deals with these disorders on a daily basis. A general practitioner can prescribe anti-depressants, but it is always advisable to seek out a specialist for any specific illness that requires specific types of medication. Depression can also occur as a side to a recent illness. Depression occurs in 10 to 27% of stroke survivors. One in four people who have cancer experience depression. Depression affects 70% of diabetics who experience diabetic complications. 40 to 65% of patients with heart disease will experience some form of depression. And many people living with AIDS will at one time or another experience disease related depression. Here again, you need to seek out a professional for help. A therapist can help in many instances. If you need more than the psychotherapy a therapist can provide, then they can refer you to a psychiatrist who can prescribe anti-depressants.

Help is also available, if you are willing to reach out and get healthy, by calling The National Depressive and Manic Depressive Association at 1-800-826-3632. The National Alliance for the Mentally Ill can be reached at 1-800-950-6264. The National Mental Health Association can be found at 1-800-433-5959. These organizations can help you as well as refer you to some local therapists and psychiatrists. As always, I wish you the best in your quest for the best for yourself!

It may shock you to learn, that I have never truly enjoyed the satisfaction of animal ownership. This is due, in large part, to the fact that I am not the most responsible individual on the planet and have felt, until recently, that having a cat or dog would only result in that animal's quick and untimely demise. For instance, I did own a cat for two days when I lived in San Antonio. Best friend and much-loved drag diva Victoria West gave me a beautifully marked kitten, prior to moving to Dallas several years ago, but the feline either made a risky escape from my third floor apartment balcony or smuggled herself out in a laundry cart. my dog may be of the male persuasion, he is, undoubtedly, a bitch. Another perfect example of Harley's "new attitude" occurred yesterday, when I was in the process of interviewing comedienne Margaret Cho.

Margaret Cho. The Margaret Cho. She of the infamous impersonations of her Korean mother and the wonderful, albeit brief, television sitcom *All-American Girl*. I had interviewed her 'pre-Harley', some months ago, when she toured through Texas in her stand-up show *I'm The One That I Want*. 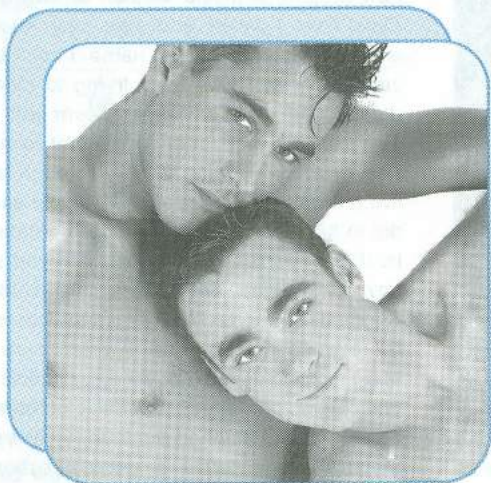
Yes, I felt that Margaret Cho was more important. No, I wasn't amused.
