Arteries, Walking & Triglycerides

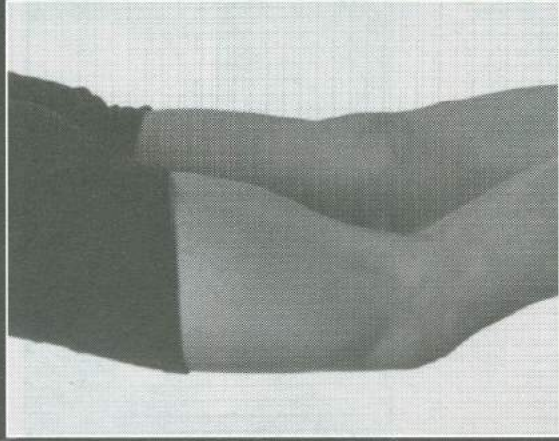
I'm sure that it's no secret to you that staying physically active can reduce the risk of heart disease. Now, the results of a new study suggest that the benefits of exercise can prevent the age-related deterioration of blood vessels. According to the studies author, Dr. Stefano Taddei, of the University of Pisa in Italy, the lining of the blood vessels, known as endothelium, plays an important role in the cardiovascular system (the study was found in the June 27th issue of *Circulation: Journal of the American Heart Association*). The endothelium produces a chemical called nitric oxide, which signals the blood vessels to relax when the heart needs more blood. The study found that older folks who are athletic tend to have much healthier blood vessels than their sedentary peers. In fact, the study indicated that a 60 year old who exercises daily, could have the arteries of a 40 year old.

Hardening of the arteries, a common disease in older folks can lead to blood clots that may occur if the endothelium begins to deteriorate. This could possibly lead to stroke and heart disease. The study indicated that exercise could keep the endothelium in shape by ensuring that it produces enough nitric oxide. In the study, Dr. Taddei and colleagues tested blood vessel functioning in 12 men (average age 37) and 12 men (average age 63) who were sedentary. Also, he tested 11 men (average age 37) and 14 men (average age 63) who were athletic. The athletic ones were long distance runners, cyclists or triathletes. All participants were



on the studies findings, "it would be wise for everyone to practice regular physical activity as much as possible. Jogging, cycling, swimming or tennis, or brisk walking for at least 30 minutes five times a week." Walking is a great way to get a good cardiovascular workout. But most people who use walking for their main form of exercise do not do it frequently or fast enough to gain real health benefits (according to a report released by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention).

The Surgeon General's office recommends walking 30 minutes with moderate intensity every day of the week. After a telephone interview of 7,600 Americans, the CDC discovered some interesting information from folks who use walking as their main source of physical activity. Although about of the walkers adhered to the recommendations by walking a minimum of 30 minutes at a time, only about a third walked at least four times a week and only a quarter walked with enough speed



to qualify as a brisk walk. Thus, the study found that a mere six percent of walkers met the health-related recommendations by walking at least 30 minutes per session, four or more times a week, at 3.5 or more

miles per hour.

The CDC suggests that if you walk for exercise do it briskly and frequently for maximum benefit. Cardiovascular exercise has been proven to prevent heart disease. It can also lower triglyceride levels in the blood. Triglycerides are a blood chemical that can raise the risks of dying from a heart attack. "The chemical raises a person's risk of dying even if your blood cholesterol levels are normal," says Dr. Melissa Austin, professor of epidemiology at the University of Washington who lead a research project published in *Circulation: Journal of the American Heart Association*. Triglyceride levels above 200 milligrams per deciliter of blood are considered to be a risk. The heart association recommends these steps to reduce hypertriglyceridemia (the condition caused by having too much triglyceride in the blood). If you are overweight, cut down on calories to reach your ideal weight. Reduce the fat and cholesterol in your diet. Start and stick to a regular exercise program. Reduce the amount of alcohol you consume. Excessive use of alcohol raises the levels of some fats in the blood and can lead to hypertriglyceridemia. Heavy drinking has been linked to stroke, high blood pressure and heart failure.

The findings on triglycerides are a result of a 20-year study conducted by the heart association. Researchers monitored 100 families to find possible genetic links between primary relatives, siblings and offspring for heart disease. The study found that people had a 70 percent greater risk of getting heart disease if their relatives had elevated triglyceride levels. "Now that we know that too many triglycerides can be harmful, our next step is to do more research to see if lowering them with medication works," says Dr. Austin the studies author. She stressed, "Until then, the best thing for people to do is exercise and maintain a proper diet."
