





TWT caught up with Jeffrey Payne and his husband David Roy who have been tirelessly promoting Mr. International Leather since Jeffrey won the title at IML XXXI in May. Since then he has spent nearly every weekend at leather events around the U.S. and abroad promoting the competition and lifestyle.

Tell us the impetus behind founding The Sharon St. Cyr Fund.

David and I began the program "Hearing from the Heart" with The Sharon St. Cyr Fund, Inc. to raise money to assist individuals within our community who are hearing impaired with the purchase of hearing aids. Our first project has been the 2010 International Mr. Leather #31 calendars and sales are going extremely well; however, the requests for assistance is higher than we ever anticipated and they do not look like they will slow down. In response to this, David and I are issuing the "1000 in 25 Challenge" to our community; 1000 calendars sold in 25 days. As a community, when we make this goal, 8 individuals, at minimum, will be provided with a hearing aid before Christmas.

How many people are affected by hearing loss?

31 million Americans suffer from hearing loss. vet 24 million are without hearing aids. Hearing aids are not usually covered by medical insurance companies. With the cost for one hearing aid \$1,500 to \$2,500, most people are not able to make the purchase. David and I spent \$5,000 on my hearing aids, and whereas we are fortunate that we had the money to make the purchase, there are plenty of individuals within our own community who are not able to make this purchase. Studies have shown that persons who wear hearing aids are able to hear for longer periods of time before losing their hearing entirely. Think of it as a "use it or lose it" situation. The daily use of hearing aids enables a person whose hearing loss is inevitable to hear for a longer period of time; if a person does not use hearing aids, a person loses their hearing more rapidly. The sooner we get people fitted with a hearing aid, the

sooner we can help them potentially offset their hearing loss.

I know what it is like to slowly hear the world go a little quieter every day. I relish the moments when I hear my husband, my friends and my community tell me they love me. That is why this project is so important to me. I want everyone to hear those words as long as they possibly can hear them.

Pictures are worth a thousand words, but tell us about your calendar.

Yes, pictures indeed say a tremendous amount don't they! I first have to admit that it was outside of my comfort zone. It's one thing to have photo's taken of me for an article or as a portrait; however, posing for 12 photos and knowing they will appear on a calendar and hanging on someones wall is odd for me. However, working with Brett (the photographer) made it a great experience and knowing that the money raised by doing this project is definitely worth it. And this is a calendar we will work to do on a yearly basis in order to promote the cause and help those persons within our community with hearing impairments.

So people can help by just buying a calendar?

Yes!! realize that 1000 calendars may seem like a lot of calendars and \$20 may seem like a lot of money for a calendar. And yes, this is the part where Sally Struthers would usually talk about how "For a cup of coffee a day you can sponsor a child" and then parade all the little children around her and say, "Do it for the children". I'm not going to do that. I will parade hot leathermen and leatherwomen around me though, but that has nothing to do with the selling of calendars. That's another fund raiser.



Calendars can be ordered online or through the mail. I know our community has 1000 individuals that are able to spend \$20. Maybe at this time it isn't you and that is understandable. But do you know of someone that is able and willing? Forward this information to them in an email and send them a link to http://www.lML2009.com/chanties.htm. If they do not want to pay with a credit card, they can mail a check made out to "The Sharon St. Cyr Fund Inc." to 2641 Heatherwood Drive, Dallas TX 75228. And why stop at only one person? The more we sell, the more hearing aids we are able to purchase and the more people we are able to assist.

Thank you.

And I thank everyone that has already stepped forward to support this cause and I thank you for helping me get the word out.



28. We chatted with Henrichsen about the party, his dance music retail site Masterbeat.com, and even more importantly how on earth he managed to build those abs of steel.

What does a song require to be a dance floor hit today?

Every hit has to have some kind of melody, journey and a climax that drives the floor crazy. A diva vocal screaming about joy, happiness, or breakup doesn't hurt either!

Where do you find your beats?

Um, Masterbeat com of course. I try to devote a few hours a week to going through all of the new music that pours in each week.

For those that don't know, Masterbeat.com is your baby. It's essentially an i-Tunes for dance music.

Why did the dance music need its own i-Tunes?

iTunes is very mainstream consumer oriented. They don't carry all of the extended remixes that are released by the labels for every title or artist and they also carry a rather low-quality audio file. Even though they just upgraded their audio, Masterbeat carries full 320kbps MP3's and will soon have WAV (completely lossless) files from the major labels – being the first DSP to carry lossless. This is important for DJ's and audiophiles who want the best sounding file they can get.

What tracks are available on Masterbeat that are not available on i-Tunes? Great examples are recent remix packages from U2 and Lady Gaga. iTunes will have 3 or 4 remixes, usually the radio edits, and we have 10-12 remixes of each release, and they are the full extended (8-11 minute) DJ versions you hear in the club.

What's the hottest track right now?
