**METRO BUSES ARE NOW
"SAFE HAVENS"**

METRO's Transit On Watch program introduces a new feature. Each bus is now a "safe haven" for people in trouble. Anytime you are in trouble and a bus drives by, you can board it and get help. Don't worry about not having change or that the bus is not going your way. The bus driver can call for help on the two-way radio in his or her bus.

Other METRO vehicles with a radio such as staff pool cars, transit police cars and maintenance trucks are also "safe havens". All METRO operators have been instructed on how to keep their eyes and ears open for crimes in progress and to report emergencies over their two-way radio.

So, if you find yourself in an unsafe situation, remember that a METRO bus is a safe place.

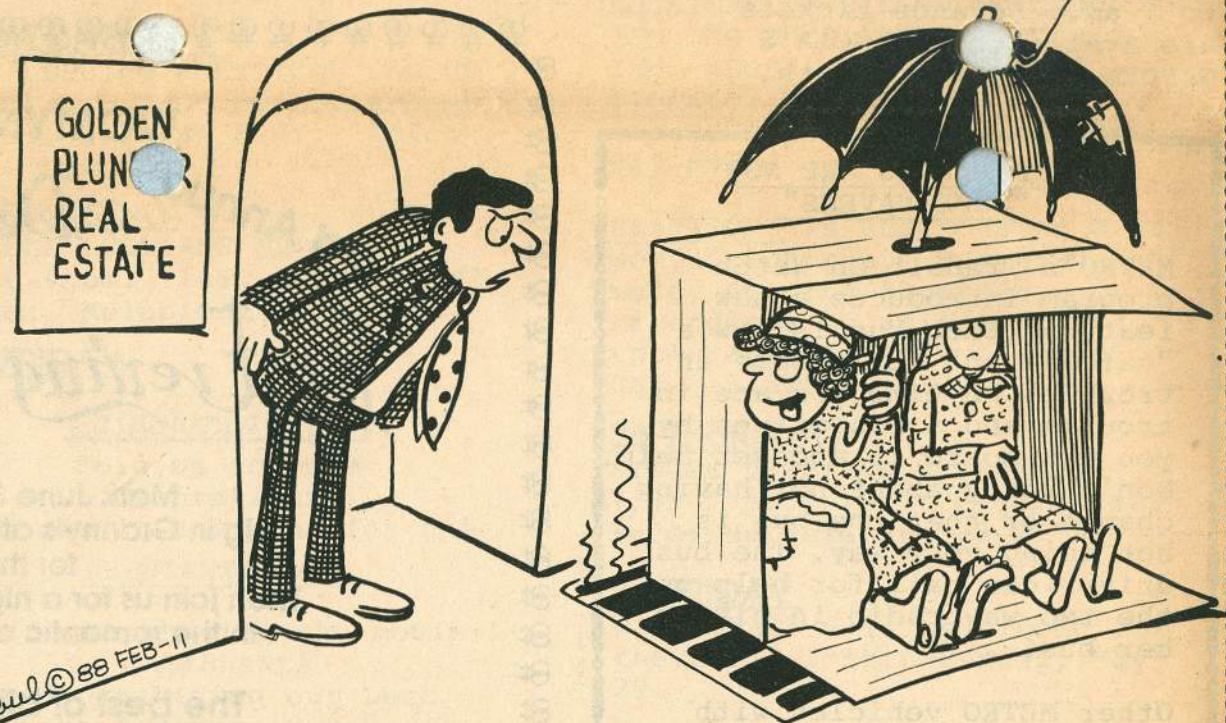

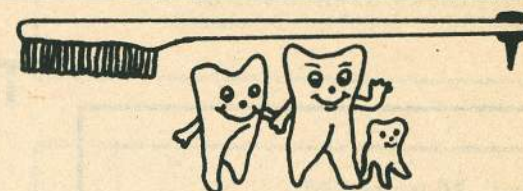
